- FIRST PITCH: Amid an eight-game homestand, the Statesmen welcome instate rival Mississippi College to Harvey Stadium-Ferriss Field for a three-game Gulf South Conference set. Saturday's doubleheader is scheduled for a 1 p.m. and Sunday's single game is a 1 p.m. first pitch.
- **200:** Statesmen skipper **Rodney Batts** is one win shy of career win No. 200 after last weekend's sweep of against Union University.
- ♦ HALL OF FAME WEEKEND: The 2020 and 2022 classes were enshrined into the Delta State University Sports Hall of Fame on Friday night at the Grammy Museum in Cleveland, Miss. Past Diamond Statesmen greats Edwin Maysonet (Class of 2020). Josh Melton (Class of 2021) and Dusty Hughes (Class of 2021) were among the 16 inductees. Joining Maysonett in the 2020 class were **Clyde Muse** (Men's Basketball), Jennifer Artichuk (Women's Swimming and Diving), Jeremey Richardson (Men's Basketball). Lardester Hicks-Green (Football), Mark Hudspeth (Coach), Michael **Eubanks** (Football) and **Nicole Trotter-Fran**cis (Women's Basketball). Joining Melton and Hughes in the 2022 class were Micah Davis (Football), Trevar Deed (Football), Steve Campbell (Coach), Bobby Barrett (Coach), Tanya Redmon (Women's Basketball) and Chico Potts (Men's Basketball).
- DESCRIPTION HOME: The Green-and-White own a 7-3 mark in the friendly confines of Harvey Stadium at Ferriss Field. Delta State is hitting .304 and is averaging 7.9 runs per game with 12 doubles, one triple and nine home runs.

The Statesmen also enjoy success on the mound at home, boasting a 3.40 ERA with 88 strikeouts against 33 walks with one shutout. Carson Clowers has a .457 batting average. 16 hits. 11 runs scored and nine RBI. Chad Ragland is hitting .379 with 11 runs scored and five steals. Blayke Dendy (.345) has 12 RBI followed by Hayden White (.324) with 11. Jake Barlow (.343) has three home runs.

- O GOING THE DISTANCE: Harrison Haley notched his 4th complete game in game two of the Union series and is 6-0 on the season. His four complete games rank 2nd in the GSC (7th NCAA) while his six wins sit atop the GSC (7th NCAA), Statesmen hurlers have a GSC-leading five complete games, which is 9th nationally. The Madison, Miss., native and teammate Hammer Franks are tied for 3rd in the GSC (10th NCAA) with nine starts. Halev is 3rd in the conference in strikeouts (49), walks per nine innings (1.52) and 1st in WHIP (1.03).
- SC WEEKLY HONORS: Hayden Cooper was selected as the GSC Player of the Week and the NCBWA South Region Player of the Week. Cooper was instrumental in DSU's three-game sweep of Union University, going 9-for-14 for a .643 average and 11 RBI in the series. The sophomore added three doubles and three home runs while slugging 1.500 with a .667 on base percentage. The Wentzville, Mo., native went 6-for-9 with two doubles, two home runs, and nine RBI in Saturday's doubleheader sweep of Union. Cooper was 4-for-5 with two home runs, one double, and seven RBI in game one and 2-for-4 with a double and two RBI in

game two. His seven RBI were two shy of the DSU single-game record. Cooper stayed hot in game three, going 3-for-5 with a double, a home run, and two RBI. Cooper went 10-for-14 (,500) with three doubles, three home runs and 12 RBI in four games last week.

- PLAYING THE FIELD: The Statesmen are 2nd in the GSC and **28th** in the NCAA with a .971 fielding percentage.
- © GETTING OFFENSIVE: The Statesmen's 8.3 runs scored per game rank 2nd in GSC (35th NCAA) and the .296 batting average is 5th. Delta State has belted 32 home runs (6th GSC), 17 sac-flies (2nd GSC), and 300 hits (6th GSC)
- THE PERCENTAGES: The Statesmen are 3rd in the GSC in on base percentage (.408) and in hit by a pitch (54) (28th NCAA) and 5th in slugging percentage (.457).

