### OVC Play Begins

- Southeast Missouri (5-6) opens its 20-game Ohio Valley Conference schedule at Tennessee Tech (5-6) Thursday. Tip-off is scheduled for 7:30 p.m., CT at the Eblen Center.
- SEMO starts league play on the road for the fourth time in six years with Brad Korn as its head coach.
- The Redhawks face TTU in their conference-opener for the first time under Korn.
- SEMO was picked second in this year's OVC Preseason Poll behind Little Rock.
- Tennessee Tech was picked seventh in the 11-team predicted order of finish.

### Series Notes

- Southeast Missouri and Tennessee Tech meet for the 64th time on the front end of this year's home-and-home series.
- TTU holds a 39-24 lead in the all-time series that started in 1991-92.
- SEMO won three-straight games against the Golden Eagles and swept the two-game set a year ago.
- The Redhawks are 6-26 at the Eblen Center.
- SEMO last won there on Jan. 16, 2025 (77-70).
- Thursday will be SEMO's final game at the Eblen Center since TTU is leaving the Ohio Valley Conference at the conclusion of the 2025-26 campaign.

### OVC Openers

- The Redhawks are 12-22 all-time in Ohio Valley Conference openers.
- Southeast Missouri started OVC play with a win in each of the last two seasons.
- The Redhawks are 2-3 in such games under Head Coach Brad Korn.
- This year marks only the second time SEMO and Tennessee Tech meet to start OVC action.
- The teams also began OVC play on Dec. 9, 2000. TTU won that game, 70-68, in Cape Girardeau.

### Defending OVC Regular-Season Champions

- Southeast Missouri won 10 of its previous 11 league games dating back to last season.
- SEMO was on a 10-game winning streak in league play before Eastern Illinois ended that stretch in the final Ohio Valley Conference game of the 2024-25 campaign.
- The Redhawks went 15-5 against OVC foes and tied a program record in conference victories en route to their first outright regular-season title.

### Two More

- Brad Korn is two wins away from moving to second all-time among head coaches in victories during Southeast Missouri's NCAA Division I era.
- Korn has won 79 games and currently ranks third on that list behind Gary Garner (126, 1997-2006) and Dickey Nutt (80, 2009-15).
- Korn led SEMO to 21 wins in 2024-25, its second-most in a season since the Redhawks moved to the Division I level.

### Korn vs. Tennessee Tech

- Brad Korn is 6-4 against Tennessee Tech as Southeast Missouri's head coach.
- The Redhawks beat the Golden Eagles in each of the last three meetings between the teams.
- Of the six wins, four were in Cape Girardeau.
- SEMO won at the Eblen Center for the first time with Korn at the helm a year ago.

### Non-Conference Ends with a Dub

- Southeast Missouri wrapped up its 11-game non-conference schedule with an 88-65 win over Saint Xavier (Dec. 14).
- SEMO closed out non-league play on a three-game winning streak.
- The Redhawks five non-conference wins this season came against Webster (Nov. 12), Cal Poly (Nov. 25), St. Mary of the Woods (Dec. 2), Chattanooga (Dec. 6) and Saint Xavier (Dec. 14). Two of those victories were outside of Cape Girardeau (Nov. 25, Dec. 6).

### Winning Streak

- The Redhawks are on a three-game winning streak after beating St. Mary of the Woods, 88-57, on Dec. 2, Chattanooga, 74-70, on Dec. 6 and Saint Xavier, 88-65, on Dec. 14.
- Southeast Missouri has won four of its last six contests and is one of two teams in the Ohio Valley Conference entering the week on a winning streak of three or more games.
- Lindenwood currently has the longest winning streak in the OVC at four games.

### Stacker Among National Leaders in Free Throw Percentage

- Braxton Stacker leads the Ohio Valley Conference and ranks 12th in the nation in free throw percentage.
- Stacker has missed only two free throws through 11 starts.
- He is 33-of-35 for 94.3 percent.
- Stacker did not miss a free throw with a minimum of four attempts in four games this year.

### Winning Streak

- The Redhawks are on a three-game winning streak after beating St. Mary of the Woods, 88-57, on Dec. 2, Chattanooga, 74-70, on Dec. 6 and Saint Xavier, 88-65, on Dec. 14.
- Southeast Missouri has won four of its last six contests and is one of two teams in the Ohio Valley Conference entering the week on a winning streak of three or more games.
- Lindenwood currently has the longest winning streak in the OVC at four games.

