QUICK HITTERS

➔ **FIRST PITCH:** Delta State University heads to the Sunshine State for the 2022 NCAA South 2 Region Tournament on May 19-22 in St. Leo, Fla. The Statesmen, who enter the field as the sixth seed, face third seeded Rollins in the first-ever matchup between the two schools on Thursday, May 19 at 5 p.m. (CT).

➔ **STRONG FIELD AWAITS:** The NCAA South Region 1 and 2 Tournaments boast five ranked teams among the eight-team field. Hosts Tampa checks in at No. 4 (CBN) and No. 2 (NCBWA), and St. Leo is No. 12 (CBN) and No. 18 (NCBWA). Rollins is No. 24 (NCBWA). Delta State shows up at No. 17 (CBN) and No. 25 (NCBWA) while Valdosta State is No. 22 (CBN) and No. 21 (NCBWA). Nova Southeastern received votes in the CBN poll while GSC Tournament Champion Lee University is unranked.

➔ **35th NCAA APPEARANCE:** Delta State is making its 35th NCAA postseason appearance, owning 12 regional titles and NCAA Division II Baseball Championship appearances. The Statesmen claimed the 2004 NCAA National title and have three national runner-up finishes. The Statesmen have an overall 101-69 NCAA

Tournament record, a 73-46 mark in NCAA Regionals, and are 0-2 in NCAA Super Regionals.

➔ **GSC REGULAR SEASON CHAMPS:** The Statesmen captured their first regular-season title since 2018 and its 22nd overall title to earn the No. 1 overall seed in the 2022 GSC Baseball Tournament.

➔ **BATTS NAMED GSC COY:** Delta State skipper Rodney Batts was named the Gulf South Conference Coach of the Year. Batts garners his first GSC Coach of the Year honor and adds to a list that includes 17 COY honorees for Statesmen skippers. Dave "Boo" Ferriss was named COY four times, while his predecessor Bill Marchant was a three-time selection. Current Athletic Director and former Head Coach Mike Kinnison earned the honor nine-time during his 23-year tenure.

➔ **FERRISS TROPHY FINALIST:** Harrison Haley was named one of five finalists for the 18th Dave "Boo" Ferriss Trophy presented by Pearl River Resort and the Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indians on Monday, May 23, 2022. Named after legendary player and Delta State Head Coach Dave "Boo" awarded to the top

➤ **FOUR STATESMEN EARN ALL-GSC HONORS:** Four Statesmen earned 2022 All-GSC First and Second-Team accolades. **Jake Barlow** (2B) and **Carson Clowers** (SS) were selected to the first-team while **Harrison Haley** (P) and **Chad Ragland** (CF) earned second-team laurels. Barlow earns First-Team All-GSC honors for the third straight year while Clowers, Haley, and Ragland earn their first selection.

➤ **ALL-TOURNAMENT:** **Blayke Dendy** was named to the 2022 Gulf South Conference Baseball All-Tournament team following the GSC Championship game. Dendy hit .438, going 7-for-16 with two doubles, a home run, and 11 RBI over four tournament games. The Yazoo, Miss., native slugged .750 with a .471 on base percentage and three runs scored. In the tournament opener, Dendy was 3-for-4 with a double, a grand slam home run, and eight RBI in a 13-0 win over eventual tournament runner-up Shorter University. Dendy was 3-for-5 with a double and two RBI during DSU's 10-6 win over No. 3 seed Montevallo.

➤ **OFF THE FIELD SUCCESS:** The trio of **Jake Barlow**, **Hayden White**, and **Blayke Dendy** recently garnered CoSIDA Academic First-Team All-District 5 baseball honors, advancing to the CoSIDA Academic All-American ballot. Barlow graduated from Delta State with a bachelor's degree in environmental science and a 3.69 GPA and is seeking a second degree in health, physical education, and recreation with a 3.34 GPA. White tallied a 3.75 GPA while earning his degree in biology and has a 4.00 GPA while seeking a master's degree in biology. Dendy is majoring in biology with a 3.45 GPA.

➤ **TOP MALE SENIOR SA:** The 54th Green and White Awards hosted by Delta State University Athletics on Tuesday, April 26th, 2022, saw **Jake Barlow** bring home the Charles S. Kerg Senior Top Male Senior Student-Athlete of the Year award. The Charles S. Kerg Senior Student-Athlete of the Year Award was established in 1968 by former Director of Athletics and Head Football Coach Horace McCool to honor the all-around student-athletes who excelled on the field, in the classroom, and within the campus and community.

