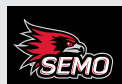

## Redhawks Back on the Road

- Southeast Missouri closes out its six-game road trip at in-state foe Lindenwood this weekend. The Redhawks and Lions will play a 3 p.m. doubleheader Saturday followed by a 12 p.m., CT single game Sunday.
- SEMO is 4-1 on the road in Ohio Valley Conference play this season.
- The Redhawks posted series wins against six of their last nine OVC foes dating back to last season.
- SEMO won five of its last six road games.

## Series Notes

- Southeast Missouri is 6-0 all-time against Lindenwood, which first joined the Ohio Valley Conference on July 21, 2022.
- SEMO swept three-game series against LU in 2023 and 2024.
- The Redhawks outscored the Lions, 26-7, in three games during their last trip to St. Charles in 2023.
- On Feb. 11, 2025, LU notified the NCAA of its intention to participate in the expedited process to exit the reclassification process one year early.
- Final approval from the NCAA will allow the Lions to be eligible for NCAA Championship postseason competition beginning in the 2025-26 academic year.

## Two Months In

- The Redhawks ended the month of March with a 9-7 record.
- Southeast Missouri won six of its final nine games in March.
- SEMO begins April with its trip to Lindenwood this weekend.

## Seventh Inning Production

- Southeast Missouri is outscoring opponents, 24-5, in the seventh inning this season.
- SEMO recently rallied for three runs with two outs in the top of the seventh inning to get by Eastern Illinois, 3-0, on Mar. 28.

## OVC Series Wins

- Southeast Missouri started Ohio Valley Conference play with series wins in two of its first four conference weekends.
- SEMO took two of three at home vs. UT Martin (Mar. 8-9), swept Western Illinois (Mar. 14-15) on the road, dropped two of three at home vs. SIU Edwardsville (Mar. 21-22) and split a doubleheader at Eastern Illinois (Mar. 28).
- The Redhawks improved to 22-11 all-time in OVC openers this year.
- SEMO also started league action with a win for the 11th time in its last 15 seasons.
- The Redhawks won seven of their last eight home-openers and claimed an OVC opening series win for the seventh time under Head Coach Mark Redburn.
- 2025 marked SEMO's fifth-straight year where it started OVC play at home.

## Milestones Ahead for Redburn

- Mark Redburn is approaching two more milestones in his coaching career.
- Redburn needs six more victories to reach 500 career wins as a head coach. He has been a head coach for 21 years between stops at St. Charles Community College, Jefferson College, Evansville and Southeast Missouri.
- Overall, Redburn is 494-472 as a head coach.
- Redburn is also just three wins away from getting 150 Ohio Valley Conference victories.
- He is 147-85 all-time in OVC games.

## OVC Success

- Since 2019, Southeast Missouri has won three Ohio Valley Conference championships, two OVC Tournament titles and made the NCAA Tournament twice.
- SEMO finished among the top two teams in the OVC during four of the last five years.
- The Redhawks won the OVC regular-season title in 2019, 2021 and 2023 (all odd years) during that span.
- In its last five seasons, SEMO finished with 16 or more OVC victories.
- The Redhawks were 19-8 in 2024, 20-2 in 2023, 16-10 in 2022, 23-6 in 2021 and 17-5 in 2019.
- SEMO averaged less than seven (6.5) league losses over the last six seasons. Since 2018, the Redhawks have gone 117-42 against OVC foes.
- The reigning OVC Tournament Champion Redhawks will vye for their eighth OVC Tournament crown in 2025.
- Mark Redburn is 147-85 all-time in OVC games. Redburn's 147 conference wins are the most among the league's 10 active head coaches.
- SEMO had winning OVC records in each of the last six seasons.

## Redhawks Deal SIU Edwardsville First OVC Loss

- The Redhawks ended Ohio Valley Conference leader SIU Edwardsville's eight-game conference winning streak when they won, 2-1, on Mar. 22.
- SIUE leads the OVC in overall (17) and league victories (8) thus far.

## About Lindenwood

- Lindenwood is sixth in the Ohio Valley Conference standings with an even 6-6 record.
- The Lions became the first team in the OVC to win a series against league leader SIU Edwardsville this season.
- LU is last in the conference in hitting with a .233 batting average.

