ARGOS

INSIDE THE SERIES: DELTA STATE vs. WEST FLORIDA

- **84TH HOMECOMING: Homecoming**, it's an annual right for alumni from across the country and this week, as **Delta State** gears up to host its' 84th gathering, which promises to be one of the best yet! The **Statesmen** (3-3, 2-2 GSC) will host the **Argonauts** (4-2, 2-1 GSC) of the **University of West Florida** on Saturday, Oct. 15 to culminate a week-long string of events celebrating DSU. Kickoff is set for 4 p.m. at Parker Field-McCool Stadium. The Statesmen are **51-30-2** all-time in Homecoming games at Delta State.
- **INSIDE THE SERIES:** Saturday's clash marks the **first meeting** all-time between **Delta State** and **West Florida** on the gridiron. The **Argonauts** (4-2, 2-1 GSC) are in their inaugural season in the Gulf South Conference under head coach **Pete Shinnick**. The GSC's top two scoring offenses will face off in the match-up, as DSU averages 42.0 points per game and UWF 38.3 points per game.
- **TRACKING THE ARGONAUTS:** In their first season of intercollegiate football competition, the **Argonauts** of **West Florida** have been incredibly successful. Under head coach **Pete Shinnick**, UWF has raced out of the gate to a **4-2** start, including impressive wins over No. 19 Florida Tech (42-39), Missouri S&T (45-28) & Mississippi College (42-28). **Kaleb Nobles** leads the high-octane Argos offense, averaging 336.0 yards passing per game. **Ishmael Morrow** leads UWF with 49 receptions for 733 yards and five touchdowns. UWF's defense has also recorded a league-best 28 sacks for minus 216 yards.
- **LAST TIME OUT:** The **Statesmen** dropped their second road loss of the season, falling **54-42** at the **University of West Alabama**. The **Tigers** (3-3, 3-1 GSC) jumped out to a 21-7 first half lead and held off a furious second-half rally by the Statesmen. **Chris Robinson** caught a career-high eight passes for 175 yards and two touchdowns. **Tyler Sullivan** became just the second Statesman to eclipse 9,000 total offense yards in career after totaling 391 yards on the night. The senior from Louisville, Miss., completed 27-of-37 attempts for 382 yards with four touchdowns and three interceptions.
- **RACING TO A RECORD:** Junior wide receiver/kick returner **LaDarion Peterson** established a new school-record for kick return yardage in a game with **245** at West Alabama on Oct. 8 at Tigers Stadium. The Woodville, Miss., returned seven kicks, including one 91-yards for a touchdown. The previous record of 168 yards was set by Maurice Moore versus Harding on Oct. 16, 2010. The Statesmen had also failed to return a kickoff for a touchdown since Jeremy Ricks' accomplished the feat at West Georgia on Oct. 27, 2007.
- **CAREER NIGHT AT UWA:** Despite a 54-42 setback to West Alabama, three Statesmen recorded career highs in receptions versus the **Tigers**. **Chris Robinson** (175 yards/2 TDs), **K'Shun Evans** (91 yards) and **Alex Pina-Rhoden** (70 yards) all finished the night with eight receptions, marking career bests for each player.
- **COOLEY TD MAKER:** Junior wide receiver **Chris Cooley** made the most of his three receptions at West Alabama, scoring two touchdowns, including a 35-yard effort in the second half. Half of Cooley's six receptions this season have gone for scores.
- **ECTOR CLEANING UP:** Sophomore linebacker **Chandler Ector** has flourished in new-DC Raleigh Jackson's system. The Decatur, Ga., native is tied for the team lead with 39 tackles. This past weekend at UWA, Ector finished with a game-high 9.5 stops.

