Series History

Saturday marks the 36th meeting between Southeast Missouri and SIU Edwardsville. SEMO holds a 23-12 advantage in the all-time series. The Redhawks are 14-4 against the Cougars at the Show Me Center. SEMO has won each of the last three games of the series and seven of the previous 10 matchups against SIUE.

Oh So Close

Southeast Missouri came up short in a one-point overtime loss to Ohio Valley Conference co-leader Morehead State Thursday. SEMO led by 14 points in the first half before MSU mounted its come-from-behind victory during a nationally-televised ESPNU matchup. The Redhawks hosted a ESPNU game for the first time in six years.

Overtime Games

The Redhawks played their sixth overtime game in two years under Head Coach Brad Korn against Morehead State Thursday. Southeast Missouri fell to 2-4 in those contests.

End of January

Saturday's meeting with SIU Edwardsville marks Southeast Missouri's final game of January. SEMO is currently 3-3 this month. A win over the Cougars will give the Redhawks their first winning record in January since 2016-17 (5-3).

Two of Three

Southeast Missouri won two of its last three games. The Redhawks recently saw a two-game winning streak end with a 74-73 loss to Morehead State (Jan. 27). Prior to that, SEMO beat Tennessee State, 85-63, at home on Jan. 20 and Eastern Illinois, 87-58, on the road on Jan. 22. SEMO won two-straight games three times this season.

Russell Misses First Start

Four-time Ohio Valley Conference Freshman of the Week point guard Phillip Russell missed his first start of the season vs. Morehead State (Jan. 27). Russell was out due to COVID protocols. He will also miss Saturday's game vs. SIU Edwardsville. Russell was the only Redhawk who started every game this year before the Morehead State contest.

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Harris Delivers

Chris Harris recorded a game and season-high 22 points off the bench to lead four Southeast Missouri players in double figures vs. Morehead State (Jan. 27). Harris shot 9-of-14 from the field and matched a career-best four 3-pointers made. It was his first 20-point game this season and third of his career. Harris has scored double figures in two-straight games.

Nicholas Steps Up

DQ Nicholas narrowly missed a double-double with 12 points and nine rebounds against Morehead State (Jan. 27). Nicholas started at point guard in the absence of Phillip Russell. He made 4-of-8 field goals and 4-of-6 free throws. Nicholas' nine rebounds also marked a season-high.

Great Job Manny!

Forward Manny Patterson scored six of Southeast Missouri's seven points of the game against Morehead State (Jan. 27). Patterson had 10 of his 12 points in the first half alone. He posted double figures in each of his last two starts.

Largest OVC Road Win

The Redhawks recently celebrated their largest Ohio Valley Conference road win in program history when it pounded Eastern Illinois, 87-58, on Jan. 22. The victory surpassed a 27-point (108-81) win at Austin Peay on Feb. 28, 2013.

How May I Assist You?

Southeast Missouri assisted 27 of its 31 made field goals at Eastern Illinois (Jan. 22). Phillip Russell distributed a season-high eight assists against the Panthers. The 27 assists are SEMO's most in a game this season.

Russell Nabs Fourth OVC Freshman of the Week Accolade

Point guard Phillip Russell claimed his fourth Ohio Valley Conference Freshman of the Week honor on Jan. 24. Russell shared the accolade with SIU Edwardsville's Ray'Sean Taylor Russell, who hails from St. Louis, averaged 12 points and 7.5 assists in two wins for SEMO last week. He shot 50 percent (8-of-16) from the field and collected three steals to go along with 15 assists in that stretch. Russell finished

with 15 points and seven dishes vs. Tennessee State (Jan. 20) before scoring nine points and distributing a season-high eight assists two days later at Eastern Illinois (Jan. 22). Russell and Taylor both lead the OVC with four Freshman of the Week awards this year. Morehead State's Johni Broome (Player of the Week) and SIUE's DeeJuan Pruitt (Newcomer of the Week) rounded out the week's honorees.

Defense Tightens Up

The Redhawks recently put together their two best defensive performances of the season. After holding Tennessee State to 63 points, Southeast Missouri turned around two days later to limit Eastern Illinois to only 58. SEMO also forced an average of 17 turnovers per game and gave up just 60.5 points in those contests. The 58 points against EIU were the fewest allowed by the Redhawks this year.

Putting Up the Points

Southeast Missouri has scored over 80 points in five of its first seven Ohio Valley Conference games. As a result, SEMO ranks second in the league with 81.4 points per game against OVC foes. The Redhawks put up a season-best 98 points in conference play during their victory over Austin Peay (98-79, Jan. 1).

