SERIES HISTORY

UT Martin leads SEMO in the all-time series, 42-30. UTM won both contests during the 2020-21 season and the initial 2021-22 matchup. The Skyhawks won the most recent meeting, 70-66, Feb. 3, 2022, in Martin, Tennessee at the Kathleen and Tom Elam Center. Taelour Pruitt notched 16 points and Deanay Watson had a double-double outing of 15 points and 10 rebounds. Pruitt shot 4-for-8 from the field including 4-for-7 from beyond the arc with five rebounds and four steals Thursday. She was also 4-for-6 at the charity stripe. Watson converted 6-for-11 in a game-high 35 minutes for her fourth double-double of the 2021-22 campaign. Pruitt and Watson combined for 18 points (11 and seven, respectively) in the third quarter to set the table for the decisive final period. SERIES HISTORY

SEMO leads Murray State in the all-time series, 36-32. The Racers won two of the three matchups with the Redhawks during the 2020-21 season. Murray State most recently won the initial 2021-22 matchup, 82-58, Dec. 30, 2021, at the CFSB Center in Murray, Kentucky. Deanay Watson posted 14 points and Roshala Scott added 12. Watson shot 7-for-13 from the field and grabbed eight boards with a steal. Scott converted 6-for-11 on baskets. Halle Smith added eight points, shooting 2-for-2 from the field and 1-for-1 on triples..

SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

Murray State is 20-7 in 2021-22 and 12-4 in OVC play. The Racers have won their last five including most recently against Austin Peay (68-61, OT, Feb. 16) and at UT Martin (69-56, Feb. 19). Katelyn Young powered Murray State to two wins on the week by averaging 26.5 points and 10.5 rebounds for OVC Player of the Week honors. The sophomore tied her career-high of 31 points in an overtime win over Austin Peay, which she followed with a double-double of 22 points and 13 rebounds at UT Martin. Young shot 51.4 percent from the floor and 85.7-percent from the line on the week, by going 12-for-14 from the stripe on Wednesday and 4-4 Saturday. The Oakwood, Illinois native ended the week by averaging 3.0 assists, 1.5 steals and 0.5 blocks.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENT UT MARTIN

The Skyhawks most recently went 2-1 in their contests last week in Martin. Tennessee. UT Martin is 11-16 in 2021-22 and 8-8 in league play. UTM picked up its fourth straight victory after holding visiting OVC foe Morehead State to under 30 percent from the field and 29 turnovers in a 54-36 victory on Feb. 16. Shae Littleford scored a careerhigh 21 points on 6-of-11 shooting from the floor while knocking down 4-of-5 three-point attempts. The Skyhawks also beat Austin Peay, 60-57, on Feb. 14 to open the week. UTM then dropped the season series to Murray State following a 69-56 setback Feb. 19 on Senior Day. Littleford averaged 12.3 points while shooting 47.8 percent from the field in the team's three contests. Littleford tallied seven points, three assists and one steal in the win over Austin Peay while setting a new career-high with 21 points, two assists and two steals against Morehead State. In the team's final home game against Murray State, she tossed in nine points, three rebounds and two assists. UTM will close the regular season at Tennessee Tech Saturday.

NEWSOME FACES ALMA MATER UTM THURSDAY

Redhawk assistant coach and recruiting coordinator Jasmine Newsome will face her alma mater, UT Martin, Thursday for the second time this season as an opposing coach. Newsome helped lead the Skyhawks to four OVC Tournament titles and four consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances. She holds a multitude of UTM records and inducted into the UT Martin Athletics Hall of Fame in 2019 while having her jersey hung in the rafters of the Kathleen and Tom Elam Center on Feb. 8, 2020. Prior to joining Rekha Patterson's staff at SEMO, Newsome served as an assistant coach on the UT Martin women's basketball staff for six seasons. In her coaching stint with the Skyhawk, Newsome has seen the program win three OVC regular season titles during the 2015-16, 2019-20 and 2020-21 seasons along with four of the program's 20-win seasons. The Skyhawks also qualified for the postseason four times with berths in the Women's NIT in 2016, 2018, 2020 (canceled) and 2021.

