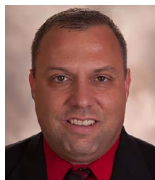

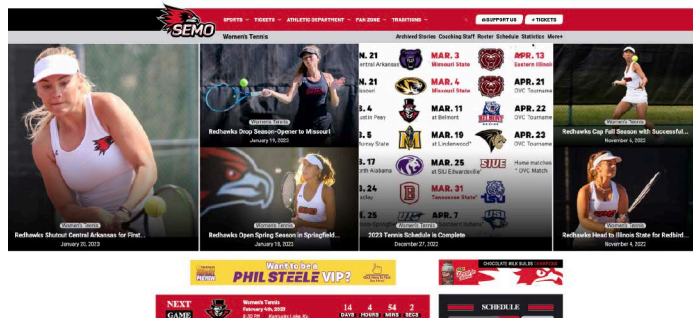

Mary Beth is in her eighth season as Southeast Missouri's Head Women's Tennis Coach.

Gunn guided SEMO to its first-ever Ohio Valley Conference regular-season title, first OVC Tournament crown and first NCAA Tournament appearance over the last two years alone.

In 2022, the Redhawks (15-7) claimed the OVC Tournament Championship as the #2 seed. SEMO defeated #1 seed Austin Peay, 4-1, to garner its first-ever trip to the NCAA Tournament. SEMO faced #15 Stanford in the first round of the NCAA Tournament in Palo Alto, California.

The year before that, SEMO made more history winning its first-ever OVC regular-season title. The Redhawks finished the 2021 campaign with an overall record of 15-5 and perfect 7-0 mark in conference play. It was the first time in program history SEMO went undefeated in OVC action.

This 2023 spring, Gunn will vie for her third-consecutive

winning season. If she accomplishes the feat, Gunn will become the first head coach in SEMO women's tennis history to put together winning seasons three years in a row.

SEMO celebrated yet another first when tennis student-athlete Grace Powderly became the first in SEMO Athletics history to win the prestigious OVC Steve Hamilton. Powderly won the award in 2022 that is given annually to an OVC male or female student-athlete of junior or senior standing that best exemplifies significant athletics performances along with good sportsmanship and citizenship.

In all, Gunn has enjoyed four winning seasons in her first seven years at the helm. She posted winning conference marks in three of those years. Additionally, Gunn picked up her 50th career win when SEMO beat SIU Edwardsville, 5-2, on Apr. 16, 2021.

SEMO's 15 wins in both 2021 and 2022 are the Redhawks most in a season since the 1993 team posted 17 victories.

Gunn became the first

Redhawk women's tennis coach to win the coveted OVC Coach of the Year award in 2021. SEMO also swept the OVC Player (Romana Tarajova) and Freshman (Daniela Hlacikova) of the Year honors that season.

Gunn has coached three First-Team All-OVC selections (Romana Tarajova, Daniela Hlacikova, Oleksandra Doroshenko) and three second-team picks (Oleksandra Doroshenko, Kseniya Zonova, Ksenia Shikanova). In 2022, Daniela Hlacikova and Teona Velkoska became the first doubles team to win all-conference honors under Gunn. The six All-OVC honorees are a program best.

She also coached the doubles tandem of Zonova and Velkoska who ranked as high as #71 in the 2021 Oracle Intercollegiate Tennis Association Division I Women's Rankings. The duo upended Missouri's top doubles team of Bronte Murgett and Marta Oliveira who were ranked #29 at the time.

SEMO closed out its 2021 season on an 11-match winning streak with seven-straight victories in league play to nail down its regular-season title.

Academically, Gunn's teams have been equally impressive. Most recently, the women's tennis team recorded a 3.53 grade point average during the Fall 2022 semester.

SEMO was awarded its eighth consecutive Intercollegiate Tennis Association All-Academic Team Award in 2022. The Redhawks accumulated a 3.73 cumulative grade point average

during the 2021-22 academic year. Seven Redhawks earned ITA Scholar-Athlete laurels with a GPA of 3.5 or higher.

