Redhawks Open OVC Play

Southeast Missouri (5-8) opens Ohio Valley Conference play at Murray State (10-2) Thursday. Tip-off is set for 7 p.m., CT at the CFSB Center.

Series History

Southeast Missouri and Murray State meet for the 84th time Thursday. MSU leads the all-time series by a count of 62-21. The Racers have won eight-straight against the Redhawks. SEMO last beat MSU in Murray on Jan. 26, 2017 (75-74). The Racers and Redhawks meet again in the final game of the 2021-22 regular season on Feb. 26 in Cape Girardeau.

OVC Openers

The Redhawks are 10-20 in Ohio Valley Conference openers. This year marks the fourth-straight where Southeast Missouri begins league play on the road. SEMO is in its 31st season as a member of the OVC.

Redhawks at the CFSB Center

Southeast Missouri has the most wins over Murray State at the CFSB Center of any opponent. SEMO beat the Racers a total of six times in that facility with its last victory coming there on Jan. 26, 2017 (75-74).

Non-Conference is Done

Southeast Missouri wrapped up its 13-game non-conference schedule with an 84-68 road loss at California Baptist (Dec. 21). The Redhawks dropped six of their last eight games against non-league foes.

Four-Game Skid

The Redhawks are looking to snap a four-game losing streak when they begin Ohio Valley Conference action this week. Southeast Missouri fell to Purdue Fort Wayne (Dec. 11), Southern Illinois (Dec. 15), Pepperdine (Dec. 18) and California Baptist (Dec. 21). All four of those matchups were on the road. Three of those losses were by double-digits.

SEMO Faces OVC Leader Murray State

Southeast Missouri opens Ohio Valley Conference play with a tough test when it faces league leader Murray State. MSU was picked to finish third in this year's OVC Preseason Poll, one spot ahead of Southeast Missouri. The Racers are tied for first in the league with 10 wins and had won seven in a row prior to their 71-58 loss to Auburn.

California Recap

Southeast Missouri went 0-2 during its road trip to California with losses to Pepperdine (Dec. 18) and California Baptist (Dec. 21). SEMO squared off against each of those teams for the first time in its program history. In all, the Redhawks have played 14 of California's NCAA Division I schools.

Top Scorer

After a strong California road trip, redshirt-freshman Phillip Russell moved to first on the team in scoring with 14.6 points per game. Russell led Southeast Missouri with a career-high 25 points at Pepperdine (Dec. 18) and followed that up with 17 at California Baptist (Dec. 21). He shot 15-of-27 (55.5 pct.) from the field and 7-of-14 (50 pct.) from 3-point range in those contests. Russell is one of three Redhawks averaging double figures in scoring heading into Ohio Valley Conference play. Eric Reed, Jr. (14.3 ppg) and Chris Harris (11.4 ppg) are the others.

Russell Picks Up Second OVC Freshman of the Week Honor

Point guard Phillip Russell picked up his second Ohio Valley Conference Freshman of the Week award on Dec. 20. A native of St. Louis, Russell averaged 17.5 points, two rebounds, two assists and two steals per game in two starts. He also shot 50 percent (13-of-26) from the field and 42.9 percent (6-of-14) from 3-point range. He scored a career-high 25 points (20 in the second half) and buried a season-best four 3-pointers at Pepperdine (Dec. 18). Murray State's Tevin Brown (Player) and UT Martin's KJ Simon (Newcomer) completed the week's honorees.

Welcome Back Sam

After missing eight games with an ankle sprain, Sam Thompson made a nice return at Pepperdine (Dec. 18). Thompson scored 13 points on a near-perfect 6-of-6 field goals in 23 minutes off the bench. He added three rebounds, as well in his first double-digit scoring performance as a Redhawk. Thompson then returned to the starting lineup for the first time since Nov. 19 when he took the court at California Baptist (Dec. 21).

OVC Time

Murray State (10-2), Belmont (10-3) and Morehead State (8-5) are the three teams with winning records heading into the start of Ohio Valley Conference play. The first OVC game will be on Wednesday with four other matchups to follow on Thursday. All 10 teams will be in action New Year's Day.

