Redhawks Continue Road Stretch

- Southeast Missouri continues its three-game road stretch when it heads to in-state foe Lindenwood Thursday. Tip-off is set for 7:30 p.m., CT at Hyland Arena.
- SEMO is on the road in Ohio Valley Conference play for fourth time.
- Each of the Redhawks first three road OVC contests were decided by a combined 12 points.
- SEMO edged Tennessee State, 67-65, on Jan. 2, dropped a close 66-63 decision at UT Martin on Jan. 4 and beat Tennessee Tech, 77-70, on Jan. 16 in those matchups.
- SEMO is 3-5 in true road matchups this season.

Series Notes

- Southeast Missouri and Lindenwood are the only Division I schools in Missouri that are conference rivals.
- SEMO holds a slight 4-3 edge in the all-time series between the schools located a little over two hours apart.
- LU won three of the last four meetings and is 2-0 against the Redhawks at Hyland Arena.
- Both games played in St. Charles were decided by four or less points.
- The Lions beat SEMO, 105-102, in overtime on Jan. 23, 2023 and, 58-54, on Jan. 30, 2024.

OVC Update

- The Redhawks start the week in a three-way tie for third in the Ohio Valley Conference standings with SIU Edwardsville and UT Martin. All three of those teams have 5-3 league records.
- Morehead State (7-1) tops the standings followed by second-place Little Rock (5-2).
- Southeast Missouri picked up its 10th win of the season with a 77-70 road victory over Tennessee Tech (Jan. 16).
- SEMO (10-9) became the fourth OVC team to 10 wins joining Morehead State (12-7), Little Rock (11-7) and SIU Edwardsville (12-7).
- The Redhawks surpassed their number of overall (9) and OVC (4) wins from 2024-25.
- SEMO began the 2024-25 season with a 3-0 record in OVC play marking the first time it won three-straight games to start a conference season since 2011-12.
- The Redhawks beat Eastern Illinois (79-72, Dec. 19), SIU Edwardsville (80-64, Dec. 21) and Southern Indiana (77-66, Jan. 9) at home, and Tennessee State (67-65, Jan. 2) and Tennessee Tech (77-70, Jan. 16) on the road for their OVC wins this year.
- SEMO won six of its last nine OVC games dating back to last year's season-ending 70-66 victory at Southern Indiana.

Seven of 10

- Southeast Missouri won seven of its last 10 games with five of those victories coming in Cape Girardeau.
- SEMO saw a season-long five-game winning streak end with a three-point (66-63) loss at UT Martin (Jan. 4).
- The Redhawks had a six-game home winning streak until their 67-56 loss to Morehead State (Jan. 11).
- SEMO is 3-2 at the Show Me Center and 2-1 on the road in conference play.

Back to Work

- After playing four games in seven days, Southeast Missouri was idle last weekend.
- SEMO returns to action following a seven-day break.
- The Redhawks last played at Tennessee Tech, where they came away with a 77-70 victory on Jan. 16.

Nice Defense

- Southeast Missouri has held its opponent under 70 points in six of its last eight games.
- SEMO (67.9 ppg allowed) is second in the Ohio Valley Conference in scoring defense behind SIU Edwardsville (66.6 ppg allowed).
- SIUE's 64 points are the fewest scored by a Division I opponent against SEMO this season.

200 Assists in Sight

- Point guard Rob Martin (185) is 15 assists away from reaching 200 in his career.
- Martin leads Southeast Missouri and ranks fourth in the Ohio Valley Conference with 77 assists through 19 games this season.
- He averages four assists per game and has dished out five or more a total of five times.
- Martin finished with a career-high nine assists in SEMO's OVC opener against Eastern Illinois (Dec. 19).
- Jonathan Dalton was the last Redhawk to get 200 or more assists in a career (315, 2016-19).

Martin Leads the Way

- Rob Martin led Southeast Missouri in scoring three of the last four games.
- Martin scored 15 points against Southern Indiana (Jan. 9) and followed that up with 21 vs. Morehead State (Jan. 11) and 19 vs. Little Rock (Jan. 14).
- He is SEMO's second-leading scorer with 11.6 points per game through 19 starts this season.
- Martin finished as the Redhawks top scorer a total of five times in 2024-25.