ABOUT LAST WEEK

SEMO most recently split its final two regular-season road games. Taelour Pruitt registered a game-high 23 points with four rebounds as SEMO dropped a competitive road contest to Tennessee Tech, 65-55, Feb. 17 at the Eblen Center in Cookeville, Tennessee. Pruitt, a senior from Crowley, Texas, notched her seventh career 20-plus game as a Redhawk (third in 2021-22), shooting 9-for-21 from the field including a pair of triples (2-for-7) in a game-high 37 minutes. Deanay Watson led four Redhawks in double-digits scoring as SEMO defeated Morehead State, 70-62, Feb. 19 at the Johnson Center in Morehead, Kentucky. Watson paced SEMO with her sixth doubledouble of the campaign, finishing with 17 points and 10 rebounds. The senior from Bradenton, Florida, shot 7-for-14 from the field including 2-for-2 on three-pointers. Johné Stewart added a career-best 12 points in a team-best 34 minutes. The Jacksonville transfer from Memphis, Tennessee, shot 6-for-12 with five boards and four assists in her fifth career start as a Redhawk. Kennedi Watkins chipped in 11 points while Jaliyah Green had 10 followed by Taelour Pruitt (nine points, four assists and four steals) and Kori Tomlin (seven points).

TP HEATING UP

Taelour Pruitt has registered double-figures scoring in six of the last eight games to lead SEMO on the stats sheet in six of the last 10 games. Pruitt paced the Redhawks this past week with 32 points (16.0ppg) and six boards (16.0rpg) as SEMO split its final 2021-22 regular-season road trip. Pruitt registered a game-high 23 points with four rebounds as SEMO dropped a competitive road contest to Tennessee Tech, 65-55, Feb. 17 evening at the Eblen Center. Pruitt, a senior from Crowley, Texas, notched her seventh career 20-plus game as a Redhawk (third in 2021-22), shooting 9-for-21 from the field including a pair of triples (2-for-7) in a game-high 37 minutes. She then added nine points, four assists and four steals in the Redhawks win at Morehead State Feb. 19. Pruitt was 5-for-5 at the charity stripe at Morehead State. Pruitt has started in the last 16 games for the Redhawks. She has played in all 27 games, averaging 10.5 points with 2.7 boards in 28.8 minutes. Pruitt is shooting 34 percent from the field.

THE DAILY SHOW WITH JOHNÉ **STEWART**

Johné Stewart paced the Redhawks newcomers this past week with 20 points (10.0ppg) and six rebounds (3.00rpg) as SEMO split its final 2021-22 regular-season road trip. Stewart notched a career-best 12 points in a team-high 34 minutes at Morehead State Feb. 19. The Jacksonville transfer from Memphis, Tennessee, shot 6-for-12 with five boards and four assists in her fifth career start as a Redhawk. Stewart opened the week with eight points, shooting 4-for-5 at TTU on Feb. 17 with three assists. She has passed out a career-best six assists twice in 2021-22. Stewart had six assists with four points at UT Martin on Feb. 3. She tallied a career best six rebounds and six assists in her third career start as a Redhawk Jan. 29, 2022, against SIUE. She made her first career start as a Redhawk on Jan. 13 against Tennessee Tech. Stewart finished with three points and three rebounds in 14 minutes of court time. She closed the week with 33 minutes at SIUE on Jan. 15. Stewart, a transfer from Jacksonville, has played in 22 games this season with five starts. She is averaging 18.4 minutes of court time with 2.5 rebounds and 1.7 assists.

