STATESMEN TRAVEL TO NO. 4 VALDOSTA STATE FOR KEY GSC TILT

- ➔ **THE KICKOFF:** Delta State University (2-3, 0-2 GSC) hits the road to battle Gulf South Conference foe No. 4/3 Valdosta State University (4-0, 1-0 GSC) on Sat., Oct., 9 at 6 p.m. (CT) at Bazemore-Hyder Stadium in Valdosta, Ga. Delta State enters the week looking to snap a three-game winless streak by a combined 14 points. The losses include No. 13 West Georgia (27-26), FCS Jackson State (24-17), and No. 1 West Florida (39-33).
- ➔ **IN OCTOBER:** DSU is **171-181-1** record in October, including a **10-17** mark under coach Cooley.
- ➔ **AGAINST THE STATE:** DSU is **49-33-1** all-time against the Peach State and **14-12** under Cooley.
- ➔ **SERIES SNAPSHOT:** The Statesmen are looking to snap a five-game Valdosta State winning streak in the series and are seeking their first win in Bazemore-Hyder Stadium since a 49-32 win on Sept. 20, 2014.
- ➔ **500:** Delta State amassed a season-high 580 yards of total offense for the second time this season and ran 102 plays. The 102 plays were the most since the Statesmen ran 110 plays against Texas A&M Commerce on Sept. 13, 2013, and a week later ran 101 versus former GSC member North Alabama. The Statesmen also ran 101 plays against Valdosta State in 2014.
- ➔ **CAREER NIGHT:** Several Statesmen surpassed career-highs against West Florida. **Patrick Shegog** completed 32-of-50 passes for 459 yards, all career-bests. **Corintheus Edmonds** equaled his career-high with eight catches and set a new career-best with 161 receiving yards. Edmonds is the second DSU receiver with a 100-yard receiving game this season as **Dohnite Meyers** had 110 yards against McKendree. **Dohnite Meyers** eclipsed his career-high with seven catches for 75 yards, and **Todd Lee Battle** had a career-high five receptions.
- ➔ **GETTING OFFENSIVE:** **Patrick Shegog** 1,307 total offense yards is 2nd in the conference behind West Georgia's **Harrison Frost** (1527) while his 261.4 yards of total offense is 5th after amassing 481 total yards against UWF.
- ➔ **BEHIND ENEMY LINES:** Delta State is second in the GSC with 7.8 tackles for loss per game and fourth with 2.5 sacks per outing. **Marvin Terry** is 2nd in the GSC with 1.2 TFLs per game, and **Tim Williams'** 1.0 sacks per game are first in the GSC.
- ➔ **TURNOVERS:** Delta State leads the GSC and ranks 3rd in the country with 15 turnovers gained, nine interceptions, and six fumble recoveries. **Sherrad Paige** and **Ty Woods** have two picks and five Statesmen boast one INT each. The six fumble recoveries rank 2nd in the GSC and 20th in the country. **Manny Barber** and **John Valesco** are tied for 4th in the NCAA and third in the GSC with two fumble recoveries.
- ➔ **UTILITY MAN:** **Kory Gainwell** ranks third in the GSC with 120.8 all-purpose yards per game and leads the country in combined return yards with 489 yards, all on 19 kickoff returns. The Benton, Miss., native is 3rd in the GSC with 25.7 yards per return (**35th NCAA**) on kickoffs. Gainwell has also rushed 28 times for 123 yards and three touchdowns and caught one pass for seven yards on offense.

HONORING OUR PAST



RETRO LOOK FOR 2019

Since taking over the program in 2013, head coach **Todd Cooley** has not been afraid of change. However, the one constant each year has been Delta State's green helmets.

This year, Cooley and his staff are paying tribute to the teams of the late 1980s and 1990s by going "old school" with white face masks and the DSU block state logo. Previous designs are below.





