- Southeast Missouri (2-6) remains home to face St. Mary of the Woods (5-3) in midweek action Tuesday. Tip-off is set for 6:30 p.m., CT at the Show Me Center.
- St. Mary of the Woods College is the second non-Division I opponent SEMO plays this
- Two of the Redhawks final three non-conference games are against non-Division I foes
- SEMO also welcomes Saint Xavier for its final tune-up before Ohio Valley Conference play on Dec. 14.

Series Notes

- · The Redhawks meet St. Mary of the Woods for the second-straight season.
- · Southeast Missouri won the first matchup between the teams, 93-56, on Dec. 15, 2024.
- That game was played at the Show Me Center.
- Tuesday is an exhibition game for the Pomeroys.

Non-Division I Opponents

- Southeast Missouri is on a 41-game winning streak against non-Division I opponents.
- Head Coach Brad Korn is 12-0 all-time in such games.
- Korn is 2-0 vs. Missouri Baptist, 1-0 vs. William Woods, 1-0 vs. Harris-Stowe, 1-0 vs. Lindsay Wilson College, 2-0 vs. Webster, 1-0 vs. Lyon College, 1-0 vs. Crowley's Ridge, 1-0 vs. Bethel (Tenn.), 1-0 vs. St. Mary of the Woods and 1-0 vs. Westminster.

First Month is Done

- Southeast Missouri wrapped up its first month of the 2025-26 campaign with an 88-77 home loss to Lipscomb (Nov. 29).
- SEMO finished November with a 2-6 record that includes wins over Webster University (Nov. 12) and Cal Poly (Nov. 25).
- · The Redhawks outscored their opponents, 339-330, in the second half through their first eight games this year.

Rattle Tested

- SEMO curently has the 21st toughest schedule in the country eight games into its 2025-26 season.
- The Redhawks past Division I opposition, which included Saint Louis (6-1), Missouri (8-0), Iowa (7-0), St. Thomas (6-3), Cal Poly (4-5), Northern Arizona (4-2) and Lipscomb (4-4) is a combined 39-15 (.722).
- · SEMO ranks behind Arkansas-Pine Bluff, Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, UTEP, Florida Atlantic, Michigan, Eastern Kentucky, Nevada, Ohio, Kansas State, Tennessee State, Middle Tennessee, St. John's, BYU, Oral Roberts, UConn, New Mexico, Furman, USC, Alabama A&M and Florida A&M.
- Chattanooga (Dec. 6) is the final Division I opponent on the Redhawks non-conference slate.

Northern Arizona MTE

- The Redhawks split two games at the Northern Arizona Multiple Team Event on Nov. 25-26.
- Southeast Missouri beat Cal Poly, 85-68, and fell to host Northern Arizona, 79-72.
- The Redhawks won the second half in both of those contests.
- SEMO outscored Cal Poly, 55-37, in the second half to pull off its come-from-behind win.
- The Redhawks were in Arizona for the second time in three years.
- SEMO last played there when it opened its 2023-24 season at Grand Canyon located in Phoenix.

Almodovar Goes Off

- Luke Almodovar scored a season-high 29 points with 27 in the second half to key Southeast Missouri's come-from-behind win over Cal Poly (Nov. 25).
- Almodovar scored layup on the opening possession of the second half and then drained a 3-pointer to give SEMO its first lead of the contest.
- He shot 10-of-15 from the field and 4-of-7 from 3-point range in the second stanza after going 1-of-6 from the floor and 0-of-3 from distance in the first half.
- It was Almodovar's third 20-point game this season.
- He ranks second on the team and is eighth in the Ohio Valley Conference with 14.1 points per game.

First Division I Win

- Southeast Missouri's 84-68 victory over Big West Conference member Cal Poly (Nov. 25) marked its first Division I win of the season.
- SEMO outscored the Mustangs 55-37 in the second half en route to its comeback win in Flagstaff, Arizona.
- The Redhawks limited the Big West's top 3-point shooting team to a season-low five 3-pointers made.
- ^a Cal Poly entered that matchup with 78 three-pointers made and had made 13 against Northern Arizona the night before it faced the Redhawks.

