SPARTANS PREVIEW

After multiple years of struggling, all signs point towards the Spartans reinstating themselves as competitors in Canada West.

The headlining story for the 2021-22 Spartans lies in the new additions that have compiled over the past two years. This new group, headlined by *Mason Bourcier* (Kelowna, B.C.), *Tre Fillmore* (Amarillo, Texas), *Ja'Qualyn Gilbreath* (Amarillo, Texas), and *Vlad Mihaila* (Surrey, B.C.), should thrive under TWU head coach *Trevor Pridie's* fast-paced offence.

Andrew Goertzen (Langley, B.C.) will be stepping into a major role on the court for the Spartans this year. As Pridie's offence excels under quick possessions and shooting, Goertzen will have to use his size and defensive prowess to hold down the paint against some size-reliant teams in Canada West.

Every TWU men's basketball game will be available live and on demand this season on Canada West TV – the official streaming home of the conference. Passes are now on sale.

HEAD COACH TREVOR PRIDIE

"There are a lot of unknowns still. We haven't played many preseason games, but we basically have a brand new starting five this season, making things uncertain. We have one of the best backcourts in the country alongside some good supporting guys. We're going to be fun. We can push the game's tempo with our quickness, skill, and ability to score."

BACKCOURT

Big things are bound to happen with the new additions of Bourcier, Fillmore, and Mihaila for TWU's perimeter play. *Ja'Qualyn Gilbreath* is a proven scorer at the U SPORTS level, while Bourcier was outstanding in his two years at UBC. Fillmore and Mihaila both provide knockdown shooting ability combined with solid defensive attributes on the perimeter. Even though the prospective starting five brings a significant amount of scoring to the table already, *Riley Braich* (Abbotsford, B.C.) and *Isaiah Reimer* (Abbotsford, B.C.) are natural shooters who will fill out TWU's second unit. As scoring won't be an issue for the Spartans, second-year Mitchell Morgan (Vancouver, B.C.) has made massive strides in his game, blossoming into a bonified source of energy off the bench for the Spartans.

FRONTCOURT

With Goertzen's role on the court being significant, his role in team leadership cannot be understated. As the longest-standing member of the TWU men's basketball team, Goertzen has been through highs, and lows as a member of the Spartans. With this year's team showing signs of promise, the fourth-year big man's U SPORTS experience will prove to be valuable throughout the season's ebbs and flows. First-years *Connor Platz* (Langley, B.C.) and *Sam Dyck* (Almonte, Ont.) will have important roles behind their experienced counterpart in Goertzen. Platz, who stands at a towering 6'10", combines his size with a soft touch around the basket. On the other hand, Dyck brings toughness, strength, and versatility to the floor to round out TWU's frontcourt.