Home Winning Streak Ends at Five

Southeast Missouri's homecourt winning streak ended at five games following the Redhawks 74-73 overtime loss to Morehead State (Jan. 27). The home winning streak was SEMO's longest in five years. The Redhawks are now 5-3 at the Show Me Center this year.

Akenten Rises

Nana Akenten came off the bench to score double figures in four of his last five games. Akenten dropped in a season-high 19 points at Belmont (Jan. 6) and followed that up with 16 and 17 points against Tennessee State (Jan. 8, Jan. 20), and 12 points at Eastern Illinois (Jan. 22). He is Southeast Missouri's third-leading scorer with 10.6 points per game in Ohio Valley Conference play.

Redhawks End Road Skid

The Redhawks ended a seven-game losing streak in true road games with their 87-58 victory over Eastern Illinois (Jan. 22). Southeast Missouri improved to 3-7 in true road contests after winning its first road game since Nov. 26 (at Incarnate Word, 79-76).

Back to Work

After a 12-day layoff, the Redhawks thumped Tennessee State, 85-63, Thursday night at the Show Me Center. Southeast Missouri did not play a week ago due to COVID protocols within its program. The victory marked SEMO's second in Ohio Valley Conference play and put the Redhawks at fifth in the league standings entering this weekend.

Lots of Positives

The Redhawks posted their second-largest win of the season with their 85-63 win over Tennessee State (Jan. 20). Defensively, Southeast Missouri put together a strong effort forcing 17 turnovers and holding the Tigers to 63 points. SEMO also shot a season-best 57.4 percent (31-of-54) from the field.

Branson Hits Career-High

Dylan Branson matched a career-high 12 points to lead four Redhawks in double figures against Eastern Illinois (Jan. 22). Branson scored all of his points in the first half alone. He rallied Southeast Missouri early by draining a pair of 3-pointers and scoring 10 points in the opening 6:10 of the contest. It was the second time Branson scored double figures in his career.

Redhawks for Three!

Southeast Missouri is averaging a league-best 11.3 three-pointers made in Ohio Valley Conference games. SEMO buried 79 three-pointers in seven conference matchups. The Redhawks made a season-high 17 three-pointers vs. Austin Peay (Jan. 1) and have drained 12 or more in four of their OVC contests. Nana Akenten (18) and Eric Reed, Jr. (20) combined for 38 of SEMO's made threes in league action.

Big Run

After falling behind by nine points (21-12) with a little over eight minutes to play in the first half, Southeast Missouri made it a two-possession game before closing the stanza with a vengeance. SEMO used a 12-0 run in the final 1:40 to pull ahead of Tennessee State, 41-34, at the half. The Redhawks then carried their momentum into the second half, where they man-handled the Tigers, 44-29.

SEMO averaged 49 points in the second half during its two matchups with TSU this season.

COVID Protocols

The Redhawks missed two games due to COVID protocols within their program. Southeast Missouri was scheduled to play Tennessee Tech at home on Jan. 13 and SIU Edwardsville on the road Jan. 15. SEMO's game with TTU will not be rescheduled at this time since the Golden Eagles already reached their four-game rescheduling limit. In the event a window opens up on a Thursday or Saturday due to other postponements, the Conference office will work with both schools to reschedule that game. If the game is not rescheduled, it will become a no-contest. Meanwhile, the Redhawks game at SIUE has been rescheduled for Feb. 7 at 7 p.m., CT.

Over 600

DQ Nicholas cleared 600 points in his career with his 12-point effort against Morehead State (Jan. 27). Nicholas now has 606 points as a Redhawk.

Doing the Dishes

Redshirt-freshman Phillip Russell dished out a season-high eight assists at Eastern Illinois (Jan. 22). Russell averaged 7.5 assists in his last two starts. He leads Southeast Missouri with 56 assists and ranks 14th in the Ohio Valley Conference in that category. Russell had

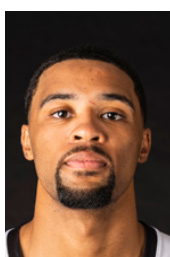

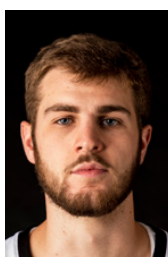

Chase's Place

Chase Thompson established a season-high nine points on 3-of-4 field goals against Tennessee State (Jan. 20). Two days later, Thompson logged a season-best 23 minutes. He had scored no more than four points in 13 games prior to his effort at TSU.