SERIES NOTEBOOK: VALDOSTA STATE

- **Delta State** and **Valdosta State** collide for the 40th time on the gridiron and the 18th in Valdosta, Ga. The Statesmen hold a slim 20-18-1 lead in the overall series record and are 10-8 on the road.
- **Gary Goff** is in his third season at the helm of the Valdosta State football program with a 14-1 overall record and a 9-0 GSC mark. In his first season with VSU, Goff led the Blazers to a 10-1 record and an 8-0 conference record, including the 2019 GSC title. Before VSU, Goff was at Tiffin for eight seasons.
- **Last time out for VSU:** The Blazers scored 35 second-half points to stretch a 14-13 halftime lead into a 39-13 win over visiting Shorter University. The Blazers amassed a season-high 574 yards of offense in the game and held Shorter to just 49 yards of offense in the second half. VSU rushed for a season-high 316 yards and passed for a season-high 258 yards.
- **VSU Offense:** The Blazer's balanced attack ranks 2nd in the GSC in scoring (43.5), total offense (470.5), and rushing (245.0) and is 5th in passing (225.5). **Seth McGill** is 2nd in the GSC with 92.0 yards per game rushing. **Lio'Undre Gallimore** is 3rd in the conference with 87.8 receiving yards per game along with 19 catches for 351 yards and five touchdowns.
- **VSU Defense:** Valdosta State boasts the GSC's top defenses, leading the league in scoring defense (7.5 ppg.) and pass defense (89.5). VSU ranks 2nd in total defense (231.3 y/pg.) and 6th in rush defense (141.0). The Blazers limited Shorter to just 49 yards of offense in the second half and 251 yards of offense overall last week. VSU linebacker **Nick Moss**, who had double-digit stops for the second-straight game, had 13 tackles and eight solos in the win over Shorter. VSU recorded four sacks and six tackles for loss. The Blazers are a plus-nine in turnover margin with seven fumble recoveries and four interceptions.

NEWS, NOTES, & SIDEBAR STATS

DEFEND OVER THE TOP: Dayreke Snow leads the GSC with nine passes defended and Sherrod Paige is tied for 3rd with teammates **Junior Faulk** and **Ty Woods** with six. Delta State is 1st in the league and second in the nation behind Henderson State (11) with nine interceptions. **Sherrod Paige** and **Ty Woods** have two picks apiece, tied for 2nd in the GSC. Five other Statesmen boast one interception each.

SACK ATTACK: The Statesmen's 14 sacks rank 4th in the GSC and 91 yards is tied for second. **Tim Williams, Jr.**, five sacks leads the GSC.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES:

► **Robbie Evans'** 11.3 yards per punt return is 2nd in the GSC (39th NCAA).

► Freshman **Parker Burleson** has taken over the top spot in the GSC in average (42.8), punts inside the 20 (9) and punts over 50 yards (5).

► Burleson also leads the GSC and ranks 10th in the nation in net punting average (38.76).

► Freshman **Connor Mantellis'** was 1-for-1 against UWF and is now 5-for-9 on the season, ranking third in the GSC.

► Delta State leads the GSC in kick return defense (18.60 yds./ret.).

► Delta State's 25.19 kickoff return average as a team ranks 2nd in the GSC and 20th in NCAA.

DELTA STATE PICKED 3rd IN GSC COACHES POLL: The Statesmen are picked to finish **third** in the annual **Gulf South Conference Preseason Coaches Poll**. Defending National Champion West Florida was named the 2021 GSC Football Preseason Favorite for the first time in school history, collecting 47 points behind five first-place votes. Nipping at the Argonauts' heels is defending GSC Champion Valdosta State which posted 45 points and nabbed the final three first-place votes. Delta State ranked third in the Coaches' Poll voting with 33 points followed by West Alabama (30) and West Georgia (26) to round out the Top Five. Mississippi College (22), North Greenville (14), and Shorter (seven) complete the GSC Pre-Season Poll.

SIX STATESMEN NAME PRESEASON ALL-GSC: Six Statesmen (three offensive and three defensive players) were named to the Pre-Season All-GSC Team. Three-time All-GSC center **Innis Claud V** and junior **Nicolas Melsop** anchor an offensive line that will open holes for one of the league's top returning backs in senior **Rico Owens**. The defensive side starts with All-American defensive back **Junior Faulk** is joined by seniors **Dante Williams** (LB) and **Zane Samuel** (DE).

D2FOOTBALL.COM PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS: **Junior Faulk** and **Innis Claud V** were named to the D2Football.com Preseason All-American teams. Faulk was named to the first team while Claud was listed on the second team.

CAREER INT WATCH: **Junior Faulk's** interception was the 10th of his career, tying him for fourth in career interceptions with **Kim Stewart** (1969-70) and **Don Fennell** (1964-66). Faulk needs two interceptions to move into third, three to move into second and four to tie **Dominique Davenport** (2008-2011) atop the list. (See Career INT list on page five). Faulk set the Delta State single season record with nine interceptions in 2019 to break the old mark of eight held by Garrett Williams (2010).