Strong at Home

- Brad Korn posted a winning record at home each of his first five seasons as head coach.
- Southeast Missouri's 12-3 record at the Show Me Center in 2024-25 is his best home record to date.
- Korn is 45-26 all-time in Cape Girardeau.
- The Redhawks won five of their last six home games dating back to last season.
- SEMO led the Ohio Valley Conference in home attendance during OVC play a year ago.
- The Redhawks are 1-2 at home this season and are in Cape Girardeau for three of their final four non-conference games.

Call Me for Assistance

- BJ Ward ranks second in the Ohio Valley Conference with 35 assists through eight starts this season.
- Ward is averaging 4.4 per game and has dished out five or more assists in four of his last seven outings.
- He matched his career-high of seven assists three times this year, as well.
- Ward went over 150 assists at Iowa (Nov. 18) and has 164 in his career.
- He also ranks third in the league in assist/turnover ratio (1.9).

Blocker Cracks Starting Five

- Louisiana Tech transfer Landren Blocker made his first career Southeast Missouri start at Iowa (Nov. 18).
- Blocker has been in the starting lineup for the last four games.
- SEMO has used two different lineup combinations seven games into its 2025-26 campaign.

Double Vision

- Five Southeast Missouri players are averaging double figures in the scoring column.
- Braxton Stacker paves the way with 15.1 points a game.
- Luke Almodovar (14.1), BJ Ward (11.5),
 Marqueas Bell (10.0) and Brendan Terry (10.0) round out that group.

 Stacker (7), Terry (5), Bell (4), Almodovar (4) and Ward (4) have teamed up for 24 double-digit scoring games this season.

Redhawks Conclude Sixth MTE Under Korn

- The Redhawks recently completed their sixth different Multiple Team Event (MTE) with Brad Korn as their head coach.
- This year, Southeast Missouri traveled to Flagstaff, Arizona to play both Cal Poly (Nov. 25) and event host Northern Arizona (Nov. 26).
- SEMO split two games at its MTE for the second-straight year.
- Prior to 2025-26, the Redhawks played at the Central Arkansas Tournament (2024-25), Chattanooga Coke Zero Sugar Classic (2023-24), Milwaukee Cream City Classic (2022-23), Incarnate Word Thanksgiving Classic (2021-22) and Negro League Baseball Museum Tip-Off Classic (2020-21, Kansas City, Mo.).
- Korn now has a record of 5-8 in MTEs.

Away from Home

- The Redhawks closed out a three-game stretch away from home.
- Southeast Missouri went 1-2 with losses at lowa (Nov. 18) and Northern Arizona (Nov. 26) and a win over Cal Poly (Nov. 25) in that span.
- SEMO played five of its first seven games outside of Cape Girardeau. The Redhawks are looking for their first true road win this 2025-26 season.

Season-High Field Goal Percentage

- Southeast Missouri shot a season-best 52 percent (26-of-50) from the field at lowa (Nov. 18).
- It marked the second time this year where SEMO shot over 50 percent.
- The Redhawks also finished with a 51.6 percent (33-of-64) clip vs. Webster (Nov. 12).

Double-Digit Margins

- Six of the Redhawks first eight games this season have been decided by double-digits.
- Southeast Missouri's wins thus far include an 87-41 victory vs. Webster (Nov. 12) and 84-68 win over Cal Poly (Nov. 25).
- SEMO fell to Saint Louis (92-67, Nov. 3) and Iowa (99-70, Nov. 18) on the road, and St. Thomas (84-72, Nov. 15) and Lipscomb (88-77, Nov. 29) at home in the other four matchups.

Home-Opening Win

- With its win over Webster University (Nov. 12), Southeast Missouri improved to 26-9 in home-openers since joining the NCAA Division I ranks in 1991-92.
- SEMO began its home slate with a win in 10 of the last 14 years and posted victories in 17 of its previous 21 home-opening contests.
- The Redhawks won their home-opener in seven of their last 10 seasons.
- SEMO is 3-3 in home-openers under Head Coach Brad Korn.