Prior to that, SEMO's women's tennis team boasted the Department of Athletics' highest GPA with a 3.82 mark during the spring of 2021. Eight student-athletes earned ITA Scholar-Athlete distinction during the 2020-21 campaign.

Maja Lundell was the recipient of the Trombetta Award, which is given to a graduating SEMO female student-athlete with the highest GPA. Lundell registered a perfect 4.0 GPA in her career as a Redhawk and graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Biology: Microbiology, Cellular, Molecular Biology. She was also selected as a recipient of the 2020-21 President's Spirit of Southeast Award. Lundell was the third Redhawks tennis player to receive the President's Spirit of Southeast Award under Gunn joining Kseniya Zonova (2019-20) and Anais Emelie (2018-19).

Gunn's turnaround for SEMO's women's tennis program has been no other short of spectacular. The Redhawks had losing seasons in 10-straight years before her 13-8 record ended that stretch in 2016-17. Prior to that winning campaign, SEMO had gone a combined 3-39 the previous two seasons. The Redhawks also made the OVC Tournament for the first time in a decade during that 2016-17 campaign.

Prior to SEMO, Gunn coached at Western Illinois, Limestone College and fellow OVC member

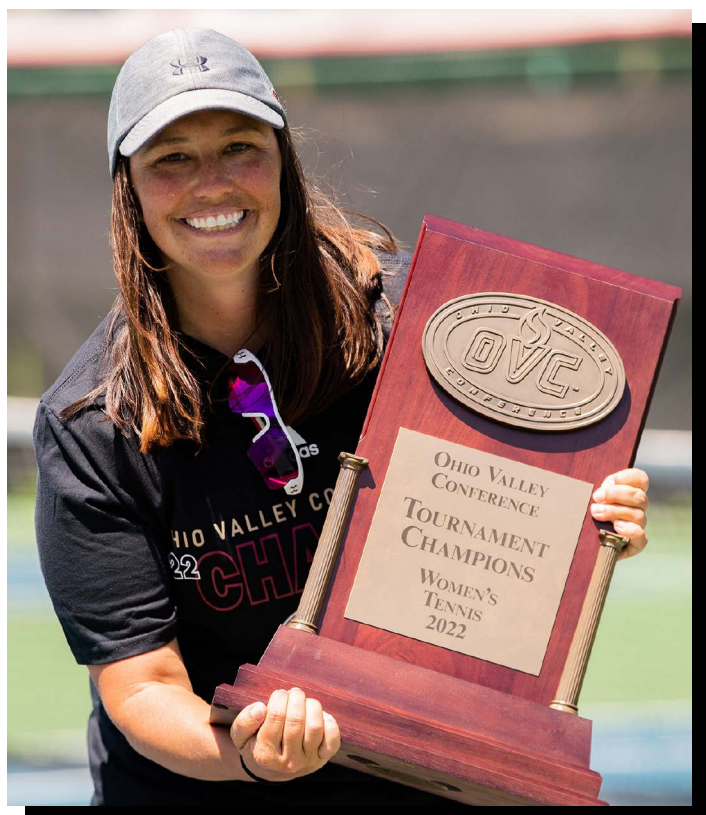


UT Martin. She was the head women's tennis coach at WIU and served as an assistant coach at both Limestone College (2014-15) and UT Martin (2009-13).

Gunn was on coaching staffs for two conference championship teams. She helped lead UTM to the OVC Women's Tennis Championship in 2010-11 and Limestone College to a Conference Carolinas women's

tennis title in 2014-15. Gunn was named the Intercollegiate Tennis Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2015.

Gunn earned both her bachelor's degree in English and History (2008) and master's degree in Education (2011) from UTM. She was a standout tennis player at UT Martin, earning All-OVC honors with the Skyhawks in 2007.

