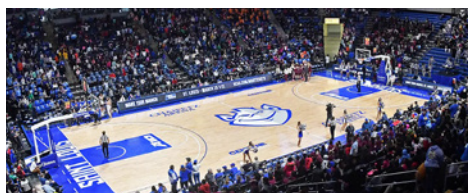

Redhawks Start 2025-26 Season at Saint Louis

- Southeast Missouri will travel two hours north on Interstate 55 to open its 2025-26 season at Saint Louis Monday. Tip is set for 7 p.m., CT at Chaifetz Arena.
- Monday's season-opener will air live on FanDuel Sports Extra and ESPN+ with Tom Ackerman, Scott Highmark and Tamar Sher on the call.
- SEMO starts the year with back-to-back road games this week. After the Redhawks visit Atlantic 10 member SLU, they stay in Missouri to face SEC member Mizzou on Nov. 7.
- The Redhawks are one of five Ohio Valley Conference schools opening their seasons Monday.
- Morehead State (vs. Midway), Western Illinois (at Radford), Tennessee Tech (at Western Kentucky) and Tennessee State (vs. Fisk) are the others.

Series Notes

- Southeast Missouri and Saint Louis meet for the seventh time on the hardwood.
- SLU holds a 5-1 advantage in the all-time series which began in 2001-02.
- All six games were played in St. Louis. Each of the last four matchups between the teams were played at Chaifetz Arena.
- This is the fourth time in program history where SEMO faces Saint Louis in its season-opener.

- The Redhawks also opened the 2009-10 (L, 41-59, Nov. 14), 2013-14 (L, 64-87, Nov. 8) and 2018-19 (L, 65-75, Nov. 6) campaigns there.
- SEMO last played the Billikens on Nov. 6, 2018 under then-Head Coach Rick Ray.
- The Redhawks only win in the series came on Dec. 29, 2004 (65-49) at the Savvis Center (now Enterprise Center).

Korn vs. Saint Louis

- Brad Korn squares off against Saint Louis for the first time as a head coach.
- Saint Louis is the only Division I Missouri school Korn has not faced in his head coaching tenure.
- Korn is 2-2 all-time against such opponents with a 2-1 mark vs. Kansas City, 0-1 record vs. Missouri and 1-0 mark vs. Missouri State.

Season-Openers

- Southeast Missouri is 13-21 in season-opening games during its NCAA Division I era.
- SEMO opens a season away from home for the 19th time in 20 years.
- The Redhawks are 3-2 in season-openers with Brad Korn at the helm.
- SEMO's last season-opening win, a 64-61 victory at South Florida (Nov. 7, 2022) at the time gave the Redhawks three-straight season-opening victories for the first time in program history.

Season 119

- The 2025-26 campaign marks the 119th season in Southeast Missouri men's basketball history.
- This year is SEMO's 35th as an NCAA Division I program and member of the Ohio Valley Conference.
- The Redhawks are 406-574 since joining the Division I ranks in 1991-92.

- SEMO has a total of 10 winning seasons as an NCAA Division I program.
- The Redhawks won two OVC regular-season titles (1999-2000, 2024-25), two OVC Tournament crowns (1999-2000, 2022-23) and made two NCAA Tournament appearances (1999-2000, 2022-23).
- Since Brad Korn took over as head coach in 2020-21, SEMO won its first OVC Tournament title in over two decades and first OVC regular-season championship in 25 years.

Roster Talk

- The 2025-26 roster consists of 14 players, including one graduate, six seniors, three juniors, one sophomore and three freshmen.
- Southeast Missouri has nine returnees from its Ohio Valley Conference regular-season championship team.
- Marqueas Bell, Brendan Terry, Braxton Stacker, Troy Cole, Jr., David Idada, Jay Reynolds, BJ Ward, Saxton Hoepker and Elliot Lowndes are the returning players.
- Transfers Landren Blocker (Louisiana Tech), Blaize Sagna (Stetson) and Luke Almodovar (St. Francis, Ind.) along with true freshmen PJ Farmer and Trace Sadler complete this year's team.

Redhawks Tabbed Second in OVC Preseason Poll

- Southeast Missouri was picked second in the 2025-26 Ohio Valley Conference Preseason Poll during the league's annual media day on Oct. 14.
- For only the third time in program history, SEMO was voted as high as second in the league's preseason poll.
- The Redhawks were tied for second with then-OVC member Austin Peay in the 1999-2000 version and second overall (first in the West Division) in the 2013-14 predicted order of finish.
- Little Rock, which was eliminated by SEMO in the semifinals of the 2025 OVC Tournament, is the preseason favorite with 188 points and 12 of the possible 22 first-place votes.
- The Redhawks tallied 177 points and six first-place nods.

