#### **Series History**

Southeast Missouri faces Dallas Baptist in a series for the second time in its program history. These teams last opened the 2012 season against each other. DBU swept SEMO, 3-0, with three victories that were decided by no more than two runs. The Patriots won by scores of 7-6, 3-2 and 3-1 in Dallas.

#### **Reigning Champions**

The Redhawks and Patriots are both reigning champions of their respective conferences.

Southeast Missouri won the Ohio Valley
Conference regular-season and tournament titles, while Dallas Baptist did the same in the Missouri Valley Conference last season.

SEMO advanced to the NCAA Oxford Regional

hosted by Ole Miss, while DBU came within one win of making the College World Series.

#### Season-Openers

Southeast Missouri is 12-18 all-time in season-openers during its NCAA Division I era (since 1992). SEMO is 3-2 in such games under Head Coach Andy Sawyers. SEMO beat Western Michigan at home in 2019, UT Arlington in Nacogdoches, Texas in 2017 and South Alabama in Mobile, Alabama in 2021 for Sawyers' season-opening victories.

#### Season 64

The 2022 campaign marks Southeast Missouri's 64th year of college baseball. The Redhawks are in their 31st season as an NCAA Division I program. SEMO is 1,394-1,139 all-time and 860-752-1 at the NCAA Division I level

since the inception of its baseball program. The Redhawks have a 426-293-1 record in Ohio Valley Conference play. SEMO won five OVC regular-season titles (2002, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2021), four OVC Tournament crowns (1998, 2002, 2016, 2021) and made four NCAA Tournament appearances (1998, 2002, 2016, 2021) in program history.

#### **Against Ranked Teams**

Dallas Baptist is ranked No. 22 in the D1Baseball and No. 23 in the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association preseason polls. Southeast Missouri is 3-14 in their last 17 meetings with ranked opponents. That record includes a 0-6 mark against teams ranked in the top five. SEMO last beat a ranked team on Apr. 29, 2018 (10-6, vs. #20 Tennessee Tech). Here are SEMO's results in the last 17 matchups with ranked teams:

#### **OVC Preseason Favorite**

Southeast Missouri was tabbed the preseason favorite in the 2022 Ohio Valley
Conference Baseball Preseason Poll on Feb.
10. The reigning OVC regular-season and tournament champion, SEMO received eight of the possible 18 first-place nods in the overall voting by league Head Coaches and
Communication Directors. SEMO accumulated a total of 114 points, while Murray State – which the Redhawks beat to win the OVC
Tournament crown in 2021 – was picked second with four first-place votes and 104 points. Morehead State (93 pts.), Austin Peay

(87 pts.) and Belmont (86 pts.) round out the top five, while SIU Edwardsville (55 pts.), Eastern Illinois (50 pts.), Tennessee Tech (43 pts.) and UT Martin (16 pts.) complete the nine-team predicted order of finish.

#### 2022 Redhawks

The Redhawks 2022 roster consists of 38 players, including four seniors, 16 juniors, nine sophomores and nine freshmen. Southeast Missouri returns five position starters and two starting pitchers. SEMO also has each of its top five hitters back from last season.

## Wilber Named OVC Preseason Player of the Year

Senior shortstop Tyler Wilber was voted the 2022 Ohio Valley Conference Preseason Player of the Year. A native of Los Alamitos, California, Wilber started all 52 games last season. A Second-Team All-OVC pick, he was Southeast Missouri's leading hitter witha .378 batting average. Wilber also led the Redhawks in RBI (49), total bases (109), slugging percentage (.542), and hits (76). He finished the regular-season with a league-best .400 batting average. Additionally, Wilber was a semifinalist for the Brooks Wallace Award.

#### **Batting Titles**

Tyler Wilber won the Ohio Valley Conference regular-season batting title twice in his career to date. Wilber was hitting .400 at the end of regular-season play in 2021 and hit .383 during the 2019 campaign.

#### What a Career!

Tyler Wilber is in his fourth-year as Southeast Missouri's starting shortstop. Wilber enters his final season with a career batting average of .384. His batting average is the secondhighest in a career among players in SEMO's NCAA Division I era, just points behind Todd Shylanski (.387, 1991-92). Wilber ranks fourth all-time among the Redhawks career leaders in batting average and sixth in on-base percentage (.468). He has 184 hits, 101 runs, 39 doubles, six triples, 11 home runs and 101 RBI in 124 starts.

