Redhawks Host Southern Indiana

- Southeast Missouri hosts Southern Indiana in its final home Ohio Valley Conference series this weekend. SEMO and USI will play a single game at 3 p.m. Saturday followed by a doubleheader at 12 p.m., CT Sunday.
- Video for all three games of this weekend's series can be accessed online at ESPN+.
- There will be a Rowdy softball bobblehead giveaway at Sunday's doubleheader.
- SEMO plays its last four home games of the season when it welcomes Southern Indiana (Apr. 26-27) and Murray State (Apr. 30).
- SEMO posted series wins against nine of its last 12 OVC foes dating back to the 2024 season.

Series Notes

- Southeast Missouri holds a 22-3 lead in its all-time series against Southern Indiana.
- SEMO is 12-1 against USI in Cape Girardeau.
- The Screaming Eagles won the series in Evansville last season, snapping a nine-game losing streak against the Redhawks.
- SEMO swept USI the last time it played at the Southeast Softball Complex in 2023.
- USI is in its third year as a member of the Ohio Valley Conference.
- Mark Redburn is 4-2 against the Screaming Eagles as SEMO's head coach.

OVC Series Wins

- Southeast Missouri posted series wins in five of its seven Ohio Valley Conference weekends.
- SEMO swept Western Illinois (Mar. 14-15) on the road and Morehead State (Apr. 12-13) at home.
- The Redhawks also took two of three at home vs. UT Martin (Mar. 8-9), at Lindenwood (Apr. 6-7) and at Tennessee Tech (Apr. 18-19) for their other series wins this year.

- In all, SEMO has 52 series wins and 41 series sweeps against OVC foes with Mark Redburn as its head coach.

Redburn Celebrates Milestone Wins

- Mark Redburn recently celebrated two milestones in his head coaching career.
- Redburn earned his 150th career Ohio Valley Conference win when Southeast Missouri beat Morehead State, 11-7, on Apr. 12.
- Six days later, Redburn picked up his 500th career victory as a head coach when the Redhawks defeated Tennessee Tech, 6-3, on Apr. 18.
- Overall, Redburn is 501-474 in 21 years as a head coach between stops at St. Charles Community College, Jefferson College, Evansville and Southeast Missouri.
- In OVC games, Redburn is 154-87 all-time.

Hitting Streak Stops at 11 Games for Saysoff

- Brooklyn Saysoff's career-long 11-game hitting streak came to an end in Southeast Missouri's series finale at Tennessee Tech (Apr. 19).
- Saysoff had multiple hits four times and multiple RBI on seven occasions during that stretch which began on Mar. 22.
- Her 11-game hitting streak stands as the second-longest on the team this season.

Seven-Game Winning Streak Ends

- Southeast Missouri's season-long seven-game winning streak ended with a one-run loss to Tennessee Tech (Apr. 19).
- SEMO won each of the last two games of its series at Lindenwood (Apr. 6-7), swept Morehead State (Apr. 12-13) and won its first two games of its series at Tennessee Tech (Apr. 18) during that span.
- It was SEMO's longest winning streak since the Redhawks won 10 in a row during the 2023 campaign.

Over 20 Wins

- With its doubleheader sweep of Tennessee Tech (Apr. 18), Southeast Missouri went over 20 wins this season.
- SEMO improved to 21-14 overall and ranks second in the Ohio Valley Conference behind Eastern Illinois (25-17) and SIU Edwardsville (25-18) in wins.

Strong April

- The Redhawks are 7-2 with three series wins in April.
- As a team, Southeast Missouri has 23 extra base hits this month, including 13 doubles, three triples and seven home runs.
- Pitching wise, SEMO has allowed just three runs per game in April.
- Brooklyn Sayoff is hitting .480 with eight runs scored, 12 hits, five doubles, two home runs and 12 RBI in April alone. Sayoff has reached base in 12-straight games, as well.

Winkler on Seven-Game Hitting Streak

- Right fielder Madison Winkler carries a seven-game hitting streak into this weekend's series against Southern Indiana.
- Winkler's current hitting streak is tied for third-longest on the team in 2025.
- She is hitting .450 during her active hitting streak.

