#5/4 Boston University (5-3-1, 1-0-1 HEA) at Connecticut (3-3-5, 1-1-1 HEA)

TONIGHT IN HARTFORD

- Boston University visits Hartford to take on Connecticut in the opener of a weekend home-and-home series.
- A win or tie on Friday would allow the Terriers to go undefeated in their first three Hockey East contests for just the second time since 2002 (2010-11).



- The Terriers and Huskies have just five prior meetings and BU is 3-1-1 in them.
- The teams split their league series last season with BU earning a 4-2 home win before suffering a 5-2 loss in Hartford three days later.
- During the 2014-15 season, the teams skated to a 4-4 draw at Agganis Arena before the Terriers posted a 5-2 road victory two weeks later.
- In the first-ever tilt between the two schools on Nov. 17, 2013, BU posted a 4-1 home win.

SCOUTING THE HUSKIES

- Connecticut is coming off a weekend series at Ohio State, skating to a 3-3 draw on Saturday after a 7-4 loss in the opener.
- The Huskies opened the season with a two-game home sweep of Alabama Huntsville on Oct. 7-8 but their only other win in the nine games since came at Notre Dame in their Hockey East opener on Oct. 27. Five of those nine contests resulted in ties.
- Sophomore Tage Thompson leads the team in both points (14) and goals (7) while classmate Maxim Letunov has 11 points on four goals and seven as-



sists. Senior Evan Richardson has added 10 points (4g, 6a).

• Senior Rob Nichols and freshman Adam Huska have split starts in goal this season and Nichols holds the edge in goals-

against average (2.40 - 3.11) while Huska is just ahead in save percentage (.916 - .915).

• Mike Cavanaugh is in his fourth season as head coach of the Huskies and has a career record of 42-57-20.

LAST YEAR'S SERIES

- Boston University and UConn split their league series last season with each team winning at home.
- At Agganis Arena on Oct. 24, Jakob Forsbacka Karlsson's first career goal kicked off a three-goal third period and gave BU the lead for good in a 4-2

- Boston University is coming off a weekend split at then-No. 18 Michigan, as the Terriers earned a 4-2 victory on Saturday after being shut out, 4-0, on Friday.
- Saturday's result marked BU's first win at Yost Ice Arena in seven tries.
- In the opener, Michigan scored on its first two power plays and never looked back, adding an even-strength goal and an empty-netter in the

- The Terriers are 4-1-1 in the past six games and three of the wins were shutouts.
- The three shutouts came in BU's first three home games, marking the first time in the Terriers' 95-season history that they blanked their first three home opponents.

ROOKIE NETMINDER IMPRESSES

• After an impressive start to his collegiate career, freshman Jake Oettinger was named

- the Hockey East Stop It Goaltending Co-Goaltender of the Month for October.
- Oettinger had a .947 save percentage and 1.42 goals-against average in October.
- He closed out the month with back-to-back shutouts as part of a 134:14 shutout skein that was the sixth-best in program history.
- He currently ranks seventh in the nation in save percentage (.932) and eighth in goalsagainst average (1.79).
- The top four goals-against averages among Hockey East goaltenders belong to freshmen.
- Oettinger was also named Hockey East Rookie of the Week on Oct. 24.

PENALTY KILL EXCELS

- The Terriers' penalty kill ranks tied for fifth in the country with a 90.3-percent success rate (56-of-62).
- BU killed off 22 straight opponent power plays, its longest such streak since 25 straight in March 2011, before Northeastern ended last Friday.
- BU has already scored five shorthanded goals after totaling just two all of last season. That total is tied with Bentley for first in the country.

- Down 4-1 entering the third on Friday, BU got goals from sophomore Jordan Greenway and freshman Clayton Keller to make it a onegoal game before Denver hung on for the win.
- Freshman Jake Oettinger made 31 saves in goal for the Terriers while Tanner Jaillet turned aside 23 BU shots for the Pioneers.

DAVID QUINN HEAD COACH

BOSTON UNIVERSITY '89 FOURTH SEASON

Career Record: 63-45-15 (4th season)

One of the most respected hockey coaches in the country, David Quinn enters his fourth season as the head coach at his alma mater, Boston University.

Quinn has led the Terriers to back-to-back appearances in the NCAA tournament (2015, 2016) and orchestrated the biggest turnaround in BU hockey history in 2014-15, including Hockey East and Beanpot titles and a spot in the national title game.

During the 2014-15 campaign, the Terriers enjoyed an 18-win improvement from previous season, marking the fifth-best turnaround in NCAA men's hockey history. BU posted a 28-8-5 record with the .744 winning percentage ranking second in the country. After leading BU to its 30th Beanpot crown, Quinn guided the Terriers to the Hockey East regular-season and tournament titles before earning the No. 3 overall seed in the NCAA tournament.