- Pitching wise, the Lions lead the OVC in strikeouts (183), strikeouts looking (56) and opposing batting average (.253).
- Avery Wapp, who was named OVC Co-Pitcher of the Week Monday, leads the league in earned run average (2.22), opposing batting average (.206) and strikeouts looking (32).
- Offensively, Jolie McMinn is the Lions' top threat hitting .354 with six runs scored, five doubles, four home runs and 19 RBI.

## View from the Top

- Sydney Dennis leads the Ohio Valley Conference with a .443 batting average.
- Dennis is one of three players in the league hitting over .400 this season. Eastern Illinois' Kendall Grover (.433) and Western Illinois' Malia Robertson (.400) are the others.
- She leads Southeast Missouri in batting average, hits (39) and doubles (11) through 26 games.
- Dennis struck out only five times in 88 at-bats this year.

## Tough to Strike Out

- Southeast Missouri's hitters have struck out an Ohio Valley Conference low 84 times this season.
- Redhawk hitters are striking out less than four times (3.23) per game.
- Every other school in the OVC has struck out over 100 times in 2025.

## Dennis Closes in on 150 Career Starts

- Game one of this weekend's series at Lindenwood will mark the 150th career start for Sydney Dennis.
- Dennis has has started 149 of 170 games in her career.
- She has played and started the most career games of any Redhawk on this year's team.

## Complete Game Kell

- Delaney Kell picked up her second-straight complete game victory at Eastern Illinois (Mar. 28).
- Kell allowed just four hits and struck out five in her team-high second shutout of the season.
- She improved to 5-2 and leads the Redhawks in wins, complete games (3) and shutouts (2).

## Saysoff Lifts Redhawks

- Brooklyn Saysoff hit a two-out, two-RBI double in the top of the seventh inning to send Southeast Missouri to its 3-0 victory over Eastern Illinois (Mar. 28).
- The game was scoreless until Saysoff's big hit that sparked a three-run seventh inning.
- She hit .571 (4-for-7) with one run scored, a double, three RBI, a .571 on-base percentage and .714 slugging percentage in two games against the Panthers.
- Saysoff enters the weekend on a three-game hitting streak.

## Hitting Streak Ends at 18 Games

- Sydney Dennis' career-best hitting streak ended at 18 games. Dennis' streak went from Feb. 22 to Mar. 21.
- She finished with two or more hits 11 times during that stretch.
- Dennis' hitting streak was the longest by any Southeast Missouri player in the last seven years.
- Rachel Anderson's 16-game hitting streak from Apr. 13-May 10, 2018 was the longest during that span prior to the 2025 campaign.

## Dennis Among National Leaders

- Sydney Dennis ranks eighth in the nation in doubles per game (0.42) and 49th in batting average (.443).
- Dennis leads the Ohio Valley Conference in those categories, as well.

## Kell Registers 20th Career Win

- Delaney Kell earned her 20th career victory in her second complete game of the season.
- Kell struck out three and allowed just one run on four hits in seven innings to beat SIU Edwardsville (Mar. 22).
- She improved to 5-2 in 12 appearances and four starts this season.
- Kell's career record stands at 21-9.

## Leading the OVC

- Southeast Missouri leads the Ohio Valley Conference in batting average (.323), on-base percentage (.498), earned run average (3.06), runners picked off (3), fewest hits allowed (171), fewest runs allowed (105), fewest earned runs allowed (76), fewest walks allowed (79) and fielding percentage (.965).
- Individually, Sydney Dennis tops the OVC in batting average (.443). Brooklyn Saysoff is first in RBI (30), Tegan Livesay is first in fewest walks allowed (10) and Maddie Carney (34) and Willow Van Haren (34) are first in fewest hits allowed. Carney also leads the league in fewest runs allowed (17).

## New Record

- The Redhawks outscored Western Illinois, 40-12, in their series sweep in Macomb on Mar. 14-15.
- Southeast Missouri's 40 runs established a new program record for most runs in a series.
- SEMO's previous record was 37 runs in a three-game sweep of Morehead State on Apr. 14-15, 2024.
- The Redhawks beat the Leathernecks by scores of 16-5, 15-4 (5 innings) and 9-3.