OVC Success

- Since 2019, Southeast Missouri has won three Ohio Valley Conference championships, two OVC Tournament titles and made the NCAA Tournament twice.
- SEMO finished among the top two teams in the OVC during four of the last five years.
- The Redhawks won the OVC regular-season title in 2019, 2021 and 2023 (all odd years) during that span.
- In its last five seasons, SEMO finished with 16 or more OVC victories.
- The Redhawks were 19-8 in 2024, 20-2 in 2023, 16-10 in 2022, 23-6 in 2021 and 17-5 in 2019.

- SEMO averaged less than seven (6.5) league losses over the last six seasons. Since 2018, the Redhawks have gone 124-44 against OVC foes.
- The reigning OVC Tournament Champion Redhawks will vye for their eighth OVC Tournament crown in 2025.
- Mark Redburn is 154-87 all-time in OVC games. Redburn's 154 conference wins are the most among the league's 10 active head coaches.
- SEMO had winning OVC records in seven-straight seasons.

OVC Update

- At 14-6, Southeast Missouri is third in the Ohio Valley Conference standings with six league games remaining.
- SEMO is three games out of first place behind Eastern Illinois (17-3) and SIU Edwardsville (15-5). EIU and SIUE play each other this weekend.
- EIU is presently the hottest team in the conference with a 10-game OVC winning streak. The Panthers have not lost an OVC game since the Redhawks beat them, 3-0, on Mar. 28.
- The Panthers completed series sweeps against each of their last three OVC opponents.
- SEMO hosts fourth-place Southern Indiana (10-9) this weekend before concluding its league slate at sixth-place Tennessee State (10-10).

First Home Run for Bradley

- Tori Bradley hit a pinch-hit home run for the first round-tripper of her career at Tennessee Tech (Apr. 19).
- Bradley scored Southeast Missouri's first run of the game when she homered over the center field wall in the top of the fourth inning.
- She became the seventh Redhawk to hit a home run this season.

Comeback Bid Falls Short at Tennessee Tech

- Southeast Missouri rallied to score the final five runs of the game in a close 6-5 setback in its series finale at Tennessee Tech (Apr. 19).
- SEMO had the bases loaded with one out and scored two runs in the top of the seventh inning to make it a one-run ballgame.
- Reliever Emily York, however, got out of the jam forcing the Redhawks to leave two runners in scoring position.

View from the Top

- Sydney Dennis leads the Ohio Valley Conference with a .433 batting average.
- Dennis is one of only two players in the league hitting over .400 this season. Eastern Illinois' Kendall Grover (.412) is the other.
- She leads Southeast Missouri in batting average, hits (52), triples (3), runs scored (28) and on-base percentage (.466) through 35 games.
- Dennis struck out only five times in 120 at-bats this year.

Complete Game Kell

- Delaney Kell threw a team-high four complete games this season.
- Kell is 7-3 in 16 appearances and eight starts.
- She leads the Redhawks in wins, shutouts (2), saves (1) and innings pitched (59.1).
- Kell has thrown 10 complete games in her career.

Redhawks Sweep OVC Honors

- For the first time this season, Southeast Missouri swept the Ohio Valley Conference Player and Pitcher of the Week awards.
- Infielder Brooklyn Saysoff was named OVC Player of the Week and Tegan Livesay was tabbed Pitcher of the Week on Apr. 7.
- Saysoff hit .800 in two games against Lindenwood. She went 4-for-5 with two runs, a pair of doubles, two RBI and one stolen base. Saysoff scored SEMO's only run in game one and then went 3-for-3 in the nightcap. Her two-RBI single opened a five-run fifth inning in the Redhawks 5-0 game two victory.
- Livesay pitched the first shutout of her career with masterful performance in game two of SEMO's doubleheader at Lindenwood (Apr. 6).
- She allowed just four hits and recorded a career-high seven strikeouts in seven innings. Livesay walked one and retired the Lions in order during the first, second and sixth frames. She became the third Redhawk

pitcher to throw a shutout in 2025.

- It marked the third time SEMO swept the OVC weekly honors under Head Coach Mark Redburn.