Stacker is Rolling

- Braxton Stacker scored double figures in seven of his first eight starts of the 2025-26 campaign.
- Stacker opened the year with 12 points at Saint Louis (Nov. 3) and followed that up with a career-high 26 points four days later at Missouri (Nov. 7). He then finished with 10 points vs. Webster (Nov. 12), 11 at lowa (Nov. 18), 18 vs. Cal Poly (Nov. 25), 15 at Northern Arizona (Nov. 26) and 24 vs. Lipscomb (Nov. 29).
- He has scored double figures a team-high 25 times in his career.
- Stacker ranks first on the team in scoring (15.1 ppg) and leads the Redhawks in steals (12) and free throw percentage (25-of-27, .926).

About St. Mary of the Woods

- St. Mary of the Woods comes to Cape Girardeau on a two-game winning streak.
- SMWC scored 97 points in both of those wins which came against Saint Xavier (III.) (97-91) and East-West University (97-67).
- The Pomeroys are under the direction of first-year Head Coach Maverick Harris.
- Taray Howell leads SMWC with 19.3 points a game.

Milestone Mark

- Braxton Stacker went over 500 points in his Southeast Missouri career vs. Webster University (Nov. 12).
- Stacker officially cleared the mark when he knocked down a 3-pointer less than a minute into the game.
- He currently has 582 points in 65 games and 35 starts as a Redhawk. That point total is most among SEMO's active players.

Back-to-Back Double-Doubles for Bell

- Marqueas Bell finished with a double-double in two-straight games.
- Bell registered the first double-double of his career with 15 points and 10 rebounds vs.
 Webster University (Nov. 12).
- Three days later, he had 11 points and 10 rebounds vs. St. Thomas (Nov. 15).
- Bell hit a season-high in points and careerbest in rebounds against the Gorloks.
- He came off the bench to score double figures four of SEMO's first five games.
- Bell also finished with 10 points in 22 minutes at Saint Louis (Nov. 3) and 13 points in 17 minutes at Missouri (Nov. 7).
- This year marked the first time in his career where Bell scored double figures in fourstraight games.

Lopsided Win

- The 46-point win over Webster (87-41) on Nov. 12 was Southeast Missouri's fourth-largest margin of victory under Head Coach Brad Korn.
- SEMO has recorded six wins by 31 or more points with Korn at the helm.
- Four of those were by 46 or more.

- SEMO's largest victory under Korn was by 55 points (93-38) vs. Crowley's Ridge on Nov. 13, 2024.
- His biggest margin of victory against a NCAA Division I team stands at +31 vs. Eastern Illinois (75-44) on Jan. 30, 2021.

Near Upset in Columbia

- The Redhawks nearly pulled off an upset at SEC member Missouri (Nov. 7).
- Southeast Missouri led the Tigers, 51-46, at halftime and was ahead by nine (55-46) with 18:55 left to play in the second half.
- Missouri, which missed 12 free throws, made six in the final 47 seconds to fend off the Redhawks in its close 89-84 win.

Stacker's Free Throw Streak Ends at 36

- Braxton Stacker, who leads the Ohio Valley Conference in free throw shooting, saw his streak of free throws made end at 36.
- Stacker made 36-consecutive free throws dating back to the 2024-25 campaign.
- The streak ended when he missed a free throw with 12:58 remaining in the second half vs. Lipscomb (Nov. 29).
- Stacker is shooting 92.6 percent (25-of-27) at the free throw line this year.

Nice Defense

- Southeast Missouri leads the Ohio Valley Conference in turnover margin eight games into its 2025-26 season.
- SEMO is forcing 15.8 turnovers per game and turning the ball over 12.3 times per contest for a +3.5 margin.
- The Redhawks forced 127 turnovers in their first eight games, second-most in the OVC behind Tennessee State (130).

First Points for Reynolds

- Jay Reynolds, the son of Southeast Missouri Associate Head Coach J.R. Reynolds, scored the first points of his career vs. Webster University (Nov. 12).
- Reynolds finished with six points on a pair of 3-pointers against the Gorloks.
- He redshirted as a true freshman in 2024-25.

Starting Streaks

- Brendan Terry has not missed a start in his two-year career at Southeast Missouri.
- Terry has started 41-consecutive games.
- BJ Ward started 40-straight contests since Nov. 10, 2024.