➤ **DEFENSE:** The Statesmen lead the GSC .976 fielding percentage (**6th NCAA**). Their 38 errors are the fewest in the GSC, ahead of UWF's 42. The Statesmen enter the NCAA South 2 Region Tournament with a string of seven games without committing an error.

➤ **WORKING AHEAD:** The Statesmen are 26-1 when leading after six innings and 18-0 when leading after the seventh and eighth innings. Delta State is 14-2 when scoring in the first inning and 19-5 overall when scoring first.

➤ **GETTING OFFENSIVE:** Delta State is **2nd** in the conference with 8.1 runs (**37th NCAA**) scored per game and is **3rd** in runs scored (381). The Statesmen are hitting .304 (**4th GSC**) with 52 home runs (**4th GSC**), 88 doubles (**3rd GSC**), and 468 hits (**5th GSC**). **Jake Barlow** is **4th** in the league with 50 runs scored. Clowers sits atop the GSC with a .388 batting average (**90th NCAA**).

OFFICIAL NICKNAME



Delta State has one official and one unofficial mascot. Since its inception, Delta State's athletic teams have officially been known as the **STATESMEN** and **LADY STATESMEN** because of the role State Rep. Walter Sillers, Jr. played in the location of the school in Cleveland. Sillers was speaker of the Mississippi House of Representatives for 20 years. DSU Athletics requests for fans and media to refer to us at Statesmen and Lady Statesmen officially.

However, since the late 1980s, the student body has embraced a mascot that depicts a piece of okra wearing boxing gloves and brandishing a fierce expression. [12] The "Fighting Okra" grew out of humor among students about the improbability that anyone would find a "Statesman" particularly frightening. In the mid-1990s, a student vote was taken, resulting in the university taking on "The Fighting Okra" as an **UNOFFICIAL** mascot. The "Fighting Okra" was featured in the "Okraphobia" episode of the Food Network show Good Eats.

The popularity of "The Fighting Okra" grew so much that many myths started on how the mascot came to be, the most popular of these stating there was a stubborn okra plant at first base on the baseball field that grew back every time it was cut. The true origin of the fighting okra mascot was a discussion between basketball and baseball players in the "Court of Governors" dormitory. The Statesman mascot was temporarily prohibited from participating in athletic activities after a physical altercation with the Mississippi College's Choctaw mascot at a basketball game. Basketball player Houston Williamson was lamenting the fact that "Fighting Statesmen" was not particularly frightening to their opponents. All present agreed that an alternative mascot would have to be mean and green. After a lively discussion and many suggestions, baseball pitcher Bob Black suggested that okra was green, fuzzy, and tough. The DSU baseball team began using the chant "Okra! Okra! Okra! Okra!" at DSU basketball games.

➤ **PUTTING DUCKS ON THE POND:** The Statesmen have drawn a league-high 235 walks while ranking are **2nd** with a .417 on base percentage, and **3rd** with 86 hit by a pitch (**24th NCAA**). **Carson Clowers** is **6th** in the GSC with a .470 on base percentage.

➤ **TOUCH 'EM ALL:** **Jake Barlow** is **4th** in the GSC in home runs (13) and **5th** in slugging percentage (.675). **Kirkland Trahan** is second on the team with 10 homers, ranking **8th** in **GSC**. The Statesmen's 53 homers and 1.13 round trips per game rank **4th** in the conference. The Statesmen are 15-1 when hitting two or more home runs and 12-8 when hitting one homer. DSU is 16-3 when not allowing an opponent home run.

➤ **DRIVE 'EM IN:** **Blayke Dendy** and **Hayden White** rank among the GSC's top RBI leaders, Dendy is **6th** with 51 RBI (**8th GSC**) while White's 48 RBI are **9th**.

➤ **BOOKENDS:** **Chad Ragland** and **Carson Clowers** have been solid at the top and bottom of the Statesmen batting order. Ragland is hitting .328 with 58 hits, 49 runs scored, 13 doubles, a triple, a home run, and 35 RBI. Clowers owns a .398 average with 45 hits, eight doubles, two homers, 26 RBI, and 33 runs scored in the nine-hole. Five players have combined to hit .318 (59-for-185) with 49 runs scored 14 doubles, and 35 RBI in the leadoff spot. Twelve Statesmen have combined to hit .350 (54-for-154) with 40 runs scored, 35 RBI, eight doubles, and two home runs from the nine-hole this season.

