CARDINAL CLASHES WITH MUSTANGS THURSDAY NIGHT

Stanford looks to open the season 3-0 for sixth time under eighth-year head coach Johnny Dawkins when the Cardinal hosts SMU on Thursday, Nov. 19, to wrap up its season-opening three-game homestand at Maples Pavilion.

Thursday's game will be televised nationally on the ESPN2 with Roxy Bernstein, Doris Burke and Jeff Goodman on the call. The contest will also be carried live on KNBR 1050 AM as Stanford alums Scott Reiss (play-by-play) and John Platz (analyst) have the call courtside from Maples. KZSU 90.1 FM, Stanford's student radio station will also provide live coverage of Thursday's action.

OPENING 2-0

Stanford opened the season with victories in its first two games for the second straight season and sixth time under Johnny Dawkins. The Cardinal has won its first three games of the year five times in the past seven seasons. Dawkins won his first 10 games as head coach at Stanford to open the 2008-09 season.

DUNKS GALORE

Stanford's first two games have produced 13 dunks by the Cardinal. Six of Michael Humphrey's nine field goals this season have been dunks. Below is Stanford's dunk counter for the year.

OFFENSIVE PRODUCTION

Stanford leads the Pac-12 in scoring, averaging 93.0 points. The scoring average is 20.7 points per game more than the Cardinal averaged in 37 games last season. Stanford also leads the Pac-12 in field goal percentage, shooting 54.8 percent from the field (63-of-115).

It's the first time in the Johnny Dawkins era in which the Cardinal has scored at least 90 points in back-to-back games. Stanford last achieved the feat with 111 points in a victory over Harvard on Nov. 9, 2007 and 97 points the following game in a win over Northwestern State on Nov. 10, 2007.

RECORD VS. SMU, AMERICAN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE

Stanford and SMU have faced each other twice previously, with the Cardinal earning wins in both matchups. More recently, Stanford posted an 86-51 victory over SMU at home during the 1998-99 season. The Cardinal also recorded an 80-70 win over the Mustangs in Dallas during the 1963-64 season. Stanford is 18-13 all-time against current members of the American Athletic Conference, most recently earning a 72-59 victory over Connecticut on Jan. 17, 2015 at Maples Pavilion.

MARGIN OF VICTORY

Stanford's 34-point win (93-59) over Charleston Southern last time out was its largest margin of victory since it defeated Arkansas-Pine Bluff by 35 (74-39) on Dec. 29, 2014.

NEW LOOK LINEUP

Rosco Allen was the lone Cardinal from Stanford's starting lineup in the 2015 postseason NIT Championship game against Miami who has started either of the Cardinal's first two games this season. Stanford's starting lineup in its last game vs. Charleston Southern (Rosco Allen, Reid Travis, Michael Humphrey, Dorian Pickens and Christian Sanders) have started a combined 67 games individually.

HUMPHREY SEEING DOUBLE

Sophomore Michael Humphrey has posted double-doubles in each of the first two games with 13 points and 11 rebounds against Green Bay and 13 points and 12 rebounds against Charleston Southern. He has four career double-doubles in 32 career games.

SANDERS CONTROLS OFFENSE

Senior point guard Christian Sanders scored a career-best 23 points in 31 minutes of action in the season opener against Green Bay. He more than doubled his previous career-high of 12 vs. Belmont during the 2012-13 season. In Sunday's win over Charleston Southern, he recorded a career-high eight assists. Sanders has scored 29 points in his first two games this year, after totaling 24 playing in 35 games last season.

WHAT RETURNED FROM 2014-15

Nine members of the Cardinal returned from last season, including starters Rosco Allen and Marcus Allen. In all, three members of last year's team who averaged more than 20 minutes per game returned this year in Rosco Allen, Marcus Allen and Reid Travis. The nine returning players have played in a combined 402 games at Stanford, with senior Rosco Allen and junior Marcus Allen having played in a team-high 69 contests for the Cardinal.

TOUR OF ITALY

Stanford enjoyed a 17-day tour of Italy from Aug. 19-Sept. 4, playing six exhibition games against some of the country's top professional teams. The program also had an opportunity to explore the country, visiting Rome, Florence, Venice, Bologna, Como and Pesaro during its exhibition tour.

NIT SEASON TIP-OFF

Stanford was selected to play in the 2015 NIT Season Tip-Off, with the championship round games set for Nov. 26 and Nov. 27 at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y. The Cardinal will face Villanova at 1:30 p.m. PT on Thanksgiving Day and matchup against either Arkansas or Georgia Tech on Nov. 27, depending on the outcome of the games on Nov. 26. The Cardinal's first two games of the season against Green Bay and Charleston Southern were also part of the NIT Season Tip-off tournament.

TRI-CAPTAINS

Senior Rosco Allen, junior Marcus Allen and sophomore Reid Travis were voted captains for the 2015-16 season. Combined, the trio has played in 164 career games combined. All three averaged more than 20 minutes per game last season for the Cardinal.

PRESEASON RECOGNITION

Sports Illustrated projected sophomore Reid Travis as one of the nation's breakout scorers, while junior Marcus Allen was recognized as one of the nation's projected under the radar breakout players by CBS Sports College Basketball Insider Jon Rothstein.