SEMO Debuts

- Five players, including PJ Farmer,
 Trace Sadler, Landren Blocker, Luke
 Almodovar and Jay Reynolds saw their first
 action in a Redhawk uniform at Saint Louis
 (Nov. 3).
- Farmer, Sadler, Almodovar and Reynolds each played at the NCAA Division I level for the first time.
- Blocker, a transfer from Louisiana Tech, led SEMO with seven rebounds.

Nice Homecoming for Ward

- In his first time playing against Saint Louis in his career, St. Louis native BJ Ward led the Redhawks with 16 points on Nov. 3.
- Ward shot 5-of-14 from the field, made two 3-pointers and hit 4-of-6 free throws. He also dished out three assists and added one steal in 32 minutes.
- It was the 17th double-digit scoring game of his career.

Four Score Double Figures

- Southeast Missouri had four double-digit scorers in two games this season.
- BJ Ward, Brendan Terry, Braxton Stacker and Marqueas Bell each finished with double figures in the scoring column at Saint Louis (Nov. 3).
- Ward scored 16 points, Terry followed with 13, Stacker added 12 and Bell chipped in 10 against the Bilikens.
- Almodovar (20), Ward (19), Terry (14) and Bell (11) had double figures vs. St. Thomas (Nov. 15).

Season 119

- The 2025-26 campaign is the 119th season in Southeast Missouri men's basketball history.
- This year is SEMO's 35th as an NCAA Division I program and member of the Ohio Valley Conference.
- The Redhawks are 408-580 since joining the Division I ranks in 1991-92.
- SEMO has a total of 10 winning seasons as an NCAA Division I program.
- The Redhawks won two OVC regular-season titles (1999-2000, 2024-25), two OVC Tournament crowns (1999-2000, 2022-23) and made two NCAA Tournament

- appearances (1999-2000, 2022-23).
- Since Brad Korn took over as head coach in 2020-21, SEMO won its first OVC Tournament title in over two decades and first OVC regular-season championship in 25 years.

Roster Talk

- The 2025-26 roster consists of 14 players, including one graduate, six seniors, three juniors, one sophomore and three freshmen.
- Southeast Missouri has nine returnees from its Ohio Valley Conference regular-season championship team.
- Marqueas Bell, Brendan Terry, Braxton Stacker, Troy Cole, Jr., David Idada, Jay Reynolds, BJ Ward, Saxton Hoepker and Elliot Lowndes are the returning players.
- Transfers Landren Blocker (Louisiana Tech), Blaize Sagna (Stetson) and Luke Almodovar (St. Francis, Ind.) along with true freshmen PJ Farmer and Trace Sadler complete this year's team.

Redhawks Tabbed Second in OVC Preseason Poll

- Southeast Missouri was picked second in the 2025-26 Ohio Valley Conference Preseason Poll during the league's annual media day on Oct. 14.
- For only the third time in program history, SEMO was voted as high as second in the league's preseason poll.
- The Redhawks were tied for second with then-OVC member Austin Peay in the 1999-2000 version and second overall (first in the West Division) in the 2013-14 predicted order of finish.
- Little Rock, which was eliminated by SEMO in the semifinals of the 2025 OVC Tournament, is the preseason favorite with 188 points and 12 of the possible 22 first-place votes.
- The Redhawks tallied 177 points and six first-place nods.
- SIU Edwardsville (163 pts.), Tennessee State (135 pts.), Lindenwood (100 pts.) and Morehead State (100 pts.) complete the top six.
- Tennessee Tech (80 pts.), UT Martin (79 pts.), Southern Indiana (67 pts.), Eastern Illinois (63 pts.) and Wester Illinois (57 pts.) rounded out the balloting.

Returning All-OVC Pick

- Forward Brendan Terry is Southeast Missouri's only returning All-Ohio Valley Conference player from last season.
- Terry earned Second-Team All-OVC honors in his first year at SEMO in 2024-25.
- He ranked third on the team in scoring with 11.2 points per game and second with 4.5 rebounds per contest.
- Terry started all 33 games and scored double figures in 18 of his starts, as well.