In the Redhawk Invitational, she defeated Lauren Rowe of Southern Indiana (6-3, 6-4) and cruised past Western Illinois' Lara Diniz de Souza (6-3, 6-2)...Fought her way past Nebraska's Jessica Aragon with a 6-2, 6-1 win and Tulsa's Maria Berlanga (3-6, 6-3, 10-6) at the ITA Central Regional Championships en route to a 2-1 record for the weekend...Ended singles play with a win over Nadiia Konieva from Milwaukee (6-2, 6-4) at the Illinois State Redbird Dual... Recorded a 10-4 doubles record... Played the entire fall with Teona Velkoska...Started with two doubles victories over Reagan Miley and Sasha Lebedeva (ORU) 7-6 (7-4) and Diana, Cabrera and Alyson, Piskulic (6-0) of Missouri State at the Central Arkansas Tournament... Spring 2022: Selected to the 2022 All-OVC First Team for her second career All-OVC First Team honor ... With Teona Velkoska, was named to the 2022 All-OVC Doubles Team... Named OVC Tennis Player of the Week a conference-best two times in 2022 (2/15 and 4/12) and the OVC Doubles Team of the Week with Velkoska a league-best two times this season (3/8 and 4/5)... (1/23) Fiona Arrese, 5-7, 6-0, 6-1, Mary Houston of Missouri State (2/11), 4-6, 6-3, 10-8, and Emelie Schwarte of Missouri (2/18), 6-1, 6-3...Commenced league play with a 6-2, 6-1 win over Christine Gouws at Eastern Illinois (3/25)...Won five-straight league matches from April 2-19 leading into the 2022 OVC Tennis Tournament...In that span, beat Sina Albersmeier of UT Martin (4/2, 6-2, 6-3), Naomi Von Bose of Tennessee State (4/8, 6-0, 6-2), Belmont's (4/9, 6-4, 4-6, 6-1) Somer Henry, Jana Leder of Austin Peay (4/16, 6-4, 6-4) in a matchup of the 2021 OVC Co-Freshmen of the Year and Sarah Bureau of Murray State (4/19, 7-6 (8-6), 6-3)...Fell to #15 Stanford's (5/6) #23-ranked Alexandra Yepifanova, 4-6, 1-6, in the First Round of the 2022 NCAA Tournament...In doubles, started the season with a 6-3 win over Missouri State's (2/11) Juliette Robinson and Sandra Lukacova with Velkoska...Went on an eight-match win streak with Velkoska from March 14-April 16 with non-conference victories at Montreat College (3/14) and Gardner-Webb (3/17) followed by six-straight OVC wins over Eastern Illinois (3/25, 6-2), SIUE (3/29, 6-2), UT Martin (4/2, 6-1), Tennessee State (4/8, 6-1), Belmont (4/9, 6-2) and Austin Peay (4/16, 6-2)...Downed Belmont's (4/30) Somer Henry and Peyton Lee, 6-3, as #2 SEMO earned the 4-0 sweep to advance to 2022 OVC Tennis Championship Final...Took on #15 Stanford's (5/6) Sara Choy / Alexandra Yepifanova (4-5, unfinished) in the First Round of the 2022 NCAA Tournament with Velkoska at the second position.

Fall 2021: Competed in four tournaments in the fall...Posted a 5-2 record for the fall in singles with a win over Belmont's Anastasiya

Zholdakova (1-6, 6-3, 10-7) at Austin Peay's Fall Tournament (9/16)...At the Central Arkansas Fall Tournament, defeated Missouri State's Sandra Lukacova (6-3, 6-3) and Yada Vasupongchai (6-4, 6-2) of UCA...Won her third straight singles match over Mya Spencer of Saint Louis, 3-6, 6-3, 10-8, in a hidden home dual (10/10) in Cape Girardeau...Fought past Maria Thibault of SIUE, 6-7 (4), 7-5 (10-2) to open the ITA Women's Central Regional Championship (10/21-24)...Went 4-3 in doubles play during the fall...Played with Myroslava Zelenchuk (2-2), Manuela Barriga (0-1), Vivian Lai (1-0) and Teona Velkoska (1-0)...Recorded two doubles victories with Zelenchuk at the UCA Tournament (10/3)...The first victory came against Louisiana Tech (6-0) defeating the Bulldog's pairing of Olga Bienzobas and Alexia Romero...The second win coming against Louisiana Tech (6-1) again versus the pair of Lara Unkovich and Ana Rodrigues.