- SIU Edwardsville (163 pts.), Tennessee State (135 pts.), Lindenwood (100 pts.) and Morehead State (100 pts.) complete the top six.
- Tennessee Tech (80 pts.), UT Martin (79 pts.), Southern Indiana (67 pts.), Eastern Illinois (63 pts.) and Western Illinois (57 pts.) rounded out the balloting.

Returning All-OVC Pick

- Forward Brendan Terry is Southeast Missouri's only returning All-Ohio Valley Conference player from last season.
- Terry earned Second-Team All-OVC honors in his first year at SEMO in 2024-25.
- He ranked third on the team in scoring with 11.2 points per game and second with 4.5 rebounds per contest.
- Terry started all 33 games and scored double figures in 18 of his starts, as well.

More OVC Players to Watch

- In addition to Brendan Terry, guards Braxton Stacker and BJ Ward were selected among the Ohio Valley Conference's Players to Watch this preseason.
- Stacker rated fourth on the team in scoring with 8.9 points and third in rebounding with 3.1 boards a game last season. He came off the bench in 26 of his 27 games.
- Ward was fifth behind Stacker with 8.4 points per game in 32 starts. He drained 51 three-pointers which were good for second-most on the team. Ward also added 74 assists and 30 steals.

Non-Conference Games

- Brad Korn is 28-38 in non-conference action.
- Korn's best non-league record as Southeast Missouri's head coach stands at 9-9 in 2022-23, the season SEMO won its first OVC Tournament title and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 23 years.
- His other non-conference records include 2-5 in 2020-21, 6-9 in 2021-22, 5-8 in 2023-24 and 6-7 in 2024-25.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI BASKETBALL NOTES

Welcome Home BJ!

- For the first time in his career, St. Louis native BJ Ward returns home to play Saint Louis University.
- Ward is in his third year as a Redhawk and graduated from Chaminade College Prep School.
- As a prep, he was a three-year starting point guard leading Chaminade to back-to-back trips to the Final Four of the Class 6 State Tournament.
- Ward scored 14.8 points per game and led the team with 195 assists and 33 steals as a senior.

3-Pointer Streak

- The Redhawks have made at least one 3-pointer in 522 consecutive games.
- The last time Southeast Missouri did not make a 3-pointer was vs. Western Illinois (0-of-6) on Dec. 10, 2008.

Last 24 Games

- Southeast Missouri went 18-6 in its final 24 games of 2024-25.
- The Redhawks won nine of their last 13 games of the 2024-25 season by double figures.

Sixth Year for Korn

- Brad Korn is in his sixth year as Southeast Missouri's head coach.
- Korn led SEMO to two conference titles (2022-23 OVC Tournament; 2024-25 OVC Regular-Season) in three years.
- The reigning OVC Coach of the Year, Korn is 74-85 overall and 46-47 in conference play.
- He ranks third all-time in wins among head coaches in SEMO's NCAA Division I era behind Gary Garner (126 wins, 1997-2006) and Dickey Nutt (80 wins, 2009-15).
- On July 1, 2025, Korn agreed to a contract extension through the 2029-30 season.

His new contract will run through Apr. 30, 2030. It extends his current deal that was signed through the 2026-27 season.

Non-Conference Slate

- The Redhawks have an 11-game non-conference schedule in 2025-26.
- Southeast Missouri plays its first two games on the road against in-state schools Saint Louis (Nov. 3) and Missouri (Nov. 7).
- SEMO travels to Big Ten Conference member Iowa (Nov. 18) and returns a trip on the back end of a home-and-home series to Chattanooga (Dec. 6).
- The Redhawks head west to face Cal Poly (Nov. 25) and Northern Arizona (Nov. 26) in Flagstaff, Arizona before Thanksgiving.
- SEMO's home non-conference foes include non-Division I schools Webster (Nov. 12), St. Mary of the Woods (Dec. 2) and Saint Xavier (Ill.) (Dec. 14), St. Thomas (Minn.) (Nov. 15) and Lipscomb (Nov. 29).