#### Mason Secures Preseason All-OVC Honors

Left fielder Jevon Mason joined Tyler Wilber on this year's Preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference Team. Mason, who hails from West Des Moines, Iowa, made the league's All-Tournament Team in his first year as a Redhawk in 2021. He ranked second on the team with a .350 batting average behind Wilber. Mason led Southeast Missouri with 14 doubles and boasted a team-best .447 on-base percentage.

#### 124 and Counting

Tyler Wilber has never missed a start in his Southeast Missouri career. The shortstop has started 124 consecutive games as the most experienced player on the roster. Wilber committed only nine errors in 52 starts at short in 2021.

## Grossius Gets the Ball on Opening Day

Right-hander Bryce Grossius will make his first career Friday start when he takes the mound for game one of Southeast Missouri's series at #22/23 Dallas Baptist. Grossius made his way into SEMO's weekend rotation where he logged eight starts last season. He walked only two and struck out 25 in 19 innings during Ohio Valley Conference play. For the season, Grossius went 4-3 with 57 strikeouts and 14 walks in 54.1 innings over 18 appearances and eight starts. He ranked second on the team in strikeouts in 2021.

#### More on the Rotation

Left-hander Noah Niznik is scheduled to start Saturday and right-hander Austin Williams will start Sunday against Dallas Baptist. Niznik made 11 starts and pitched one complete game to go along with 34 strikeouts in 55.2 innings last season. Meanwhile, Williams mainly pitched in relief where he made all but on of his 22 appearances out of the bullpen. He led the Redhawks with six saves.

#### From Walk-On to Scholarship

What a rookie season right-hander Kyle Miller had for Southeast Missouri in 2021. Miller, who joined the team as a walk-on, compiled a 4-2 record in 20 appearances and five starts. He rated third on the team with 52 strikeouts in 51.1 innings. Miller picked up his first career save on six outs in the Redhawks

season-opening win at South Alabama a year ago and then finished his freshman year by throwing a complete game two-hitter with 10 strikeouts in the Redhawks Ohio Valley Conference Tournament Championship win over Murray State. Miller begins his 2022 campaign as a scholarship player.

#### **Keck Can Run**

Junior catcher Andrew Keck led Southeast Missouri and ranked second in the Ohio Valley Conference in stolen bases last season. Keck was 17-of-19 on the basepaths and has stolen 34 bases in his career.

#### Newcomer Talent

Outfielder Josh Cameron, infielder Ben Palmer. pitcher Jason Rackers, outfielder Joel Vaske and utility player Tommy Windt are some of the high-impact newcomers on Southeast Missouri's roster this season. Cameron was a First-Team National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) All-American at Butler Community College in 2021. He finished his career as one of the best junior college power hitters in the country. Cameron hit .412 and ranked second in the NJCAA with 25 home runs. Palmer was the 2021 NJCAA Division I ABCA/Rawlings Gold Glove winner at Iowa Western Community College. Vaske earned Third-Team NJCAA All-America accolades at Kirkwood CC and Rackers, who joins the Redhawks from SEC member Tennessee, is among the top 2022 Draft Prospects in the Ohio Valley Conference according to Baseball America. Windt secured Second-Team NJCAA Division I All-America laurels as a designated hitter at South Suburban College.

#### 2022 Schedule

A 55-game schedule with 25 matchups at Capaha Field is in store for the Southeast Missouri baseball team this upcoming 2022 season. SEMO opens its season with a three-game series at reigning Missouri Valley Conference regular-season and tournament champion Dallas Baptist on Feb. 18-20. DBU is one of four NCAA Tournament teams from last season included on the Redhawks 2022 docket. Southeastern Conference member Ole Miss, which hosted the NCAA Regional SEMO played in during the 2021 campaign, will welcome the Redhawks for a midweek tilt on Apr. 19. Indiana State and Oklahoma State are

the other 2021 NCAA Tournament participants. SEMO heads to ISU for a two-game set on Mar. 15-16 and travels to OSU (May 6-8) for its final non-conference series. OSU was runner-up in the Big 12 Conference Tournament last season. The Redhawks also face Kentucky (Feb. 22), Bellarmine, Saint Louis (Mar. 1, Mar. 29), Bradley (Mar. 4-6), Arkansas State (Mar. 8, Apr. 5), Valparaiso (Mar. 11-13), Missouri State (Mar. 18-20, May 10) and Southern Illinois (Apr. 12, Apr. 26) in non-conference action. SEMO hosts Bellarmine in its home-opening weekend on Feb. 25-27. The Redhawks 24-game Ohio Valley Conference schedule begins with a home series against SIU Edwardsville (Mar. 25-27). Murray State (Apr. 8-10), Morehead State (Apr. 22-24) and UT Martin (May 13-15) round out SEMO's home OVC foes. SEMO will make trips to Austin Peay (Apr. 1-3), Tennessee Tech (Apr. 14-16), Belmont (Apr. 29-May 1) and Eastern Illinois (May 19-21) for its four conference road series.