Comeback Sweep

- The Redhawks came from behind to win all three games of their series vs. Morehead State (Apr. 12-13).
- Southeast Missouri trailed, 7-1, before scoring the final 10 runs of the game to beat the Eagles, 11-7, in game one.
- In game two, SEMO fell behind, 3-1, and broke a 4-4 tie in the bottom of the seventh inning to edge MSU.
- The Redhawks were down, 1-0, early in the contest before scoring eight unanswered runs to finish off the Eagles in Sunday's series finale.

Affolter Homers

- Left fielder Brittany Affolter hit her first career home run vs. Morehead State (Apr. 13).
- Affolter led off the bottom of the fourth inning with her first round-tripper.
- She became the sixth different Redhawk to hit a home run this season.

Gerwitz Clears 100 Career Starts

- Tatum Gerwitz, who has started all 35 games in center field this season, made her 100th career start in game two of Southeast Missouri's doubleheader vs. Morehead State (Apr. 12).

- Gerwitz (104) and Sydney Dennis (158) are the only two players on this year's team with over 100 career starts.

About Southern Indiana

- Southern Indiana is coming off a series sweep over UT Martin.
- USI is fourth in the standings, 3.5 games behind Southeast Missouri.
- The Screaming Eagles are last in the Ohio Valley Conference in hitting with a .242 batting average.
- Caroline Stapleton leads USI with a .355 batting average, while Lily Brown (.308) and Jordan Mackey (.303) are also hitting over .300 this season.
- Josie Newman, who was named OVC Pitcher of the Week on Apr. 21, is 8-13 with 171 strikeouts in 21 appearances and 20 starts. Newman has thrown 16 complete games in 2025.

Redhawks Notch Fifth Shutout

- Southeast Missouri posted its fifth shutout of the season when it beat Lindenwood, 5-0, on Apr. 6.
- SEMO is tied for first in the Ohio Valley Conference in shutouts along with Eastern Illinois and UT Martin.

Tough to Strike Out

- Southeast Missouri's hitters have struck out an Ohio Valley Conference low 111 times this season.
- Redhawk hitters are striking out less than four times (3.2) per game.
- Every other school in the OVC has struck out 112 or more times in 2025.
- SEMO hitters went three games without striking out this season.
- Sydney Dennis is the toughest on the team and second toughest in the OVC to strike out. Dennis has struck out only five times in 120 at-bats this year.

Dennis Logs 150th Career Start

- Game one of Southeast Missouri's doubleheader at Lindenwood (Apr. 6) marked the 150th career start for Sydney Dennis.
- Dennis has started 158 of 179 games in her career.
- She has played and started the most career games of any Redhawk on this year's team.

Saysoff Lifts Redhawks

- Brooklyn Saysoff hit a two-out, two-RBI double in the top of the seventh inning to send Southeast Missouri to its 3-0 victory over Eastern Illinois (Mar. 28).
- The game was scoreless until Saysoff's big hit that sparked a three-run seventh inning.
- She hit .571 (4-for-7) with one run scored, a double, three RBI, a .571 on-base percentage and .714 slugging percentage in two games against the Panthers.

Hitting Streak Ends at 18 Games

- Sydney Dennis' career-best hitting streak ended at 18 games. Dennis' streak went from Feb. 22 to Mar. 21.
- She finished with two or more hits 11 times during that stretch.
- Dennis' hitting streak was the longest by any Southeast Missouri player in the last seven years.
- Rachel Anderson's 16-game hitting streak from Apr. 13-May 10, 2018 was the longest during that span prior to the 2025 campaign.

Saysoff Among National Leaders

- Brooklyn Saysoff ranks 10th in the nation in doubles per game (0.40) and 31st in doubles (14).
- Saysoff is also 32nd in the country in RBI per game (1.2).

Kell Registers 20th Career Win

- Delaney Kell earned her 20th career victory in her second complete game of the season.
- Kell struck out three and allowed just one run on four hits in seven innings to beat SIU Edwardsville (Mar. 22).
- Kell's career record stands at 23-10.