OVC Schedule

- The Ohio Valley Conference schedule includes 20 games for the Redhawks.
- For the third-straight year, the league membership includes 11 teams (Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Little Rock, Morehead State, Southeast Missouri, SIU Edwardsville, Southern Indiana, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, UT Martin, Western Illinois).
- This year the Conference schedules again feature a true round-robin slate.
- Each team will play two games before Christmas; the schedule picks back up on Dec. 30 and continues until Saturday, Feb. 28.
- SEMO opens OVC play at Tennessee Tech on Dec. 18.
- This year marks the final year Tennessee Tech and Little Rock will be members of the OVC. TTU is joining the Southern Conference and Little Rock is moving to the United Athletic Conference (UAC) in 2026-27.

About Saint Louis

- Saint Louis was picked second in the 2025-26 Atlantic 10 Preseason Poll.
- SLU, which garnered 11 first-place votes, was one point behind favorite VCU.
- Center Robbie Avila represents the Billikens on the Atlantic 10's Preseason All-Conference Team. Avila averaged 17.3 points, 6.9 rebounds and four assists a year ago.
- Josh Schertz is in his second season as head coach at SLU.
- Schertz had success at all three of his head coaching stops. He went to 10 NCAA Division II Championships in 13 years at Lincoln Memorial and guided Indiana State to two postseason appearances in three years, including a magical run to the finals of the 2024 National Invitation Tournament.
- He ranks eighth among all active NCAA head men's basketball coaches with a career winning percentage of .773 (422-124 in 17 seasons).

2026 OVC Tournament

- The 2026 Ohio Valley Conference Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held Mar. 4-7 at the Ford Center in Evansville, Indiana.
- It marks the ninth-straight year the event will be held at the venue.
- The Ford Center, which opened in November 2011, is an 11,000-seat arena located in the core of Evansville's downtown district.
- The OVC Board of Presidents accepted an agreement to continue to hold the OVC Men's and Women's Basketball Championships at the Ford Center through 2032.
- including two seniors, seven juniors, three sophomores and one freshman.
- Rob Martin, BJ Ward, TJ Biel, David Idada, Braxton Stacker and Marqueas Bell are the returnees back from last season.
- SEMO added six transfers and one freshman to complete this year's team.

Championship Culture

- Southeast Missouri's Department of Athletics has won an unprecedented 37 conference championships since the start of the 2019-20 season.
- Every sport won at least one OVC title in that stretch.
- In 2024-25 alone, SEMO won seven OVC championships. That total was more than the

number of conference titles won by any two schools in the league combined.

- Additionally, SEMO claimed the OVC Commissioner's Cup for the third time in five years.

2024-25 Review

- Southeast Missouri entered the 2024-25 season ranked seventh in the Ohio Valley Conference Preseason Poll and won its first outright OVC regular-season title in program history.
- SEMO clinched its regular-season championship with a statement 83-68 road win at SIU Edwardsville, which upended the Redhawks in the OVC Tournament final.
- It was the Redhawks' second OVC regular-season title in program history and first in 25 years.
- SEMO initially moved to first in the standings with their 57-45 win at Little Rock (Feb. 11) and stayed there the rest of the regular-season.
- The Redhawks advanced to the OVC Tournament championship game for the fourth time in program history and second in three years with Brad Korn as head coach.
- SEMO earned the #1 seed in the eight-team tournament and claimed a double bye for the first time in program history.
- The Redhawks' 78-59 win over #4 Little Rock was their largest in an OVC Tournament semifinal game in program history.
- For only the third time since it moved to the NCAA Division I ranks in 1991-92, SEMO reached 20 or more wins in a season. The Redhawks' 21 wins ranked second behind the 1999-2000 team (24-7). The other 20-win season was in 1998-99 (20-9).
- SEMO tied a single-season program record with 15 OVC victories. The Redhawks began their 20-game league schedule with a 3-0 record and later went 9-1 in their final 10 conference games.
- All of SEMO's success came just one year after the Redhawks finished 10th in the OVC and missed making the league's postseason tournament in 2023-24. SEMO went from 9-22, 4-14 in the OVC to 21-12, 15-5 in the OVC for its best one-year turnaround in program history.
- The Redhawks won 10-straight games from Jan. 25-Feb. 27 for their longest winning streak during the NCAA Division I era. SEMO never won more than seven consecutive games since it moved to Division I in 1991-92. It was the program's longest winning streak in 35 years since the 1989-90 team won 11 in a row.