#### **OVC Tournament Moves to Lexington**

For the first time in 2022, the OVC Baseball Championship will be held at the Lexington Legends Ballpark in Lexington, Kentucky on May 25-28. Since 2001, the Championship has been held at four other neutral locations, including Paducah, Kentucky (2001-09), Jackson, Tennessee (2010-16, 2021), Oxford, Alabama (2017-18) and Marion, Illinois (2019).

#### On Deck

Southeast Missouri travels to Southeastern Conference member Kentucky for its first midweek game of the season on Feb. 22.



ndy Sawyers is the reigning Ohio Valley Conference Coach of the Year after leading Southeast Missouri to the league's regularseason and tournament titles, and the program's fourth NCAA Tournament berth in 2021.

Sawyers looks to carry the momentume into the 2022 campaign, his sixth year as SEMO's head coach.

The Redhawks finished their championship season with an overall 30-22 record and 17-10 in the OVC. SEMO recorded 30 wins in a season for the first time with Sawyers at the helm and posted series wins in eight of its nine series against league foes in 2021.

Sawyers coached his first OVC Specialty Award-Winner when left-hander Dylan Dodd was tabbed the league's Pitcher of the Year.

Dodd later became the

highest draft pick in program history when he was selected in the third round by the Atlanta Braves in the 2021 Major League Draft. Additionally, Dodd wrapped up his final college season as a Second-Team Collegiate Baseball All-American.

Statistically, SEMO led the OVC with 14 saves and a .967 fielding percentage after committing just 49 errors in 52 contests. The Redhawks were also second in the conference in wins as their 30 victories marked the most in a season in five years.

In 2020, SEMO had an overall record of 9-8 and a 2-1 mark in OVC play when its season abruptly ended due to a global COVID-19 pandemic. The Redhawks heated up to win seven of nine contests prior to the end of competition.

The Redhawks led the OVC in

batting average (.314), hits (188), triples (9), plate appearances (707), at-bats (598), hit by pitch (26), stolen bases (36), fewest walks allowed (54) and fielding percentage (.976), and rated second in slugging percentage (.503), on-base percentage (.404), runs (129), RBI (121) and home runs (21) at the time their 2020 campaign came to a close. SEMO also ranked among the top 10 teams in the nation in hits (6th) and triples (8th).

Individually, Justin Dirden led the conference in slugging percentage (.900), RBI (26), home runs (9), hits (29), total bases (63) and stolen bases (9) before signing as an undrafted free agent with the Houston Astros

Shortstop Tyler Wilber topped the OVC in runs (26) and center fielder Danny Wright tied a league-high with 29 hits when play was suspended. Pitching wise, left-handers Dylan Dodd (2-1, 36 Ks) and Noah Niznik (3-0, 15 Ks) were a combined 5-1 with 51 strikeouts and two complete game shutouts through four starts in 2020.

Before they took the field in 2019, the Redhawks ushered in a state-of-the-art hitting facility adjacent to Capaha Field. The 4,000-square foot facility can fit up to four batting cages and is equipped with portable pitching mounds. It also had HitTrax Rapsodo technology which is used to enhance overall player performance through real-tiem stats and performance metrics.

SEMO went 23-32 during an injury-riddled 2019 campaign. The Redhawks played without five of their position starters for much of the season.

Despite the misfortune with injuries, SEMO had a pair of All-OVC performers in Wilber

and Niznik.

A First-Team selection, Wilber led the OVC with a .383 batting average and was the Redhawks leader in hits (80) doubles (19), triples (3), RBI (40), slugging percentage (.531) and on-base percentage (.480).

Niznik, who landed a spot on the All-Newcomer Team, started 13 games as a freshman. He led the team with a 3.63 ERA, ranked second in innings (62) and third in both strikeouts (49) and wins (3).

The year before that, Sawyers guided the 2018 squad to the program's 13th consecutive OVC Tournament berth as the Redhawks finished 27-30 overall and second in the conference with a 20-10 record.

That team produced three First-Team All-OVC performers, including Carlos Vega, Trevor Ezell and Dirden.

Sawyers was hired as the sixth head coach in program history on July 29, 2016.