WATKINS IS WAT'S UP WITH THAT

Kennedi Watkins registered 18 points (9.0ppg) and 10 rebounds (5.0rpg) this past week as SEMO split its final 2021-22 regularseason road trip. Watkins chipped in 11 points with three rebounds at Morehead State on Feb. 19. She opened the week with seven points and seven boards at Tennessee Tech on Feb. 17. She has notched double digits scoring in eight of the last 12 games. Watkins tied a career-best 14 points for the third time this season, producing the feat against SIUE on Jan. 29. She previously notched 14 points at SIUE (Jan. 15) and against Mississippi Valley State (Nov. 26, 2021). Watkins has played in 23 games and started in the first seven games of the 2021-22 season. Watkins has started 12 games this season. She is averaging 8.1 points, and 5.6 rebounds in 22.0 minutes. She ranks third in OVC games with 2.6 offensive rebounds (41). Watkins is averaging 8.6 points per game in OVC play with 5.4 rebounds per game (15th, 86).

GOOD SHOW. WATSON

Deanay Watson has posted double-figures scoring in seven of SEMO's last eight games. She has notched a double-double in four of those games during that span. She most recently paced SEMO with her sixth double-double of the campaign, finishing with 17 points and 10 rebounds at Morehead State on Feb. 19. The senior from Bradenton, Florida, shot 7-for-14 from the field including 2-for-2 on three-pointers. She opened the week with five points and four rebounds at Tennessee Tech on Feb. 17. Watson, a senior from Bradenton, Florida, has started in all but two games (25 starts in 27 games) for the Redhawks in 2021-22. She has posted double-figure points in 19 games. Watson is averaging 11.2 points per game with 5.9 boards in 29.6 minutes. Watson is shooting 52 percent from the field and has registered 10 or more points in 15 of the last 20 games. In OVC play, Watson is averaging 12.3 points (16th) with 6.0 rebounds (seventh) in 31.1 minutes (497 minutes, 14th). She is shooting .494 (80-162) and is fourth for offensive rebounding (38, 2.4/game).

OUR FAVORITE COLOR BESIDES RED IS JALIYAH GREEN

Jaliyah Green finished with 10 points, as one of four Redhawks to turn in a double-digit scoring performance Feb. 19 at Morehead State. Green was 4-for-8 from the field shooting with a pair of rebounds. She also dished out three assists and a steal. It marked Green's first double-digit scoring outing since a career-high 16 against Tennessee Tech on Jan. 13. Green has started the last three games and made 18 starts in 2021-22. She has competed in 22 games and started the first seven. Green is averaging 6.4 points with 3.3 boards in 25.2 minutes of court time.

PRUITT COMPETES IN 100TH CAREER GAME AT SEMO

Taelour Pruitt played in her 100th career game as a Redhawk Feb. 10 at Austin Peay. The senior from Crowley, Texas, has made 70 starts and totaled 857 points in her career at SEMO. Pruitt ranks seventh overall in SEMO program history for career 3-pointers (115). She also is ninth for steals (161) and 10th for assists (293). She ranks eighth in OVC only play with 3.1 assists (50), fifth for steals (2.3spg, 36) and has an assist-turnover margin of 0.9 (9th). Pruitt is also ninth on three-pointers made with 23 (1.4 per game). She has appeared in 493 minutes (30.8 minutes per game, 17th) and is averaging 10.5 points per game (168 points, 24th). Overall in 2021-22. Pruitt is third for threepointers attempted (143) and fifth for steals (2.00spg, 54 steals).

FIRST CAREER STARTS AS REDHAWKS

Michaela Mavfield made her first career start as a Redhawk Feb. 12 against Belmont. Chandler Davis and Diona Reed also both made their first career starts as Redhawks Feb. 5 against Eastern Illinois. Reed finished with four points, a personal best three rebounds and an assist in 13 minutes. Davis appeared in 12 minutes Feb. 5 after finishing with a career-high eight points to pace the Redhawks non-starters at UT Martin on Feb. 3. She shot 3-for-4 from the field and a perfect 2-for-2 on trevs against the Skyhawks. Davis made her second-straight start at Austin Peay on Feb. 10 while Reed has started in the last three games for SEMO.