### Non-Conference Games

- Following this year's 5-6 non-conference record, Brad Korn is now 33-44 all-time in non-league action.
- Korn's best non-conference record as Southeast Missouri's head coach stands at 9-9 in 2022-23, the season SEMO won its first OVC Tournament title and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 23 years.
- His other non-conference records include 2-5 in 2020-21, 6-9 in 2021-22, 5-8 in 2023-24 and 6-7 in 2024-25.

### Unbeaten in December

- The Redhawks are undefeated through their first three games in December for the first time with Brad Korn as their head coach.
- Southeast Missouri beat St. Mary of the Woods, 88-57, on Dec. 2, Chattanooga, 74-70, on Dec. 6 and Saint Xavier, 88-65, on Dec. 14 for those victories.
- SEMO travels to Tennessee Tech (Dec. 18) and Tennessee State (Dec. 20) for its final December games.
- The Redhawks are averaging 83.3 points per game this month alone.

### Bell Springs for Career-High

- Marqueas Bell pitched in a career-high 19 points to lead Southeast Missouri to its win over Saint Xavier (Dec. 14).
- Bell made a perfect 6-of-6 field goals and added 6-of-7 free throws against the Cougars.

- He also led the Redhawks with six rebounds and dished out three assists in 20 minutes.
- It was Bell's fifth double-digit scoring game this season.

### Over 80

- The Redhawks scored over 80 points for the fifth time this season in their 88-65 rout of Saint Xavier (Dec. 14).
- Southeast Missouri's 88 points matched a season-high.
- SEMO is 4-1 in games where it scores over 80 points.

### Idada and Bell in Starting Lineup

- Since David Idada and Marqueas Bell joined the starting lineup, Southeast Missouri has gone 3-0.
- Idada and Bell made their first starts of the season vs. St. Mary of the Woods (Dec. 2).
- It was the first time both were in the starting lineup since Mar. 2, 2024 (at Southern Indiana).

### Against Non-Division I

- With its 88-65 win over Saint Xavier (Dec. 14), Southeast Missouri finished with a 3-0 record against non-Division I opponents this season.
- SEMO blew also blew out Webster University (87-41, Nov. 12) and St. Mary of the Woods (88-57, Dec. 2).
- The Redhawks are on a 43-game winning streak against non-Division I opponents.
- Head Coach Brad Korn is 14-0 all-time in such games.
- Korn is 2-0 vs. Missouri Baptist, 1-0 vs. William Woods, 1-0 vs. Harris-Stowe, 1-0 vs. Lindsay Wilson College, 2-0 vs. Webster, 1-0 vs. Lyon College, 1-0 vs. Crowley's Ridge, 1-0 vs. Bethel (Tenn.), 2-0 vs. St. Mary of the Woods, 1-0 vs. Westminster and 1-0 vs. Saint Xavier.
- The Redhawks have not allowed more than 65 points in their last 12 meetings with non-Division I teams. SEMO outscored

its opponents by a combined 1044-612 (+432) in that span.

### Gritty Road Win

- Southeast Missouri picked up its first true road win of the season with a 74-70 victory over Chattanooga (Dec. 6).
- Neither team led by more than five points in an up-tempo game that featured 13 ties and 19 lead changes.
- SEMO scored four points in the final 59 seconds to grind out its win over the 2024-25 Southern Conference Regular-Season and NIT Champion Mocs.

### Cole, Jr. Rises

- Troy Cole, Jr. provided a late spark to send the Redhawks to their win over Chattanooga (Dec. 6).
- Cole, Jr. stole the ball and threw down a dunk to give Southeast Missouri a 70-68 edge with 1:39 to go.
- After Makai Richards made two free throws to tie the game one last time, Cole, Jr. drove the baseline for another dunk to put SEMO up again (72-70).
- Following a missed shot by former Redhawk Teddy Washington, Jr., SEMO got the rebound and Braxton Stacker was fouled and later hit two free throws to finish off the Mocs.
- Cole, Jr. had a season-high nine points and five rebounds in 19 minutes off the bench.

### Winning the Second Half

- Southeast Missouri won the second half in four of its last six games.
- SEMO recently outscored Chattanooga, 30-24, in the game's final 20 minutes to get a 74-70 win on Dec. 6.
- The Redhawks are outscoring opponents, 449-522 (+27) in the second half this year.