## Bombs Away

- Southeast Missouri hit eight home runs in its series sweep of Western Illinois (Mar. 14-15).
- Five different players homered in the series.
- Sydney Melton, Gracie Luna and Hailey Burnett had two apiece, while Brooklyn Saysoff and Kinley Wilkins each had one.
- It was the Redhawks most home runs in a series since they hit nine in a three-game sweep of Tennessee State on Mar. 19-20, 2022.
- SEMO homered in seven of its last 12 games and has a total of 12 this season.
- Melton and Luna lead the team with four round-trippers apiece.

## Home Games

- Southeast Missouri is currently 3-3 at the Southeast Softball Complex this season.
- The Redhawks are 55-12 at the Southeast Softball Complex since the start of the 2021 season.
- SEMO twice went undefeated at home during that stretch in 2022 (14-0) and 2023 (13-0).

## First to 200 Hits

- Southeast Missouri became the first Ohio Valley Conference team to 200 hits this season when it pounded out 42 in its series sweep of Western Illinois (Mar. 14-15).
- SEMO outhit WIU by a +23 margin (42-19) with double-digit hits in all three contests.
- The Redhawks are averaging 9.2 hits per game and had 11 or more hits a total of nine times in 2025.

## Melton Has Big Weekend

- Sydney Melton hit .500 with seven runs scored, a double, three home runs and five RBI to lead Southeast Missouri to four wins during its spring break last week.
- Melton went 7-for-14 at the plate with multiple hits in three contests.
- She homered in back-to-back games during SEMO's doubleheader sweep of Western Illinois (Mar. 14) and scored the Redhawks only run on a solo home run at Central Arkansas (Mar. 11).
- Melton also boasted a 1.214 slugging percentage and .533 on-base percentage for the week.

## RBI Time

- Gracie Luna hit .428 (6-for-14) with five runs scored, three home runs and 10 RBI in her last four games.
- Luna knocked in two or more runs in four of her last six starts.
- Meanwhile, Brooklyn Saysoff added five hits, five runs scored, nine RBI and one home run during that span.
- Saysoff and Luna are first and second on the team with 30 and 26 RBI this season, respectively.
- Saysoff leads the Ohio Valley Conference in RBI, as well.

## Wilkins Has Career Day

- Kinley Wilkins had a career day when she went 2-for-3 with four runs scored, three RBI, one home run and two walks in Southeast Missouri's series opening win at Western Illinois (Mar. 14).
- Wilkins established career-highs in hits, runs, RBI and home runs during that contest.
- She has started in left field nine-straight contests.

## Kell Gets 100 Career Strikeouts

- Delaney Kell registered her 100th career strikeout in the top of the sixth inning vs. UT Martin (Mar. 9).
- Kell recorded three-straight strikeouts in that inning to reach her milestone.
- She went 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA in two appearances and one start against the Skyhawks.
- Kell threw 7.2 scoreless innings with nine strikeouts to just one walk, as well.
- Kell has 109 strikeouts in her career.

## Redhawks Third in the OVC in Scoring

- Southeast Missouri ranks third in the Ohio Valley Conference in scoring with 5.7 runs per game.
- The Redhawks are outscoring opponents, 147-105 (+42), through 26 games this season.
- SEMO scored double-digit runs on five occasions with a season-high 16 at Western Illinois (Mar. 14).

## Nine of 13

- The Redhawks won nine of their last 13 games.
- Southeast Missouri's longest winning streak of the season was four games on two occasions from Feb. 14-22 and Mar. 12-15.

## OVC Update

- Southeast Missouri enters the weekend at third in the Ohio Valley Conference standings.
- SEMO (7-4) is behind both Tennessee State (8-3) and Eastern Illinois (8-3) which share the second-place spot.
- SIU Edwardsville (9-3) is atop the standings.
- TSU is currently the hottest team in the league with a six-game winning streak.

