TOP-10 TILT AT AGGANIS

- For the 15th time in the past 21 years, Boston University and Harvard face off on the Tuesday before Thanksgiving.
- The Terriers are playing their third game in five days after splitting a weekend home-and-home series with UConn.



Arena, with Harvard winning a 2-0 contest.

- The two teams have played 23 overtime games and Harvard holds a 10-8-5 edge. There have been 12 shutouts and each team has six to its credit.

HIDEY HO, HARVARD

- BU and Harvard are the closest Division I hockey schools - from rink to rink - in the country. Here are the three closest:
 1. BU-Harvard (1.9 miles)
 2. BU-Northeastern (2.1 miles)
 3. Brown-Providence (2.6 miles)
- While neither have a hockey program, Drexel and Penn are the two closest schools in all of Division I, just about a half-mile apart.

SERIES HISTORY

- BU and Harvard have played 152 times since the 1922-23 season and the Terriers hold a 78-68-6 (.533) advantage.
- In the five meetings at Agganis Arena, Harvard has won three times and BU has won twice.
- The Terriers have won the past two meetings after dropping five straight to the Crimson. That was BU's longest losing streak versus Harvard since dropping nine straight from 1960-64.
- The only teams BU has played more games against have been Boston College (270), Northeastern (229), New Hampshire (177) and Providence (176). Of the above, the only rivalry that is older is BC, as the Eagles and Terriers first played during the 1917-18 season.
- BU and Harvard first met on Dec. 13, 1922, at Boston

SCOUTING THE CRIMSON

- Harvard is coming off a 5-2 home win over Boston College on Friday to rebound from its lone loss of the season, a 4-2 road contest at Quinnipiac on Nov. 12.
- The Crimson opened the year with a weekend sweep at Arizona State before opening conference play at home with a tie against Colgate and a win over Cornell. Harvard also won at Princeton before the loss to the Bobcats.
- Harvard ranks second in the nation in power-play percentage (28.1 %), third in scoring average (4.29) and tied for fourth in scoring defense (2.00).
- Four of the team's top six point-scorers are seniors. Senior Tyler Moy has a squad-best 11 points and is tied with sophomore Lewis Zerter-Gossage for the team lead in goals at five. Sophomore Sean Malone has added nine points (4g, 5a) and four others have tallied eight.
- Junior Merrick Madsen has started every game in goal thus far and sports a .924 save percentage and a 1.85 goals-against average.
- Ted Donato is in his 13th season as head coach at his alma mater and has a even career record of 181-181-46.

LAST SEASON AT BRIGHT-LANDRY

- Down 5-3 late in the third period, Boston University got goals from three seniors in a span of 2:09 to earn a thrilling 6-5 victory at then-No. 4/5 Harvard on Jan. 7, 2016.

• All six goals came from the Terriers' senior class. Matt Lane scored two goals and set-up classmate Ahti Oksanen's game-winner, which gave BU its first and only lead.

• Danny O'Regan scored twice, including the tying goal at 17:06 of the third, to pass his father, Tom, on BU's all-time points list. Captain Matt Grzelcyk started the late rally with a power-play marker with 3:58 remaining on the clock.

• Senior Sean Maguire turned in a 32-save performance to earn the win in goal. Merrick Madsen made 24 saves for Harvard and suffered his first collegiate loss in 10 decisions.

• Harvard held a 29-10 shot advantage through two periods before the Terriers recorded 20 of the 28 shots in the final stanza.

• It was the third 6-5 decision in BU-Harvard games since the start of the 2009-10 season. All three were won by the road team and the other two went to overtime.

HOME-AND-HOME SPLIT WITH UCONN

• BU is coming off a weekend split with Connecticut in which each team won on the road.

• Sophomore Jordan Greenway scored his team-leading sixth goal of the season and freshman Gabriel Chabot tallied his first goal as a Terrier to lead BU to a 2-1 victory on Friday in Hartford.

• Junior goaltender Connor LaCouvee made his first start of the season on Friday and stopped 28 of 29 shots to earn the win.

• On Saturday, the Huskies scored twice in each of the final two periods en route to a 4-0 loss for the Terriers, who held a 37-20 shot advantage.

BLANKING THE COMPETITION

• The Terriers are 5-2-1 in the past eight games

and three of the wins were shutouts.