### Battle Tested

- At one time this season, Southeast Missouri had the 10th toughest schedule in the nation.
- Now, SEMO is 39th among NCAA Division I teams in that category.
- The Redhawks non-conference Division I opposition, which included Saint Louis (9-1), Missouri (10-2), Iowa (9-2), St. Thomas (9-4), Cal Poly (5-6), Northern Arizona (4-6), Lipscomb (6-4) and Chattanooga (5-6) is a combined 57-31 (.647).

### Northern Arizona MTE

- The Redhawks split two games at the Northern Arizona Multiple Team Event on Nov. 25-26.
- Southeast Missouri beat Cal Poly, 85-68, and fell to host Northern Arizona, 79-72.
- The Redhawks won the second half in both of those contests.
- SEMO outscored Cal Poly, 55-37, in the second half to pull off its come-from-behind win.
- The Redhawks were in Arizona for the second time in three years.
- SEMO last played there when it opened its 2023-24 season at Grand Canyon located in Phoenix.

### Almodovar Goes Off

- Luke Almodovar scored a season-high 29 points with 27 in the second half to key Southeast Missouri's come-from-behind win over Cal Poly (Nov. 25).
- Almodovar scored layup on the opening possession of the second half and then drained a 3-pointer to give SEMO its first lead of the contest.
- He shot 10-of-15 from the field and 4-of-7 from 3-point range in the second stanza after going 1-of-6 from the floor and 0-of-3 from distance in the first half.
- It was Almodovar's third 20-point game this season.
- He ranks second on the team and 12th in the Ohio Valley Conference in scoring with 13.5 points per game.

### First Division I Win

- Southeast Missouri's 84-68 victory over Big West Conference member Cal Poly (Nov. 25) marked its first Division I win of the season.
- SEMO outscored the Mustangs 55-37 in the second half en route to its comeback win

in Flagstaff, Arizona.

- The Redhawks limited the Big West's top 3-point shooting team to a season-low five 3-pointers made.
- Cal Poly entered that matchup with 78 three-pointers made and had 13 against Northern Arizona the night before it faced the Redhawks.

### Strong at Home

- Brad Korn posted a winning record at home each of his first five seasons as head coach.
- Southeast Missouri's 12-3 record at the Show Me Center in 2024-25 is his best home record to date.
- Korn is 47-26 all-time in Cape Girardeau.
- The Redhawks won eight of their last 10 home games dating back to last season.
- SEMO led the Ohio Valley Conference in home attendance during OVC play a year ago.
- The Redhawks are 3-2 at home this season.

### Call Me for Assistance

- BJ Ward ranks second in the Ohio Valley Conference with 47 assists through 11 starts this season.
- Ward is averaging 4.3 per game and has dished out five or more assists in four of his starts.
- He matched his career-high of seven assists three times this year, as well.
- Ward went over 150 assists at Iowa (Nov. 18) and has 176 in his career.
- He also ranks second in the league in assist/turnover ratio (2.14).

### Lineup Combinations

- Southeast Missouri has used three different lineup combinations through its first 11 games this season.
- BJ Ward, Braxton Stacker, Troy Cole, Jr., Luke Almodovar and Brendan Terry started four games (1-3).
- Ward, Stacker, Landren Blocker, Almodovar and Terry started four games (1-3).
- And, Ward, Stacker, Blocker, David Idada and Marqueas Bell started two contests (3-0).

### Double Vision

- Four Southeast Missouri players are averaging double figures in the scoring column.
- Braxton Stacker paves the way with 14.1 points a game.
- Luke Almodovar (13.5), Marqueas Bell (10.2) and BJ Ward (10.2) round out that group.

- Stacker (10), Almodovar (6), Ward (5) and Bell (5) have teamed up for 26 double-digit scoring games this season.

### Redhawks Conclude Sixth MTE Under Korn

- The Redhawks recently completed their sixth different Multiple Team Event (MTE) with Brad Korn as their head coach.
- This year, Southeast Missouri traveled to Flagstaff, Arizona to play both Cal Poly (Nov. 25) and event host Northern Arizona (Nov. 26).
- SEMO split two games at its MTE for the second-straight year.
- Prior to 2025-26, the Redhawks played at the Central Arkansas Tournament (2024-25), Chattanooga Coke Zero Sugar Classic (2023-24), Milwaukee Cream City Classic (2022-23), Incarnate Word Thanksgiving Classic (2021-22) and Negro League Baseball Museum Tip-Off Classic (2020-21, Kansas City, Mo.).
- Korn now has a record of 5-8 in MTEs.