## First Home Run Goes to Melton

- Sydney Melton hit Southeast Missouri's first home run of the 2025 season.
- Melton hit a solo home run to left field in the bottom of the third inning vs. UT Martin (Mar. 8).
- She then turned around to hit another solo home run, this time in the top of the fourth inning for the Redhawks only run at Central Arkansas (Mar. 11).

## Redhawks Smash Arkansas-Pine Bluff

- Southeast Missouri registered its largest margin of victory this season with a 13-0 five-inning win at Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Mar. 12).
- It marked the second time SEMO won a game by double-digit runs in 2025.
- The Redhawks went 3-0 against teams from the Southwestern Athletic Conference.
- SEMO also beat Alabama State twice earlier this year.
- The Redhawks outscored those opponents by a combined 32-6 over those three contests.

## Winkler Delivers

- Madison Winkler hit a series-best .750 in the Redhawks three-game sweep of Western Illinois (Mar. 14-15).
- Winkler went 6-of-8 at the plate with four runs scored, two doubles, a triple and five RBI.
- She is fourth on the team with a .347 batting average in her first year at Southeast Missouri.

## Luna Has Big Game

- Gracie Luna went 3-for-4 with two runs scored, a home run and four RBI to lead Southeast Missouri in its win at Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Mar. 12).
- Luna hit a three-run home run as part of an eight-run second inning.
- Her three hits established a new career-high, while her four RBI tied a career-best.

## First Career Hits

- Taryn Coon and Mary Tutwiler each recorded their first career hits at Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Mar. 12).
- Coon went 2-for-2 with one RBI and Tutwiler finished with a single and two runs scored.
- Eight different Redhawks had a hit in that game.

## Redhawks Wrap Up Tournament Play

- Southeast Missouri went 6-7 in tournament play leading up to the start of Ohio Valley Conference action this weekend.
- SEMO went 2-2 at both the Troy University Cardinal Clash (Feb. 13-15) and Chattanooga Frost Classic (Feb. 22-23), and 2-3 at the UL Monroe Best on the Bayou Tournament (Feb. 28-Mar. 2).

## Dennis Named Co-OVC Player of the Week

- Shortstop Sydney Dennis won Southeast Missouri's first Ohio Valley Conference honor this season when she was named Co-OVC Player of the Week on Mar. 3.
- A native of Eureka, Missouri, Dennis hit safely in five games and had multiple hits four times at the Best on the Bayou Tournament (Feb. 28-Mar. 2).
- She hit .550 (11-for-20) with five runs scored, three RBI and two stolen bases to lead SEMO in the tournament.
- Dennis had three hits vs. both Memphis (Feb. 28) and Tarleton State (Mar. 1) and finished with two hits twice against UL Monroe.
- Tennessee State's Onnika Spencer and Lindenwood's Avery Wapp (Pitcher of the Week) rounded out the week's honorees.

## Career Achievement

- Sydney Dennis went over 100 career hits during the Best on the Bayou Tournament in Monroe, Louisiana.
- Dennis officially recorded her 100th hit in the sixth inning against UL Monroe on Feb. 28.
- She has 129 hits in her career.

## Over .300

- Six Southeast Missouri starters are currently hitting .315 or better in a minimum of 24 starts.
- Sydney Dennis leads the way with a .443 batting average. Sydney Melton (.368), Brooklyn Saysoff (.349), Madison Winkler (.347), Tatum Gerwitz (.338) and Gracie Luna (.315) round out the group.

- Gerwitz is the only Redhawk who started all 26 games.

## Extra Inning Victory

- The Redhawks finished the Best on the Bayou Tournament with a thrilling 7-5 win over Tarleton State in 10 innings on Mar. 2.
- Southeast Missouri scored two unearned runs when Sydney Melton scored on a one-out error and freshman Addisyn Martinie hit a two-out single through the right side.

## Redhawks Finish Season-Opening Cardinal Clash Strong

- The Redhawks recorded back-to-back wins over Southwestern Athletic Conference member Alabama State for a strong finish at their season-opening Troy University Cardinal Clash Tournament.
- Southeast Missouri had early season-highs of 14 runs and 15 hits to pick up its first win of the year with a 14-3 victory over the Hornets on Feb. 14.
- A day later, SEMO closed out the tournament with a 5-3 win over Alabama State.
- The victories gave the Redhawks their first winning streak of the 2025 campaign.