Big Road Win

- Southeast Missouri never trailed en route to a 77-70 win at Tennessee Tech (Jan. 16).
- SEMO handed the Golden Eagles their first home loss of the season.
- After leading by 21 at halftime (47-26), TTU used a 24-9 run in the first 10:06 of the second half to get within six.
- The Golden Eagles later narrowed SEMO's lead to 59-57 with eight minutes to go before the Redhawks countered with a 9-0 run and didn't look back.
- The Redhawks snapped a seven-game losing streak against TTU in Cookeville winning their for the first time since 2014.
- SEMO moved to 6-26 all-time against the Golden Eagles at the Eblen Center.

What a Half

- The Redhawks put together their best first half of basketball this season against Tennessee Tech (Jan. 16).
- Southeast Missouri shot 60 percent (18-of-30) from the field and built its largest halftime lead against a Division I opponent (47-26).
- SEMO's .600 field goal percentage was its best in a first half this year.
- The Redhawks also moved to 9-0 in games where they lead at the half.

Major Improvement

- After finishing 10th in the Ohio Valley Conference in free throw shooting a year ago, Southeast Missouri ranks second in that category.
- Through 19 games, SEMO is shooting 70.8 percent (230-of-325) behind Southern Indiana's 72.9 percent (255-of-350) clip.
- In conference games alone, the Redhawks are the top free throw shooting team in the OVC.
- SEMO is shooting 73.5 percent (122-of-166) at the charity stripe against league opponents.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI BASKETBALL NOTES

About Lindenwood

- Lindenwood is on a two-game losing streak after suffering back-to-back road losses at Southern Indiana (80-73, Jan. 16) and Ohio Valley Conference leader Morehead State (82-65, Jan. 18).
- LU is 7-1 at home this season with its seven home victories tying for second-most in the league.
- Jadis Jones (11.7 ppg), a freshman guard from New Madrid, Missouri, is the Lions' third-leading scorer behind Anias Futrell (13.5 ppg) and Markeith Browning II (13.1 ppg).
- Jones was named OVC Freshman of the Week for the sixth time on Jan. 20.
- As a team, LU leads the conference with nine steals a game.
- Sixth-year LU Head Coach Kyle Gerdeman and Associate Head Coach Anthony Beane were at SEMO as assistant coaches earlier in their careers.
- LU, which is in year three of the reclassification process, has officially notified the NCAA of its intent to engage in the expedited process to exit the reclassification phase one year early thus allowing for all teams to be fully eligible for NCAA Championships during the 2025-26 academic year.
- This came shortly after the Division I council adopted the proposal to revise the process for institutions reclassifying from Division II or Division III to Division I on Jan. 16, 2025. The revised process will now require a three-year reclassification for an institution moving from Division II to Division I and a four-year period for institutions from Division III to Division I.

Close Games

- Southeast Missouri has been involved in four game decided by four or less points in 2024-25.

- Three of those matchups came in Ohio Valley Conference play -- won, 67-65, at Tennessee State (Jan. 2); lost, 66-63, at UT Martin (Jan. 4); lost, 73-71, vs. Little Rock (Jan. 14).
- SEMO is 2-2 in games decided by four or less points.

OVC Leader in Turnover Margin

- The Redhawks are first in the Ohio Valley Conference with a +3.05 turnover margin.
- Southeast Missouri is committing a league low 10.8 turnovers per game while forcing 13.8.
- SEMO turned the ball over less than 10 times a total of seven games this season.

Stacker Goes Off

- Southeast Missouri trailed, 47-36, with 11:52 remaining against UT Martin (Jan. 4) when Braxton Stacker gave the Redhawks a big lift.
- Stacker came off the bench and knocked down a 3-pointer on three-straight possessions to close out a 12-2 run that made it a 47-45 contest with 10:13 to go.
- He later stepped back and buried another 3-pointer to cut UTM's lead to 50-48 before it was a two-possession game the rest of the way.
- Stacker finished with a career-high 22 point, made a career-best six 3-pointers and added a career-high four blocks against the Skyhawks.
- He has scored double figures in four of his last seven games.

Milestone Win

- Brad Korn picked up his 60th career win as head coach when Southeast Missouri beat Westminster, 88-39, on Dec. 29.
- Korn, who is in his fifth year at SEMO, has an overall record of 63-82 and 36-45 in Ohio Valley Conference games.

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- Korn's 63 wins are fourth-most among SEMO's head coaches during the NCAA Division I era behind Gary Garner (126), Dickey Nutt (80) and Ron Shumate (71).