➤ **ON THE BUMP:** **Harrison Haley** is **1st** in the GSC (**7th NCAA**) with 10 wins while ranking **4th** in the GSC (**19th NCAA**) with five complete games. Statesmen hurlers are **4th** in the conference with six complete games. The Madison, Miss., native is **2nd** in the GSC (**21st NCAA**) with 14 starts followed by **Hammer Franks** and **Landon Zizmann** with 13 starts (**9th GSC**). Haley is **2nd** in walks per nine innings (1.48), **9th** in the conference in strikeouts (68), and **3rd** in WHIP (1.15).

➔ **IT TAKES SACRIFICE:** The Statesmen are **2nd** in the GSC with 28 sac-flies (**30th NCAA**) and their 12 sac-bunts rank **8th**. **Carson Clowers** has six sac-flies to rank **2nd** while his seven sac-bunts top the GSC.

➔ **TWO OUT RBI:** Delta State has 111 two-out RBI with **Wyatt Pratt** pacing the Statesmen with 17.. He is followed by **Hayden White** (15), **Kirkland Trahan** (14), **Blayke Dandy** (11), **Carson Clowers** (11), and **Jake Barlow** (9). The Statesmen had 12 two-out RBI in the GSC Tournament and were led by **Chad Ragland** with four followed by Dendy with three.

➔ **LAST STAND:** Before DSU's home finale against Christian Brothers, Delta State baseball honored seniors **Jake Barlow**, **Cooper Brune**, **Charles Darnall**, **Will Myers**, **Wyatt Pratt**, **Chad Ragland**, and **Hayden White**.

➔ **RECORDS CHASE:** **Jake Barlow** is for **3rd** on the DSU career home runs list with 45 which also ranks tied for **9th** among NCAA Division II active home run leaders and **8th** on the GSC all-time homers list. Barlow remains five home runs of **Zach Shannon** (2017-18) for second. Barlow is tied with Shannon for **7th** on the DSU career RBI list with **173** career RBI and needs two RBI to move up to sixth. His **398** total bases ranks **7th** all-time at DSU. Barlow's **42** career doubles are five doubles shy of ninth on the DSU doubles list. The redshirt senior belted 19 home runs in 2021, tying him for **5th** on the DSU single-season homers list with **Mike Plumlee** (1992) and **Zack Shannon** (2017).

Rodney Batts is in his third season at the helm of the Delta State University baseball program and his 15th season overall. Batts has a 73-45 mark as the Statesmen skipper and is 211-136 for his career.

In his second season, Batts led the Statesmen to a 28-20 record and a 21-14 mark in GSC play, guiding the Statesmen to a runner-up finish in the GSC Tournament and a berth in the NCAA South Regional in Pensacola, Fla.

The Columbus, Miss., native was officially introduced as Delta State's 10th head baseball coach by Director of Athletics and coaching mentor Mike Kinnison on Tuesday, July 2, 2019.

Batts, who is just the third head baseball coach in the last 57 years, joins a distinguished list of former Statesmen who were given the opportunity to lead the program, including Don Ward, Bill Marchant, and Mike Kinnison, who Batts is replacing in the dugout. All three previous alumni head coaches led the program to at least one appearance in the NCAA College World Series.

Batts returns to his alma mater after five seasons as the head coach at Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College. During his five seasons in Perkinston, Miss., the Bulldogs won 119 games, including 75 in the last two seasons, and made back-to-back appearances in the NJCAA Region 23 Tournament in 2018 and 2019. In 2019, MGCC went 29-18 on the diamond, including a 16-12 record in MACJC play. The Bulldogs swept Meridian Community College 10-8 and 10-8 to advance to the Region 23 Tournament.

Batts, a former All-GSC second baseman, played for the Statesmen under Bill Marchant from 1995-1996. He hit .334 with 24 doubles, eight triples, 10 home runs, 86 RBIs and 39 stolen bases during his DSU career.

Batts etched his name in the Statesmen history books when he hit one of the most dramatic home runs in Delta State and Gulf South Conference history - a three-run home run with two outs in the bottom of the ninth inning to defeat Alabama-Huntsville and deliver DSU the 1996 GSC championship. The Statesmen went on to win the NCAA South Central