## Preseason OVC Favorite

- For the fifth time in six years, Southeast Missouri was tabbed the Ohio Valley Conference preseason favorite.
- SEMO, which went 28-26 overall and 19-8 in the OVC a year ago, won the 2024 OVC Tournament and made its third NCAA Division I Softball Tournament appearance.
- The Redhawks accumulated 152 points and nine of the possible 20 first-place votes by the league's head coaches and communications directors.
- Southern Indiana was second with 140 points and six first-place nods, while Eastern Illinois rounded out the top three with the remaining five first-place votes and 139 total points.
- Tennessee State (107 pts.), Tennessee Tech (82 pts.), Lindenwood (80 pts.), UT Martin (74 pts.), SIU Edwardsville (73 pts.), Morehead State (30 pts.) and Western Illinois (23 pts.) complete the predicted order of finish.
- Prior to 2025, SEMO was also the OVC preseason favorite in 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2024.

## First Career Shutout for Van Haren

- Willow Van Haren threw the first shutout of her career at Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Mar. 12).
- Van Haren struck out three, walked one and gave up six hits in five scoreless innings.
- She is 2-2 and leads the Redhawks with 32 strikeouts this season.

## Kell Records First Win of 2025

- Delaney Kell earned her first win of the 2025 season against IU Indy (Feb. 22).
- Kell threw three relief innings allowing two runs on two hits. She also struck out one.
- She became the fourth different SEMO pitcher to get a win this season.
- Kell has 21 victories in her career.

- First baseman Aubrie Shore will miss the entire 2025 season due to a back injury.
- Shore, who started 147 of 150 games in her career and earned All-Ohio Valley Conference honors in multiple seasons, is expected to be back with the Redhawks in 2026.

## One-Run Games

- Southeast Missouri has been involved in eight one-run games this year.
- SEMO won its first one-run game of the season when it edged Indiana State, 3-2, on Feb. 22.
- Overall, the Redhawks are 3-5 in one-run contests.

## Off and Running

- Southeast Missouri is 33-of-37 in stolen bases this season.
- Tatum Gerwitz (10-of-11), Madison Winkler (8-of-9), Brooklyn Saysoff (5-of-5) and Sydney Dennis (5-of-5) combined for 28 of those stolen bases.
- SEMO ranks fourth in the Ohio Valley Conference in that category.

## New Career-High for Saysoff

- Infielder Brooklyn Saysoff established a new career-high with four hits vs. Alabama State (Feb. 14).
- Saysoff went 4-for-5 with a stolen base, two runs scored and two RBI.
- She finished the Troy University Cardinal Clash with a combined six hits in her last two games.

- After Alabama State cut Southeast Missouri's lead to 5-3 on Feb. 15, Redhawk relievers took over and did not allow a run the rest of the way.
- SEMO's bullpen threw four shutout innings to hold off the Hornets.
- Tegan Livesay tossed three scoreless no-hit innings with four strikeouts and Delaney Kell followed that up with one scoreless inning and two strikeouts.
- Kell claimed her first save of the season following that performance.

## SEMO Debuts

- Madison Winkler, Elliott Stinson and Addisyn Martinie made their Southeast Missouri debuts at the Troy University Cardinal Clash (Feb. 13-15).
- Winkler, a transfer from Louisville, started all four games in right field and hit .308 with three runs scored, two walks and three stolen bases. She made all of her starts in right field for the tournament.
- A transfer from Southern Illinois, Stinson picked up a win in her first career SEMO start inside the circle.
- Stinson tossed 4.2 innings allowing two runs on three hits and striking out three.
- Meanwhile, freshman Addisyn Martinie got her first career hit against Alabama State (Feb. 14).
- Freshman Selby Patberg played in her first college game vs. Indiana State (Feb. 22).

## Double-Digit Hits

- Southeast Missouri pounded out a season-high 16 hits at Western Illinois (Mar. 14).
- The Redhawks finished with 10 or more hits 10 times this season and are 9-1 in those games.