Nearly Everyone Scores

Nine of Southeast Missouri's 10 available players got in the scoring column during the Redhawks rout of Eastern Illinois (Jan. 22). All nine of those players scored in the first half. Dylan Branson (15), Chris Harris (14), Nana Akenten (12), Manny Patterson (11), Phillip Russell (9), Eric Reed, Jr. (9), DQ Nicholas (8), Nygal Russell (7) and Parker Long (2) scored against EIU.

Back in the 20s

Two days after going scoreless for the first time this season, Phillip Russell pitched in 22 points at Tennessee State (Jan. 8). Russell shot 6-of-11 from the field and made a season-high 9-of-13 free throws in his fifth 20-point effort of 2021-22.

First OVC Win

Southeast Missouri picked up its first Ohio Valley Conference win of the season in impressive fashion when it thumped Austin Peay, 98-79, on Jan. 1. With the win, SEMO improved to 14-15 all-time in OVC home-openers. It was the Redhawks first victory in an OVC home-opener since 2016-17. That year, SEMO beat Eastern Kentucky, 81-48, on Dec. 31.

Happy New Year!

The Redhawks started the New Year with a 98-79 win over Austin Peay. SEMO and APSU went head-to-head in the only Ohio Valley Conference game that day as all other matchups were postponed. The Redhawks posted a victory in their first game of a New Year for the second-straight season. Last season, SEMO beat Tennessee State, 83-79, in double overtime on Jan. 2.

Redhawks Lead OVC in Free Throw Percentage

Southeast Missouri leads the Ohio Valley Conference in free throw percentage. SEMO is shooting 73.2 percent (297-of-406) at the line through 20 games. SEMO is shooting over 20 (20.3) free throws per game.

Big Games

Five days after pouring in a career-high 34 points vs. Austin Peay (Jan. 1), Eric Reed, Jr. led Southeast Missouri with 22 points at Belmont (Jan. 6). Reed, Jr. scored all of his points in the first half and buried six more 3-pointers along the way. In his last three starts alone, Reed, Jr. averaged 25.3 points per game and knocked down 17 three-pointers for an average of nearly six (5.6) per contest in that span.

Over 100

With his six 3-pointers made at Belmont (Jan. 6), Eric Reed, Jr. went over 100 in his Southeast Missouri career. Reed, Jr. is 103-of-245 from 3-point range as a Redhawk. His .420 three-point field goal percentage currently ranks third all-time among SEMO's career leaders.

Thompson Hits Double-Digits Again

Freshman Sam Thompson scored double figures for the second time in seven starts this season when he dropped in 10 points at Belmont (Jan. 6). Thompson shot 5-of-8 from the field and grabbed four rebounds in 20 minutes.

Redhawks Take Two OVC Honors

Southeast Missouri shooting guard Eric Reed, Jr. and freshman point guard Phillip Russell earned Ohio Valley Conference weekly honors on Jan. 3. Reed, Jr. won the OVC Player of the Week award for the first time in his career and Russell claimed his third Freshman of the Week accolade this season. A native of Baton Rouge, Louisiana, opened OVC play with a pair of 20-point performances last week. He led SEMO with 20 points at Murray State (Dec. 30) and followed that up with a career-high 34 points two days later in the Redhawks New Year's Day win over Austin Peay (Jan. 1). Reed, Jr. buried seven 3-pointers against the Governors in a game where his team made a season-high 17 treys. His 34 points are the

most in a game by any player in the OVC so far this season. For the week, Reed, Jr. averaged 27 points and five rebounds per game, while shooting 56.7 percent (17-of-30) from the field, 75 percent (9-of-12) at the free throw line and 55 percent (11-of-20) from 3-point range. Russell, who hails from St. Louis, scored double figures in two starts a week ago. He averaged 17.5 points, four assists and one steal per contest. Russell also shot 92.8 percent (13-of-14) at the free throw line and 40 percent (6-of-15) from downtown. He scored 20 points vs. Austin Peay (Jan. 1) for his fourth game with 20 or more points this year. Additionally, Russell has scored double figures in seven-straight games and 13 of 15 starts in 2021-22. UT Martin guard KJ Simon won the league's Newcomer of the Week award to complete this week's honorees.

Reed, Jr. Goes Off

Guard Eric Reed, Jr. scored an Ohio Valley Conference single-game high 34 points to lead Southeast Missouri to its dominating 98-79 win over Austin Peay (Jan. 1). Reed, Jr. became just the second player in the OVC to score over 30 points in a game this year. Murray State's Tevin Brown scored 33 points vs. Chattanooga (Dec. 18) prior to Reed, Jr.'s performance. The 34 points rank third-most in a game during SEMO's NCAA Division I era.