Pulling Rank

- In Ohio Valley Conference games, Southeast Missouri leads the league in free throw percentage (.735) and assist/turnover ratio (1.23).
- Overall, SEMO is first in the OVC in 3-point field goal percentage defense (.272).
- The Redhawks are among the top three teams in the conference in scoring defense (2nd, 67.9 ppg allowed), scoring margin (3rd, +5.53), free throw percentage (2nd, .708), 3-point field goal percentage defense (1st, .272), field goal percentage (2nd, .440), field goal percentage defense (3rd, .413), turnover margin (1st, +3.05), assist/turnover ratio (2nd, 1.26) and rebounding defense (3rd, 35.2 rpg).

Redhawks Tied for Third in the Nation Defending the Three

- Southeast Missouri is tied for third in the nation in 3-point percentage defense with Middle Tennessee (.272) behind Tennessee (.255) and Cincinnati (.269).
- Opponents are shooting just 27.2 percent from downtown against Southeast Missouri this season.
- SEMO has held its opponent to five or less 3-pointers made in 12 of its 19 games in 2024-25.
- There are a total of 355 NCAA Division I basketball teams.

Redhawks Edge Tennessee State

- Southeast Missouri earned its first Ohio Valley Conference road win with a 67-65 victory in a gritty performance at Tennessee State (Jan. 2).
- In a physical game that featured 10 ties and 10 lead changes, SEMO made six free throws in the final 2:44 to come away with the two-point win.
- Teddy Washington, Jr. paved the way with 11 points, a season-high seven steals and made a big free throw with seven seconds left to seal the victory.
- SEMO beat TSU for the seventh time in 10 meetings between the teams.

- The Redhawks limited the Tigers to just 65 points who entered that game as the OVC's top scoring team (80.1 ppg).

First Win in 2025

- The Redhawks started the 2025 calendar year with a 67-65 road win at Tennessee State (Jan. 2).
- Southeast Missouri improved to 3-2 in its first game of the New Year with Brad Korn as head coach.
- It was the first time SEMO began a New Year with a road win under Korn.

December Ends

- The Redhawks went 4-2 in December after sweeping their season-long four-game home stand.
- Southeast Missouri finished with a winning record in December for the second-straight season.
- SEMO's recent 88-39 win over Westminster (Dec. 29) gave the Redhawks their first winning record of the season at 7-6.

Washington, Jr. Misses First Game

- Teddy Washington, Jr. missed his first game of the 2024-25 season against Westminster College (Dec. 29).
- Washington, Jr. did not play due to illness. He missed practice for that reason the day before that contest.
- Washington, Jr. returned at Tennessee State (Jan. 2), where he scored 11 points and added a career-best seven steals.

Stacker Steps In

- Braxton Stacker made his first start of the season in place of Teddy Washington, Jr. against Westminster (Dec. 29).
- Stacker scored a career-high 16 points, grabbed five rebounds and dished out three assists in 18 minutes.
- He shot 7-of-11 from the field and knocked down one 3-pointer, as well.
- Stacker's last start was during Southeast Missouri's 2023-24 season finale at Southern Indiana (Mar. 2).

SEMO Defeats SIU Edwardsville

- Southeast Missouri scored 80 points in a commanding 16-point victory (80-64) over SIU Edwardsville (Dec. 21).
- BJ Ward paved the way with 18 points, while Teddy Washington, Jr. and Brendan Terry followed close behind with 17 apiece.
- The Redhawks never trailed in the game and outrebounded SIUE, 37-22.

- The Cougars did not have an offensive rebound in the contest.
- It was the first time in SEMO's NCAA Division I era where an opponent did not have an offensive rebound against the Redhawks.

Washington, Jr. Recognized by HoopsHD.com

- Southeast Missouri guard Teddy Washington, Jr. was recognized among the best players in college basketball during the 2024 calendar year.
- HoopsHD's Jon Teitel ranked the top five players from each conference based on their all-around statistics.
- SIUE's Ray/Sean Taylor, Tennessee State's Brandon Weston, Eastern Illinois' Kooper Jacobi and Southern Indiana's Stephen Olowoniyi joined Washington, Jr. on the list out of the Ohio Valley Conference.

