QUICK HITTERS

FIRST PITCH: Delta State University

welcomes the University of West Florida to Harvey Stadium-Ferriss Field for a three-game conference set, starting with a single game on Friday at 6 p.m. followed by a doubleheader on Saturday at 1 p.m.

WELCOME BACK: For the first time since 2019, the Argonauts will make their way to Cleveland for a weekend series. The last 10 games in the series have been played on UWF's home turf, including seven games in 2021. Last season's regular-season series got shifted to Pensacola, Fla., due to weather. The Statesmen also made trips to UWF for the GSC Championship series and the NCAA Division II South Regional. In the seven games played at Spooner Field in 2021, the Statesmen were the home team six times.

DEFENSIVELY SPEAKING: The series pits the top two defenses in the GSC. West Florida has a .976 fielding percentage (9th NCAA) and their 30 errors are the fewest in the GSC (30). The Statesmen are right on the Argos heels with a .972 fielding percentage (16th NCAA) and 31 errors.

200: Skipper Rodney Batts captured his 200th win in DSU's 6-4 win in game one of the Mississippi College series.

OOPS HE DID AGAIN: Right fielder Kirkland Trahan belted a solo home run and a two-run home run in an eight-run third inning in Delta State's 18-13 win over Mississippi College. Trahan is the first Statesmen hit two home runs in an inning since Andy Dillard homered twice in the third inning against Southern Arkansas on March 29, 2003.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Green-and-White are

10-3 in the friendly confines of Harvey Stadium at Ferriss Field and are wrapping up an eight-game homestand. Delta State is hitting .302, averaging 8.2 runs per game with 19 doubles, one triple, and 16 home runs. The Statesmen have a 4.21 ERA with 104 strikeouts against 40 walks and one shutout. Carson Clowers has a .425 batting average, 18 hits, 14 runs scored, and 10 RBI. Chad Ragland is hitting .368 with 15 runs scored, seven RBI, and four steals. Hayden White (.333) has three homers and 18 RBI followed by Blakey Dendy (.306) with four home runs and 12 RBI and Jake Barlow (.326) with three home runs and 11 RBI.

GETTING OFFENSIVE: The Delta's 8.4 runs scored per game rank 2nd in GSC (33rd NCAA) and the .296 batting average is 5th. Delta State has belted 39 home runs (3rd GSC), 65 doubles (3rd GSC), 20 sac-fies (2nd GSC), and 326 hits (7th GSC).

PUTTING DUCKS ON THE POND: The Statesmen are 2nd in the GSC in on base percentage (.411), 3rd hit by a pitch (63) (19th NCAA), and base on walks (168).

TOP TO BOTTOM: Chad Ragland and Carson Clowers bookended the Statesmen batting lineup this season. Ragland is hitting .355 with 43 hits, 40 runs scored (4th GSC), 10 doubles, a triple, a home run, and 25 RBI. Ragland leads the GSC with 1.21 runs scored per game and is tied with Hayden White with 14 multi-hit games. Clowers has been turning the lineup over in the nine-hole, hitting .400 with 34 hits, 25 runs scored, four doubles, 17 RBI, 13 walks and has been hit by a pitch three times. Clowers is 3rd in the GSC with a .396 overall batting average,

2nd with a .492 on base percentage. Clowers ranks fourth on the team with 12 multi-hit games.

LONG BALL: Jake Barlow's 10 home runs rank 3rd in the GSC (64th NCAA) and his .30 homers per game are also 3rd. Barlow ranks in the GSC's top five in slugging percentage (.691/4th), doubles per game (.36/4th), and doubles (12/4th).

GOING THE DISTANCE: Harrison Haley is 4th in the GSC (14th NCAA) with four complete games while his seven wins sit atop the GSC (10th NCAA). Statesmen hurlers have five complete games, 3rd in the conference and 20th nationally. The Madison, Miss., native and Hammer Franks are tied for 3rd in the GSC (12th NCAA) with 10 starts. Haley is 5th in the conference in strikeouts (54), 2nd in walks per nine innings (1.49), and 5th in WHIP (1.12).

➤ **TWO OUT RBI:** Delta State has 72 two-out RBI this season. **Kirkland Trahan** and **Hayden White** lead the team with 12 two-out RBI followed by **Chad Ragland** with nine and **Carson Clowers** with seven and **Jake Barlow** and **Hayden Cooper** with six.