Leading the OVC

- Southeast Missouri leads the Ohio Valley Conference in batting average (.316), doubles per game (1.54), earned run averaged (2.98), on-base percentage (.397), RBI per game (5.2), strikeout-to-walk ratio (1.74), strikeouts per seven innings (4.7) and sacrifice flies (13).
- Individually, Sydney Dennis tops the OVC in batting average (.433) and hits (52). Tegan Livesay is first in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.00), Brooklyn Saysoff is first in RBI per game (1.20) and RBI (42), Maddie Carney is first in ERA (2.35) and Willow Van Haren is first in fewest hits allowed per seven innings (6.0).

New Record

- The Redhawks outscored Western Illinois, 40-12, in their series sweep in Macomb on Mar. 14-15.
- Southeast Missouri's 40 runs established a new program record for most runs in a series.
- SEMO's previous record was 37 runs in a three-game sweep of Morehead State on Apr. 14-15, 2024.
- The Redhawks beat the Leathernecks by scores of 16-5, 15-4 (5 innings) and 9-3.

Bombs Away

- Southeast Missouri hit eight home runs in its series sweep of Western Illinois (Mar. 14-15).
- Five different players homered in the series.
- Sydney Melton, Gracie Luna and Hailey Burnett had two apiece, while Brooklyn Saysoff and Kinley Wilkins each had one.
- It was the Redhawks most home runs in a series since they hit nine in a three-game sweep of Tennessee State on Mar. 19-20, 2022.
- Luna leads the team with six home runs.
- As a team, SEMO has 19 round-trippers through 35 games.

Home Games

- Southeast Missouri is currently 6-3 at the Southeast Softball Complex this season.
- The Redhawks are 58-12 at the Southeast Softball Complex since the start of the 2021 season.
- SEMO twice went undefeated at home during that stretch in 2022 (14-0) and 2023 (13-0).

First to 200 Hits

- Southeast Missouri became the first Ohio Valley Conference team to 200 hits this season when it pounded out 42 in its series sweep of Western Illinois (Mar. 14-15).
- SEMO outhit WIU by a +23 margin (42-19) with double-digit hits in all three contests.
- The Redhawks are averaging 8.8 hits per game and had 10 or more hits a total of 11 times in 2025.

Melton Has Big Weekend

- Sydney Melton hit .500 with seven runs scored, a double, three home runs and five RBI to lead Southeast Missouri to four wins during its spring break last week.
- Melton went 7-for-14 at the plate with multiple hits in three contests.
- She homered in back-to-back games during SEMO's doubleheader sweep of Western

Illinois (Mar. 14) and scored the Redhawks only run on a solo home run at Central Arkansas (Mar. 11).

- Melton also boasted a 1.214 slugging percentage and .533 on-base percentage for the week.

RBI Time

- Brooklyn Saysoff and Gracie Luna have accounted for 42 percent of Southeast Missouri's runs batted in through 35 contests.
- Saysoff leads the team with 42 RBI, while Luna is close behind with 35.
- Saysoff leads the Ohio Valley Conference in RBI.

Wilkins Has Career Day

- Kinley Wilkins had a career day when she went 2-for-3 with four runs scored, three RBI, one home run and two walks in Southeast Missouri's series opening win at Western Illinois (Mar. 14).
- Wilkins established career-highs in hits, runs, RBI and home runs during that contest.

Kell Gets 100 Career Strikeouts

- Delaney Kell registered her 100th career strikeout in the top of the sixth inning vs. UT Martin (Mar. 9).
- Kell recorded three-straight strikeouts in that inning to reach her milestone.
- She went 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA in two appearances and one start against the Skyhawks.
- Kell threw 7.2 scoreless innings with nine strikeouts to just one walk, as well.
- Kell has 119 strikeouts in her career.

Redhawks Second in the OVC in Scoring

- Southeast Missouri ranks second in the Ohio Valley Conference in scoring with 5.5 runs per game.
- The Redhawks are outscoring opponents, 193-132 (+61), through 35 games this season.
- SEMO scored double-digit runs on six occasions with a season-high 16 at Western Illinois (Mar. 14).

First Home Run Goes to Melton

- Sydney Melton hit Southeast Missouri's first home run of the 2025 season.
- Melton hit a solo home run to left field in the bottom of the third inning vs. UT Martin (Mar. 8).
- She then turned around to hit another solo home run, this time in the top of the fourth inning for the Redhawks only run at Central Arkansas (Mar. 11).