Korn in the OVC

- Brad Korn has an all-time record of 36-45 in Ohio Valley Conference games.
- Korn guided Southeast Missouri to its first Ohio Valley Conference Tournament title and NCAA Tournament appearance in over two decades during the 2022-23 campaign.
- It was SEMO's second OVC Tournament championship and NCAA Tournament berth in program history.
- In 2022-23, the Redhawks finished fifth in the OVC with a 10-8 record and became the first #5 seed to win an OVC Tournament.
- SEMO's other conference records under Korn include 9-11 (2020-21), 8-9 (2021-22) and 4-14 (2023-24).
- The Redhawks had their best OVC start with Korn at the helm in 2024-25.

Terry Rises

- Brendan Terry, who has started all 19 games this season, scored double figures in nine of his last 13 outings.
- He scored 10 points vs. Westminster College (Dec. 29).
- Before that, Terry matched his career-high of 17 points against SIU Edwardsville (Dec. 21).
- Terry also finished with 13 points vs. Eastern Illinois (Dec. 19), 17 against St. Mary of the Woods (Dec. 15), 12 points at Murray State (Dec. 8), 14 vs. Kansas City (Nov. 30), 12 vs. Southern Indiana (Jan. 9), 13 vs. Morehead State (Jan. 11) and 12 vs. Little Rock (Jan. 14).
- Terry is SEMO's third-leading scorer (9.6 ppg) and second-leading rebounder (4.1 rpg). He is second on the team with 29 steals, as well.

3-Pointer Streak

- The Redhawks have made at least one 3-pointer in 508 consecutive games.
- The last time Southeast Missouri did not make a 3-pointer was vs. Western Illinois (0-of-6) on Dec. 10, 2008.
- SEMO has made 140-of-437 threes at a 32 percent rate this season.
- The Redhawks drained 10 or more threes in a game five times this year.

80 or More

- Southeast Missouri has scored 80 or more points a total of six times this season.
- SEMO scored a season-high 93 points in wins over NAIA opponents Crowley's Ridge College (Nov. 13) and St. Mary of the Woods (Dec. 15).
- The Redhawks finished with 82 points vs. Chattanooga (Nov. 17), 80 against Kansas City (Nov. 30), 80 vs. SIU Edwardsville (Dec. 21) and 88 vs. Westminster (Dec. 29), also home games.
- SEMO is 5-1 in games where it scores 80 or more points.

Washington, Jr. Named OVC Player and Newcomer of the Week

- Teddy Washington, Jr. was named both Ohio Valley Conference Player and Newcomer of the Week on Dec. 23.
- Washington, Jr. averaged 22.5 points and 8.5 rebounds per game leading SEMO to wins over Eastern Illinois (Dec. 19) and SIU Edwardsville (Dec. 21).
- He had a double-double 28 points and 10 rebounds vs. EIU and followed that up with 17 points and seven rebounds against SIUE.
- For the week, Washington, Jr. shot 50 percent (14-of-28) from the field and 50 percent from 3-point range (7-of-14). He also went a perfect 10-of-10 at the free throw line, dished out four assists and added two steals.
- Washington, Jr. won all three of SEMO's OVC weekly honors this season. He was also tabbed OVC Co-Newcomer of the Week on Dec. 2.

Redhawks Crush St. Mary of the Woods

- Southeast Missouri ended a two-game losing streak with a 93-56 win over St. Mary of the Woods (Dec. 15).
- The 37-point victory is SEMO's third-largest of the season.
- SEMO scored 48 first-half points against the Pomeroy's for its most in an opening half of basketball thus far.

- The Redhawks had five players score double figures, including Brendan Terry (17), Troy Cole, Jr. (14), Rob Martin (13), Teddy Washington, Jr. (12) and Braxton Stacker (11).
- SEMO's 93 points matched a season-high.

Redhawks Win OVC Opener

- Southeast Missouri started Ohio Valley Conference play with a 79-72 win over Eastern Illinois (Dec. 19).
- SEMO opened OVC play with a win for the second year in a row.
- The Redhawks moved to 12-22 all-time in OVC openers and 2-3 in such games under Head Coach Brad Korn.
- At the time, SEMO also handed EIU its eighth-straight road loss.

Redhawks Down Kansas City

- Southeast Missouri cruised past Kansas City, 80-59, on Nov. 30.
- SEMO used a 16-2 run to get ahead of the Roos early and never looked back.
- The Redhawks led by as many as 26 points before polishing off their third victory of the season.
- It was SEMO's 12th by more than 20 points under Head Coach Brad Korn.
- The 21-point victory is also the largest the Redhawks have against a Division I opponent this year.