### Away from Home

- The Redhawks closed out a three-game stretch away from home.
- Southeast Missouri went 1-2 with losses at Iowa (Nov. 18) and Northern Arizona (Nov. 26) and a win over Cal Poly (Nov. 25) in that span.
- SEMO played five of its first seven games outside of Cape Girardeau.
- The Redhawks are 1-4 in true road games.

### Season-High Field Goal Percentage

- Southeast Missouri shot a season-best 52 percent (26-of-50) from the field at Iowa (Nov. 18).
- SEMO has shot over 50 percent four times this year.
- The Redhawks also finished with a 51.6 percent (33-of-64) clip vs. Webster (Nov. 12), 51.5 percent (35-of-68) mark vs. St. Mary of the Woods (Dec. 2) and 50.8 percent (31-of-61) showing vs. Saint Xavier (Dec. 14).

### Double-Digit Margins

- Eight of the Redhawks first 11 games this season have been decided by double-digits.
- Southeast Missouri's double-digit wins thus far include an 87-41 victory vs. Webster (Nov. 12), an 84-68 win over Cal Poly (Nov. 25), an 88-57 win over St. Mary of the Woods (Dec. 2) and an 88-65 victory over Saint Xavier (Dec. 14).
- SEMO fell to Saint Louis (92-67, Nov. 3) and Iowa (99-70, Nov. 18) on the road, and

St. Thomas (84-72, Nov. 15) and Lipscomb (88-77, Nov. 29) at home in the other four matchups.

### Home-Opening Win

- With its win over Webster University (Nov. 12), Southeast Missouri improved to 26-9 in home-openers since joining the NCAA Division I ranks in 1991-92.
- SEMO began its home slate with a win in 10 of the last 14 years and posted victories in 17 of its previous 21 home-opening contests.
- The Redhawks won their home-opener in seven of their last 10 seasons.
- SEMO is 3-3 in home-openers under Head Coach Brad Korn.

### Stacker is Rolling

- Braxton Stacker scored double figures in 10 of his first 11 starts of the 2025-26 campaign.
- Stacker scored 10 or more points in his last seven outings.
- He opened the year with 12 points at Saint Louis (Nov. 3) and followed that up with a career-high 26 points four days later at Missouri (Nov. 7). He then finished with 10 points vs. Webster (Nov. 12), 11 at Iowa (Nov. 18), 18 vs. Cal Poly (Nov. 25), 15 at Northern Arizona (Nov. 26), 24 vs. Lipscomb (Nov. 29), 10 vs. St. Mary of the Woods (Dec. 2), 12 at Chattanooga (Dec. 6) and 12 vs. Saint Xavier (Dec. 14).
- He has scored double figures a team-high 28 times in his career.
- Stacker ranks first on the team in scoring (14.1 ppg) and leads the Redhawks in steals (17), free throw percentage (.33-of-35, .943) and is second in 3-point field goals made (22).
- Stacker rates eighth in the Ohio Valley Conference in scoring and leads the league in free throw percentage. He is also 10th in steals.
- He is one of two Redhawks who started every game this year.

### About Tennessee Tech

- Tennessee Tech enters Thursday's game on a two-game winning streak after beating West Georgia (Dec. 6) and Bethel (Dec. 13).
- TTU won three of its first four games at the Eblen Center this year.
- The Golden Eagles lead the Ohio Valley Conference in field goal percentage (.476) and rank second in scoring (80.8 ppg).
- TTU is also third in the league with 84 three-pointers made.

- Ty Owens is the conference leader in assists (4.4 apg) and Dani Pounds is the Golden Eagles top scoring threat with 12.2 points per contest.

### Milestone Mark

- Braxton Stacker went over 600 points in his Southeast Missouri career at Chattanooga (Dec. 6).
- Stacker finished with 12 points against the Mocs.
- He currently has 616 points in 68 games and 38 starts as a Redhawk. That point total is most among SEMO's active players.

### Back-to-Back Double-Doubles for Bell

- Marqueas Bell finished with a double-double in two-straight games.
- Bell registered the first double-double of his career with 15 points and 10 rebounds vs. Webster University (Nov. 12).
- Three days later, he had 11 points and 10 rebounds vs. St. Thomas (Nov. 15).
- Bell hit a season-high in points and career-best in rebounds against the Gorloks.
- He came off the bench to score double figures four of SEMO's first five games.
- Bell also finished with 10 points in 22 minutes at Saint Louis (Nov. 3) and 13 points in 17 minutes at Missouri (Nov. 7).
- This year marked the first time in his career where Bell scored double figures in four-straight games.