Redhawks Smash Arkansas-Pine Bluff

- Southeast Missouri registered its largest margin of victory this season with a 13-0 five-inning win at Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Mar. 12).
- It marked the second time SEMO won a game by double-digit runs in 2025.
- The Redhawks went 3-0 against teams from the Southwestern Athletic Conference.
- SEMO also beat Alabama State twice earlier this year.
- The Redhawks outscored those opponents by a combined 32-6 over those three contests.

Winkler Delivers

- Madison Winkler hit a series-best .750 in the Redhawks three-game sweep of Western Illinois (Mar. 14-15).
- Winkler went 6-of-8 at the plate with four runs scored, two doubles, a triple and five RBI.
- She is fourth on the team with a .353 batting average in her first year at Southeast Missouri.

Luna Has Big Game

- Gracie Luna went 3-for-4 with two runs scored, a home run and four RBI to lead Southeast Missouri in its win at Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Mar. 12).
- Luna hit a three-run home run as part of an eight-run second inning.
- Her three hits established a new career-high, while her four RBI tied a career-best.

First Career Hits

- Taryn Coon and Mary Tutwiler each recorded their first career hits at Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Mar. 12).
- Coon went 2-for-2 with one RBI and Tutwiler finished with a single and two runs scored.
- Eight different Redhawks had a hit in that game.

Redhawks Wrap Up Tournament Play

- Southeast Missouri went 6-7 in tournament play leading up to the start of Ohio Valley Conference action this weekend.
- SEMO went 2-2 at both the Troy University Cardinal Clash (Feb. 13-15) and Chattanooga Frost Classic (Feb. 22-23), and 2-3 at the UL Monroe Best on the Bayou Tournament (Feb. 28-Mar. 2).

Dennis Named Co-OVC Player of the Week

- Shortstop Sydney Dennis won Southeast Missouri's first Ohio Valley Conference honor this season when she was named Co-OVC Player of the Week on Mar. 3.

- Dennis had three hits vs. both Memphis (Feb. 28) and Tarleton State (Mar. 1) and finished with two hits twice against UL Monroe.
- Tennessee State's Onnika Spencer and Lindenwood's Avery Wapp (Pitcher of the Week) rounded out the week's honorees.

Career Achievement

- Sydney Dennis went over 100 career hits during the Best on the Bayou Tournament in Monroe, Louisiana.
- Dennis officially recorded her 100th hit in the sixth inning against UL Monroe on Feb. 28.
- She has 142 hits in her career.

.300 or Better

- Six Southeast Missouri starters are currently hitting .300 or better in a minimum of 33 starts.
- Sydney Dennis leads the way with a .433 batting average. Brooklyn Saysoff (.378), Sydney Melton (.356), Madison Winkler (.353), Tatum Gerwitz (.320) and Gracie Luna (.300) round out the group.
- Gerwitz is the only Redhawk who started all 35 games.

Extra Inning Victory

- The Redhawks finished the Best on the Bayou Tournament with a thrilling 7-5 win over Tarleton State in 10 innings on Mar. 2.
- Southeast Missouri scored two unearned runs when Sydney Melton scored on a one-out error and freshman Addisyn Martinie hit a two-out single through the right side.

Redhawks Finish Season-Opening Cardinal Clash Strong

- The Redhawks recorded back-to-back wins over Southwestern Athletic Conference member Alabama State for a strong finish at their season-opening Troy University Cardinal Clash Tournament.
- Southeast Missouri had early season-highs of 14 runs and 15 hits to pick up its first win of the year with a 14-3 victory over the Hornets on Feb. 14.
- A day later, SEMO closed out the tournament with a 5-3 win over Alabama State.
- The victories gave the Redhawks their first winning streak of the 2025 campaign.