Washington, Jr. Delivers

- Newcomer Teddy Washington, Jr. has scored double figures in 14 of his 18 games.
- Washington, Jr. finished with 17 points against SIU Edwardsville (Dec. 21) and had a double-double 28 points and 10 rebounds in his first career Ohio Valley Conference start vs. Eastern Illinois (Dec. 19). He scored 24 points in the second half of that contest.
- He scored over 20 points three times with 25 vs. Chattanooga (Nov. 17) and a season-high 28 vs. both Eastern Illinois (Dec. 19) and Kansas City (Nov. 30).
- Washington, Jr. turned in a double-double on three occasions with 18 points and 12 rebounds vs. Crowley's Ridge (Nov. 13), 25 points and 10 boards against Chattanooga (Nov. 17) and 28 points and 10 rebounds vs. Eastern Illinois (Dec. 19).

- He ranks eighth in the OVC in scoring and 13th in rebounding.

- After missing the first six games due to injury, Braxton Stacker made his 2024-25 debut against Kansas City on Nov. 30.
- Stacker came off the bench to score 10 points and grab three rebounds in 17 minutes.
- He also made 3-of-4 free throws and knocked down one 3-pointer against the Roos.
- Stacker scored double figures for the fourth time when he posted a career-high 22 points at UT Martin (1/4).
- He dropped in 16 points in his first start of the season vs. Westminster (Dec. 29).
- Stacker has played in 12 games since his return.

Happy to Assist You

- For the second time this season, Southeast Missouri finished with 20 or more assists in a game.
- SEMO assisted 20 of its 36 made field goals against St. Mary of the Woods (Dec. 15) and had a season-high 22 assists on 37 made field goals against Crowley's Ridge College (Nov. 13).
- The Redhawks are averaging 13.6 assists per game in 2024-25.

Balanced Scoring

- Southeast Missouri has had three or more players get double figures in the scoring column during 12 of its 19 games this season.
- Teddy Washington, Jr. leads the way with 14 double figure scoring games.
- SEMO had a season-high five players with double-digit points vs. both St. Mary of the Woods (Dec. 15) and Westminster (Dec. 29).

Martin Pours it On

- Rob Martin has scored double figures 28 times in his career and 20 or more points on six occasions.
- Martin is second on the team in scoring with 11.6 points per game.
- He ranks first in the Ohio Valley Conference in assist/turnover ratio (3.2).
- Martin established a new career-high with seven rebounds against St. Mary of the Woods (Dec. 15) and Westminster (Dec. 29).
- He scored double figures on nine occasions in 2024-25.

Home-Opening Beatdown

- Southeast Missouri picked up its first win of the season with a dominating 93-38 home-opening victory over Crowley's Ridge College (Nov. 13).
- The +55 margin of victory was the largest under Head Coach Brad Korn. It was also the second time the Redhawks beat an opponent by 50 or more points with Korn at the helm.
- It was SEMO's largest win since the Redhawks beat Central Baptist, 118-56 (+62), on Nov. 11, 2013.
- The Redhawks improved to 25-9 in home-openers since joining the NCAA Division I ranks in 1991-92.
- SEMO also began its home slate with a win for the ninth time in 13 years and posted a victory for the 16th time in 20 home-opening contests.

Double-Digit Threes

- Southeast Missouri made 10 or more 3-pointers in a game five times this year.
- SEMO drained a season-high 12 threes at Vanderbilt (Nov. 10) and followed that up with 11 three days later vs. Crowley's Ridge College (Nov. 13). The Redhawks had 12 three-pointers at Central Arkansas (Nov. 21), 10 vs. Eastern Illinois (Dec. 19) and 10 at UT Martin (1/4).
- Teddy Washington, Jr. (37), BJ Ward (31) and Rob Martin (22) have combined for 90 of SEMO's 140 made threes.
- The Redhawks already surpassed their total of four games with 10 or more 3-pointers made in 31 contests during the 2023-24 campaign.

Korn at the Show Me Center

- Brad Korn finished with a winning record at home each of his first four years as Southeast Missouri's head coach.
- Korn is 39-25 all-time at the Show Me Center.
- The Redhawks went 7-6 (2020-21), 8-5 (2021-22), 9-4 (2022-23) and 8-7 (2023-24) at home since Korn took over as head coach.
- SEMO is 7-3 in Cape Girardeau this year.

