

## AROUND THE HORN: @DELTASTATESB HEADS TO THE ANNUAL CHARGER CHILLOUT

- THIS WEEK: This week the **Delta State University** softball heads to the annual Charger Chillout. This will be the 11th time DSU has played in the tournament hosted by the University of Alabama in Huntsville.
- OPPONENT: The Lady Statesmen will take on Southern Indiana, Spring Hill, Trevecca Nazerene, Carson Newman, Miles, and Young Harris. It will be the first weekend of games of the season for Southern Indiana, Trevecca, and Miles.
- LAST WEEKEND: The Lady Statesmen went 1-2 at the Gulf Shores Invitational last week. DSU opened with a win over Union 8-2 before being defeated by North Georgia and Saint Leo. Katelyn Hayman had three hits in six at bats last weekend. Jenny Griggers had two RBI in seven at bats.
- EXPERIENCE IN THE LINEUP: The infield returns three of four starters from last years squad. Jenny Griggers, Taylor Picou, and Kailyn Lofton all bring plenty of experience to the infield. Grigger led the team with 47 hits last season. She has also had 29 RBI to lead Delta State as well.

  Lofton had 40 hits with 24 RBI last year. She only had nine strikeouts in 130 at bats last season. Picou was second on the team last year with four home runs. Katelyn Hayman, Karley Bloesch, and Raegan Stafford all return as well for the Lady Statesmen
- ► IN THE CIRCLE: Lacey Coats earned the only win for DSU last weekend. In the victory over Union, she allowed two runs on eight hits with strikeout and a walk in four and a third innings. Olivia Burns earned the save.
- NEWCOMERS TO WATCH FOR THE LADY STATESMEN: Chrissy Tubbs scored a run last weekend in her debut for the Lady Statesmen. True freshman Campbell Kraft made three starts at thrid base and was walked once at the plate. MyCala Helms and Abigail Carter split time behind the plate catching and each had a hit and Carter had a RBI.
- UPCOMING: The Lady Statesmen will head to Rome, Ga. to open Gulf South Conference play. The Lady Statesmen will take on Shorter University with two games on Saturday, February 19 and one game on Sunday, February 20.




## **DELTA STATE RANKS FOURTH IN WINS IN GSC HISTORY**