- ON THE BUMP: The Statesmen rank prominently five GSC pitching categories, including WHIP (1.44/ 2nd GSC | 54th NCAA), strikeouts (234/5th), and strikeouts per nine innings (8.4/2nd).
- THE TOP: Chad Ragiand is thriving at the top of the Statesmen lineup. hitting .357 with 40 hits, 36 runs scored (4th GSC), nine doubles, a triple, a home run and 24 RBI. Ragland averages 1.20 runs scored per game (2nd **GSC**) and is tied with **Hayden White** with 13 multi-hit games.
- Council Date: Jake Barlow's 10 home runs rank 2nd in the GSC (41st NCAA) and his .33 homers per game are 3rd. Barlow is also in the top 10 in the league in slugging percentage (.713/4th), doubles per game (.37/3rd), doubles (11/4th), and runs per game (1.07/10th).
- TURNING IT OVER: Carson Clowers continues to turn the DSU lineup over from the nine-hole, hitting .420 with 24 hits, 24 runs scored, four doubles, 17 RBI, 12 walks and has been hit by a pitch three times. Clowers is 2nd in the GSC with a .406 overall batting average, 2nd with 1.41 runs scored per game and 3rd with a .488 on base percentage.
- RECORDS CHASE: Jake Barlow is for 3rd on the DSU career home runs list with 42, passing Jud Thigpen (2001-2005) with his third-inning solo home run against Arkansas-Monticello. He needs and eight home runs to catch **Zach Shannon** (2017-18) for second. The redshirt-senior belted 19 home runs in 2021, tving him for 5th on the DSU single season homers list with Mike Plumlee (1992) and Zack Shannon (2017). Barlow has 161 career RBI and needs four RBI to move onto the DSU career RBI top 10 list.

Delta State has one official and one unofficial mascot. Since its inception, Delta State's athletic teams have officially been known as the **Statesmen** and **Lady Statesmen** because of the role State Rep. Walter Sillers, Jr. played in the location of the school in Cleveland. Sillers was speaker of the Mississippi House of Representatives for 20 years. DSU Athletics requests for fans and media to refer to us at Statesmen and Lady Statesmen officially.

However, since the late 1980s, the student body has embraced a mascot that depicts a piece of okra wearing boxing gloves and brandishing a fierce expression.[12] The "Fighting Okra" grew out of humor among students about the improbability that anyone would find a "Statesman" particularly frightening. In the mid-1990s, a student vote was taken, resulting in the university taking on "The Fighting Okra" as an **unofficial** mascot. The "Fighting Okra" was featured in the "Okraphobia" episode of the Food Network show Good Eats.

The popularity of "The Fighting Okra" grew so much that many myths started on how the mascot came to be, the most popular of these stating there was a stubborn okra plant at first base on the baseball field that grew back every time it was cut. The true origin of the fighting okra mascot was a discussion between basketball and baseball players in the "Court of Governors" dormitory. The Statesman mascot was temporarily prohibited from participating in athletic activities after a physical altercation with the Mississippi College's Choctaw mascot at a basketball game. Basketball player Houston Williamson was lamenting the fact that "Fighting Statesmen" was not particularly frightening to their opponents. All present agreed that an alternative mascot would have to be mean and green. After a lively discussion and many suggestions, baseball pitcher Bob Black suggested that okra was green, fuzzy, and tough. The DSU baseball team began using the chant "Okra! Okra! Okra! Okra!" at DSU basketball games.

Rodney Batts is in his third season at the helm of the Delta State University baseball program and his 15th season overall. Batts has a 61-40 mark as the Statesmen skipper and is 199-131 for his career.

In his second season, Batts led the Statesmen to a 28-20 record and a 21-14 mark in GSC play, guiding the Statesmen to a runner-up finish in the GSC Tournament and a berth in the NCAA South Regional in Pensacola, Fla.