### Lopsided Win

- The 46-point win over Webster (87-41) on Nov. 12 was Southeast Missouri's fourth-largest margin of victory under Head Coach Brad Korn.
- SEMO has recorded seven wins by 31 or more points with Korn at the helm.
- Four of those were by 46 or more.
- SEMO's largest victory under Korn was by 55 points (93-38) vs. Crowley's Ridge on Nov. 13, 2024.
- His biggest margin of victory against a NCAA Division I team stands at +31 vs. Eastern Illinois (75-44) on Jan. 30, 2021.

- The Redhawks nearly pulled off an upset at SEC member Missouri (Nov. 7).
- Southeast Missouri led the Tigers, 51-46, at halftime and was ahead by nine (55-46) with 18:55 left to play in the second half.
- Missouri, which missed 12 free throws, made six in the final 47 seconds to fend off the Redhawks in its close 89-84 win.

### Stacker's Free Throw Streak Ends at 36

- Braxton Stacker, who leads the Ohio Valley Conference in free throw shooting, saw his streak of free throws made end at 36
- Stacker's streak of 36 free throws dated back to the 2024-25 campaign.
- The streak ended when he missed a free throw with 12:58 remaining in the second half vs. Lipscomb (Nov. 29).
- Stacker is shooting 94.3 percent (33-of-35) at the free throw line this year.

### Nice Defense

- Southeast Missouri leads the Ohio Valley Conference in turnover margin 11 games into its 2025-26 season.
- SEMO is forcing 15.9 turnovers per game and turning the ball over 12.3 times per contest for a +3.5 margin.
- The Redhawks forced 175 turnovers, most in the OVC.
- Opponents turned the ball over 15 or more times in eight games against SEMO's defense this season.

### First Points for Reynolds

- Jay Reynolds, the son of Southeast Missouri Associate Head Coach J.R. Reynolds, scored the first points of his career vs. Webster University (Nov. 12).
- Reynolds finished with six points on a pair of 3-pointers against the Gorloks.
- He redshirted as a true freshman in 2024-25.

### Starting Streak

- BJ Ward started 43-straight contests.
- The last time Ward was not in the starting lineup was Nov. 4, 2024 (at Bradley).



## SOUTHEAST MISSOURI BASKETBALL NOTES

### SEMO Debuts

- Five players, including PJ Farmer, Trace Sadler, Landren Blocker, Luke Almodovar and Jay Reynolds saw their first action in a Redhawk uniform at Saint Louis (Nov. 3).
- Farmer, Sadler, Almodovar and Reynolds each played at the NCAA Division I level for the first time.
- Blocker, a transfer from Louisiana Tech, led SEMO with seven rebounds.

### Nice Homecoming for Ward

- In his first time playing against Saint Louis in his career, St. Louis native BJ Ward led the Redhawks with 16 points on Nov. 3.
- Ward shot 5-of-14 from the field, made two 3-pointers and hit 4-of-6 free throws. He also dished out three assists and added one steal in 32 minutes.

### Four Score Double Figures

- Southeast Missouri had four double-digit scorers in two games this season.
- BJ Ward, Brendan Terry, Braxton Stacker and Marqueas Bell each finished with double figures in the scoring column at Saint Louis (Nov. 3).
- Ward scored 16 points, Terry followed with 13, Stacker added 12 and Bell chipped in 10 against the Biliens.
- Almodovar (20), Ward (19), Terry (14) and Bell (11) had double figures vs. St. Thomas (Nov. 15).

### Season 119

- The 2025-26 campaign is the 119th season in Southeast Missouri men's basketball history.
- This year is SEMO's 35th as an NCAA Division I program and member of the Ohio Valley Conference.
- The Redhawks are 411-580 since joining the Division I ranks in 1991-92.
- SEMO has a total of 10 winning seasons as an NCAA Division I program.
- The Redhawks won two OVC regular-season titles (1999-2000, 2024-25), two OVC Tournament crowns (1999-2000, 2022-23) and made two NCAA Tournament appearances (1999-2000, 2022-23).
- Since Brad Korn took over as head coach in 2020-21, SEMO won its first OVC Tournament

title in over two decades and first OVC regular-season championship in 25 years.