In his first year as an NCAA Division I head coach in 2017, Sawyers led the Redhawks to a winning season (29-26 overall, 16-14 OVC). He also picked up his first career OVC Tournament win along the way.

First-Team pick Dan Holst, Second-Team selections Brian Lees, Chris Osborne, Justin Murphy and Clay Chandler, and All-Newcomer Team member Danny Wright formed a group of six All-OVC players in Sawyers' debut season as a Division I head coach.

In all, Sawyers has two decades worth of collegiate coaching experience.

Prior to arriving in Cape Girardeau, he worked two seasons as the Associate Head Coach/Offensive Coordinator at Big 12 Conference member Kansas State. There, Sawyers oversaw the hitters and catchers, while helping coordinate recruiting efforts.

Sawyers has coached in two College World Series, two NCAA Super Regionals and nine NCAA Tournaments during his coaching tenure. He has mentored 40 Major League Baseball draft picks, including two first-round selections and nine top-10 round picks.

The Wildcats ranked fourth in the Big 12 offensively with a .284 team batting average in 2016. K-State's offense registered a .400 slugging percentage and .372 on-base percentage, scored 335 runs, had 550 hits, belted 100 doubles, notched 17 triples, and finished with 30 home runs and 300 RBI.

Sawyers coached freshman Josh Rolette who garnered Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American honors in 2016. He also helped mentor Jake Scudder who was named Big 12 Newcomer of the Year. The Wildcats had three studentathletes on the All-Big 12 Teams that season.

The 2015 and 2016 campaigns were Sawyers' second stint at K-State.

He previously served as an assistant coach for the Wildcats in 2009 and 2010. Sawyers helped lead K-State to an 80-30-1 record and the first two NCAA Regional appearances in school history over that span.

The 2009 season was a year of power for the Wildcats under Sawyers. The team hit 22 triples and 58 home runs, most in both categories since 1997. The offense shined when it came to

stolen bases as the 149 steals were second-most in the nation and just two shy of breaking the Big 12 record. Overall, the team finished among Big 12 leaders in on-base percentage (2nd, .399), runs scored (2nd, 458), hits (2nd, 675), RBI (2nd, 420), doubles (3rd, 123), and fewest strikeouts (4th, 393).

Six Wildcats claimed All-Big 12 honors in 2009, including outfielder Nick Martini, who also garnered Louisville Slugger Freshman All America honors, and Justin Bloxom and Carter Jurica, who finished fourth and eighth, respectively, in the Big 12 in batting average.

The 2010 squad matched the success of 2009 by also reaching the NCAA postseason, and the offense topped the previous season totals in batting average (.323 in 2010; .317 in 2009), runs per game (7.6 vs. 7.4) and OBP (.426 vs. .399).

Before K-State, Sawyers spent four seasons as Associate Head Coach at Texas A&M (2011-14). Those four seasons at Texas A&M represented the end of Sawyers' five-year stint with the Aggies after he spent 2008 as a volunteer assistant coach.

In each of those five seasons, Sawyers helped Texas A&M reach an NCAA Regional while also winning a pair of Big 12 championships. In addition, he coached standouts Tyler Naquin - 2011 Big 12 Player of the Year, All-American and a first round pick by the Cleveland Indians in 2012 - and Krey Bratson, a 2011 Freshman All-American.

Before his appointment at Texas A&M in 2008, Sawyers worked with current Aggie head coach Rob Childress as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Nebraska from 2003-07.

While in Lincoln, he helped the Huskers earn four trips to the NCAA Tournament, including an appearance at the 2005 College World Series. Sawyers, who lettered two years at Nebraska, worked with 12 Huskers who were selected in the MLB Draft, including Alex

Collegiate Baseball.

After working as the volunteer assistant at Nebraska in 2000, Sawyers worked the 2001 and 2002 seasons as head coach at Hutchinson Community College, compiling an 87-30 record and two postseason berths. In 2001, the Dragons went 40-16 and won the Jayhawk West Sub-Regional, while the 2002 squad set a school record with 47 wins and was ranked as high as seventh by the NJCAA.

Sawyers' coaching career began at Northwestern (La.)

State in 1999 as a volunteer assistant coach, helping the Demons finish second in the Southland Conference.

He first played collegiately at Point Loma (Calif.) Nazarene College in 1994. Following a year off, he played at Mendocino (Calif.) Junior College in 1996 before finishing up his playing career at Nebraska.

A native of Willits, California, Sawyers received his bachelor (1998) and master's (2000) degrees from Nebraska. He is married to the former Dena Lindeblad and the couple have two sons, Andrew James (A.J.) and Alex.