➤ **RECORDS CHASE:** **Jake Barlow** is for 3rd on the DSU career home runs list with 42 and needs eight home runs to catch **Zach Shannon** (2017-18) for second. The redshirt senior belted 19 home runs in 2021, tying him for 5th on the DSU single-season homers list with **Mike Plumlee** (1992) and **Zack Shannon** (2017). Barlow has 163 career RBI and needs two RBI to move onto the DSU career RBI top 10 list while his 377 total bases are seven away from moving into the top 10 on in career total bases list. Barlow's 41 career doubles are six doubles away from ninth on the DSU doubles list.

OFFICIAL NICKNAME



Delta State has one official and one unofficial mascot. Since its inception, Delta State's athletic teams have officially been known as the **STATESMEN** and **LADY STATESMEN** because of the role State Rep. Walter Sillers, Jr. played in the location of the school in Cleveland. Sillers was speaker of the Mississippi House of Representatives for 20 years. DSU Athletics requests for fans and media to refer to us as Statesmen and Lady Statesmen officially.

However, since the late 1980s, the student body has embraced a mascot that depicts a piece of okra wearing boxing gloves and brandishing a fierce expression.[12] The "Fighting Okra" grew out of humor among students about the improbability that anyone would find a "Statesman" particularly frightening. In the mid-1990s, a student vote was taken, resulting in the university taking on "The Fighting Okra" as an **UNOFFICIAL** mascot. The "Fighting Okra" was featured in the "Okraphobia" episode of the Food Network show Good Eats.

The popularity of "The Fighting Okra" grew so much that many myths started on how the mascot came to be, the most popular of these stating there was a stubborn okra plant at first base on the baseball field that grew back every time it was cut. The true origin of the fighting okra mascot was a discussion between basketball and baseball players in the "Court of Governors" dormitory. The Statesman mascot was temporarily prohibited from participating in athletic activities after a physical altercation with the Mississippi College's Choctaw mascot at a basketball game. Basketball player Houston Williamson was lamenting the fact that "Fighting Statesmen" was not particularly frightening to their opponents. All present agreed that an alternative mascot would have to be mean and green. After a lively discussion and many suggestions, baseball pitcher Bob Black suggested that okra was green, fuzzy, and tough. The DSU baseball team began using the chant "Okra! Okra! Okra! Okra!" at DSU basketball games.

Rodney Batts is in his third season at the helm of the Delta State University baseball program and his 15th season overall. Batts has a 64-40 mark as the Statesmen skipper and is 202-131 for his career.

In his second season, Batts led the Statesmen to a 28-20 record and a 21-14 mark in GSC play, guiding the Statesmen to a runner-up finish in the GSC Tournament and a berth in the NCAA South Regional in Pensacola, Fla.

The Columbus, Miss., native was officially introduced as Delta State's 10th head baseball coach by Director of Athletics and coaching mentor Mike Kinnison on Tuesday, July 2, 2019.

Batts, who is just the third head baseball coach in the last 57 years, joins a distinguished list of former Statesmen who were given the opportunity to lead the program, including Don Ward, Bill Marchant, and Mike Kinnison, who Batts is replacing in the dugout. All three previous alumni head coaches led the program to at least one appearance in the NCAA College World Series.

Batts returns to his alma mater after five seasons as the head coach at Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College. During his five seasons in Perkinston, Miss., the Bulldogs won 119 games, including 75 in the last two seasons, and made back-to-back appearances in the NJCAA Region 23 Tournament in 2018 and 2019. In 2019, MGCC went 29-18 on the diamond, including a 16-12 record in MACJC play. The Bulldogs swept Meridian Community College 10-8 and 10-8 to advance to the Region 23 Tournament.

Batts, a former All-GSC second baseman, played for the Statesmen under Bill Marchant from 1995-1996. He hit .334 with 24 doubles, eight triples, 10 home runs, 86 RBIs and 39 stolen bases during his DSU career.

Batts etched his name in the Statesmen history books when he hit one of the most dramatic home runs in Delta State and Gulf South Conference history - a three-run home run with two outs in the bottom of the ninth inning to defeat Alabama-Huntsville and deliver DSU the 1996 GSC championship. The Statesmen went on to win the NCAA South Central