NOTEABLES

- Cooley is in his eighth season as head coach of the Delta State University Statesmen football program. Cooley became the 19th coach in program history on Friday, Jan. 25, 2012. In his four seasons as head coach of the Statesmen, Cooley is 43-32 overall and 25-27 against the GSC.
- In his previous five seasons, the Nashville, Ark., native, has guided the Statesmen two trips to the NCAA Division II Football Championship Playoffs (2014/2017) and in 2014 Delta State captured its seventh Gulf South Conference title.
- Cooley tied former Steve Campbell for the second fastest coach to accumulate 20 victories, accomplishing the feat in 25 games. Cooley led DSU to a 7-3 mark in 2013 during his first season and followed up that performance with a 9-2 record in 2014 and a share of the GSC title. The Nashville, Arkansas, native started out the season 4-0 to get his 20th win in a 40-0 victory over Albany State at Parker Field-McCool Stadium (Sept. 26, 2015).
- Cooley is a two-time Coach of the Year recipient in the Gulf South Conference following the 2013 and 2014 campaigns. He joins Ron Roberts (2007/2008) as the only two-time recipients of the award in the program's history.

PARKER FIELD @ McCOOL STADIUM

- ▶ One of the Gulf South Conference's oldest and most historic venues, Travis E. Parker Field at Horace L. McCool Stadium has served as the home of the Statesmen since it opened in 1970. Delta State has enjoyed tremendous success at Parker-McCool under its last four coaches, posting an impressive 85-32 record.
- ▶ Formerly known as Delta Field and Travis E. Parker Field, the 8,500 seat stadium was completed in time for the 1970 season. In 1984, the field was renamed to honor former Mississippi Institutions of Higher Learning Board of Trustees member, Travis E. Parker, a tireless supporter of Delta State University and Delta area communities.
- ▶ In 2007, DSU honored long-time coach and administrator Horace McCool by naming the stadium in his honor. McCool was 76-48-3 in 14 seasons as head coach of the Statesmen and was instrumental in running the Department of Athletics as Director of Athletics. During his time as AD, McCool helped revive Lady Statesmen basketball, which blossomed into a national power under the legendary Margaret Wade.
- ▶ The current facility replaced the "old" Delta Field, which is located between Sillers Coliseum and the Hugh Ellis Walker Alumni-Foundation House on the Delta State campus. The Statesmen have enjoyed a 252-126-15 mark at home.
- ▶ The two-level press facility includes booths for radio, film, coaches, and working press, as well as to a snack kitchen and restroom. The press box is completely enclosed, with the exception of the second-level film deck, and is climate controlled for year-round comfort and convenience.
- ▶ Parker-McCool has gone through several recent renovations, including the installation of artificial turf in the summer of 2014, a press box revitalization project in May of 2013, and the addition of a new scoreboard/video board in the fall of 2008. Past additions have included the chairback seats in 1993 and the creation of a picnic area in the southwest corner of Parker Field in 2001.
- ▶ In the summer of 2014, Delta State began construction on a new visitor's concession stand and bathroom on the southeast corner of Parker-McCool.
- ▶ In his first season as head coach of the Statesmen, coach Todd Cooley led Delta State to a perfect 4-0 record at Parker-McCool. The Nashville, Arkansas native is the first head coach since Ron Roberts to go undefeated at home in his first season at DSU.
- ▶ Delta State has an 8-2 (.800) record in NCAA Division II postseason play.
- ▶ The Statesmen went 2-0 at Parker-McCool in the 2000 NCAA playoffs en route to the national championship. DSU defeated Valdosta State (49-12) and North Dakota State (34-16) at home with road wins over Catawba (20-14) and Bloomsburg (63-34) in the NCAA title game.
- ▶ Trevar Deed set a DSU postseason record with 16 receptions for 203 yards and four touchdowns in a 55-34 loss to North Alabama in the second round of the 2008 NCAA Division II playoffs at Parker-McCool.
- ▶ In DSU's 45-7 victory over Shaw University in the first round of the 2007 NCAA playoffs, senior linebacker and Harlon Hill finalist Michael Eubanks set a new NCAA DII single-game sack record with five versus the Hawks.