• The three shutouts came in BU's first three home games, marking the first time in the Terriers' 95-season history that they blanked their first three home opponents.

ROOKIE NETMINDER IMPRESSES

• Freshman Jake Oettinger did his part to excite the Agganis faithful as he put together a home shutout skein of 204:41 to start his career.

• Oettinger was named the Hockey East Stop It Goaltending Co-Goaltender of the Month for October after posting a .947 save percentage and a 1.42 goals-against average in the month.

• He closed out the month with back-to-back shutouts as part of a 134:14 shutout skein that was the sixth-best in program history.

• The top three goals-against averages among Hockey East goaltenders belong to freshmen.

• Oettinger was also named Hockey East Rookie of the Week on Oct. 24.

PENALTY KILL EXCELS

• The Terriers' penalty kill ranks seventh in the nation with a 90.3-percent success rate (65-of-72).

• Earlier this season, BU killed off 22 straight opponent power plays, its longest such streak since 25 straight in March 2011.

• BU has already scored five shorthanded goals after totaling just two all of last season. That total is tied with Bentley and St. Lawrence for first in the country.

LEADING THE PACK

• Freshman Patrick Harper had at least one point in the first seven games of his collegiate career and now has a team-best 15 points on five goals and 10 assists.

- His points-per-game average of 1.36 ranks 15th in the nation and fourth among rookies.
- Harper was named Hockey East Rookie of the Week on Nov. 14 after putting up a goal and two assists in the Terriers' 4-2 victory at Michigan.

TERRIER TIDBITS

- Junior Nikolas Olsson is the only current Terrier who has scored a goal against Harvard.
- Sophomore Jordan Greenway has 12 points (5g, 7a) over the past eight games and he is tied for second in the nation in game-winning goals with three.
- Sophomore Charlie McAvoy has at least one assist in seven of BU's 11 games thus far this season.
- Freshman Clayton Keller is one of nine Division I players with two shorthanded goals this season.
- Over half (17) of BU's 33 goals thus far have come in the third period.
- Junior Brandon Hickey (three) and sophomore Bobo Carpenter (four) have already matched their assist totals from last season.

HOME, SWEET HOME

- The Terriers had a nine-game home winning streak, the longest in Agganis Arena history, come to an end on Saturday.
- It was the longest since a 10-game win streak at Walter Brown Arena that started on Feb. 28, 1997, before ending on Dec. 9 later that year.
- BU is 19-3-2 in its past 24 home contests.
- Last season, the Terriers had the highest home winning percentage in Agganis' 11-year history, posting a 14-2-2 record (.833).

KELLER HONORED

- Freshman Clayton Keller was named the Hockey East Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Week for the second time this season on Nov. 7.
- He scored four points (2g, 2a) in the Terriers' weekend series against Northeastern.

SPLIT IN ANN ARBOR

- Boston University earned a weekend split at then-No. 18 Michigan on Nov. 11-12, as the Terriers earned a 4-2 victory on Saturday after being shut out, 4-0, on Friday.
- Saturday's result marked BU's first win at Yost Ice Arena in seven tries.
- In the opener, Michigan scored on its first two power plays and never looked back, adding an even-strength goal and an empty-netter in the third to record the first regular-season shutout in the teams' all-time series.
- The Terriers held a 30-21 shot advantage on Friday and took 75 shot attempts while allowing only 38.
- In the win on Saturday, sophomores Jordan Greenway and Charlie McAvoy and freshman Patrick Harper each recorded a goal and two assists.
- McAvoy broke a 1-1 tie midway through the third before Greenway gave the Terriers the lead for good at 3-2 with 7:23 left in regulation.
- Harper added an insurance goal on a redirect with just under five minutes to play.
- After Michigan dominated the play in the opening period and took a 1-0 lead into the first

intermission, freshman Dante Fabbro potted a power-play goal at 5:28 of the second to make it a 1-1 contest.

- Oettinger made 27 saves to pick up his fifth win of the year.
- BU committed a season-low three penalties.