- SEMO went undefeated in February (8-0) becoming the first team in 39 years to go unbeaten in February. Ron Shumate's 1985-86 team (8-0) was the last to do it.
- The Redhawks swept home-and-home series against five OVC opponents in 2024-25. Those were the most in a season under Head Coach Brad Korn and the most in the last two years combined (4). SEMO beat SIU Edwardsville, Southern Indiana, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and Western Illinois twice during the regular-season.
- Brad Korn led SEMO to a winning record at home for the fifth-straight year. The Redhawks' 12-3 record was Korn's best at the Show Me Center since he took over as head coach. In conference games, SEMO led the OVC in home attendance.
- SEMO ranked fourth in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage defense. Opponents shot just 28.3 percent from beyond the arc. The Redhawks held their opponents to five or less 3-pointers made in 22 of 33 games.
- The Redhawks led the OVC with a +3.03 turnover margin. SEMO forced 13.7 turnovers per game and committed a league low 10.6 per contest. The Redhawks turned the ball over less than 10 times on 15 occasions in 2024-25.
- SEMO finished the year with a single-season program record 269 steals.

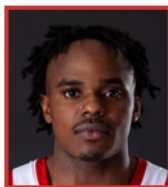

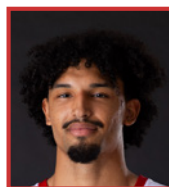

- Played in 62 games and logged 34 starts in his career.

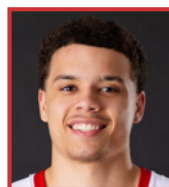

- Broke SEMO's single-season record with a .653 field goal percentage.

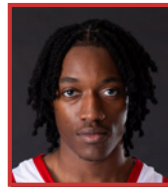

- Comes from a talented family that includes brothers Ronnie Bell (currently with the Detroit Lions) and Kendrick Bell. Kendrick is his twin brother who is a wide receiver at Michigan.

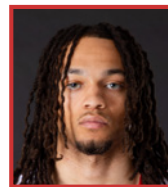

In-Season Interview Policy

All of Southeast Missouri's basketball student-athletes and coaches will be available to the media throughout the 2025-26 season. Interviews should be arranged through the Southeast Missouri Strategic Communications Office. Interviews with players and coaches will be conducted either before or after practices during the season. Please let the Strategic Communications Office know if you plan to attend practice. Practices are held at either the Show Me Center or Student Recreation Center.

Credentials

Credentials are required for entrance to the Show Me Center. To request season or single-game credentials, please contact Jeff Honza in the Southeast Missouri Strategic Communications Office by phone at (573) 651-2933 or email at redhawk1@me.com / jhonza@semo.edu. Credentials can be picked up at the NCAA Pass Gate located at the Southeast entrance of the Show Me Center. Southeast Missouri follows the guidelines set forth by the NCAA governing the issuance of credentials. Press credentials will be issued to accredited sports writers of daily and weekly newspapers. Photo passes will be issued to accredited members of the photo media working for newspapers and television stations. All credential requests should come from sports editors, directors or anchors. Spouses, dates and minors will not be permitted on Press Row or in the press areas at the Show Me Center. Any unauthorized use of credentials will result in revocation of credentials issued by Southeast Missouri State University and credential requests will not be honored for future SEMO athletic events.

Press Row

Media will be assigned seats courtside on the north side of the Show Me Center. Press Row is reserved for working media



only. Professional decorum is expected at all times. Cheering or outward expression is strictly prohibited.

Southeast Missouri's official athletics website is updated daily with information on all 15 sports available. Complete schedules, results, coaches and player bios, and other information can be accessed.

Postgame Interviews

The Southeast Missouri Strategic Communications staff will make requested student-athletes available to the media at the conclusion of each game. Head Coach Brad Korn's first postgame responsibility after meeting with the team is his live radio show. Korn and selected student-athletes will address the media after every game and the opposing head coach will be available upon request. Korn will address any media immediately after his postgame radio obligation with the Redhawks Radio Network.

Photographers/Videographers

Photographers and videographers working the floor level at the Show Me Center are required to shoot from behind the dash lines along the baselines and must sit on the floor in those areas. The Strategic Communications Department may identify other positions off the court where

photographers/videographers may work, provided the view is not blocked for fans. At no time may photographers/videographers work directly from behind the official scorer's table and team benches, and in front of any courtside signage. No tripods may be placed on or beside the court and flash photography is strictly prohibited.