CARTWRIGHT TO MISS SEASON

Sophomore guard Robert Cartwright sustained a compound fracture in his right arm and will miss the 2015-16 season. The injury occurred during Stanford's team practice at Maples Pavilion on Nov. 2. Cartwright underwent successful surgery and will begin his rehabilitation period in the coming weeks. Cartwright played in all but one game, earning one start, as a freshman during Stanford's 2015 Postseason NIT Championship run. The point guard averaged 1.9 points in 11.1 minutes per game. He shot 33.3 percent from three-point range.

HOME SWEET HOME

Stanford opened the 2015-16 season with a pair of wins during the first weekend of the year and is now 94-30 at Maples Pavilion under head coach Johnny Dawkins. Stanford has won at least 10 home games for 22 straight seasons dating back to 1992-93.

CARDINAL IN THE NBA

Five former Stanford standouts – Brook Lopez (Brooklyn Nets), Robin Lopez (New York Knicks), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks), Josh Huestis (Oklahoma City Thunder) and Anthony Brown (Los Angeles Lakers) – are currently on NBA rosters. Powell, Huestis and Brown all played under head coach Johnny Dawkins.

STANBACK JOINS CARDINAL

Trevor Stanback, regarded as one of the highest-rated prospects on the West Coast, signed a National Letter of Intent with Stanford Nov. 11. Stanback, a 6-10, 220-pound power forward from Maranatha High School in Pasadena, Calif., is a consensus four-star prospect by the recruiting services. He ranks as the 13th-best power forward in the nation by Scout.com and 68th-best prospect overall. A member of the Rivals100 for the Class of 2016, the group ranks him as the 88th-best prospect nationally. Scout.com ranks the power forward as the third-best prospect in the state of California, while ESPN.com has him as the ninth-best prospect in the Golden State. He is rated the 18th-best power forward nationally by 247Sports.

QUICK LOOK BACK AT 2014-15

Stanford (24-13, 9-9 Pac-12) concluded its 100th season by capturing its second NIT championship in four seasons and third overall in school history. Qualifying for its fourth straight postseason appearance, the Cardinal won its final five games. Stanford finished ranked No. 34 in the RPI. Stanford's senior trio of Anthony Brown, Stefan Nastic and Chasson Randle accounted for 66.0 percent of the Cardinal's overall scoring and 45.3 percent of its rebounding in 2014-15.

ANOTHER 20-WIN CAMPAIGN

Stanford, which posted 24 wins last season, reached the 20-win plateau for the 23rd time in school history and fourth during head coach Johnny Dawkins' seven-year tenure. The only other coach in the 100-year history of the program to record at least four 20-win seasons was Mike Montgomery, who accomplished the feat 13 times over an 18-year career.

FOUR STRAIGHT POSTSEASONS

Stanford is one of four Pac-12 teams to have appeared in four consecutive post-seasons. Arizona earned three straight NCAA berths after reaching the 2012 NIT. Colorado played in the NCAA Tournament for three consecutive seasons before taking part in the 2015 CBI. Oregon reached the NCAA Tournament three years in a row after playing in the 2012 NIT.

Johnny Dawkins' contributions since arriving on The Farm have come in the form of both team and individual success, most notably guiding the Cardinal to the 2014 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 and the 2012 Postseason NIT championship.

Meanwhile, Dawkins has also been responsible for overseeing the development of Landry Fields, Josh Huestis and Dwight Powell, all of whom parlayed outstanding senior seasons into NBA Draft selections. Huestis (first round) and Powell (second round) were taken in the first round of the 2014 NBA Draft while Fields (second round) was chosen in 2010.

Dawkins has also made significant strides off the court, with the 2014 recruiting class representing the latest top-20 crop of freshmen to arrive on The Farm. Even more impressively, that same young talent is being developed quickly. In 2012, Chasson Randle became the fourth player to earn All-Freshman Team status among conference players during Dawkins' tenure following a six-year period in which only two Cardinal rookies were honored.

A very high standard in the classroom has also been established during Dawkins' tenure. In 2013-14, Stanford totaled the most Pac-12 All-Academic selections (6) of any conference school for the fifth consecutive season while Powell and Randle were tabbed back-to-back Pac-12 Scholar-Athletes of the Year.

The 2013-14 campaign was especially memorable, as Stanford (23-13, 10-8 Pac-12) advanced to the Sweet 16 for only the fifth time in school history after upsets of No. 7 seed New Mexico and No. 2 seed Kansas. Despite losing two starters and two key reserves to season-ending injuries, the Cardinal finished tied for third in the highly-competitive Pac-12.

Stanford finished 19-15 overall two seasons ago, advancing to the NIT second round. The Cardinal finished 9-9 in the Pac-12, swept the season series against California for the first time since 2008 and notched a 76-52 home upset of No. 10/12 Oregon.

Stanford produced a 26-11 record in 2011-12 en route to capturing the Postseason NIT title, the third championship in school history. The Cardinal chalked up its best win total since a 28-8 campaign in 2007-08. Stanford was the Pac-12's winningest program and tallied a league-best four top-50 RPI victories.

The Cardinal concluded the 2010-11 season at 15-16, fielding a team without a senior for the first time in school history. Stanford finished 14-18 during the 2009-10 campaign, Dawkins' second year at the helm.

In 2008-09, Dawkins directed Stanford to a 20-14 record and reached the CBI semifinals. In addition to surpassing Robert Burnett as the winningest first-year head coach in school history, Dawkins ranked third in victories among 21 first-year head coaches in Division I with no prior college head coaching experience.