Double-Doubles

- Southeast Missouri players have accounted for four double-doubles through 15 games this season.
- BJ Ward has one double-double and Teddy Washington, Jr. has three.

- In 2023-24, not one player had a double-double for SEMO during the entire season.

Lowndes Cracks Starting Five

- John A. Logan College transfer Elliot Lowndes started each of Southeast Missouri's last 14 games.
- Lowndes grabbed eight rebounds in 15 minutes during his first career NCAA Division I start at Central Arkansas (Nov. 21).
- The next day, he scored five points and had four boards vs. UNC Asheville (Nov. 22).
- Lowndes is the Redhawks top shot blocker with 15 this season.
- SEMO has used four different starting lineup combinations through 19 games.

20-Point Scorers

- The Redhawks had a 20-point scorer in seven games this season.
- BJ Ward registered 22 points at Vanderbilt (Nov. 10), Damarion Walkup dropped in 23 vs. Crowley's Ridge (Nov. 13), Rob Martin (29), Teddy Washington, Jr. (25) went over 20 points vs. Chattanooga (Nov. 17), scored 28 vs. Kansas City (Nov. 30) and dropped in 28 vs. Eastern Illinois (Dec. 19), Braxton Stacker finished with 22 at UT Martin (Jan. 4) and Martin scored 21 vs. Morehead State (Jan. 11).

Ward Plays Strong

- BJ Ward scored double figures in eight of his first 19 games.
- Ward was in the starting lineup the last 18 contests.
- He began the year with 17 points off the bench at Bradley (Nov. 4) and followed that up with a career-high 22 in his first start of the season at Vanderbilt (Nov. 10). Three days later, Ward registered 11 points and 10 rebounds for his first career double-double vs. Crowley's Ridge College (Nov. 13). He scored 13 vs. Chattanooga (Nov. 17), 19 at Central Arkansas (Nov. 21), 10 vs. UNC Asheville (Nov. 22) and 14 vs. Southern Indiana (Jan. 9).
- Ward's six-game double-digit scoring streak to open the season is the longest of his career.
- He led SEMO with 18 points in its win over SIU Edwardsville (Dec. 21).
- Ward ranks fourth on the team in scoring with 9.2 points per game.
- Ward knocked down a career-best six 3-pointers against the Commodores and ranks second on the team with 26 treys.
- He made the game-tying 3-pointer with 11 seconds left against Little Rock (Jan. 14).

Redhawks Bury 12 Threes

- The Redhawks gave Vanderbilt all it could handle in their 85-76 loss on Nov. 10.
- Southeast Missouri made 12 three-pointers in the contest and, at one time, led by double figures early in the game.
- The Redhawks matched that total with 12 threes at Central Arkansas (Nov. 21).
- SEMO finished with 10 or more made threes in a game 30 times under Head Coach Brad Korn.

Non-Division I Opponents

- The Redhawks beat NAIA members Crowley's Ridge, 93-38, on Nov. 13, St. Mary of the Woods, 93-56, on Dec. 15 and Westminster, 88-39, on Dec. 29.
- SEMO is on a 40-game winning streak against non-Division I opponents.
- Head Coach Brad Korn is 11-0 all-time in such games. Korn is 2-0 vs. Missouri Baptist, 1-0 vs. William Woods, 1-0 vs. Harris-Stowe, 1-0 vs. Lindsey Wilson College, 1-0 vs. Webster College, 1-0 vs. Lyon College, 1-0 vs. Bethel (Tenn.), 1-0 vs. Crowley's Ridge, 1-0 vs. St. Mary of the Woods and 1-0 vs. Westminster College.
- The Redhawks have not allowed more than 61 points in each of their last nine meetings with non-Division I teams. SEMO outscored its opponents by a combined, 781-449 (+332), in that span.

Welcome to NCAA Division I Basketball

- Five players saw their first basketball action at the NCAA Division I level during Southeast Missouri's season-opener at Bradley (Nov. 4).
- Forward Brendan Terry and guard Troy Cole, Jr. each made their first career starts as Redhawks, while Damarion Walkup, Saxton Hoepker and Elliot Lowndes came off the bench.
- Terry (Pensacola State College), Cole, Jr. (Highland CC), Walkup (Olney Central College), Hoepker (Southwestern Illinois College) and Lowndes (John A. Logan College) are all junior college transfers.
- Fellow newcomer Teddy Washington, Jr. also made his first career start as a Redhawk. SEMO is Washington, Jr.'s second Division I school after spending the 2023-24 campaign at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi.