Preseason OVC Favorite

- For the fifth time in six years, Southeast Missouri was tabbed the Ohio Valley Conference preseason favorite.
- SEMO, which went 28-26 overall and 19-8 in the OVC a year ago, won the 2024 OVC Tournament and made its third NCAA Division I Softball Tournament appearance.
- The Redhawks accumulated 152 points and nine of the possible 20 first-place votes by the league's head coaches and communications directors.
- Southern Indiana was second with 140 points and six first-place nods, while Eastern Illinois rounded out the top three with the remaining five first-place votes and 139 total points.
- Tennessee State (107 pts.), Tennessee Tech (82 pts.), Lindenwood (80 pts.), UT Martin (74 pts.), SIU Edwardsville (73 pts.), Morehead State (30 pts.) and Western Illinois (23 pts.) complete the predicted order of finish.
- Prior to 2025, SEMO was also the OVC preseason favorite in 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2024.

First Career Shutout for Van Haren

- Willow Van Haren threw the first shutout of her career at Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Mar. 12).
- Van Haren struck out three, walked one and gave up six hits in five scoreless innings.
- She is 4-2 and is first on the team with 41 strikeouts this season.

Kell Records First Win of 2025

- Delaney Kell earned her first win of the 2025 season against IU Indy (Feb. 22).
- Kell threw three relief innings allowing two runs on two hits. She also struck out one.
- She became the fourth different SEMO pitcher to get a win this season.
- Kell has 23 victories in her career.

Shore Out for Season

- First baseman Aubrie Shore will miss the entire 2025 season due to a back injury.
- Shore, who started 147 of 150 games in her career and earned All-Ohio Valley Conference honors in multiple seasons, is expected to be back with the Redhawks in 2026.

One-Run Games

- Southeast Missouri has been involved in 12 one-run games this year.
- SEMO won its first one-run game of the season when it edged Indiana State, 3-2, on Feb. 22.
- Overall, the Redhawks are 6-6 in one-run contests.

Off and Running

- Southeast Missouri is 48-of-56 in stolen bases this season.
- Tatum Gerwitz (13-of-14), Madison Winkler (12-of-13), Brooklyn Saysoff (6-of-7) and Sydney Dennis (9-of-11) combined for 40 of those stolen bases.

New Career-High for Saysoff

- Infielder Brooklyn Saysoff established a new career-high with four hits vs. Alabama State (Feb. 14).
- Saysoff went 4-for-5 with a stolen base, two runs scored and two RBI.
- She finished the Troy University Cardinal Clash with a combined six hits in her last two games.

Nice Work by the Bullpen

- After Alabama State cut Southeast Missouri's lead to 5-3 on Feb. 15, Redhawk relievers took over and did not allow a run the rest of the way.
- SEMO's bullpen threw four shutout innings to hold off the Hornets.
- Tegan Livesay tossed three scoreless no-hit innings with four strikeouts and Delaney Kell followed that up with one scoreless inning and two strikeouts.
- Kell claimed her first save of the season following that performance.

SEMO Debuts

- Madison Winkler, Elliott Stinson and Addisyn Martinie made their Southeast Missouri debuts at the Troy University Cardinal Clash (Feb. 13-15).
- Winkler, a transfer from Louisville, started all four games in right field and hit .308 with three runs scored, two walks and three stolen bases. She made all of her starts in right field for the tournament.
- A transfer from Southern Illinois, Stinson picked up a win in her first career SEMO start inside the circle.
- Stinson tossed 4.2 innings allowing two runs on three hits and striking out three.
- Meanwhile, freshman Addisyn Martinie got her first career hit against Alabama State (Feb. 14).
- Freshman Selby Patberg played in her first college game vs. Indiana State (Feb. 22).

Double-Digit Hits

- Southeast Missouri pounded out a season-high 16 hits at Western Illinois (Mar. 14).
- The Redhawks are 10-1 in games where they get 10 or more hits.

Roster Talk

- The Redhawks 2025 roster consists of 22 players, including six seniors, three juniors, 11 sophomores and two freshmen.
- Sydney Dennis, Tatum Gerwitz, Delaney Kell, Sydney Melton, Tori Bradley and Aubrie Shore are the seniors.
- Division I transfers Elliott Stinson (P, Southern Illinois) and Madison Winkler (OF, Louisville) make their debuts as Redhawks this year.
- SEMO has players represented from five different states, including Illinois, Kansas, Kentucky, Missouri and Oklahoma.