FIRST OVC WIN IN 2021-22

Four Redhawks finished in double-digits scoring as SEMO registered its first Ohio Valley Conference victory of the 2021-22 season, 60-53, over Morehead State (1-17, 0-8 OVC) Jan. 27, 2022 at the Show Me Center. Taelour Pruitt paced SEMO with 15 points while Watson and Kennedi Watkins each had 12 points. Watson finished with a double-double, adding 10 boards while Watkins pulled down nine rebounds. Roshala Scott chipped in 10 points and seven rebounds in her first start back from injury since Jan. 6 at Belmont. Pruitt. Watkins and Scott each had four steals as the Redhawks totaled a season high 17. SEMO cashed in 26 points off Morehead State turnovers Thursday. Pruitt shot 5-for-11 and 4-for-4 on free throws with two assists. Watson appeared in a game-high 38 minutes, going 5-for-14 from the field. Watkins finished 5-for-13 shooting for her fifth-straight double-digit game.

PATTERSON ECLIPSES 100 CAREER

Head coach Rekha Patterson eclipsed the 100-win mark in her career at the helm of Southeast Missouri with a 60-53 victory over Morehead State on Jan. 27, 2022. In seven

seasons at SEMO, Patterson has registered a record of 101-105.

TOMLIN FROM DOWNTOWN

Kori Tomlin registered nine points, three assists, two steals and a rebound, coming off the bench against SIUE on Jan. 29. Tomlin, a junior transfer from Moberly Area Community College, shot a career-best 3-for-3 from beyond the arc and finished 3-for-5 shooting. She most recently had seven points with three rebounds, shooting 2-for-4 from three-point range against Morehead State on Feb. 19. Tomlin made her first career start as a Redhawk Dec. 9 against Purdue Fort Wayne. She finished with a career-best four steals, four assists and three points against the Mastodons. Tomlin posted a career-best 10 points in 24 minutes against Harris-Stowe State on Dec. 5. She was 3-for-9 shooting and 3-for-7 on triples with five assists and two steals. Tomlin has played in all 27 games thus far this season with nine starts and is averaging 3.5 points, 1.6 rebounds and 2.0 assists in 22.3 minutes of court time. She is shooting 34 percent from the field and 33 percent from distance.

Michaela Mayfield tallied a career best nine points, going a personal-best 7-for-8 at the charity stripe against Tennessee State on Jan. 20. Mayfield also finished with two boards, two assists and a steal in 16 minutes of court time. Mayfield, a sophomore from Gurdon, Arkansas, has played in 26 games in 2021-22 for the Redhawks. She is averaging 2.0 points with 2.4 rebounds in 9.8 minutes of action. She most recently made her first career start against Belmont on Feb. 12

WHERE WE RANK IN THE OVC

SEMO ranks third as a team in the conference with 940 rebounds (34.81rpg, sixth). Deanay Watson leads the Redhawks with 158 (5.9rpg) followed by Kennedi Watkins (128, 5.6rpg). Halle Smith has 107 (4.0rpg) and Jaliyah Green has notched 73 (3.3rpg). SEMO is fifth for steals (230, 8.5 steals/game), fifth for blocked shots (74, 2.7 blocks/game) and fifth for free throw attempts (287-for-428). In OVC only play, SEMO is sixth for offensive rebounds (11.3, 180), third for three-point field goal defense (.305) and seventh for offensive rebound percentage (.324)

and sixth for steals (8.9, 143) percentage (.337) and sixth for steals (9.4, 131).

REDHAWKS ADD MID-YEAR TRANSFER FORWARD JULIA SION

SEMO head coach Rekha Patterson announced Jan. 10 the addition of mid-year transfer Julia Sion for the 2021-22 season. Sion, a 6-2 junior forward, will join the Redhawks this season after transferring from North Alabama. She will have two years of eligibility remaining and is not eligible this season after playing at UNA in 2021-22.

NON-CONFERENCE RECAP

SEMO went 4-7 in its 2021-22 nonconference slate. The Redhawks picked up wins over the University of Health Sciences & Pharmacy (UHSP, 68-45, Nov. 9), Mississippi Valley State (82-76, Nov. 26). Harris-Stowe State (95-57, Dec. 5) and Purdue Fort Wayne (68-51, Dec. 9).