Eruption from Three

Southeast Missouri erupted for a season-high 17 three-pointers against Austin Peay (Jan. 1). Only SEMO and Belmont (vs. Lipscomb, Dec. 2) have made 17 three-pointers in a game of the Ohio Valley Conference teams this season. The Redhawks shot a blazing 60.7 percent (17-of-28) from downtown with six different players making a three. Eric Reed, Jr. matched a career-best seven three-pointers and Phillip Russell buried five treys to lead the way. SEMO outscored the Governors, 24-3, from 3-point range in the first half alone.

Another Month Starts with a Win

Southeast Missouri began each of its first three months this season with a win. The Redhawks opened the year with a 99-94 victory at Missouri State (Nov. 9), beat Webster University (Dec. 4), 76-64, to start December and began January with a 98-79 pasting of Austin Peay (Jan. 1).



Season-High Free Throws

Southeast Missouri sunk a season-high 29 free throws against Austin Peay (Jan. 1). SEMO finished at 29-of-36 for 80.6 at the charity stripe in that game. It marked the third time the Redhawks made 25 or more free throws in a game this season.

100th Game

Nygall Russell scored nine points and had four rebounds in the 100th game of his career vs. Austin Peay (Jan. 1). Russell shot 4-of-8 from the field in 24 minutes. He has played in 105 games and made 39 starts as the most experienced player on Southeast Missouri's roster.

Shooting 3s

Southeast Missouri is shooting an average of 25.5 three-pointers per game this season. SEMO attempted a season-high 35 three-pointers at Murray State (Dec. 30) and at Eastern Illinois (Jan. 22). The Redhawks made a season-high 17 three-pointers vs. Austin Peay (Jan. 1) and buried 10 or more threes in seven contests this year. For the season, the Redhawks are shooting 34.7 percent from three. SEMO drained an average of 11 in its seven Ohio Valley Conference games.

Russell Power

Phillip Russell has scored double figures in nine of his last 11 starts. Russell, who ranks second on the team in scoring with 14.3 points per game, recently pitched in 15 vs. Tennessee State (Jan. 20). He has scored double figures in 15 of his 19 starts.

Non-Conference is Done

Southeast Missouri wrapped up its 13-game non-conference schedule with an 84-68 road loss at California Baptist (Dec. 21). The Redhawks dropped six of their last eight games against non-league foes.

California Recap

Southeast Missouri went 0-2 during its road trip to California with losses to Pepperdine (Dec. 18) and California Baptist (Dec. 21). SEMO squared off against each of those teams for the first time in its program history. In all, the Redhawks have played 14 of California's NCAA Division I schools.

Russell Picks Up Second OVC Freshman of the Week Honor

Point guard Phillip Russell picked up his second Ohio Valley Conference Freshman of the Week award on Dec. 20. A native of St. Louis, Russell averaged 17.5 points, two rebounds, two assists and two steals per game in two starts. He also shot 50 percent (13-of-26) from the field and 42.9 percent (6-of-14) from 3-point range. He scored a career-high 25 points (20 in the second half) and buried a season-best four 3-pointers at Pepperdine (Dec. 18). Murray State's Tevin Brown (Player) and UT Martin's KJ Simon (Newcomer) completed the week's honorees.

I Double Dare You

Nygall Russell collected his team-high second double-double of the season with 15 points and 10 rebounds at Pepperdine (Dec. 18). Russell shot 5-of-9 from the field with three of his makes coming from 3-point range. Russell leads the Redhawks and ranks fourth in the Ohio Valley Conference in rebounding (7.3 rpg).

Strong Shooting

For the fifth time this season, Southeast Missouri shot over 50 percent when it made 31-of-54 field goals at a season-best 57.4 percent clip vs. Tennessee State (Jan. 20). The Redhawks also shot 57.1 percent at Missouri State (Nov. 9), 51.9 percent vs. Evansville (Dec. 8), 52.6 percent at Pepperdine (Dec. 18) and 53.1 percent vs. Austin Peay (Jan. 1). SEMO is 4-1 when it shoots over 50 percent.

Career Night for the Russells

Point guard Phillip Russell poured in a career-high 24 points and forward Nygall Russell added a career-best 15 rebounds in Southeast Missouri's win over Evansville (Dec. 8). P. Russell shot 10-of-16 from the field, knocked down a pair of 3-pointers, dished out four assists and had two steals, while N. Russell grabbed 11 of his boards in the first half. All 15 of his rebounds came on the defensive end.