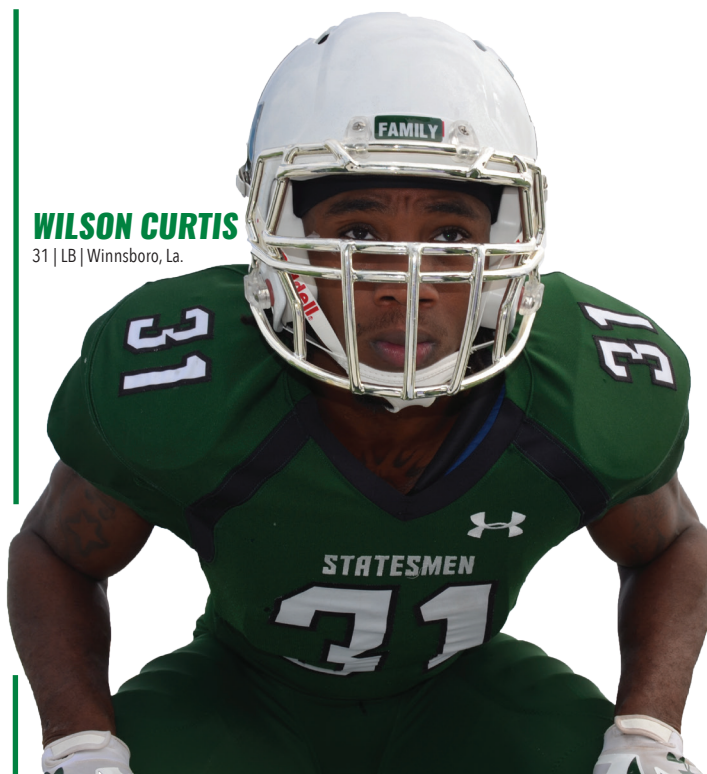

- **HOMECOMING HYSTERIA:** Saturday's showdown with the University of West Florida will mark Delta State's **84th Homecoming**. The Statesmen are **51-30-2** all-time and **2-1** under Todd Cooley in Homecoming games.
- **TWO STATESMEN JOINING SPORTS HoF:** Delta State University will honor eight Statesmen and Lady Statesmen for their contributions by inducting them into the Delta State University Sports Hall of Fame. The induction is the highest honor given to former athletes or coaches and the 2016 class includes **Jim Devers** (FB) and **Rico McDonald** (FB). Devers lettered two years in track and field at Delta State before joining the Statesmen football squad as a junior in 1969. Devers was a flanker back for former head coach Horace McCool. Devers was a driving force behind the Statesmen's offense. In 1969, he led the Statesmen in receiving with a record-breaking 62 catches for 884 yards. He was the Co-Most Valuable Player and won the Best Offensive Player Award. McDonald rushed for a school-record 3,285 yards during his career at Delta State. McDonald helped anchor for the Statesmen's success since his freshman year in 1998, when he led DSU to its fifth GSC Championship in football. Most notably, he led Delta State to the 2000 NCAA Division II National Championship his junior year, rushing for 1,637 yards. He tied the single game record for rushing touchdowns with four versus Valdosta State in 2000. He was selected to the All-GSC First Team, named a Don Hansen's HM All-American, and was selected to the Second Team Daktronics All-South Region. McDonald was a preseason All-American as a senior in 2001, rushing for 1,151 yards and 15 touchdowns in 2001.