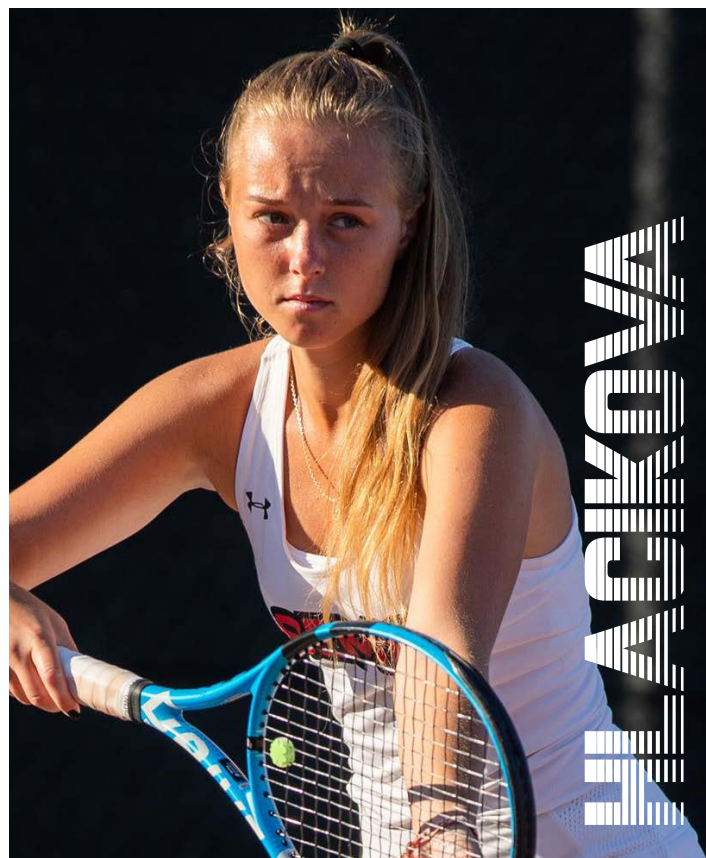
Spring 2021: Named the 2021 OVC Women's Co-Freshman of the Year and earned 2021 All-OVC First Team honors...Fourth tennis player in SEMO history to win OVC Freshman of the Year...Was second on the Redhawks in 2021, with a singles mark of 14-3 and an OVC record of 6-1 (second singles)...Competed at the first (1-0), second (8-2) and third (5-1) singles positions...Made Redhawks debut at Mizzou (1/24), earning at third singles win over Marta Oliveira, 6-3, 1-6, 6-4...Also won her second doubles match with Romana Tarajova over Elys Ventura and Valentina Vazquez, 6-4...Went on a six-match singles win streak to start the season Jan. 24 through Feb. 20 (Bradley)...Went on an eight-match singles win streak from March 8 (William

Woods) through April 16 (at SIUE)...Her no. 2 doubles match against #4 Jacksonville State (4/24) in the 2021 OVC Championship Semifinals went unfinished...In the 2021 OVC Championship Finals against #2 Austin Peay (4/25), dropped a marathon match to Danielle Morris, 6-7 (11-9), 6-1, 7-5, at the second slot...Posted a 9-8 doubles mark...Went 7-3 at the third slot with Teona Velkoska including 4-2 during league play...Also, played doubles with Romana Tarajova (1-3 overall, 1-2 at no. 2) and Ksenia Shikanova (0-2 at no. 2)...Went on a five-match doubles win streak with Velkoska from Feb. 20 (Bradley) to April 2 (Austin Peay)...Bested Carmen Roxana Manu and Tiffany Lagarde of Kansas (3/6), 6-2, at no. 3 doubles...Dropped a 4-6 decision to #4 Jacksonville State (4/24) in the 2021 OVC Championship Semifinals

before edging Martina Paladini-Jennings and Honoka Nakanishi, 7-5, to claim the doubles point in the 2021 OVC Championship Finals against #2 Austin Peay (4/25).