Career Highlights

- Led Southeast Missouri to two OVC titles in the last three years (2024-25 OVC Regular-Season; 2022-23 OVC Tournament).
- Guided SEMO to its first outright OVC regular-season championship and #1 seed in the OVC Tournament in program history during the 2024-25 campaign.
- 2024-25 OVC Coach of the Year, becoming the second head coach in program history to win the prestigious honor.

- Coached three All-OVC players in 2024-25, SEMO's most All-Conference honorees in a season in program history.
- Led SEMO to its best one-year turnaround in program history after the Redhawks finished at 9-22 overall, 4-14 in the OVC and missed making the OVC Tournament in 2023-24 to going 21-12 overall and 15-5 in league play en route to the OVC regular-season title in 2024-25.
- In all, has coached five All-OVC guards in his tenure at SEMO, most of any head coach in program history.
- The 2024-25 team broke a single-season program record in steals (269).
- Officially hired as the seventh head coach in Southeast Missouri's NCAA Division I era on March 23, 2020.
- Began his first head coaching job in the middle of a COVID-19 pandemic during the 2020-21 season.
- Brought the national spotlight back on SEMO basketball when his 2022-23 team won the OVC Tournament title and advanced to the NCAA Tournament. It was the program's first OVC Tournament crown and NCAA Tournament appearance in over two decades.
- SEMO became the first #5 seed to ever win the OVC Tournament after winning four games in four days during the 2022-23 campaign. Along the way, the Redhawks knocked off the tourney's top two seeds in #1 Morehead State and #2 Tennessee Tech to claim the title.
- The Redhawks faced Texas A&M-Corpus Christi in the NCAA First Four on Mar. 14, 2023. SEMO's 2022-23 season ended with a close 75-71 loss in that game.
- SEMO snapped a streak of eight-straight losing seasons with its 19-17 record during 2022-23.
- It was the first time the Redhawks had both winning overall and OVC records in a season since 2004-05.
- The historic 2022-23 season received unprecedented media attention. Brad Korn and Chris Harris were featured in a live interview with Inside College Basketball studio hosts Clark Kellogg, Seth Davis, Greg Gumbel and Jay Wright on Selection Sunday prior to the Atlantic 10 Championship game.
- Became only the second head coach in SEMO basketball history to lead his team to back-to-back trips to the OVC Tournament semifinals (2021-22, 2022-23).
- The OVC Tournament semifinal appearance in 2021-22 was SEMO's first in 17 years.
- Academically, Korn's 2023-24 team completed the academic year with a 3.09 grade point average. His 2024-25 team finished the academic year with an even higher 3.18 GPA.

Previous Experience

- Korn spent five years at Big 12 Conference member Kansas State working four seasons as an assistant coach and one as the program's Director of Operations.
- In his final four years back at K-State after returning following a three-year stint at Missouri State, Korn helped the Wildcats to 82 wins and three-straight NCAA Tournaments.
- K-State posted consecutive 25-win campaigns for the first time in school history (2017-18, 2018-19).
- Spent one season on Bruce Weber's inaugural staff at K-State as Director of Operations, helping lead the Wildcats to a 27-8 record and their first-ever Big 12 regular-season title in 2012-13.
- Overall, Korn has 19 years of Division I coaching experience.
- Returned to Manhattan, Kansas in May, 2016 after three seasons at Missouri State, where he was an assistant coach under Paul Lusk.
- Before his first stint at K-State, Korn spent eight years at his alma mater, Southern Illinois, including his final six seasons as a full-time assistant under Chris Lowery.
- During his time at SIU, Korn helped lead the Salukis to a 145-116 record, four postseason appearances, two Missouri Valley Conference championships and one State Farm Missouri Valley Tournament title. The 2006-07 SIU team advanced to the Sweet 16 with Korn on the coaching staff.

Playing Experience

- Korn helped the Salukis through one of their greatest periods of success from 1999 to 2004.
- The squad went from 16 wins his redshirt-freshman season to three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances under head coaches Bruce Weber and Matt Painter.
- He was part of three Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championships.
- The 6-foot-9 forward saw action in 121 games in his career, averaging 5.2 points and 2.3 rebounds in 14.5 minutes per game.
- As a senior, Korn averaged 9.7 points on 41 percent shooting with four rebounds and 1.9 assists in helping lead SIU to 25 wins and a 17-1 mark in MVC play.
- He was named to the MVC's Most Improved Team.