### Roster Talk

- The 2025-26 roster consists of 14 players, including one graduate, six seniors, three juniors, one sophomore and three freshmen.
- Southeast Missouri has nine returnees from its Ohio Valley Conference regular-season championship team.
- Marqueas Bell, Brendan Terry, Braxton Stacker, Troy Cole, Jr., David Idada, Jay Reynolds, BJ Ward, Saxton Hoepker and Elliot Lowndes are the returning players.
- Transfers Landren Blocker (Louisiana Tech), Blaize Sagna (Stetson) and Luke Almodovar (St. Francis, Ind.) along with true freshmen PJ Farmer and Trace Sadler complete this year's team.

### Redhawks Tabbed Second in OVC

#### Preseason Poll

- Southeast Missouri was picked second in the 2025-26 Ohio Valley Conference Preseason Poll during the league's annual media day on Oct. 14.
- For only the third time in program history, SEMO was voted as high as second in the league's preseason poll.
- The Redhawks were tied for second with then-OVC member Austin Peay in the 1999-2000 version and second overall (first in the West Division) in the 2013-14 predicted order of finish.
- Little Rock, which was eliminated by SEMO in the semifinals of the 2025 OVC Tournament, is the preseason favorite with 188 points and 12 of the possible 22 first-place votes.
- The Redhawks tallied 177 points and six first-place nods.
- SIU Edwardsville (163 pts.), Tennessee State (135 pts.), Lindenwood (100 pts.) and Morehead State (100 pts.) complete the top six.
- Tennessee Tech (80 pts.), UT Martin (79 pts.), Southern Indiana (67 pts.), Eastern Illinois (63 pts.) and Western Illinois (57 pts.) rounded out the balloting.

### Returning All-OVC Pick

- Forward Brendan Terry is Southeast Missouri's only returning All-Ohio Valley Conference player from last season.
- Terry earned Second-Team All-OVC honors in his first year at SEMO in 2024-25.
- He ranked third on the team in scoring with 11.2 points per game and second with 4.5 rebounds per contest.

- Terry started all 33 games and scored double figures in 18 of his starts, as well.

### More OVC Players to Watch

- In addition to Brendan Terry, guards Braxton Stacker and BJ Ward were selected among the Ohio Valley Conference's Players to Watch this preseason.
- Stacker rated fourth on the team in scoring with 8.9 points and third in rebounding with 3.1 boards a game last season. He came off the bench in 26 of his 27 games.
- Ward was fifth behind Stacker with 8.4 points per game in 32 starts. He drained 51 three-pointers which were good for second-most on the team. Ward also added 74 assists and 30 steals.

### 3-Pointer Streak

- The Redhawks have made at least one 3-pointer in 533 consecutive games.
- The last time Southeast Missouri did not make a 3-pointer was vs. Western Illinois (0-of-6) on Dec. 10, 2008.
- SEMO made five or more 3-pointers in nine games this season.

### Last 35 Games

- Southeast Missouri went 23-12 in its last 35 games dating back to 2024-25.
- The Redhawks won nine of their last 13 games of the 2024-25 season by double figures.

### Sixth Year for Korn

- Brad Korn is in his sixth year as Southeast Missouri's head coach.
- Korn led SEMO to two conference titles (2022-23 OVC Tournament; 2024-25 OVC Regular-Season) in three years.
- The reigning OVC Coach of the Year, Korn is 79-91 overall and 46-47 in conference play.
- He ranks third all-time in wins among head coaches in SEMO's NCAA Division I era behind Gary Garner (126 wins, 1997-2006) and Dickey Nutt (80 wins, 2009-15).
- On July 1, 2025, Korn agreed to a contract extension through the 2029-30 season. His new contract will run through Apr. 30, 2030. It extends his current deal that was signed through the 2026-27 season.

### OVC Schedule

- The Ohio Valley Conference schedule includes 20 games for the Redhawks.
- For the third-straight year, the league membership includes 11 teams (Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Little Rock, Morehead State, Southeast Missouri, SIU Edwardsville, Southern Indiana, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, UT Martin, Western Illinois).
- This year the Conference schedules again feature a true round-robin slate.
- Each team will play two games before Christmas; the schedule picks back up on Dec. 30 and continues until Saturday, Feb. 28.
- SEMO opens OVC play at Tennessee Tech on Dec. 18.
- This year marks the final year Tennessee Tech and Little Rock will be members of the OVC. TTU is joining the Southern Conference and Little Rock is moving to the United Athletic Conference (UAC) in 2026-27.