CAREER-HIGH FOR WATSON

Deanay Watson registered her first doubledouble outing of the 2021-22 campaign with a career-best 23 points, 11 rebounds with two steals and a block in 30 minutes of court time Dec. 5 against Harris-Stowe State. It was her second career double-double as a Redhawk, Watson, a senior from Bradenton. Florida, was 9-for-12 from the field including 50 percent (1-for-2) from three-point range. She also was perfect 4-for-4 on free throws.

REDHAWKS INK ALECIA DOYLE FOR 2022-23 SEASON

SEMO announced the signing of Alecia Doyle for the 2022-23 season Nov. 11. Doyle, a 5-8 guard from Herrin, Illinois, is a four-year starter and letter-winner and will graduate from Carterville High School in May 2022. As a junior, she was named Southern Illinoisan Player of the Year, AP First Team All-State, Illinois Basketball Coaches Association All-State, Mississippi First Team All-Conference and SICA All-South Team. She averaged 20.1points, seven rebounds, five assists and five steals per game.

FIRST WIN IN 2021-22

SEMO captured its first victory of the 2021-22 campaign, 68-45, over the University of Health Sciences & Pharmacy (UHSP in St. Louis) (1-3) Nov. 9 at the Show Me Center. Three Redhawks finished in double-figures including a team-high 14 points and four rebounds from Roshala Scott. Freshman Kennedi Watkins chipped in 13 points and seven rebounds in her first career start. Deanay Watson also finished with a career-best tying 12 points and five boards. Shymaryia Christopher and Jaliyah Green also both made their first career collegiate starts in the victory. Christopher finished with eight points while Green had five. Halle Smith, Johné Stewart and Kori Tomlin also made their Redhawk debuts. Tomlin led all SEMO players with 25 minutes. Taelour Pruitt dished out a career-best matching seven assists to accompany eight points.

EXHIBITION RECAP

SEMO defeated William Woods, 66-49, in exhibition play Nov. 1 at the Show Me Center. Freshman Jaliyah Green led the Redhawks with 16 points to go with five rebounds and Deanay Watson chipped in 13 points hauling down eight rebounds. Roshala Scott added nine points and Shymarvia Christopher finished with seven.

OVC PRESEASON POLL

Southeast Missouri was selected to finish sixth in the Ohio Valley Conference in 2021-22. The Redhawks received 91 points in the projected order of finish. Belmont, the 2020-21 OVC Tournament Champions, was selected to finish first with 15 first place votes and 159 total points in the preseason poll. Destinee Wells, the 2020-21 OVC Tournament MVP and Freshman of the Year from Belmont, was tabbed the 2021-22 OVC Preseason Player of the Year.

TEAM MAKEUP

The Redhawks return four starters from its 2020-21 team in seniors Taelour Pruitt and Deanay Watson along with juniors Roshala Scott and Sophie Bussard. Scott was third on SEMO this past season with 10.2 points per game (265 points) and ranked fifth in the OVC in 2020-21 with 3.4 assists per game. Pruitt averaged just under 10 points (9.9, 159 points) per game in 2020-21. Bussard netted 8.8 points per contest (230 points) and paced the OVC with 931:15 minutes of court time, averaging 35.82 minutes per game. Sophomores Michaela Mayfield, Chandler Davis and Shymaryia Christopher round out the returnees this season. Mayfield was the lone freshman from that group to play this previous year and saw time at forward. The Redhawks also added eight newcomers in three transfers, four freshmen and a sophomore. Johné Stewart brings NCAA Division I experience to the team while Kori Tomlin transferred in from Moberly Area Community College. Freshmen Kennedi Watkins, Halle Smith, Jaliyah Green and Diona Reed complete the 2021-22 squad.

n six seasons, Rekha Patterson has elevated the Southeast Missouri women's basketball program from a preseason last place selection in 2015 to the 2020 **OVC Conference Tournament** Champions. The Redhawks earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament, a first in 13 years and were a team that was projected to win their First Round game before the season was cancelled due to COVID

Patterson has guided the Redhawks to six-consecutive Ohio Valley Conference Tournament appearances and led the Redhawks to just their second OVC Tournament title in program history and first since the 2006-07 season.