I Double Dare You

Nygal Russell collected his team-high second double-double of the season with 15 points and 10 rebounds at Pepperdine (Dec. 18). Russell shot 5-of-9 from the field with three of his makes coming from 3-point range. Russell leads the Redhawks and ranks fourth in the Ohio Valley Conference in rebounding (7.3 rpg).

Last Time Out

Southeast Missouri led for just 6:39 during an 84-68 loss to California Baptist (Dec. 21). SEMO was ahead by five points on three occasions early in the first half, but that was it. Phillip Russell led the Redhawks with 17 points, while Chris Harris followed with 16 off the bench. Eric Reed, Jr. added 11 points in SEMO's fifth double-digit loss of the season.

Strong Shooting

For the third time this season, Southeast Missouri shot over 50 percent when it made 30-of-57 field goals at a 52.6 percent clip at Pepperdine (Dec. 18). The .526 mark is SEMO's second-best field goal percentage of the season. The Redhawks also shot 57.1 percent at Missouri State (Nov. 9) and 51.9 percent vs. Evansville (Dec. 8). SEMO lost for the first time

this season when it shot over 50 percent from the floor (at Pepperdine).

See You Next Year

The Redhawks posted a thrilling 75-73 win over Missouri Valley Conference member Evansville (Dec. 8) in its final home game of 2021. Southeast Missouri won't be in Cape Girardeau again until it hosts Austin Peay on New Year's Day.

Redhawks Second in the OVC in Free Throw Percentage

Southeast Missouri is second in the Ohio Valley Conference with a .736 free throw percentage. SEMO made 184-of-250 free throws through its first 13 games this season. The Redhawks also attempted an average of 19.2 free throws per game during that stretch. SEMO has made and attempted more free throws than anyone else in the league thus far. Two Redhawks, Eric Reed, Jr. (3rd, .786) and Chris Harris (4th, .784) are among the top five free throw shooters in the OVC.

On the Road

Southeast Missouri lost four-straight road games and is 2-6 outside of Cape Girardeau this season. SEMO holds a 2-4 record in true road contests. Thursday marks the end of a season-long five-game road stretch for the Redhawks.

Career Night for the Russells

Point guard Phillip Russell poured in a career-high 24 points and forward Nygal Russell added a career-best 15 rebounds in

Southeast Missouri's win over Evansville (Dec. 8). P. Russell shot 10-of-16 from the field, knocked down a pair of 3-pointers, dished out four assists and had two steals, while N. Russell grabbed 11 of his boards in the first half. All 15 of his rebounds came on the defensive end.

Turnover Low

The Redhawks matched a season-low eight turnovers in their latest outing at California Baptist (Dec. 21). Southeast Missouri is averaging just under 13 (12.9) turnovers per game through 13 contests this season.

Home Winning Streak

Southeast Missouri is presently on a threegame home winning streak after beating Missouri Baptist (71-63, Nov. 22), Webster (76-64, Dec. 4) and Evansville (75-73, Dec. 8). SEMO is on its first winning streak of three or more games since 2016-17.

Gritty Win

Short-handed Southeast Missouri pulled out a gritty two-point win over Evansville (Dec. 8). SEMO played the Purple Aces with only eight available players and did not have its leading scorer (Eric Reed, Jr.) due to illness. The Redhawks assisted 15 of their 28 made field goals and made a near-perfect 12-of-13 free throws in the game.

On the Rebound

The Redhawks outrebounded Evansville (Dec. 8) by a count of 37-31. Southeast Missouri had been outrebounded for seven-straight games prior to that contest. It marked just the second time this season that SEMO won the battle of the boards.

Strong 3-Point Defense

Southeast Missouri held Evansville to a season-low 11 three-pointers made. UE, which leads the Missouri Valley Conference with 104 three-pointers made, shot just 29.7 percent (11-of-37) from long range against the Redhawks.

Every Game Starter

Phillip Russell is the only player who has started every game for the Redhawks this season. Russell enters the week as Southeast Missouri's leading scorer with 14.6 points a game. He has scored double figures in 11 of his starts and ranks fourth in the Ohio Valley Conference with a .443 (27-of-61) three-point field goal percentage.