- **SULLIVAN ALONE AT NO. 2:** Senior quarterback **Tyler Sullivan** completed 14-of-22 passes for 151 yards and three touchdowns in DSU's 61-31 win over Mississippi College to push him into second place in every major career passing statistic. In 30 career games, Sullivan has completed 671-of-1,044 passes for 8,267 yards with 69 touchdowns and 34 interceptions. He has also rushed for 16 career scores to push his TD-responsible for to 85. Previously, the Louisville, Miss., native passed **Micah Davis** (8,238/29 games) to take over second place in career total offense with **8,764** yards. **Scott Eyster** (2003-2006) holds the school-record with 14,342 yards. He also holds every career passing statistic in Delta State history, with the exception of completion percentage.
- **MR. BROWN TO YOU:** Senior defensive end **Erin Brown** is turning in his best performance as a Statesman, totaling 19 tackles, 8.5 tackles-for-loss and 3.5 sacks. The Monroe, La., native ranks third in the GSC in tackles-for-loss and sacks. Brown recorded 3.0 tackles, a sack and a tackle-for-loss in DSU's 61-31 win over MC.
- **LEAGUE LEADERS:** Running back **Chris Robinson** enters this week leading the **Gulf South Conference** in scoring (14 TD/14.0 ppg), rushing yards (560), and rushing yards per game (93.3). Punter/kicker **Cody Mills** also leads the league in average yards per punt (42.8). **Delta State** also boasts the league's top scoring offense, averaging 42.0 points per game.
- **GREEN ZONE EFFICIENCY:** Delta State is **28-for-28** inside the "Green Zone" this season in scoring situations. In fact, the Statesmen have scored 23 touchdowns and converted five field goals inside the opposition's 20-yard line.
- **LEADING AT THE HALF:** Delta State is **20-0** under head coach Todd Cooley when leading at half-time. The Statesmen are 5-10 when trailing and 0-2 when tied at the half.
- **RACE TO 30:** The Statesmen are **23-5** all-time when scoring 30 or more points against an opponent under head coach Todd Cooley.
- **TELEVISED RESULTS:** Delta State's clash with **Mississippi College** was the **33rd** game televised by the **GSC/NCAA/ESPN**. The Statesmen are **22-11** all-time in televised contests, including a 3-0 mark again the Chocotaws. In his three-plus seasons at DSU, coach **Todd Cooley** is 7-4 in televised games.

- ▶ Todd Cooley will be entering his fourth season as head coach of the Delta State University Statesmen football program. Cooley became the 19th coach in program history on Friday, Jan. 25, 2012. In his three seasons as head coach of the Statesmen, Cooley is 25-13 overall and 14-10 against the Gulf South Conference.
- ▶ With expectations riding high entering the 2015 season, the Statesmen raced out of the gate to a 4-0 record and No. 5 national ranking. Unfortunately, the ride would be short-lived, as injuries began to mount and derailed a title run for DSU. The Statesmen finished the year 6-5 overall and 2-5 in GSC play.
- ▶ In 2014, Cooley led the Statesmen to their seventh GSC title and eighth appearance in the NCAA Division II Football Championship Playoff. For his efforts, Cooley was named GSC co-Coach of the Year for a second time.
- ▶ Statesmen head coach Todd Cooley tied former Steve Campbell for the second fastest coach to accumulate 20 victories, accomplishing the feat in 25 games. Cooley led DSU to a 7-3 mark in 2013 during his first season and followed up that performance with a 9-2 record in 2014 and a share of the GSC title. The Nashville, Arkansas, native started out the season 4-0 to get his 20th win in a 40-0 victory over Albany State at Parker Field-McCool Stadium (Sept. 26, 2015).
- ▶ In his first campaign as head coach, Cooley guided the Statesmen to a 7-3 overall record and a second place finish in the Gulf South Conference. Inheriting a team that went 3-7 the year before, the high-energy Cooley built a cohesive family atmosphere in less than nine months. That energy helped feed a program's turnaround in just one season.
- ▶ For his efforts, Cooley was named Gulf South Conference Coach of the Year by his peers in the league. In all, 11 Statesmen were named to the All-GSC squad, including GSC Freshman of the Year Tyler Sullivan, who quarterbacked DSU to a 4-1 mark as a starter.
- ▶ DSU averaged 40.0 points per game offensively, while averaging 472.2 yards per game. The Statesmen pulled off three victories over nationally ranked opponents after defeating No. 21 North Alabama 37-34, No. 14 Tarleton State 38-36 and No. 24 Valdosta State 63-55.
- ▶ Known as one of the top offensive coordinators in the country, Cooley brought his high-octane system to Delta State after serving as the offensive coordinator at Northwestern Louisiana (2009-2012), Central Arkansas (2005-2008) and Arkansas Tech (2004).
- ▶ In three years running the NSU offense, Cooley's established the Demons as one of the top units in the Southland Conference. The 2012 season saw Brad Henderson finish the season ranked seventh in the SLC with 181-of-330 passes completed for 1,874 yards with 14 touchdowns and only four interceptions. The Demons averaged 24.1 points per game and ranked fifth in the league in scoring.
- ▶ Cooley's explosive offenses at Central Arkansas lit up scoreboards around the Southland Conference in 2007-08 and during his four seasons with the Bears as offensive coordinator and quarterback coach. In that time (2005-08), UCA posted an overall 35-13 record, including an 11-3 SLC mark in the Bears' first two years (2007-08) as an NCAA Division I FCS member.
- ▶ Born September 7, 1975, Cooley is married to the former Lisa Gatlin of Conway, Ark. He is the son of Lynne and the late Don Cooley of Nashville, Ark.