Turnover Low

The Redhawks matched a season-low eight turnovers in their outing at California Baptist (Dec. 21). Southeast Missouri is averaging 12.9 turnovers per game through 20 contests this season.

Gritty Win

Short-handed Southeast Missouri pulled out a gritty two-point win over Evansville (Dec. 8). SEMO played the Purple Aces with only eight available players and did not have its leading scorer (Eric Reed, Jr.) due to illness. The Redhawks assisted 15 of their 28 made field goals and made a near-perfect 12-of-13 free throws in the game.

On the Rebound

The Redhawks outrebounded Eastern Illinois, 42-27, marking only the third time this season where they won the battle of the boards. Southeast Missouri's +15 rebounding margin was its largest this year. SEMO also outrebounded Missouri State (33-30) and Evansville (37-31).

Redhawks Down Webster

The Redhawks picked up their fourth win of the season with a 76-64 victory over Webster (Dec. 4). Southeast Missouri's 12-point win was its largest of the season thus far. SEMO also extended its winning streak against non-Division I opponents to 32-straight.

Reed, Jr. Pours in 26

Eric Reed, Jr. poured in 26 points to lead Southeast Missouri to its 76-64 win over Webster (Dec. 4). Reed, Jr. made 8-of-17 field goals with all but three of those makes coming from 3-point range. He finished with five of SEMO's six 3-pointers made in the contest. Reed, Jr. also hit 5-of-6 free throws, grabbed three rebounds, dished out four assists and added a block in 32 minutes against the Gorloks.

Free Throw Streak Ends at 21

Nygall Russell's free throw streak came to an end at 21-straight at California Baptist (Dec. 21). Russell missed the second of two shots 16:11 left in the first half. The miss was his first at the free throw line since Feb. 25, 2021 (at Eastern Illinois).



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Patterson Notches Season-High

Manny Patterson narrowly missed a double-double when he dropped in a season-high 14 points and pulled down nine rebounds against Webster (Dec. 4). Patterson made 5-of-7 field goals in his second double-digit scoring game of the season. He scored a combined nine points in three starts prior to that performance.

Russell Nabs First OVC Freshman of the Week Award

Point guard Phillip Russell claimed the first Ohio Valley Conference Freshman of the Week honor of his career on Nov. 29. In four games, Russell averaged 17 points, three assists, 2.5 rebounds and 1.5 steals per contest. He shot 51.3 percent (20-of-39) from the field, 55.6 percent (10-of-18) from 3-point range and 72 percent (18-of-25) at the free throw line.

Harris Sinks Incarnate Word

Chris Harris made the first buzzer-beating shot of his career when he drained a 3-pointer to give Southeast Missouri a thrilling 79-76 win over Incarnate Word (Nov. 26). Tied, 76-76, Harris caught the inbounds pass from Dylan Branson and buried his long range 3-pointer from the left side. Harris missed his first four 3-point attempts prior to his game-winner. For Harris, it was the second game-winning shot of his career. He also made a game-winning 3-pointer with 26 seconds left vs. Purdue Fort Wayne on Nov. 10, 2019.

20-Point Games

Redhawk players have accounted for 12 20-point scoring games this season. Eric Reed, Jr. scored 21 points at Missouri State (Nov. 9), 23 at Incarnate Word (Nov. 26), 26 vs. Webster (Dec. 4), 20 at Murray State (Dec. 31), 34 vs. Austin Peay (Jan. 1) and 22 at Belmont (Jan. 6), while Phillip Russell poured in 21 points vs. Montana State (Nov. 28), 24 vs. Evansville (Dec. 8), 25 at Pepperdine (Dec. 18), 20 vs. Austin Peay (Jan. 1) and 22 at Tennessee State (Jan. 8). Chris Harris dropped in 22 points vs. Morehead State (Jan. 27). Reed, Jr. has a team-high nine 20-point games in his career.

Starting Combinations

The Redhawks have used eight different starting combinations through 20 games this year. DQ Nicholas, Nygal Russell, Dylan Branson, Manny Patterson and Eric Reed, Jr. marked the eighth lineup when they took the court vs. Morehead State (Jan. 27).

Multiple Threes

Phillip Russell buried multiple 3-pointers in 11 of his last 19 starts. Russell finished with a season-high five 3-pointers made vs. Austin Peay (Jan. 1). His 36 three-pointers made are second on the team. Eric Reed, Jr., who leads the team with 44 treys this year, has posted two or more on 11 occasions. His season-best is seven made 3-pointers vs. Austin Peay (Jan. 1).