Redhawks Down Webster

The Redhawks picked up their fourth win of the season with a 76-64 victory over Webster (Dec. 4). Southeast Missouri's 12-point win was its largest of the season thus far. SEMO also extended its winning streak against non-Division I opponents to 32-straight.

December Finale

Thursday's game marks Southeast Missouri's last in the month of December. The Redhawks are 2-4 in December and 5-8 overall two months into the 2021-22 campaign.

Reed, Jr. Reaches Season-Best

Eric Reed, Jr. recently reached a season-best 26 points to lead Southeast Missouri to its 76-64 win over Webster (Dec. 4). Reed, Jr. made 8-of-17 field goals with all but three of those makes coming from 3-point range. He finished with five of SEMO's six 3-pointers made in the contest. Reed, Jr. also hit 5-of-6 free throws, grabbed three rebounds, dished out four assists and added a block in 32 minutes against the Gorloks.

Free Throw Streak Ends at 21

Nygal Russell's free throw streak came to an end at 21-straight at California Baptist (Dec. 21). Russell missed the second of two shots 16:11 left in the first half. The miss was his first at the free throw line since Feb. 25, 2021 (at Eastern Illinois).

Patterson Notches Season-High

Manny Patterson narrowly missed a double-double when he dropped in a season-high 14 points and pulled down nine rebounds against Webster (Dec. 4). Patterson made 5-of-7 field goals in his second double-digit scoring game of the season. He scored a combined nine points in three starts prior to that performance.

Russell Nabs First OVC Freshman of the Week Award

Point guard Phillip Russell claimed the first Ohio Valley Conference Freshman of the Week honor of his career on Nov. 29. In four games, Russell averaged 17 points, three assists, 2.5 rebounds and 1.5 steals per contest. He shot 51.3 percent (20-of-39) from the field, 55.6 percent (10-of-18) from 3-point range and 72 percent (18-of-25) at the free throw line.

Harris Sinks Incarnate Word

Chris Harris made the first buzzer-beating shot of his career when he drained a 3-pointer to give Southeast Missouri a thrilling 79-76 win over Incarnate Word (Nov. 26). Tied, 76-76, Harris caught the inbounds pass from Dylan Branson and buried his long range 3-pointer

from the left side. Harris missed his first four 3-point attempts prior to his game-winner. For Harris, it was the second game-winning shot of his career. He also made a game-winning 3-pointer with 26 seconds left vs. Purdue Fort Wayne on Nov. 10, 2019.

20-Point Games

Redhawk players have accounted for six 20-point scoring games this season.

Eric Reed, Jr. scored 21 points at Missouri State (Nov. 9), 23 at Incarnate Word (Nov. 26) and 26 vs. Webster (Dec. 4), while Phillip Russell poured in 21 points vs. Montana State (Nov. 28), 24 vs. Evansville (Dec. 8) and 25 at Pepperdine (Dec. 18). Reed, Jr. has a team-high six 20-point games in his career.

Starting Combinations

The Redhawks have used seven different starting combinations through 13 games this year. Phillip Russell, Nygal Russell, Dylan Branson, Sam Thompson and Eric Reed, Jr. marked the seventh lineup when they took the court at California Baptist (Dec. 21). P. Russell, N. Russell, Reed, Jr., Dylan Branson and Patterson are 2-3 in five contests.

Shooting 3s

Southeast Missouri is shooting an average of 22.4 three-pointers per game this season. SEMO attempted a season-high 32 three-pointers vs. Webster (Dec. 4). The Redhawks 10 three-pointers made at Incarnate Word (Nov. 26), vs. Portland (Nov. 27) and at Pepperdine (Dec. 18) are their most in a game in 2021-22. SEMO is eighth in the Ohio Valley Conference in 3-point field goal percentage (.321).

Multiple Threes

Phillip Russell buried multiple 3-pointers in 10 of his last 13 starts. Russell finished with a season-high four 3-pointers made at Pepperdine (Dec. 18). His 27 three-pointers made lead the team. Eric Reed, Jr., who drained 24 treys this year, has posted two or more on seven occasions. His season-best is five made 3-pointers vs. Webster (Dec. 4).

First Home Win

Southeast Missouri picked up its first home win of the season with a 71-63 victory over Missouri Baptist (Nov. 22) prior to the

Thanksgiving holiday. SEMO overcame a 15-point first-half deficit and outscored MBU, 40-27, in the final 20 minutes.