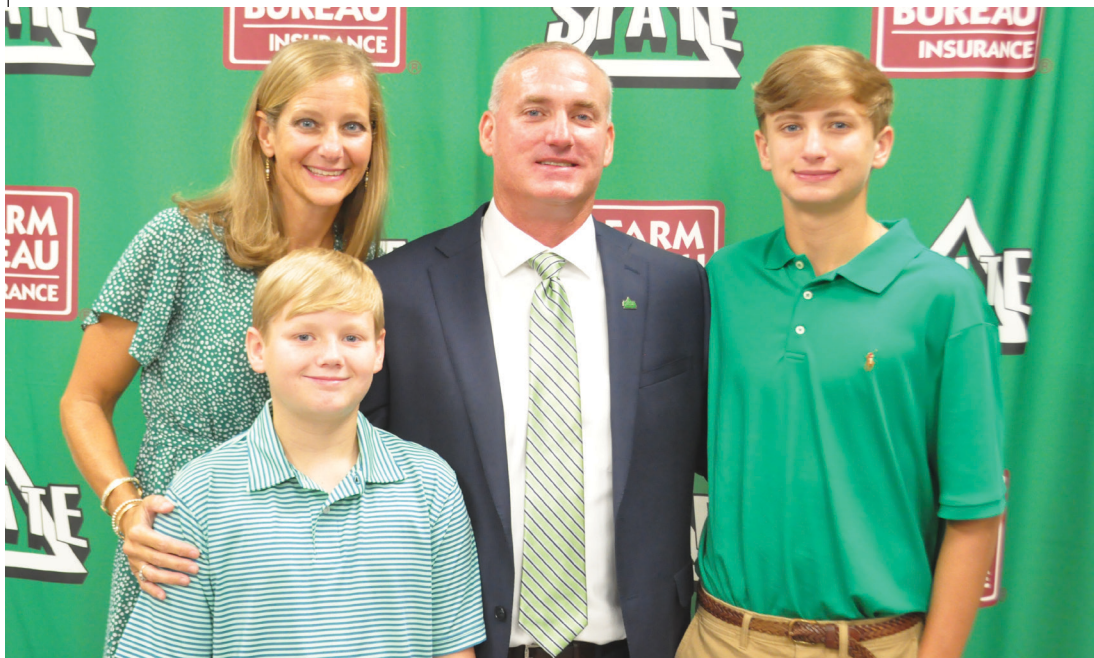
After being drafted in the 22nd round by Philadelphia and spending two years in the Phillies organization, the Columbus, Miss., native returned to the Statesmen as a graduate assistant coach in 1999.

In 2001, Kinnison named Batts a full-time assistant coach and for the next 13 seasons helped guide the Statesmen to a remarkable 583-171-2 record while capturing four GSC titles and the 2004 NCAA Division II National Championship. The Statesmen made nine NCAA postseason appearances during his time as an assistant, including five trips to the College World Series.

Fifteen Statesmen were selected in the Major League Baseball Draft from 2001-2014, including 6th round selections Eli Whiteside (2001 | Orioles) and Brent Leach (2005 | Dodgers), and 11th round selections Dusty Hughes (2003 | Royals) and Brett Durand (2007 | Marlins).

Batts graduated from Delta State in 1998 with a degree in Health, Physical Education and Recreation and later earned a master's degree in HPER in 2000.

He is married to former Lady Statesmen basketball standout Scottie (Moore) Batts of Senatobia, Miss. The couple has two sons, Austin and Reid.

THE FERRISS LEGACY

Dave "Boo" Ferriss, a member of the Boston Red Sox and Mississippi Sports Halls of Fame, is the patriarch of the Statesmen baseball program. During his 26 years as head coach, Ferriss established a lasting legacy of success on the field, in the classroom, and within the community.

The Shaw, Mississippi, native spent 46 years in baseball on the collegiate and professional levels, including 26 seasons at Delta State. A legend in national collegiate baseball coaching circles, Ferriss was inducted into the American Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame in 1988 after compiling a 639-387-8 record at Delta State. At the time, his coaching record ranked among the all-time national leaders at the NCAA Division II level for victories.

When Ferriss took over the baseball program in 1960, he literally had to begin in the dirt. The Statesmen played many of their games off campus due to a lack of a quality facility and Ferriss coached without the benefit of an assistant. Over the next three decades, Ferriss turned the meager program into a national power – directing the Statesmen to the NCAA Division II playoffs in eight of his last 12 years, including three trips to the NCAA Division II championships, where they finished third, second and third, respectively in 1977, 1978 and 1982.

Gulf South Conference championships came in 1978, 1979, 1985 and 1988, with the Statesmen finishing second in 1981 and third in 1982. Forty-nine of his players earned All-Gulf South Conference honors and academics were always at the forefront of his teaching style, as 95% of his players went on to earn their degrees.

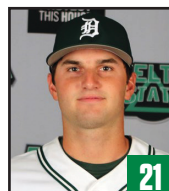

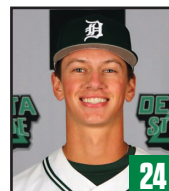