Returning All-OVC Performers

- Southeast Missouri has two returning All-Ohio Valley Conference performers from last season.
- First baseman Aubrie Shore garnered Second-Team All-OVC honors and pitcher Maddie Carney landed a spot on the OVC All-Newcomer Team.
- Shore was the only player who started all 54 games in 2024. She hit .338 as SEMO's fourth-leading hitter. Shore led the team in doubles (16), hits (54) and RBI (32).
- Carney went 6-6 with a 3.35 ERA and two saves in 31 appearances and five starts as a freshman. She pitched two complete games, one shutout and struck out 35 in 83.2 innings.

Carney ranked second on the team in appearances, wins, complete games, shutouts, innings and strikeouts.

Seven-Straight Winning Seasons

- The Redhawks put together a winning season in seven-straight years.
- Southeast Missouri posted 30 or more victories in four of those seasons (2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022).
- The Redhawks went 29-14 overall in 2023 and 28-26 in 2024.
- SEMO's 2020 season was shortened to 17 games (12-5) due to a global COVID-19 pandemic.

Team 49

- The 2025 club is the 49th team in Southeast Missouri's softball history.
- SEMO has an all-time record of 1,256-1,015-3 since softball first began in 1977.
- The Redhawks have accumulated 19 30+ win seasons, two 40-win seasons, eight Ohio Valley Conference regular-season titles, seven OVC Tournament championships and three NCAA Division I Tournament appearances in program history.

Redburn in 11th Season

- Mark Redburn is in his 11th season as Southeast Missouri's head coach.
- Redburn is 287-225 overall and 154-87 in Ohio Valley Conference games at the helm.
- He has led SEMO to three OVC regular-season titles (2019, 2021, 2023), two OVC Tournament titles (2019, 2024) and a pair of NCAA Tournament berths (2019, 2024).
- Redburn ranks second all-time in program history in wins behind Lana Richmond, who went 884-710-2 in 32 years as head coach from 1983-2014.
- Redburn holds a record of 377-400 as an NCAA Division I head coach between his stops at Evansville and SEMO.
- He has a career record of 501-474 in 21 years as a head coach.

Wallen Joins Coaching Staff

- Bryan Wallen is in his first year as an assistant coach at Southeast Missouri.
- Wallen, a graduate of SEMO, spent the last season as an assistant coach at Union University, where he worked primarily with the hitters and infielders.
- Prior to that, Wallen worked as SEMO's Director of Player Development during

the Redhawks 2023 Ohio Valley Conference championship season.

2025 Schedule

- Southeast Missouri will play a 44-game schedule with 13 home contests in 2025.
- SEMO will be outside of Cape Girardeau for its first 14 games across tournaments in Troy, Alabama, Chattanooga, Tennessee and Monroe, Louisiana.
- The Redhawks also have Central Arkansas (Mar. 11), Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Mar. 12) and Murray State (Apr. 30) on their non-conference slate.
- SEMO's 27-game Ohio Valley Conference schedule features home series against UT Martin (Mar. 8-9), SIU Edwardsville (Mar. 22-23), Morehead State (Apr. 12-13) and Southern Indiana (Apr. 26-27), and road series at Western Illinois (Mar. 15-16), Eastern Illinois (Mar. 29-30), Lindenwood (Apr. 5-6) and Tennessee State (May 3-4).

OVC Softball Championship Back in Peoria

- The 2025 Ohio Valley Conference Softball Championship will be held May 7-10 at the Louisville Slugger Sports Complex in Peoria, Illinois for the second year in a row.
- The top eight teams will head to the league's postseason event.
- Last year, #2 seed Southeast Missouri knocked off defending champion Eastern Illinois in the final.

Redhawk Hitting Streaks Among Nation's Best in 2025

- Southeast Missouri has two players ranked among the nation's longest hitting streaks in 2025.
- Sydney Dennis' 18-game hitting streak from Feb. 22-Mar. 22 is tied for third-longest in the country and Brooklyn Saysoff's 11-game hitting streak from Mar. 22-Apr. 19 is tied for ninth-longest in NCAA Division I softball.