### 2026 OVC Tournament

- The 2026 Ohio Valley Conference Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held Mar. 4-7 at the Ford Center in Evansville, Indiana.
- It marks the ninth-straight year the event will be held at the venue.
- The Ford Center, which opened in November 2011, is an 11,000-seat arena located in the core of Evansville's downtown district.
- The OVC Board of Presidents accepted an agreement to continue to hold the OVC Men's and Women's Basketball Championships at the Ford Center through 2032.

### Championship Culture

- Southeast Missouri's Department of Athletics has won an unprecedented 37 conference championships since the start of the 2019-20 season.
- Every sport won at least one OVC title in that stretch.
- In 2024-25 alone, SEMO won seven OVC championships. That total was more than the number of conference titles won by any two schools in the league combined.
- Additionally, SEMO claimed the OVC Commissioner's Cup for the third time in five years.

### 2024-25 Review

- Southeast Missouri entered the 2024-25 season ranked seventh in the Ohio Valley Conference Preseason Poll and won its first outright OVC regular-season title in program history.
- SEMO clinched its regular-season championship with a statement 83-68 road win at SIU Edwardsville, which upended the Redhawks in the OVC Tournament final.
- It was the Redhawks second OVC regular-season title in program history and first in 25 years.
- SEMO initially moved to first in the standings with their 57-45 win at Little Rock (Feb. 11) and stayed there the rest of the regular-season.
- The Redhawks advanced to the OVC Tournament championship game for the fourth time in program history and second three years with Brad Korn as head coach.
- SEMO earned the #1 seed in the eight-team tournament and claimed a double bye for the first time in program history.
- The Redhawks' 78-59 win over #4 Little Rock was their largest in an OVC Tournament semifinal game in program history.
- For only the third time since it moved to the NCAA Division I ranks in 1991-92, SEMO reached 20 or more wins in a season. The Redhawks' 21 wins ranked second behind the 1999-2000 team (24-7). The other 20-win season was in 1998-99 (20-9).
- SEMO tied a single-season program record with 15 OVC victories. The Redhawks began their 20-game league schedule with a 3-0 record and later went 9-1 in their final 10 conference games.
- All of SEMO's success came just one year after the Redhawks finished 10th in the OVC and missed making the league's postseason tournament in 2023-24. SEMO went from 9-22, 4-14 in the OVC to 21-12, 15-5 in the OVC for its best one-year turnaround in program history.
- The Redhawks won 10-straight games from Jan. 25-Feb. 27 for their longest winning streak during the NCAA Division I era. SEMO never won more than seven consecutive games since it moved to Division I in 1991-92. It was the program's longest winning streak in 35 years since the 1989-90 team won 11 in a row.
- SEMO went undefeated in February (8-0) becoming the first team in 39 years to go unbeaten in February. Ron Shumate's 1985-86 team (8-0) was the last to do it.
- The Redhawks swept home-and-home series against five OVC opponents in

2024-25. Those were the most in a season under Head Coach Brad Korn and the most in the last two years combined (4). SEMO beat SIU Edwardsville, Southern Indiana, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and Western Illinois twice during the regular-season.

- Brad Korn led SEMO to a winning record at home for the fifth-straight year. The Redhawks' 12-3 record was Korn's best at the Show Me Center since he took over as head coach. In conference games, SEMO led the OVC in home attendance.
- SEMO ranked fourth in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage defense. Opponents shot just 28.3 percent from beyond the arc. The Redhawks held their opponents to five or less 3-pointer made in 22 of 33 games.
- The Redhawks led the OVC with a +3.03 turnover margin. SEMO forced 13.7 turnovers per game and committed a league low 10.6 per contest. The Redhawks turned the ball over less than 10 times on 15 occasions in 2024-25.
- SEMO finished the year with a single-season program record 269 steals.

### Redhawks Sign Two for 2026-27

- Southeast Missouri signed shooting guard Curtis "Champ" Simpson and forward Axton Perry. Simpson and Perry will join the Redhawks in 2026-27.
- A native of Cusseta, Georgia, Simpson (6'2", 165) is a 2025-26 First-Team Preseason Class 1A D-II All-State selection entering his senior season at Chattahoochee County High School.
- He averaged 25.1 points, 7.3 rebounds and 3.2 assists per game there as a junior.
- In the state playoffs, Simpson scored 23.4 points, pulled down 8.2 rebounds and dished out 4.2 assists per contest.
- Perry, (6'7", 195) who hails from Memphis, Tennessee, has a 6'11" wingspan. He is a senior at Bartlett High School, which is ranked #18 in the Preseason MaxPreps Top-25.
- He helped lead Bartlett to the Tennessee Class AAAA state semifinals as a sophomore.
- In 2024-25, the Panthers went 24-9 overall and won the 4A District 15 title with an undefeated 12-0 record.