Walkup Scores Double Figures in Division I Debut

- Damarion Walkup scored 11 points off the bench in his Southeast Missouri debut at Bradley (Nov. 4).
- Walkup made three field goals, including two from 3-point range and knocked down 3-of-4 free throws in 26 minutes.
- His 26 minutes were third-most against the Braves behind starters Teddy Washington, Jr. (28) and Rob Martin (27).
- Walkup scored SEMO's first points of the 2024-25 campaign on a layup with 18:38 left to play in the first half.
- He had 14 points for his fourth double-digit performance of the season vs. Westminster (Dec. 29).

About the Program

- Southeast Missouri is in its 118th season of basketball in 2024-25.
- This year marks SEMO's 34th as an NCAA Division I program.
- The Redhawks first moved to the NCAA Division I ranks in 1991-92.
- SEMO has a total of nine winning seasons at the NCAA Division I level.
- The Redhawks won one Ohio Valley Conference regular-season title (1999-2000), two OVC Tournament crowns (1999-2000, 2022-23) and advanced to the NCAA Tournament twice (1999-2000, 2022-23).
- SEMO has an all-time NCAA Division I record of 395-571 and is 218-331 in the OVC.

Year Five for Korn

- Brad Korn is in his fifth year as Southeast Missouri's head coach.
- Korn's position at SEMO is his first as a head coach.
- He led the Redhawks to their first Ohio Valley Conference Tournament title and NCAA Tournament appearance in over two decades during the 2022-23 campaign.
- SEMO became the first #5 seed to win the OVC Tournament winning four games in four days along the way.
- Korn is 63-82 overall and 36-45 in the OVC.
- He was hired as the seventh head coach in SEMO's NCAA Division I era on Mar. 23, 2020.
- Korn has coached in eight NCAA Tournaments -- seven as an assistant coach and one as a head coach -- during his career.

Roster Breakdown

- The 2024-25 roster consists of 14 players, including two seniors, eight juniors, three sophomores and one freshman.
- Rob Martin, BJ Ward, TJ Biel, David Idada, Mason Hanback, Braxton Stacker and Marqueas Bell are the returnees back from last season.
- SEMO added six transfers and one freshman to complete this year's team.

Redhawks Picked Seventh in OVC Preseason Poll

- Southeast Missouri was picked seventh in the 2024-25 Ohio Valley Conference Men's Basketball Preseason Poll.
- SEMO accumulated 86 points in the overall voting by the OVC head men's basketball coaches.
- Little Rock was tabbed this year's preseason favorite with 200 points and 20 of the possible 22 first-place votes.
- The Trojans were one of three teams to share last year's OVC regular-season title along with Morehead State and UT Martin.
- Western Illinois (172 pts.), SIU Edwardsville (2 first-place votes, 151 pts.), Tennessee State (134 pts.), Morehead State (131 pts.) and Eastern Illinois (87 pts.) were also picked ahead of the Redhawks.
- Southern Indiana (79 pts.), Lindenwood (67 pts.), UT Martin (52 pts.) and Tennessee Tech (51 pts.) round out the 11-team predicted order of finish.

Returning Starters

- Guards Rob Martin and Braxton Stacker are Southeast Missouri's returning starters.
- Martin led SEMO in scoring (11.9 ppg), assists (108), minutes (28.5 mpg) and free throw percentage (.885) during his first year with the Redhawks in 2023-24.
- He ranked fifth in the Ohio Valley Conference in assists and sixth in assist/turnover ratio (1.52).
- Stacker ranked fourth on the team in scoring with 7.4 points per game and topped the Redhawks in steals (29) and blocks (15).

Byrd Joins Coaching Staff

- DJ Byrd was hired as an assistant coach to complete Southeast Missouri's staff for the 2024-25 season.
- Byrd was briefly at Barry University last summer before arriving in Cape Girardeau.
- Prior to that, he was on the men's basketball staff at Mercer University for five years.