First Home Win

Southeast Missouri picked up its first home win of the season with a 71-63 victory over Missouri Baptist (Nov. 22) prior to the Thanksgiving holiday. SEMO overcame a 15-point first-half deficit and outscored MBU, 40-27, in the final 20 minutes.

Russell Nets Career-High

Freshman point guard Phillip Russell scored a career-best 18 points against Missouri Baptist (Nov. 22). Russell made 5-of-8 field goals and did not miss a 3-pointer going a 3-of-3 from long range. He also added 5-of-7 free throws, four steals and three assists. Russell has scored double figures in three-straight contests. He ranks third on the team in scoring with 11.3 points a game.

Keep it Up Reed

Guard Eric Reed, Jr. made a 3-pointer in 28 of his last 31 games dating back to last season. Reed, Jr. buried a 3-pointer in 22-straight contests before that streak came to an end at Pepperdine (Dec. 18). It was the first time he went without a made 3-pointer since the SIU Edwardsville game on Jan. 28, 2021.

Free Throw Difference

Opponents have shot 83 more free throws than Southeast Missouri through 20 games this year. As a result, opponents are outscoring the Redhawks by a +64 (361-297) margin at the charity stripe.

About SIUE

SIU Edwardsville is ninth in the Ohio Valley Conference standings with an overall record of 7-13 and 1-6 in league play. SIUE's only conference win was a 66-53 road victory at Eastern Illinois (Jan. 13). Freshman Ray'Sean Taylor leads the Cougars and ranks second in the OVC in scoring with 17.3 points a game. SIUE is on a five-game losing streak with each of its last three losses decided by no more than six points.

Season-Opening Win

The Redhawks tipped off their 2021-22 campaign with a big 99-94 road win at Missouri Valley Conference foe Missouri State (Nov. 9). Southeast Missouri won a season-opener on the road in back-to-back years for the first time in its NCAA Division I history. With a win Saturday, SEMO will start a season at 2-0 for the first time in 18 years. The Redhawks last 2-0 start was in 2003-04 and involved a win against a Horizon League team (63-62, vs. Green Bay).

High Scoring Affair

Southeast Missouri (99) and Missouri State (94) combined for 193 points in their season-opening slugfest on Nov. 9. The 99 points marked SEMO's most in a season-opener since it scored 120 in a win over Missouri Baptist on Nov. 19, 1990. Both the Redhawks and Bears also combined to shoot 69 free throws. SEMO made 27-of-34 and MSU hit 25-of-35.

Redhawks at Home

Southeast Missouri is 12-9 at home under Head Coach Brad Korn. Last year's 7-6 mark was SEMO's first home winning record in four seasons.

Balanced Attack

Three or more players have scored double figures for Southeast Missouri a total of 18 times this season. SEMO is 8-10 when at least three of its players reach double figures in the scoring column.



Nice Shooting

Southeast Missouri shot 57.1 percent (32-of-56) from the field against Missouri State (Nov. 9). Ten of the 11 Redhawks who played scored at least three points. The .571 field goal percentage marked SEMO's best in 23 years. The Redhawks last shot over 57 percent from the field in a season-opener vs. Western Carolina on Nov. 19, 1999. SEMO made 60 percent (36-of-60) of its field goals in that game. The .571 field goal percentage is the Redhawks highest in non-conference play under Head Coach Brad Korn.

Knocking Them Down

The Redhawks made 27-of-34 free throws for just under 80 percent (79.4) against Missouri State (Nov. 9). Southeast Missouri made 21-of-26 free throws in the second half alone. Nine players went to the free throw line for SEMO. Eric Reed, Jr. and Manny Patterson each made a perfect 7-of-7 free throws to lead the way.

First Career Starts

Freshmen Phillip Russell and Sam Thompson made their first career starts at Missouri State (Nov. 9). Russell had three points, three rebounds and two assists in 25 minutes at point guard, while Thompson scored five points in 10 minutes of action.

Second Half Manny

Forward Manny Patterson scored 11 points and added a team-high seven rebounds, all in the second half against Missouri State (Nov. 9). Patterson scored seven of those points at the free throw line where he did not miss (7-of-7). It was the fourth time he finished with double-digit points in his career.

Season 115

The Redhawks are in their 115th season of basketball. This year is Southeast Missouri's 31st as an NCAA Division I program. The Redhawks are 362-533 since joining the Division I ranks in 1991-92. SEMO has a total of eight winning seasons as an NCAA Division I program with its last coming in 2013-14 (18-14).