Russell Nets Career-High

Freshman point guard Phillip Russell scored a career-best 18 points against Missouri Baptist (Nov. 22). Russell made 5-of-8 field goals and did not miss a 3-pointer going a 3-of-3 from long range. He also added 5-of-7 free throws, four steals and three assists. Russell has scored double figures in three-straight contests. He ranks third on the team in scoring with 11.3 points a game.

Keep it Up Reed

Guard Eric Reed, Jr. made a 3-pointer in 23 of his last 24 games dating back to last season. Reed, Jr. buried a 3-pointer in 22-straight contests before that streak came to an end at Pepperdine (Dec. 18). It was the first time he went without a made 3-pointer since the SIU Edwardsville game on Jan. 28, 2021.

Free Throw Difference

Opponents have shot 66 more free throws than Southeast Missouri through 13 games this year. As a result, opponents are outscoring the Redhawks by a +47 (231-184) margin at the charity stripe.

About Murray State

Murray State is a perfect 6-0 at home so far this season and has just two losses which came against East Tennessee State (Nov. 22) and Auburn (Dec. 22). The recent loss at Auburn ended the Racers seven-game winning streak. MSU has the Ohio Valley Conference's leading scorer in Tevin Brown who is averaging 19.2 points per game. KJ Williams is also among the league's top five scorers at fifth with 16.3 per contest. As a team, MSU leads the OVC in scoring (83.7 ppg) and is beating teams be a league-best +18.1 margin. The Racers are also first among OVC teams in field goal percentage (.503) and rebounding margin (+7.5).

Season-Opening Win

The Redhawks tipped off their 2021-22 campaign with a big 99-94 road win at Missouri Valley Conference foe Missouri State (Nov. 9). Southeast Missouri won a season-opener on the road in back-to-back

years for the first time in its NCAA Division I history. With a win Saturday, SEMO will start a season at 2-0 for the first time in 18 years. The Redhawks last 2-0 start was in 2003-04 and involved a win against a Horizon League team (63-62, vs. Green Bay).

High Scoring Affair

Southeast Missouri (99) and Missouri State (94) combined for 193 points in their season-opening slugfest on Nov. 9. The 99 points marked SEMO's most in a season-opener since it scored 120 in a win over Missouri Baptist on Nov. 19, 1990. Both the Redhawks and Bears also combined to shoot 69 free throws. SEMO made 27-of-34 and MSU hit 25-of-35.

Redhawks at Home

Southeast Missouri is 8-8 at home under Head Coach Brad Korn. Last year's 7-6 mark was SEMO's first home winning record in four seasons.

Balanced Attack

Three or more players have scored double figures for Southeast Missouri a total of 11 times this season. SEMO is 5-6 when at least three of its players reach double figures in the scoring column.

Nice Shooting

Southeast Missouri shot 57.1 percent (32-of-56) from the field against Missouri State (Nov. 9). Ten of the 11 Redhawks who played scored at least three points. The .571 field goal percentage marked SEMO's best in 23 years. The Redhawks last shot over 57 percent from the field in a season-opener vs. Western Carolina on Nov. 19, 1999. SEMO made 60 percent (36-of-60) of its field goals in that game. The .571 field goal percentage is the Redhawks highest in non-conference play under Head Coach Brad Korn.

Knocking Them Down

The Redhawks made 27-of-34 free throws for just under 80 percent (794) against Missouri State (Nov. 9). Southeast Missouri made 21-of-26 free throws in the second half alone. Nine players went to the free throw line for SEMO. Eric Reed, Jr. and Manny Patterson each made a perfect 7-of-7 free throws to lead the way.

First Career Starts

Freshmen Phillip Russell and Sam Thompson made their first career starts at Missouri State (Nov. 9). Russell had three points, three rebounds and two assists in 25 minutes at point guard, while Thompson scored five points in 10 minutes of action.

Second Half Manny

Forward Manny Patterson scored 11 points and added a team-high seven rebounds, all in the second half against Missouri State (Nov. 9). Patterson scored seven of those points at the free throw line where he did not miss (7-of-7). It was the fourth time he finished with double-digit points in his career.