WIN & DRAW WITH NORTHEASTERN

- Boston University took three out of four points in a weekend home-and-home series with cross-town rival Northeastern on Nov. 4-5.
- Despite holding three separate one-goal leads in the third period, the Terriers settled for a 4-4 draw with the Huskies on Friday night at Matthews Arena.
- BU rebounded with a 3-0 shutout victory at home on Saturday thanks to a three-goal second period.
- On Friday, freshman Clayton Keller gave the Terriers a 4-3 lead at 15:44 of the third with his second goal of the night but the Huskies potted an extra-attacker goal with 55.6 seconds left to force the third tie of the final stanza and sent the game to overtime.
- Freshman Patrick Harper opened and closed the scoring on Saturday and freshman Jake Oettinger (24 saves) and junior Connor LaCouvee (3) combined for the shutout.

TERRIERS BLANK QUINNIPIAC

- Boston University got a goal from a sophomore in each period and freshman Jake Oettinger saved all 22 shots he faced to earn his second shutout of the year in a 3-0 victory over No. 4/3 Quinnipiac on Oct. 22.
- Sophomore Jakob Forsbacka Karlsson had a hand in all three goals, assisting on the first two before tacking on a shorthanded empty-netter with just under a minute left in regulation.
- The Terriers allowed the Bobcats to have 12 power-play opportunities, but the penalty kill was up to the task each time.
- For the second straight night, Jordan Greenway opened the scoring, capping a give-and-go with Forsbacka Karlsson in transition with a backhander from the slot at 6:11 of the opening period.
- Bobo Carpenter extended the lead to 2-0 halfway through the second period when he converted a slick feed from freshman Patrick Harper. Forsbacka Karlsson added his second helper of the night on the play.
- Junior John MacLeod and sophomore Charlie McAvoy each picked up an assist on the night.
- It marked Quinnipiac's first shutout loss during the regular season in over four years (10/14/12 vs. Robert Morris).
- Oettinger is the first BU netminder since Sean Maguire in March 2013 to post back-to-back shutouts.

IN THE HOME OPENER

- Boston University opened the scoring with goals 20 seconds apart in the first period before tacking on five more in the final stanza to post a 7-0 victory over Sacred Heart in its home opener on Oct. 21.
- Freshman Jake Oettinger made 24 saves to earn his first collegiate shutout while two other rook-

- Sophomore Jordan Greenway earned first-star honors, scoring the game's first goal at the 7:48 mark before earning the primary assist on freshman Clayton Keller's tally 20 seconds later. Greenway added an assist in the third to match his career high in points.
- Senior Nick Roberto also equaled his career-best outing, recording a goal and two assists.
- Freshman Kieffer Bellows also found the back of the net while sophomore Bobo Carpenter capped the night with a shorthanded marker with 1:33 to play.
- This was BU's most decisive shutout victory since an 8-0 rout at Providence on Jan. 21, 2012.
- BU had seven different goal scorers for the first time since a 7-3 triumph over Wisconsin on Oct. 19, 2013.
- Four freshmen found the back of the net, marking the first time that feat has been accomplished by a BU team since Jan. 28, 1992, when Steve Thornton, Rich Brennan, Mike Prendergast and Mike Pomichter (hat trick) each scored.

SWEPT IN DENVER

- The Terriers dropped a pair of contests at then-No. 10 Denver on Oct. 14-15.
- A late comeback effort fell just short on Friday as the Pioneers held on for a 4-3 win.
- On Saturday, Denver broke a 1-1 tie halfway through the third and added an empty-netter for a 3-1 final.
- Down 4-1 entering the third on Friday, BU got goals from sophomore Jordan Greenway and freshman Clayton Keller to make it a one-goal game before Denver hung on for the win.
- Freshman Jake Oettinger made 31 saves in goal for the Terriers while Tanner Jaillet turned aside 23 BU shots for the Pioneers.
- Freshman Kieffer Bellows tied the game at 1-1 on Saturday with his first collegiate goal 43 seconds into the third but Henrik Borgstrom scored his second goal of the night with 9:37 left in to lift the Pioneers to the weekend sweep.
- Both of those goals came on the power play and Denver added an empty-netter from Tyson McLellan with 25 seconds left.
- Oettinger tallied 20 saves for the Terriers while Tanner Jaillet picked up the win in goal with a 24-save performance.

SUCCESSFUL SEASON OPENER

- Freshman Patrick Harper picked up where he left off in the preseason, scoring two goals to help Boston University earn a 6-1 triumph in its season opener at Colgate on Oct. 8.
- Harper opened the scoring on his first official shot as a Terrier – a well-placed shot from the high slot – and added another goal in the second period.
- Playing in his first game since the 2015 national championship, senior Nick Roberto recorded a shorthanded goal with 2:33 remaining in the opening period to give BU a 2-0 lead.
- Rookie Clayton Keller also notched his first collegiate goal in addition to assisting on Harper's

second tally.