Mr. Experience

Guard Nygal Russell is Southeast Missouri's most experienced player on this year's roster. Russell has played in a total of 105 games and logged 39 starts in his career. He is in his

fourth year with the Redhawks and averages 5.4 points and 3.4 rebounds per game for his career.

Redhawks Tabbed Fourth in OVC Preseason Poll

Southeast Missouri, after being picked to finish no higher than ninth in the Ohio Valley Conference Preseason Poll each of the last five seasons, was selected fourth in 2021-22. The Redhawks tallied 101 points in the overall voting by OVC Head Basketball Coaches and Communication Directors. The Redhawks achieved their highest OVC preseason ranking in seven years. SEMO was selected third overall (second in the West) ahead of the 2014-15 campaign when the conference was split in divisions. Belmont is this year's preseason favorite after garnering 161 points and all but three of the first-place votes. Morehead State, which represented the OVC in the NCAA Tournament last season, collected 141 points and three first-place nods, while Murray State (136 pts.) took third. Tennessee State (84 pts.), Austin Peay (76 pts.), SIU Edwardsville (65 pts.), Tennessee Tech (62 pts.), Eastern Illinois (43 pts.) and UT Martin (34 pts.) complete the 10-team preseason poll.

Harris Garners OVC Preseason Honors

Guard Chris Harris earned Preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference honors for the first time in his career. Harris returns as the team's top scorer. One of five returning starters, Harris averaged 12.3 points per game in 26 starts a year ago. He led the Redhawks in assists (88) and minutes played (30.2 per game), while ranking fourth in steals (25), third in 3-point field goals made (38) and second in free throw percentage (.735). Harris scored double figures in 18 of his starts. Belmont guard Grayson Murphy and Morehead State forward Johni Broome shared the OVC Preseason Player of the Year honor.

Big Step Forward

In Brad Korn's first season as head coach in 2020-21, Southeast Missouri made the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament for the first time in four years. The Redhawks finished with an overall record of 11-16 and seventh in the league with a 9-11 mark. SEMO saw a +4 im-

provement in total wins and a +6 jump in OVC victories from the 2019-20 campaign. The Redhawks' nine conference wins matched their most in a season in 20 years.

Roster Talk

Southeast Missouri's 14-man roster consists of players from eight different states (Missouri, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Nebraska, Texas, Wisconsin). SEMO has 10 returning players, including all five of its starters from 2020-21. Four freshmen (Phillip Russell, Adam Larson, Chase Thompson, Sam Thompson) complete this year's roster.

Top Scorers

Southeast Missouri brings back its top five scorers from last season in Chris Harris (12.3 ppg), Eric Reed, Jr. (11 ppg), Nana Akenten (9.3 ppg), DQ Nicholas (8.8 ppg) and Nolan Taylor (8.8 ppg). Reed, Jr. is the Redhawks top 3-point shooter after draining a team-high 61 in 27 games and 22 starts. He led the Ohio Valley Conference with a .459 (61-of-133) three-point field goal percentage.

Welcome Back

St. Louis native Phillip Russell is back with Southeast Missouri this season. Russell initially signed with the Redhawks out of high school, but decommitted and went to Saint Louis University as a walk-on. He saw action in eight games off the bench and averaged 2.1 points per contest with the Billikens. Prior to that, he helped lead Vashon High School to a state title.

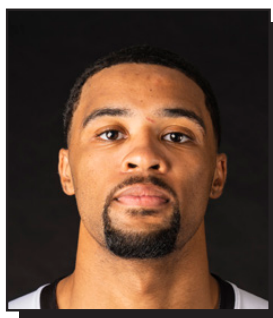

BRAD KORN

HEAD COACH

Brad Korn began his first head coaching job at Southeast Missouri in the middle of a global COVID-19 pandemic.

Throughout all the challenges and uncertainties during an unprecedented 2020-21 campaign, Korn led his first SEMO team to an overall record of 11-16 and seventh-place finish in the Ohio Valley Conference.

The Redhawks made the OVC Tournament for the first time since 2016-17 and saw a +4 improvement in total wins and a +6 jump in OVC victories from the year before. SEMO's nine (9-11) conference victories matched the program's most in a season in 20 years.

Statistically, SEMO ranked among the top five in the OVC in 3-point field goal percentage (5th, .352), rebounding margin

(5th, +2.2), defensive rebounds (5th, 25.6 per game) and defensive rebound percentage (1st, .764).

Korn was officially introduced as SEMO's head coach on Mar. 23, 2020. He is the seventh head coach in SEMO's NCAA Division I era (since 1991-92).