Season 115

The Redhawks are in their 115th season of basketball. This year is Southeast Missouri's 31st as an NCAA Division I program. The Redhawks are 359-529 since joining the Division I ranks in 1991-92. SEMO has a total of eight winning seasons as an NCAA Division I program with its last coming in 2013-14 (18-14).

Mr. Experience

Guard Nygal Russell is Southeast Missouri's most experienced player on this year's roster. Russell has played in a total of 98 games and logged 32 starts in his career. He is in his fourth year with the Redhawks and averages 5.4 points and 3.4 rebounds per game for his career.

Redhawks Tabbed Fourth in OVC Preseason Poll

Southeast Missouri, after being picked to finish no higher than ninth in the Ohio Valley Conference Preseason Poll each of the last five seasons, was selected fourth in 2021-22. The Redhawks tallied 101 points in the overall voting by OVC Head Basketball Coaches and Communication Directors. The Redhawks achieved their highest OVC preseason ranking in seven years. SEMO was selected third overall (second in the West) ahead of the 2014-15 campaign when the conference was split in divisions. Belmont is this year's preseason favorite after garnering 161 points and all but three of the first-place votes. Morehead State, which represented the OVC in the NCAA Tournament last season, collected 141 points and three first-place nods,

while Murray State (136 pts.) took third. Tennessee State (84 pts.), Austin Peay (76 pts.), SIU Edwardsville (65 pts.), Tennessee Tech (62 pts.), Eastern Illinois (43 pts.) and UT Martin (34 pts.) complete the 10-team preseason poll.

Harris Garners OVC Preseason Honors

Guard Chris Harris earned Preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference honors for the first time in his career. Harris returns as the team's top scorer. One of five returning starters, Harris averaged 12.3 points per game in 26 starts a year ago. He led the Redhawks in assists (88) and minutes played (30.2 per game), while ranking fourth in steals (25), third in 3-point field goals made (38) and second in free throw percentage (.735). Harris scored double figures in 18 of his starts. Belmont guard Grayson Murphy and Morehead State forward Johni Broome shared the OVC Preseason Player of the Year honor.

Big Step Forward

In Brad Korn's first season as head coach in 2020-21, Southeast Missouri made the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament for the first time in four years. The Redhawks finished with an overall record of 11-16 and seventh in the league with a 9-11 mark. SEMO saw a +4 improvement in total wins and a +6 jump in OVC victories from the 2019-20 campaign. The Redhawks' nine conference wins matched their most in a season in 20 years.

Roster Talk

Southeast Missouri's 14-man roster consists of players from eight different states (Missouri, Florida, Geogia, Illinois, Louisiana, Nebraska, Texas, Wisconsin). SEMO has 10 returning players, including all five of its starters from 2020-21. Four freshmen (Phillip Russell, Adam Larson, Chase Thompson, Sam Thompson) complete this year's roster.

Top Scorers

Southeast Missouri brings back its top five scorers from last season in Chris Harris (12.3 ppg), Eric Reed, Jr. (11 ppg), Nana Akenten (9.3 ppg), DQ Nicholas (8.8 ppg) and Nolan Taylor (8.8 ppg). Reed, Jr. is the Redhawks top 3-point shooter after draining a team-high 61 in 27 games and 22 starts. He led the Ohio

Valley Conference with a .459 (61-of-133) three-point field goal percentage.

Welcome Back

St. Louis native Phillip Russell is back with Southeast Missouri this season. Russell initially signed with the Redhawks out of high school, but decommitted and went to Saint Louis University as a walk-on. He saw action in eight games off the bench and averaged 2.1 points per contest with the Billikens. Prior to that, he helped lead Vashon High School to a state title. Russell will make his first career start as SEMO's point guard at Missouri State Tuesday.