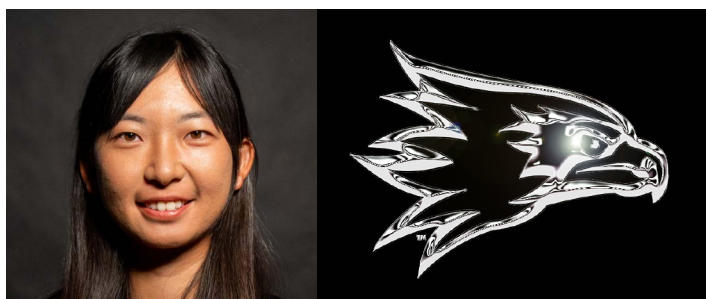

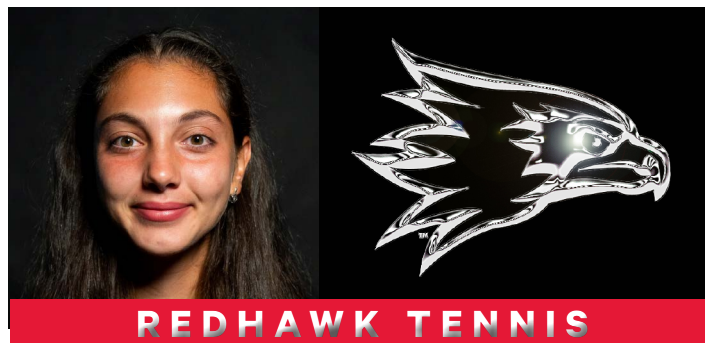

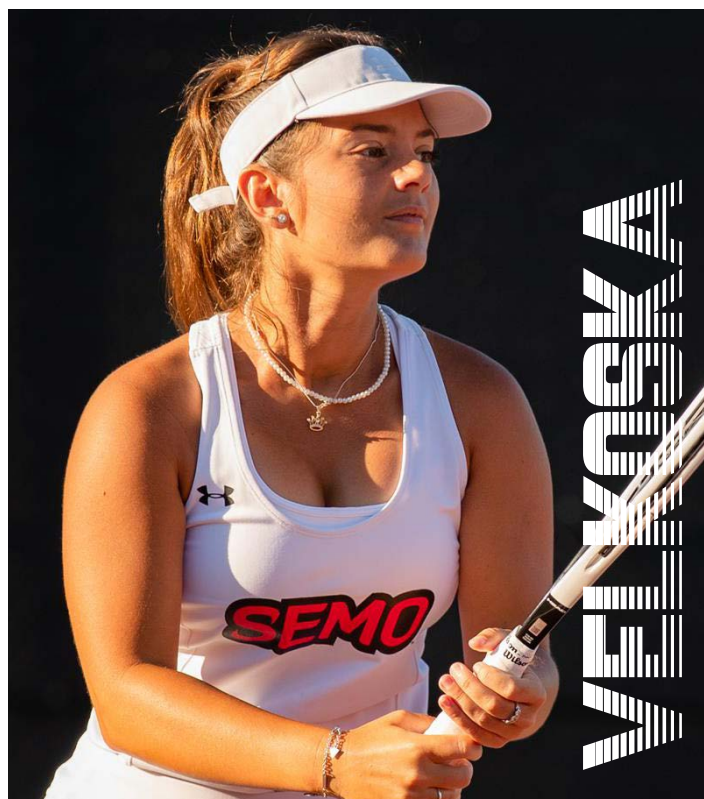