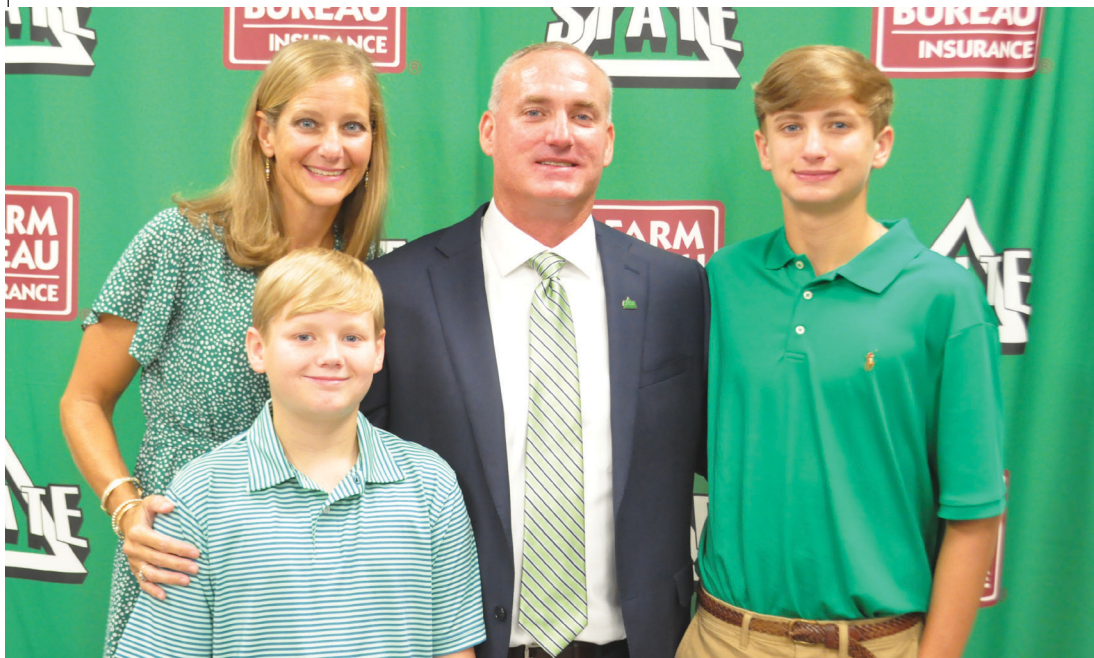
After being drafted in the 22nd round by Philadelphia and spending two years in the Phillies organization, the Columbus, Miss., native returned to the Statesmen as a graduate assistant coach in 1999.

In 2001, Kinnison named Batts a full-time assistant coach and for the next 13 seasons helped guide the Statesmen to a remarkable 583-171-2 record while capturing four GSC titles and the 2004 NCAA Division II National Championship. The Statesmen made nine NCAA postseason appearances during his time as an assistant, including five trips to the College World Series.

Fifteen Statesmen were selected in the Major League Baseball Draft from 2001-2014, including 6th round selections Eli Whiteside (2001 | Orioles) and Brent Leach (2005 | Dodgers), and 11th round selections Dusty Hughes (2003 | Royals) and Brett Durand (2007 | Marlins).

Batts graduated from Delta State in 1998 with a degree in Health, Physical Education and Recreation and later earned a master's degree in HPER in 2000.

He is married to former Lady Statesmen basketball standout Scottie (Moore) Batts of Senatobia, Miss. The couple has two sons, Austin and Reid.

THE FERRISS LEGACY

Dave “Boo” Ferriss, a member of the Boston Red Sox and Mississippi Sports Halls of Fame, is the patriarch of the Statesmen baseball program. During his 26 years as head coach, Ferriss established a lasting legacy of success on the field, in the classroom, and within the community.

The Shaw, Mississippi, native spent 46 years in baseball on the collegiate and professional levels, including 26 seasons at Delta State. A legend in national collegiate baseball coaching circles, Ferriss was inducted into the American Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame in 1988 after compiling a 639-387-8 record at Delta State. At the time, his coaching record ranked among the all-time national leaders at the NCAA Division II level for victories.

When Ferriss took over the baseball program in 1960, he literally had to begin in the dirt. The Statesmen played many of their games off campus due to a lack of a quality facility and Ferriss coached without the benefit of an assistant. Over the next three decades, Ferriss turned the meager program into a national power – directing the Statesmen to the NCAA Division II playoffs in eight of his last 12 years, including three trips to the NCAA Division II championships, where they finished third, second and third, respectively in 1977, 1978 and 1982.

Gulf South Conference championships came in 1978, 1979, 1985 and 1988, with the Statesmen finishing second in 1981 and third in 1982. Forty-nine of his players earned All-Gulf South Conference honors and academics were always at the forefront of his teaching style, as 95% of his players went on to earn their degrees.