2021-22 Schedule

A 31-game schedule with 14 matchups at the Show Me Center is in store for the Southeast Missouri men's basketball team this 2021-22 season. SEMO tips off its season against instate foe Missouri State on Nov. 3. This year marks the 147th meeting between the schools The Redhawks non-conference home slate features games against Youngstown State (Nov. 13), Arkansas State (Nov. 19), Missouri Baptist (Nov. 23), Webster University (Dec. 4) and Evansville (Dec. 8). SEMO will travel to San Antonio. Texas for a tournament at Incarnate Word University over Thanksgiving weekend. The Redhawks face Portland (Nov. 26), host Incarnate Word (Nov. 27) and Montana State (Nov. 28) as part of the four-team event. The Redhawks close out non-league action on a four-game road stretch with trips to Purdue Fort Wayne (Dec. 11), Southern Illinois (Sept. 15), Pepperdine (Dec. 18) and California Baptist (Dec. 21). Longtime rivals SEMO and SIU hook up for the 118th time on the hardwood. SEMO remains on the road for the start of Ohio Valley Conference play which begins with a visit to rival Murray State (Dec. 30). Two days later, Austin Peay (Jan. 1) comes to Cape Girardeau for the Redhawks OVC homeopener on New Year's Day. The Redhawks also host Tennessee Tech (Jan. 13), Tennessee State (Jan. 20), Morehead State (Jan. 27), SIU Edwardsville (Jan. 29), Eastern Illinois (Feb. 5), Belmont (Feb. 12), UT Martin (Feb. 24) and Murray State (Feb. 26) in home OVC play. Trips to Belmont (Jan. 6), Tennessee State (Jan. 8), SIU Edwardsville (Jan. 15), Eastern Illinois (Jan. 22), UT Martin (Feb. 3), Austin Peay (Feb. 10), Tennessee Tech (Feb. 17) and Morehead State (Feb. 19) complete SEMO's

18-game conference schedule. The 2022 OVC Tournament will be held at the Ford Center in Evansville, Indiana on Mar. 2-5. This is the fifth-straight year the tournament will be played in that venue.

Home Game vs. Morehead State will Air on ESPNU

Southeast Missouri's home game against Morehead State will air on ESPNU as part of the 2021-22 ESPN Basketball Television Package. That matchup is set for Thursday, January 27. Tip-off is set for 7 p.m., CT at the Show Me Center. This year's slate of Conference basketball games across ESPN networks includes nine total men's basketball games (six regular season contests and three OVC Tournament games) that will appear on one of the linear networks during the season. Four of the regular season matchups and the OVC Tournament semifinals will air on ESPNU, two games will be televised on ESPNews and the OVC Tournament championship game will air on ESPN2.





Pand Korn began his first head coaching job at Southeast Missouri in the middle of a global COVID-19 pandemic.

Throughout all the challenges and uncertainties during an unprecedented 2020-21 campaign, Korn' led his first SEMO team to an overall record of 11-16 and seventh-place finish in the Ohio Valley Conference.

The Redhawks made the OVC Tournament for the first time since 2016-17 and saw a +4 improvement in total wins and a +6 jump in OVC victories from the year before. SEMO's nine (9-11) conference victories matched the program's most in a season in 20 years.

Statistically, SEMO ranked among the top five in the OVC in 3-point field goal percentage (5th, .352), rebounding margin (5th, +2.2), defensive rebounds (5th, 25.6 per game) and defensive rebound percentage (1st, .764).

Korn was officially introduced as SEMO's head coach on Mar. 23, 2020. He is the seventh head coach in SEMO's NCAA Division I era (since 1991-92).

Prior to arriving in Cape
Girardeau, Korn spent five years
at Big 12 Conference member
Kansas State working
the four seasons as an
assistant coach and one as
the program's Director of
Operations.

In his final four years back at K-State after returning following a three-year stint at Missouri State (2013-16), Korn helped the Wildcats to 82 wins and threestraight NCAA Tournament appearances. K-State posted back-to-back 25-win campaigns for the first time in school history (2017-18, 2018-19).

During his first year back in 2016-17, the squad won 21 games, including eight over teams that advanced to the postseason, and knocked off Wake Forest in the NCAA First Four before losing to #18 Cincinnati in the NCAA South Regional First Round.

Working primarily with the post players, Korn was a big influence on the development of two-time All-Big 12 First
Team selection Dean Wade, who became the fourth Wildcat to earn All-Big 12 First-Team honors in 2018 and just the second to do so in back-toback seasons. Wade is one of just three players to rank in the school's Top 10 in both career scoring (1,510) and rebounding (685). He was instrumental in

the progress of Makol Mawien, who has started all 103 games in his K-State career and emerged as one of the top big men in the Big 12.