More OVC Players to Watch

- In addition to Brendan Terry, guards
 Braxton Stacker and BJ Ward were selected
 among the Ohio Valley Conference's
 Players to Watch this preseason.
- Stacker rated fourth on the team in scoring with 8.9 points and third in rebounding with 3.1 boards a game last season. He came off the bench in 26 of his 27 games.
- Ward was fifth behind Stacker with 8.4 points per game in 32 starts. He drained 51 three-pointers which were good for secondmost on the team. Ward also added 74 assists and 30 steals.

Non-Conference Games

- Brad Korn is 30-44 in non-conference action.
- Korn's best non-league record as Southeast Missouri's head coach stands at 9-9 in 2022-23, the season SEMO won its first OVC Tournament title and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 23 years.
- His other non-conference records include 2-5 in 2020-21, 6-9 in 2021-22, 5-8 in 2023-24 and 6-7 in 2024-25.

3-Pointer Streak

- The Redhawks have made at least one 3-pointer in 530 consecutive games.
- The last time Southeast Missouri did not make a 3-pointer was vs. Western Illinois (0-of-6) on Dec. 10, 2008.
- SEMO made five or more 3-pointers in seven games this season.

Last 32 Games

- Southeast Missouri went 20-12 in its last 32 games dating back to 2024-25.
- The Redhawks won nine of their last 13 games of the 2024-25 season by double figures.

Sixth Year for Korn

- Brad Korn is in his sixth year as Southeast Missouri's head coach.
- Korn led SEMO to two conference titles (2022-23 OVC Tournament; 2024-25 OVC Regular-Season) in three years.
- The reigning OVC Coach of trhe Year, Korn is 76-91 overall and 46-47 in conference play.
- He ranks third all-time in wins among head coaches in SEMO's NCAA Division I era behind Gary Garner (126 wins, 1997-2006) and Dickey Nutt (80 wins, 2009-15).
- On July 1, 2025, Korn agreed to a contract extension through the 2029-30 season.
 His new contract will run through Apr. 30, 2030. It extends his current deal that was signed through the 2026-27 season.

Non-Conference Slate

- The Redhawks have an 11-game nonconference schedule in 2025-26.
- Southeast Missouri plays its first two games on the road against in-state schools Saint Louis (Nov. 3) and Missouri (Nov. 7).
- SEMO travels to Big Ten Conference member lowa (Nov. 18) and returns a trip on the back end of a home-and-home series to Chattanooga (Dec. 6).
- The Redhawks head west to face Cal Poly (Nov. 25) and Northern Arizona (Nov. 26) in Flagstaff, Arizona before Thanksgiving.
- SEMO's home non-conference foes include non-Division I schools Webster (Nov. 12), St. Mary of the Woods (Dec. 2) and Saint Xavier (III.) (Dec. 14), St. Thomas (Minn.) (Nov. 15) and Lipscomb (Nov. 29).

OVC Schedule

- The Ohio Valley Conference schedule includes 20 games for the Redhawks.
- For the third-straight year, the league membership includes 11 teams (Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Little Rock, Morehead State, Southeast Missouri, SIU Edwardsville, Southern Indiana, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, UT Martin, Western Illinois).
- This year the Conference schedules again feature a true round-robin slate.
- Each team will play two games before Christmas; the schedule picks back up on Dec. 30 and continues until Saturday, Feb. 28.
- SEMO opens OVC play at Tennessee Tech on Dec. 18.

 Athletic Conference (UAC) in 2026-27.

2026 OVC Tournament

- The 2026 Ohio Valley Conference Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held Mar. 4-7 at the Ford Center in Evansville, Indiana.
- It marks the ninth-straight year the event will be held at the venue.
- The Ford Center, which opened in November 2011, is an 11,000-seat arena located in the core of Evansville's downtown district.
- The OVC Board of Presidents accepted an agreement to continue to hold the OVC Men's and Women's Basketball Championships at the Ford Center through 2032.

Championship Culture

- Southeast Missouri's Department of Athletics has won an unprecedented 37 conference championships since the start of the 2019-20 season.
- Every sport won at least one OVC title in that stretch.
- In 2024-25 alone, SEMO won seven OVC championships. That total was more than the number of conference titles won by any two schools in the league combined.
- Additionally, SEMO claimed the OVC Commissioner's Cup for the third time in five years.