Prior to arriving in Cape Girardeau, Korn spent five years at Big 12 Conference member Kansas State working the four seasons as an assistant coach and one as the program's Director of Operations.

In his final four years back at K-State after returning following a three-year stint at Missouri State (2013-16), Korn helped the Wildcats to 82 wins and three-straight NCAA Tournament appearances. K-State posted back-to-back 25-win campaigns

for the first time in school history (2017-18, 2018-19).

During his first year back in 2016-17, the squad won 21 games, including eight over teams that advanced to the postseason, and knocked off Wake Forest in the NCAA First Four before losing to #18 Cincinnati in the NCAA South Regional First Round.

Working primarily with the post players, Korn was a big influence on the development of two-time All-Big 12 First Team selection Dean Wade, who became the fourth Wildcat to earn All-Big 12 First-Team honors in 2018 and just the second to do so in back-to-back seasons. Wade is one of just three players to rank in the school's Top 10 in both career scoring (1,510) and rebounding (685). He was instrumental in

the progress of Makol Mawien, who has started all 103 games in his K-State career and emerged as one of the top big men in the Big 12.

Korn was also key in the growth of All-Big 12 selections Wesley Iwundu and D.J. Johnson during his first season as an assistant coach in 2016-17. Iwundu, who was twice named Third Team All-Big 12, became the first Wildcat since 2008 to be taken in the NBA Draft when he was selected with 33rd overall pick by the Orlando Magic. Johnson, an honorable mention all-league selection, broke the career field goal percentage record at 59.5 percent, while setting the single-season mark for the second consecutive season at 62.3 percent in 2016-17.

Korn spent one season



on Bruce Weber's inaugural staff at K-State as Director of Operations in 2012-13, helping the Wildcats to a 27-8 overall record and their first-ever Big 12 regular-season title. It was the school's first conference title since 1977, while the 27 wins rated second-most in school history.

Overall, he has 15 years of Division I experience, which includes time at his alma mater – Southern Illinois (2004-12). Korn has extensive ties to Weber after playing his first four years (1999-2003) for him at Southern Illinois. He redshirted in 1999-2000 before playing the next three years for Weber. He concluded his playing career for (current Purdue head coach) Matt Painter in 2003-04 before

spending the next eight years (2004-12) at SIU as an assistant for then-Saluki head coach and current K-State associate head coach Chris Lowery.

Korn returned to Manhattan in May 2016 after three seasons at Missouri State, where he served as an assistant coach to then-head coach Paul Lusk from 2013-16. At MSU, he helped the Bears to 44 wins, including a 20 -win season and a trip to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament in 2013-14.

Korn helped mentor a number of All-Missouri Valley honorees during his stay at Missouri State, including 2014 All-MVC Second-Team selection Jarmar Gulley and 2016 MVC Newcomer of the Year Dequon Miller. In addition, he coached three MVC

All-Freshman Team honorees in Austin Ruder in 2014 and Obediah Church and Jarred Dixon in 2016 as well as two Most Improved Team members (Dorrian Williams in 2015 and Chris Kendrix in 2016).

Prior to his first stint at K-State, Korn spent eight years (2004-12) at Southern Illinois, including his final six years as a full-time assistant under Lowery. He helped the Salukis post a 145-116 (.556) overall record with four postseason appearances, two Missouri Valley Conference championships and one State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament title. The squad won 20 or more games and advanced to the NCAA Tournament on three occasions (2005, 2006, 2007) during his tenure as an assistant coach, including a 2007 trip to the Sweet 16. He was a graduate assistant at SIU his first two years before being elevated to a full-time assistant coach on Jan. 31, 2006.

A native of Plano, Illinois, Korn helped the Salukis through one of their greatest periods of success from 1999 to 2004. The squad went from 16 wins his redshirt-freshman season to three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances under Weber and Painter. He was also a part of three Missouri Valley regular season championships as a player.

The 6-foot-9 forward saw action in 121 games in his career, averaging 5.2 points and 2.3 rebounds in 14.5 minutes per game. As a senior, he averaged

9.7 points on 41 percent shooting with four rebounds and 1.9 assists in helping SIU to 25 wins and a 17-1 mark in MVC play. He was named to the league's Most Improved Team.

Korn earned a bachelor's degree in Marketing from Southern Illinois in 2004 and his master's degree in Administrative Studies from Missouri State in 2016. He resides in Cape Girardeau with his wife, Kristin, and daughters Brielyn and Ashtyn.