As Patterson enters her seventh season at the helm, she and her staff have been able to recruit, retain and develop a plethora of talented studentathletes. They have tutored an OVC Tournament MVP, the first-ever Freshman of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year and All-OVC performers in each season.

Southeast Missouri qualified for its sixth-straight Ohio Valley Conference Tournament as the #3 seed during the 2020-21 season. The Redhawks finished with a 15-11 overall record. SEMO posted a 13-7 record in OVC play for third in the league for the second-consecutive year. For Patterson, it was her second-straight winning season at SEMO after guiding the Redhawks to the 2020 OVC Tournament title.

SEMO recorded four series sweeps of OVC opponents

(Tennessee Tech, Tennessee State, Austin Peay and SIUE) in 2020-21. The Redhawks led the league with a fieldgoal percentage defense of 37.1. SEMO also topped the conference for rebound margin (3.8), rebounds (1,036) and rebounds per game (39.85). SEMO ranked second in the OVC for blocked shots (147) and blocked shots per game (5.7). The Redhawks were also third for 3-point field goal defense with 27.7.

LaTrese Saine was awarded 2020-21 OVC Defensive Player of the Year and was named to the 2020-21 All-OVC First Team with Tesia Thompson. Saine is the second Redhawk in school history to earn OVC Defensive Player of the Year after Adrianna Murphy nabbed the laurel in 2017-18.

Saine led the OVC and ranked second in the NCAA in 2020-21 for blocked shots (103) and blocked shots per game (3.96). She also was second for rebounds (222) and third for rebounds per game (8.5). She rewrote the SEMO record books for blocking in 2020-21. She set the single-season (103), singlegame (10) and career block records (212) in her redshirtsenior season as a Redhawk and helped SEMO set the all-time single-game blocks record with 13 against Murray State on January 14, 2021.

Thompson (430 points) and Saine (270 points) were SEMO's top scorers averaging 18.7 and 10.4 points per game, respectively in 2020-21. Roshala Scott was third on the team with 10.2 points per game (265 points) and Taelour Pruitt

averaged just under 10 points (9.9) per game (159 points). Sophie Bussard netted 8.8 points per contest (230 points).

Patterson mentored Thompson who finished her career with six All-OVC accolades including Freshman of the Year and Tournament MVP. She averaged 19.6 points and 7.8 rebounds per game in conference play, ranking third and ninth in the OVC in those categories, respectively in 2019-20. Thompson dished out 41 assists, five blocks and 25 steals, as well. For the year, she averaged 18.6 points per game as the Redhawks top scorer. Thompson concluded her SEMO career with 1,927 points, which ranks third in program history. She also is fourth all-time in school history for career rebounds (801) and fifth for steals (192).

Patterson was named the OVC Coach of the Year in 2019-20 as she led the Redhawks to a 25-7 overall record and a third-place finish with a 14-4 mark in OVC play. It was SEMO's highest OVC finish since the 2007-08. The 2019-20 team also had the highest winning percentage in the Division I era and were ranked 21st in the final CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Poll following the historic 2019-20 season.

The 2019-20 Redhawks achieved their success after being predicted to place sixth in the league's preseason poll. Statistically, SEMO led the OVC in scoring offense (74.5 ppg) and scoring margin

(+10.6), while ranking third with a .343 three-point field goal percentage. The team also achieved an 11-game winning streak during conference play.

The Redhawks finished their non-conference slate with an 8-3 record. SEMO recorded a dominating 70-53 win over SEC member Ole Miss for its first road win over an SEC school in program history. This was just the second all-time win against a SEC foe in program history and first since 1998.