2024-25 Review

- Southeast Missouri entered the 2024-25 season ranked seventh in the Ohio Valley Conference Preseason Poll and won its first outright OVC regular-season title in program history.
- SEMO clinched its regular-season championship with a statement 83-68 road win at SIU Edwardsville, which upended the Redhawks in the OVC Tournament final.
- It was the Redhawks second OVC regularseason title in program history and first in 25 years.
- SEMO initially moved to first in the standings with their 57-45 win at Little Rock (Feb. 11) and stayed there the rest of the regular-season.

- The Redhawks advanced to the OVC
 Tournament championship game for the fourth time in program history and second in three years with Brad Korn as head coach.
- SEMO earned the #1 seed in the eight-team tournament and claimed a double bye for the first time in program history
- The Redhawks' 78-59 win over #4 Little Rock was their largest in an OVC Tournament semifinal game in program history.
- For only the third time since it moved to the NCAA Division I ranks in 1991-92, SEMO reached 20 or more wins in a season. The Redhawks' 21 wins ranked second behind the 1999-2000 team (24-7). The other 20-win season was in 1998-99 (20-9).
- SEMO tied a single-season program record with 15 OVC victories. The Redhawks began their 20-game league schedule with a 3-0 record and laster went 9-1 in their final 10 conference games.
- All of SEMO's success came just one year after the Redhawks finished 10th in the OVC and missed making the league's postseason tournament in 2023-24.
 SEMO went from 9-22, 4-14 in the OVC to 21-12, 15-5 in the OVC for its best one-year turnaround in program history.
- The Redhawks won 10-straight games from Jan. 25-Feb. 27 for their longest winning streak during the NCAA Division I era. SEMO never won more than seven consecutive games since it moved to Division I in 1991-92. It was the program's longest winning streak in 35 years since the 1989-90 team won 11 in a row.
- SEMO went undefeated in February (8-0) becoming the first team in 39 years to go unbeaten in February. Ron Shumate's 1985-86 team (8-0) was the last to do it.
- The Redhawks swept home-and-home series against five OVC opponents in 2024-25. Those were the most in a season under Head Coach Brad Korn and the most in the last two years combined (4). SEMO beat SIU Edwardsville, Southern Indiana, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and Western Illinois twice during the regularseason.
- Brad Korn led SEMO to a winning record at home for the fifth-straight year. The Redhawks' 12-3 record was Korn's best at the Show Me Center since he took over as head coach. In conference games, SEMO led the OVC in home attendance.
- SEMO ranked fourth in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage defense.
 Opponents shot just 28.3 percent from beyond the arc. The Redhawks held their

- opponents t five or less 3-pointer made in 22 of 33 games.
- The Redhawks led the OVC with a +3.03 turnover margin. SEMO forced 13.7 tournovers per game and committed a league low 10.6 per contest. The Redhawks turned the ball over less than 10 times on 15 occasions in 2024-25.
- SEMO finished the year with a single-season program record 269 steals.

Redhawks Sign Two for 2026-27

- Southeast Missouri signed shooting guard Curtis "Champ" Simpson and forward Axton Perry. Simpson and Perry will join the Redhawks in 2026-27.
- A native of Cusseta, Georgia, Simpson (6'2", 165) is a 2025-26 First-Team Preseason Class 1A D-II All-State selection entering his senior season at Chattahoochee County High School.
- He averaged 25.1 points, 7.3 rebounds and 3.2 assists per game there as a junior.
- In the state playoffs, Simpson scored 23.4 points, pulled down 8.2 rebounds and dished out 4.2 assists per contest.
- Perry, (6'7", 195) who hails from Memphis,
 Tennessee, has a 6'11" wingspan. He is a senior
 at Bartlett High School, which is ranked
 #18 in the Preseason MaxPreps Top-25.
- He helped lead Bartlett to the Tennessee Class AAAA state semifinals as a sophomore.
- In 2024-25, the Panthers went 24-9 overall and won the 4A District 15 title with an undefeated 12-0 record.