The Columbus, Miss., native was officially introduced as Delta State's 10th head baseball coach by Director of Athletics and coaching mentor Mike Kinnison on Tuesday, July 2, 2019.

Batts, who is just the third head baseball coach in the last 57 years, joins a distinguished list of former Statesmen who were given the opportunity to lead the program, including Don Ward, Bill Marchant, and Mike Kinnison, who Batts is replaces in the dugout. All three previous alumni head coaches led the program to at least one appearance in the NCAA College World Series.

Batts returns to his alma mater after five seasons as the head coach at Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College. During his five seasons in Perkiston, Miss., the Bulldogs won 119 games, including 75 in the last two seasons, and made back-to-back appearances in the NJCAA Region 23 Tournament in 2018 and 2019. In 2019, MGCCC went 29-18 on the diamond, including a 16-12 record in MACJC play. The Bulldogs swept Meridian Community College 10-8 and 10-8 to advance to the Region 23 Tournament.

Batts, a former All-GSC second baseman, played for the Statesmen under Bill Marchant from 1995 -1996. He hit .334 with 24 doubles, eight triples, 10 home runs, 86 RBIs and 39 stolen bases during his DSU career.

Batts etched his name in the Statesmen history books when he hit one of the most dramatic home runs in Delta State and Gulf South Conference history - a three-run home run with two outs in the bottom of the ninth inning to defeat Alabama-Huntsville and deliver DSU the 1996 GSC championship. The Statesmen went on to win the NCAA South Central

Regional and finish fourth at the NCAA Division II Baseball Championship Tournament in Montgomery, Ala.

After being drafted in the 22nd round by Philadelphia and spending two years in the Phillies organization, the Columbus, Miss., native returned to the Statesmen as a graduate assistant coach in 1999.

In 2001, Kinnison named Batts a full-time assistant coach and for the next 13 seasons helped guide the Statesmen to a remarkable 583-171-2 record while capturing four GSC titles and the 2004 NCAA Division II National Championship. The Statesmen made nine NCAA postseason appearances during his time as an assistant, including five trips to the College World Series.

Fifteen Statesmen were selected in the Major League Baseball Draft from 2001-2014, including 6th round selections Eli Whiteside (2001 | Orioles) and Brent Leach (2005 | Dodgers), and 11th round selections Dusty Hughes (2003 | Royals) and Brett Durand (2007 | Marlins).

Batts graduated from Delta State in 1998 with a degree in Health, Physical Education and Recreation and later earned a master's degree in HPER in 2000.

He is married to former Lady Statesmen basketball standout Scottie (Moore) Batts of Senatobia, Miss. The couple has two sons, Austin and Reed.

THE FERRISS LEGACY

Dave "Boo" Ferriss. a member of the Boston Red Sox and Mississippi Sports Halls of Fame. is the patriarch of the Statesman baseball program. During his 26 years as head coach, Ferriss establishbed a lasting legacy of success on the field, in the classroom, and within the community.

The Shaw, Mississippi, native spent 46 years in baseball on the collegiate and professional levels. including 26 seasons at Delta State. A legend in national collegiate baseball coaching circles, Ferriss was inducted into the American Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame in 1988 after compiling a 639-387-8 record at Delta State. At the time, his coaching record ranked among the all-time national leaders at the NCAA Division II level for victories.

When Ferriss took over the baseball program in 1960, he literally had to begin in the dirt. The Statesmen played many of their games off campus due to a lack of a quality facility and Ferriss coached without the benefit of an assistant. Over the next three decades, Ferriss turned the meager program into a national power - directing the Statesmen to the NCAA Division II playoffs in eight of his last 12 years, including three trips to the NCAA Division II championships, where they finished third, second and third, respectively in 1977, 1978 and 1982.

Gulf South Conference championships came in 1978, 1979, 1985 and 1988, with the Statesmen finishing second in 1981 and third in 1982. Forty-nine of his players earned All-Gulf South Conference honors and academics were always at the forefront of his teaching style, as 95% of his players went on to earn their degrees.