SEMO went 3-0 in the 2020 OVC Tournament to earn the automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament before the season ended abruptly due to COVID-19. The Redhawks outscored their opponents 263-227 in the tournament, garnering double-digit victories against the tourney's top-two seeded teams.

Patterson garnered her first OVC Tournament win with an 82-81 overtime triumph over Tennessee Tech in the first round of the 2020 tournament. Taelour Pruitt's long-range step back 3-pointer at the buzzer against Tennessee Tech sent SEMO to the semifinals against No. 2 Belmont. The buzzer beater was the top play on ESPN SportsCenter's Top-10 on March 6, 2020.

SEMO shattered program and conference records with a 114-99 victory over No. 2 Belmont in the semifinals of the OVC Tournament, Tesia Thompson scored a career-high 39 points, Carrie Shephard poured in 29 and Taelour Pruitt added 21 in

in the record-setting game that ended Belmont's streak of fourstraight OVC Tournament titles. The Redhawks broke OVC Tournament single-game records in points scored and 3-point field goal percentage (82.4 percent). SEMO missed only three times from beyond the arc going a staggering 14-of-17. Combined, SEMO and Belmont scored 213 points, also an OVC Tournament record for total points in a game.

A day after a staggering offensive showcase, #3 SEMO used a remarkable defensive effort to beat #1 UT Martin and win the 2020 OVC Tournament

Title. Defensively, SEMO held UTM to only 33.3 percent (18of-54) from the field and did not give up a 3-pointer to a Skyhawk team, which entered the game as the second-most accurate 3-point shooting team in OVC play. The Skyhawks had a 3-pointer in every game that season except this one, finishing 0-of-11 from beyond the arc.

The Redhawks 2019-20 All-OVC honorees included Tesia Thompson (First-Team, OVC All-Tournament Team MVP), Carrie Shephard (First-Team, OVC All-Tournament Team), and Taelour Pruitt (OVC All-Tournament Team).

Thompson became just the 10th Redhawk in the Division I era to surpass 1,000 points. She reached the milestone at Ole Miss (Dec. 14) in the first auarter.

Patterson also mentored Shephard, who broke her own SEMO single-season record in 3-pointers made with 88 in 2019-20. In her junior and senior seasons, Shephard made a combined 161 three-pointers, which place her fourth all-time at SEMO in career 3-pointers made. She was second on the team in scoring with 16.6 points per game and led the team with 67 steals and rates second with 101 assists.

In 2018-19, four Redhawks logged over 200 points, with Tesia Thompson leading the team and the conference with 529 points. Carrie Shephard (288), Murphy (258) and Jocelyn Taylor (234) also scored over 200 points. Carrie Shephard set the single-season record for three-pointers attempted (217) and three-pointers made (73).

In 2017-18, Patterson mentored Thompson, the first to gain All-OVC Newcomer, All-OVC Second Team and later named OVC Freshman of the Year honors in the same year. Murphy was named OVC Defensive Player of the Year, the first honor for a Redhawk. The Redhawks recorded the first ever pre-season WNIT victory over Saint Francis (82-50).

In 2016-17, Patterson mentored Bri Mitchell, the first. First Team All-OVC performer out of SEMO since Missy Whitney in 2007-08.

Mitchell and fellow 2016-17 senior Olivia Hackmann both topped the 1,000-point marks in their Redhawk careers. As a team. Southeast Missouri ranked second in the league in assists (479), fewest turnovers, scoring offense (73.9 points per game), and 3-point shooting percentage (34.9%). Individually, point guard Adrianna Murphy led the OVC in assists per game (5.8) and second in total assists (174).

In her first season as head coach, Patterson guided the Redhawks to their first winning season in seven years, posting an even 15-15 overall record and an 8-8 Ohio Valley Conference record. The Redhawks, who were picked to finish last in the 12-team league, finished tied for fifth in Patterson's first season. In addition, Southeast punched its ticket to the OVC Tournament for the first time since 2009 under Patterson's tutelage. Junior guard, Bri Mitchell was named a Second Team All-OVC performer.