- The 2024-25 team broke a single-season program record in steals (269).
- Officially hired as the seventh head coach in Southeast Missouri's NCAA Division I era on March 23, 2020.
- Began his first head coaching job in the middle of a COVID-19 pandemic during the 2020-21 season.
- Brought the national spotlight back on SEMO basketball when his 2022-23 team won the OVC Tournament title and advanced to the NCAA Tournament. It was the program's first OVC Tournament crown and NCAA Tournament appearance in over two decades.
- SEMO became the first #5 seed to ever win the OVC Tournament after winning four games in four days during the 2022-23 campaign. Along the way, the Redhawks knocked off the tourney's top two seeds in #1 Morehead State and #2 Tennessee Tech to claim the title.
- The Redhawks faced Texas A&M-Corpus Christi in the NCAA First Four on Mar. 14, 2023. SEMO's 2022-23 season ended with a close 75-71 loss in that game.
- SEMO snapped a streak of eight-straight losing seasons with its 19-17 record during 2022-23.
- It was the first time the Redhawks had both winning overall and OVC records in a season since 2004-05.
- The historic 2022-23 season received unprecedented media attention. Brad Korn and Chris Harris were featured in a live interview with Inside College Basketball studio hosts Clark Kellogg, Seth Davis, Greg Gumbel and Jay Wright on Selection Sunday prior to the Atlantic 10 Championship game.
- Became only the second head coach in SEMO basketball history to lead his team to back-to-back trips to the OVC Tournament semifinals (2021-22, 2022-23).
- The OVC Tournament semifinal appearance in 2021-22 was SEMO's first in 17 years.
- Academically, Korn's 2023-24 team completed the academic year with a 3.09 grade point average. His 2024-25 team finished the academic year with an even higher 3.18 GPA.

**CHATTANOOGA, Tenn.** - Southeast Missouri scored four points in the final 59 seconds to eke out a 74-70 win over Chattanooga in a thriller at McKenzie Arena.

In an up-tempo slugfest that featured 13 ties and 19 lead changes, SEMO delivered the knockout blow to come away with its first true road victory of the season.

Troy Cole, Jr., provided the spark the Redhawks needed to get to the finish line when he stole the ball and threw down a dunk giving SEMO a 70-68 edge with 1:39 to go.

After Makai Richards made two free throws to tie the game one last time, Cole, Jr. hammered down another big dunk. BJ Ward found Cole, Jr. who then drove the baseline and scored to regain a 72-70 advantage for the Redhawks.

Former Redhawk Teddy Washington, Jr. missed a jumper in the paint on UTC's ensuing possession. Luke Almodovar grabbed the rebound and Braxton Stacker was fouled. Stacker made two free throws with 13 seconds on the clock to ice it.

Almodovar gave SEMO its first lead in the second half when he stole the ball and went to the rim for a dunk to make it a 57-55 ballgame with 12:26 left to play.

Neither team led by more than three points for nearly nine minutes before the Redhawks took their two-possession lead in the final seconds.

SEMO and UTC shot 57 percent or better and led by no more than five points in a tightly contested first half.

Landren Blocker sent a jolt into the Redhawks out of the gate scoring a pair of layups and getting a steal in the first 2:09. Blocker's step back jumper put SEMO ahead, 6-1, with 17:51 remaining in the first half.

After Almodovar buried a 3-pointer to tie the game at 37-37, UTC answered with five-straight points and built its five-point cushion on Jordan Frison's driving layup with 51 seconds to go.

A pull up 3-pointer by Stacker and layup by Elliot Lowndes at the buzzer helped trim the Mocs' lead to 46-44 at the half.

The Redhawks shot 57.6 percent (19-of-33) from the floor, while UTC made 70.8 percent (17-of-24) of its field goals in the first 20 minutes of play.

Almodovar led three SEMO players in double figures with 16 points off the bench. He scored 12 of those from downtown.

Stacker followed with 12 points and Ward added 10. Stacker made a perfect 4-of-4 free throws and Ward posted four assists, as well.

Cole, Jr. also had nine points and five rebounds for the Redhawks, both season-highs.