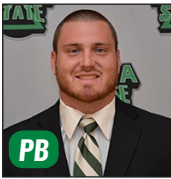

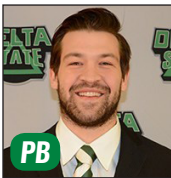

PARKER FIELD @ McCOOL STADIUM

- ▶ One of the Gulf South Conference's oldest and most historic venues, Travis E. Parker Field at Horace L. McCool Stadium has served as the home of the Statesmen since it opened in 1970. Delta State has enjoyed tremendous success at Parker-McCool under its last four coaches, posting an impressive 59-17 record.
- ▶ Formerly known as Delta Field and Travis E. Parker Field, the 8,500 seat stadium was completed in time for the 1970 season. In 1984, the field was renamed to honor former Mississippi Institutions of Higher Learning Board of Trustees member, Travis E. Parker, a tireless supporter of Delta State University and the Delta area communities.
- ▶ In 2007, DSU honored long-time coach and administrator Horace McCool by naming the stadium in his honor. McCool was 76-48-3 in 14 seasons as head coach of the Statesmen and was instrumental in running the Department of Athletics as Director of Athletics. During his time as AD, McCool helped revive the Lady Statesmen basketball program, which blossomed into a national power under the legendary Margaret Wade.
- ▶ The current facility replaced the "old" Delta Field, which is located between Sillers Coliseum and the Hugh Ellis Walker Alumni-Foundation House on the Delta State campus. The Statesmen have enjoyed a 247-125-15 mark at home.
- ▶ The two-level press facility includes booths for radio, film, coaches, and working press, as well as to a snack kitchen and restroom. The press box is completely enclosed, with the exception of the second-level film deck, and is climate controlled for year-round comfort and convenience.
- ▶ Parker-McCool has gone through several recent renovations, including the installation of artificial turf in the summer of 2014, a press box revitalization project in May of 2013, and the addition of a new scoreboard/video board in the fall of 2008. Past additions have included the chairback seats in 1993 and the creation of a picnic area in the southwest corner of Parker Field in 2001.
- ▶ In the summer of 2014, Delta State began construction on a new visitor's concession stand and bathroom on the southeast corner of Parker-McCool.
- ▶ In his first season as head coach of the Statesmen, coach Todd Cooley led Delta State to a perfect 4-0 record at Parker-McCool. The Nashville, Arkansas native is the first head coach since Ron Roberts to go undefeated at home in his first season at DSU.
- ▶ Delta State has an 8-2 (.800) record in NCAA Division II postseason play. The Statesmen have won their last four playoff games at Parker-McCool.
- ▶ The Statesmen went 2-0 at Parker-McCool in the 2000 NCAA playoffs en route to the national championship. DSU defeated Valdosta State (49-12) and North Dakota State (34-16) at home with road wins over Catawba (20-14) and Bloomsburg (63-34) in the NCAA title game.
- ▶ Trevar Deed set a DSU postseason record with 16 receptions for 203 yards and four touchdowns in a 55-34 loss to North Alabama in the second round of the 2008 NCAA Division II playoffs at Parker-McCool.
- ▶ In DSU's 45-7 victory over Shaw University in the first round of the 2007 NCAA playoffs, senior linebacker and Harlon Hill finalist Michael Eubanks set a new NCAA DII single-game sack record with five versus the Hawks.