Statistically, the Redhawks ranked 13th nationally in rebounds per game, averaging 43.4 board per game. That figure ranked second in the OVC. SEMO's 28 defensive rebounds per game ranked 24th nationally, third in the OVC.

Of the eight head coaches in the history of Southeast Missouri women's basketball, Patterson became the fourth to record a winning season in their first year at the helm of the program.

Academically, the Redhawks have averaged a 3.30 GPA over the last six years. SEMO has had 36 student-athletes on the Commissioner's Honor Roll. Sophie Bussard and Sophia Hancock each earned OVC Academic Medals of Honor in 2020-21 after earning perfect 4.0 GPAs during the academic year. Carrie Shephard earned the award in 2019-20. In 2015-16 and 2017-18 Ashton Luttrull received the OVC Medal of Honor. The Redhawks recorded their highest semester team

GPA (3.42) after the Spring 2020 semester.

Patterson was named the eighth head coach in Southeast Missouri women's basketball history during a press conference at the Show Me Center on April 15, 2015. She is the first female head coach in the NCAA Division I era for Southeast Missouri and fourth female head coach in the 39year history of the program.

Patterson is an active member of the community, serving on the Cape Girardeau Public Library Board of Directors since 2017, the Southeast Missouri FCA Board 2016-2019 and has been a member of the Chamber of Commerce since 2015. She has been a guest speaker for many local civic groups, sports organizations and Chamber of Commerce events and was the 2016 keynote speaker for the Women's Prayer Breakfast.

She currently serves as the OVC's WBCA Conference Captain.

Patterson previously was the associate head coach at Ball State from 2013-15. She also has worked on the staffs at Baylor (2002-04, 2010-12), Creighton (2007-08), Ball State (2006-07) and Eastern Illinois (2004-06).

During her coaching career, Patterson has worked with teams that have won a National Championship, reached two Final Fours, the Sweet 16 four times and has been a part of seven Big 12 championships. She has coached a National Player of the Year (Brittney Griner), two National Freshmen of the Year, four College

All-Americans, an Ohio Valley Conference Freshman of the Year (Rachel Galligan) and numerous all-conference performers.

Patterson helped guide Ball State to the WNIT. In 2014-15, the Cardinals were 13-5 in Mid-American Conference (MAC) play. In her first season back at Ball State, the Cardinals advanced to the 2014 MAC Tournament championship game. Ball State became the first team to ever play five games in a single MAC Tournament. It was her second stint with the Cardinals after previously serving as an assistant coach in 2006-07.

In 2014, Patterson was a participant in the Achieving Coaching Excellence (ACE) program that was run by the NCAA.

While at Baylor from 2009-13, Patterson was part of the first women's basketball team to ever win 40 games as the Lady Bears posted an unbeaten mark on the way to the national championship. She spent the 2012-13 season as the associate coach and recruiting coordinator after working the previous three years as the coordinator of basketball operations.

Patterson was an assistant coach at Creighton in 2007-08 when the Bluejays won 21 games, fell one win short of sharing the Missouri Valley Conference regular season title, and completed the 15th-best turnaround in the nation that season.

While she was an assistant coach at Eastern Illinois from 2004-06, Patterson was the post coach for Galligan as she earned the top freshman honor in the OVC.

From 2002-04, Patterson began her coaching career as a graduate assistant at Baylor. Prior to that, she spent a year working at the NCAA national headquarters, where she was an education services intern.

A native of Red Springs, North Carolina, Patterson was a fouryear letterwinner and two-time captain at North Carolina A&T, where she earned a bachelor's degree in public relations in 2001. She received a master's degree in education with an emphasis in sport management from Baylor in 2004.

Her mother, Eva Patterson-Heath, was the head coach of the Fayetteville State (N.C.) women's basketball program and took her team to the NCAA Division II national tournament.

She previously won over 500 games as the head coach at Red Springs (N.C.) High School.