Quinn became just the fourth men's coach ever to win his first three NCAA tournament games, as the Terriers won the NCAA Northeast Regional before defeating top-ranked North Dakota in the Frozen Four to reach the NCAA title game. He was named runner-up for the Spencer Penrose Award, given annually to the top Division I coach in the nation, and was selected as both the Hockey East and New England Coach of the Year.

In each of the past two seasons, Quinn has coached a pair of Terriers to All-America status. Matt Grzelcyk earned first-team honors in both 2015 and 2016 while Danny O'Regan closed out his career this past spring with second-team accolades. Jack Eichel, a first-team All-American in 2015, became just the second freshman to capture the Hobey Baker Award, given annually to the nation's top player.

The former BU associate head coach and Colorado Avalanche assistant was named the 11th head coach in the storied history of BU hockey on March 26, 2013. Since returning to campus, Quinn and his staff have strengthened the future of the program by securing commitments from some of the very best prospects in North America.

At the 2016 NHL Entry Draft in Buffalo, the Terriers tied an NCAA record with four players being selected in the first round (Clayton Keller, Charlie McAvoy, Dante Fabbro, Kieffer Bellows).

Quinn, who played at BU from 1984-88, replaced his former head coach and mentor, Jack Parker. An All-Hockey East and All-New England defenseman at BU and a co-captain during his senior year of 1987-88, Quinn came back to campus in 2004 to become the team's associate head coach, a role he served in for five seasons

Quinn's recruiting efforts were instrumental in helping build BU's 2009 national championship team. During his time as associate head coach, he worked primarily with the team's defensemen, turning the unit into arguably the best in the nation. All six of the defensemen from the 2009 title squad have reached the National Hockey League.

After helping the Terriers reach the pinnacle of college hockey, Quinn left to join the Avalanche organization as the head coach of its American Hockey League affiliate in Cleveland, the Lake Erie Monsters. He compiled a 115-94-7-20 record



in three seasons with Lake Erie and guided the Monsters to their first-ever playoff berth in 2010-11. He was named an assistant coach on former BU teammate Joe Sacco's staff at Colorado prior to this season.

Quinn's coaching career, which began as an assistant at Northeastern University at 1994, has also been highlighted by several successful stints with USA Hockey. Prior to serving as the Terriers' associate head coach, he spent two years as head coach of the Under-17 Team.

Playing against older opponents, the U17 team qualified for the North American Hockey League playoffs for only the third time in program history, finishing with a record above .500 for the first time ever. The squad owned a 10-3 record in international play, including a first-place finish at the Four Nations Cup in Magnitogorsk, Russia, and at the Under-18 Four Nations Vlado Druzilla in Piestany, Slovakia, where the team played up an age group. For his accomplishments, USA Hockey named Quinn as the 2003 USA Hockey Developmental Coach of the Year.

Quinn's coaching career began prematurely, as it was thought he would enjoy an excellent playing career both on the international and professional levels. A member of the U.S. National Junior Team that captured the bronze medal at the 1986 IIHF World Junior Championship, Quinn made himself a strong candidate for the 1988 and 1992 U.S. Olympic Men's Ice Hockey Teams. In addition, he was the 13th player selected in the 1984 NHL Entry Draft when the Minnesota North Stars made him their first-round selection.

However, his hopes for an Olympic Team berth and a career in the NHL came to an end prior to his senior year at BU when he was diagnosed with a blood disorder called Christmas Disease that ultimately ended his hockey-playing career. After trying to play two seasons of professional hockey, he took the assistant position at Northeastern, where he was responsible for recruiting, off-ice conditioning, scouting and video coordination.

In July 1996, Quinn was named the top assistant coach and head recruiter for the University of Nebraska Omaha. There he helped establish the school's first Division I men's ice hockey program, which began playing during the 1997-98 season.

Quinn then joined the USA Hockey National Team Development Program in Ann Arbor, Mich. The program, designed to prepare student-athletes under the age of 18 for participation on U.S. National Teams and to develop their future hockey careers, focuses its efforts on high-caliber participation on the ice and creating well-rounded individuals off the ice.

Quinn served as an assistant coach for the U.S. National Team at four IIHF World Championships -- two with the men's team (2007, 2012) and two with the women's squad (1999, 2000). He helped the women earn the silver medal at both tournaments and also served as an on-ice assistant at the 2001 U.S. Women's Olympic Trials and as a boys' coach at the 1995 and 1996 USA Hockey Select Festivals. His involvement with the USA Hockey coaching ranks began in 1995, when he served as a member of the coaching staff for the U.S. Women's Select Camp.

A native of Cranston, R.I., Quinn earned a bachelor's degree in sociology from BU in 1989.