## Roster Talk

- The Redhawks 2025 roster consists of 22 players, including six seniors, three juniors, 11 sophomores and two freshmen.
- Sydney Dennis, Tatum Gerwitz, Delaney Kell, Sydney Melton, Tori Bradley and Aubrie Shore are the seniors.
- Division I transfers Elliott Stinson (P, Southern Illinois) and Madison Winkler (OF, Louisville) make their debuts as Redhawks this year.

- SEMO has players represented from five different states, including Illinois, Kansas, Kentucky, Missouri and Oklahoma.

## Returning All-OVC Performers

- Southeast Missouri has two returning All-Ohio Valley Conference performers from last season.
- First baseman Aubrie Shore garnered Second-Team All-OVC honors and pitcher Maddie Carney landed a spot on the OVC All-Newcomer Team.
- Shore was the only player who started all 54 games in 2024. She hit .338 as SEMO's fourth-leading hitter. Shore led the team in doubles (16), hits (54) and RBI (32).
- Carney went 6-6 with a 3.35 ERA and two saves in 31 appearances and five starts as a freshman. She pitched two complete games, one shutout and struck out 35 in 83.2 innings. Carney ranked second on the team in appearances, wins, complete games, shutouts, innings and strikeouts.

## Seven-Straight Winning Seasons

- The Redhawks put together a winning season in seven-straight years.
- Southeast Missouri posted 30 or more victories in four of those seasons (2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022).
- The Redhawks went 29-14 overall in 2023 and 28-26 in 2024.
- SEMO's 2020 season was shortened to 17 games (12-5) due to a global COVID-19 pandemic.

## Team 49

- The 2025 club is the 49th team in Southeast Missouri's softball history.
- SEMO has an all-time record of 1,249-1,013-3 since softball first began in 1977.
- The Redhawks have accumulated 19 30+ win seasons, two 40-win seasons, eight Ohio Valley Conference regular-season titles, seven OVC Tournament championships and three NCAA Division I Tournament appearances in program history.

## Redburn in 11th Season

- Mark Redburn is in his 11th season as Southeast Missouri's head coach.
- Redburn is 280-223 overall and 147-85 in Ohio Valley Conference games at the helm.
- He has led SEMO to three OVC regular-season titles (2019, 2021, 2023), two OVC Tournament titles (2019, 2024) and a pair of NCAA Tournament berths (2019, 2024).

- Redburn ranks second all-time in program history in wins behind Lana Richmond, who went 884-710-2 in 32 years as head coach from 1983-2014.
- Redburn holds a record of 370-398 as an NCAA Division I head coach between his stops at Evansville and SEMO.
- He has a career record of 494-472 in 21 years as a head coach.

## Wallen Joins Coaching Staff

- Bryan Wallen is in his first year as an assistant coach at Southeast Missouri.
- Wallen, a graduate of SEMO, spent the last season as an assistant coach at Union University, where he worked primarily with the hitters and infielders.
- Prior to that, Wallen worked as SEMO's Director of Player Development during the Redhawks 2023 Ohio Valley Conference championship season.

## 2025 Schedule

- Southeast Missouri will play a 44-game schedule with 13 home contests in 2025.
- SEMO will be outside of Cape Girardeau for its first 14 games across tournaments in Troy, Alabama, Chattanooga, Tennessee and Monroe, Louisiana.
- The Redhawks also have Central Arkansas (Mar. 11), Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Mar. 12) and Murray State (Apr. 30) on their non-conference slate.
- SEMO's 27-game Ohio Valley Conference schedule features home series against UT Martin (Mar. 8-9), SIU Edwardsville (Mar. 22-23), Morehead State (Apr. 12-13) and Southern Indiana (Apr. 26-27), and road series at Western Illinois (Mar. 15-16), Eastern Illinois (Mar. 29-30), Lindenwood (Apr. 5-6) and Tennessee State (May 3-4).

## OVC Softball Championship Back in Peoria

- The 2025 Ohio Valley Conference Softball Championship will be held May 7-10 at the Louisville Slugger Sports Complex in Peoria, Illinois for the second year in a row.
- The top eight teams will head to the league's postseason event.
- Last year, #2 seed Southeast Missouri knocked off defending champion Eastern Illinois in the final.