Korn was also key in the growth of All-Big 12 selections Wesley Iwundu and D.J. Johnson during his first season as an assistant coach in 2016-17. Iwundu, who was twice named Third Team All-Big 12, became the first Wildcat since 2008 to be taken in the NBA Draft when he was selected with 33rd overall pick by the Orlando Magic. Johnson, an honorable mention all-league selection, broke the career field goal percentage record at 59.5 percent, while setting the single-season mark for the second consecutive season at 62.3 percent in 2016-17.

Korn spent one season

on Bruce Weber's inaugural staff at K-State as Director of Operations in 2012-13, helping the Wildcats to a 27-8 overall record and their first-ever Big 12 regular-season title. It was the school's first conference title since 1977, while the 27 wins rated second-most in school history.

Overall, he has 15 years of
Division I experience, which
includes time at his alma mater
– Southern Illinois (2004-12).
Korn has extensive ties to
Weber after playing his first four
years (1999-2003) for him at
Southern Illinois. He redshirted
in 1999-2000 before playing the
next three years for Weber. He
concluded his playing career for
(current Purdue head coach)
Matt Painter in 2003-04 before

spending the next eight years (2004-12) at SIU as an assistant for then-Saluki head coach and current K-State associate head coach Chris Lowery.

Korn returned to Manhattan in May 2016 after three seasons at Missouri State, where he served as an assistant coach to then-head coach Paul Lusk from 2013-16. At MSU, he helped the Bears to 44 wins, including a 20 -win season and a trip to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament in 2013-14.

Korn helped mentor a number of All-Missouri Valley honorees during his stay at Missouri State, including 2014 All-MVC Second-Team selection Jarmar Gulley and 2016 MVC Newcomer of the Year Dequon Miller. In addition, he coached three MVC All-Freshman Team honorees in Austin Ruder in 2014 and Obediah Church and Jarred Dixon in 2016 as well as two Most Improved Team members (Dorrian Williams in 2015 and Chris Kendrix in 2016).

Prior to his first stint at K-State, Korn spent eight years (2004-12) at Southern Illinois, including his final six years as a full-time assistant under Lowery. He helped the Salukis post a 145-116 (.556) overall record with four postseason appearances, two Missouri Valley Conference championships and one State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament title. The squad won 20 or more games and advanced to the NCAA Tournament on three occasions (2005, 2006, 2007) during his tenure as an assistant coach, including a 2007 trip to the Sweet 16. He was a graduate assistant at SIU his first two vears before being elevated to a full-time assistant coach on Jan. 31, 2006.

A native of Plano, Illinois, Korn helped the Salukis through one of their greatest periods of success from 1999 to 2004. The squad went from 16 wins his redshirt-freshman season to three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances under Weber and Painter. He was also a part of three Missouri Valley regular season championships as a player.

The 6-foot-9 forward saw action in 121 games in his career, averaging 5.2 points and 2.3 rebounds in 14.5 minutes per game. As a senior, he averaged

9.7 points on 41 percent shooting with four rebounds and 1.9 assists in helping SIU to 25 wins and a 17-1 mark in MVC play. He was named to the league's Most Improved Team.

Korn earned a bachelor's degree in Marketing from Southern Illinois in 2004 and his master's degree in Administrative Studies from Missouri State in 2016. He resides in Cape Girardeau with his wife, Kristin, and daughters Brielyn and Ashtyn.

After Russell scored to give SEMO a 20-18 edge, the Redhawks fell into a cold spell. As a result, the Redhawks missed 10 of 11 field goals and went scoreless for 3:43.

Meanwhile, CBU capitalized with a 13-0 run to take a 31-20 lead.

Powell, who went over 1,000 points in his CBU career, stuck a 3-pointer to finish off the jaunt with 5:37 to go.

CBU later widened its lead to 12 twice in the final four minutes of the first half before taking a 43-34 advantage at the break.

The Lancers started the second half with a 10-4 surge to quickly push their lead to 15 (53-38).

SEMO managed to get within eight but that was the last time the Lancer lead dipped below double figures.