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- Byrd worked as a graduate assistant from 2017-19 at Purdue with 2019 NABC National Coach of the Year Matt Painter.
- A former standout as a player at Purdue, Byrd saw action in 130 career games and scored 880 points along the way.
- He made 195 three-pointers, ninth-most among Boilermaker career leaders.
- Byrd was the Big Ten Conference Sixth Man of the Year in 2012 helping lead Purdue to three NCAA Tournaments (2010, 2011, 2012).
- In 2010, the Boilermakers won the Big Ten Championship and advanced to the Sweet 16 before falling to the eventual NCAA National Champion Duke Blue Devils.

November Wrap

- Southeast Missouri played seven games in November, its first month of the 2024-25 season.
- The Redhawks finished their first opening month with a 3-4 record.
- SEMO moved to 13-15 all-time in November games under Head Coach Brad Korn.

2025-26 Signees

- Southeast Missouri Trace Sadler and P.J. Farmer, both from local Sikeston High School, for 2025-26.
- Sadler is a 7-footer who averaged 4.5 rebounds and three blocks per game as a junior last season.
- Farmer, a versatile guard who is one of the top recruits in the state, averaged 14.3 points, 7.9 assists, 6.7 rebounds and 2.7 steals per game a year ago.
- Farmer is a Class 5 All-State selection who also had offers from Missouri and Ole Miss.

2024-25 Schedule

- Southeast Missouri will play 31 games, including 15 at the Show Me Center in 2024-25.
- SEMO's non-conference slate is comprised of 11 matchups, eight of which are against NCAA Division I opponents.
- The Redhawks begin the season with back-to-back road games at Missouri Valley Conference member Bradley (Nov. 4) and Southeastern Conference member Vanderbilt (Nov. 10).
- SEMO hosts NAIA affiliate Crowley's Ridge College (Nov. 13) in its home-opener. Crowley's Ridge is one of three non-Division I



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teams making trips to Cape Girardeau along with St. Mary of the Woods (Dec. 15) and Westminster (Dec. 29).

- The rest of the Redhawks non-conference slate features games at Central Arkansas (Nov. 21), Lipscomb (Dec. 5) and former Ohio Valley Conference foe Murray State (Dec. 8), a neutral site contest against UNC Asheville (Nov. 22) in Conway, Arkansas and home matchups with Chattanooga (Nov. 17) and Kansas City (Nov. 30).
- SEMO opens its 20-game OVC schedule at home prior to Christmas against Eastern Illinois (Dec. 19) and SIU Edwardsville (Dec. 21).
- For the second-straight year the league membership includes 11 teams (Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Little Rock, Morehead State, SEMO, SIU Edwardsville, Southern Indiana, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, UT Martin and Western Illinois).
- In 2024-25, the Conference schedule switches to a true round-robin slate of 20 games (after being 18 games a season ago).

Ohio Valley Conference Tournament

- The Ohio Valley Conference Board of Presidents voted to accept an agreement to hold the OVC Men's and Women's Basketball Championships at the Ford Center in Evansville, Indiana through the 2026 Championship.
- The agreement also includes an option for the 2027 Championship.
- The OVC Basketball Championships have been held in the venue since 2018. In September 2019, the OVC accepted a three-year agreement to continue hosting the event at the venue through 2023, and in December exercised an option for 2024.
- The Ford Center, which opened in November 2011, is an 11,000-seat arena located in the core of Evansville's downtown district. The 290,000-square foot facility serves as home of Evansville Thunderbolts of the Southern Professional Hockey League and the University of Evansville men's basketball team. The Ford Center also serves as host to numerous sporting events and concerts on an annual basis.
- The OVC Basketball Tournament is the fourth-oldest Division I Championship in

the country; the men's event will be held for the 60th time this year.

- The top eight men's and women's teams, based upon Conference winning percentage, automatically earn access to the OVC Basketball Championship. The OVC Basketball Championships feature 14 games of basketball action spanning four days as teams compete to capture the OVC title and earn a bid to the NCAA Tournament.



In Memory of Carl Ritter

- On Jan. 7, 2025, Southeast Missouri basketball great Carl Ritter passed away at the age of 84.
- Ritter, to this day, is SEMO men's basketball's all-time leading scorer with 1,916 points.
- He was SEMO's first draft pick when he was selected in the 10th round by the St. Louis Hawks in the 1963 NBA Draft.
- Ritter's number 32 is the only retired number in SEMO men's basketball history.