- The Terriers scored three goals in a span of 2:13 early in the third to put the game away.
- The fourth line produced BU's fourth goal of the night as freshman Gabriel Chabot found senior Tommy Kelley at the right post at 5:12 of the third.
- Keller got his goal at the left crease, finishing off a great pass by junior Brandon Hickey from the right corner at the 7:06 mark.
- Just 19 seconds later, sophomore Jakob Forsbacka Karlsson potted a goal of a rebound in front to create a 6-0 cushion and cap the three-goal spurt.
- Colgate spoiled freshman Jake Oettinger's shut-out bid with 8:13 remaining in the contest on a goal by Mike Panowyk.
- Oettinger finished the night with 29 saves while Charlie Finn (22) and Bruce Racine (2) combined for 24 stops for the Raiders.
- BU killed off all eight of Colgate's power-play chances and went 1-for-7 with the man advantage with the conversion coming on the first goal of the night, which was a 5-on-3 opportunity. Both teams recorded 30 shots on the night.
- In all, 13 Terriers registered at least one point in the contest.
- The Terriers have now won five of their past six season openers.

- Under David Quinn, BU has had its three lowest penalty-minute averages since the 1973-74 campaign.
- The Terriers averaged 10.6 penalty minutes per game last season after posting 11.4 per contest in 2014-15.
- BU averaged just 10.8 penalty minutes per contest in 2013-14 after averaging at least 15 penalty minutes per game in each of the previous five seasons.
- This season, however, BU has struggled to stay out of the box, averaging 16.5 penalty minutes per game - the 15th-highest total in the country.

ON THE DRAW

- Thanks to a pair of newcomers, BU ranked 11th in the nation in faceoffs last season, winning 53.1 percent of them.
- Freshman Jakob Forsbacka Karlsson ranked fourth among Hockey East players in faceoff percentage, winning his draws at a 59-percent clip. Classmate Bobo Carpenter was 13th in the league (55.0).

Career Record: 65-46-15 (4th season)

One of the most respected hockey coaches in the country, David Quinn enters his fourth season as the head coach at his alma mater, Boston University.

Quinn has led the Terriers to back-to-back appearances in the NCAA tournament (2015, 2016) and orchestrated the biggest turnaround in BU hockey history in 2014-15, including Hockey East and Beanpot titles and a spot in the national title game.

During the 2014-15 campaign, the Terriers enjoyed an 18-win improvement from previous season, marking the fifth-best turnaround in NCAA men's hockey history. BU posted a 28-8-5 record with the .744 winning percentage ranking second in the country. After leading BU to its 30th Beanpot crown, Quinn guided the Terriers to the Hockey East regular-season and tournament titles before earning the No. 3 overall seed in the NCAA tournament.

Quinn became just the fourth men's coach ever to win his first three NCAA tournament games, as the Terriers won the NCAA Northeast Regional before defeating top-ranked North Dakota in the Frozen Four to reach the NCAA title game. He was named runner-up for the Spencer Penrose Award, given annually to the top Division I coach in the nation, and was selected as both the Hockey East and New England Coach of the Year.

In each of the past two seasons, Quinn has coached a pair of Terriers to All-America status. Matt Grzelczyk earned first-team honors in both 2015 and 2016 while Danny O'Regan closed out his career this past spring with second-team accolades. Jack Eichel, a first-team All-American in 2015, became just the second freshman to capture the Hobey Baker Award, given annually to the nation's top player.

The former BU associate head coach and Colorado Avalanche assistant was named the 11th head coach in the storied history of BU hockey on March 26, 2013. Since returning to campus, Quinn and his staff have strengthened the future of the program by securing commitments from some of the very best prospects in North America.

At the 2016 NHL Entry Draft in Buffalo, the Terriers tied an NCAA record with four players being selected in the first round (Clayton Keller, Charlie McAvoy, Dante Fabbro, Kieffer Bellows).

Quinn, who played at BU from 1984-88, replaced his former head coach and mentor, Jack Parker. An All-Hockey East and All-New England defenseman at BU and a co-captain during his senior year of 1987-88, Quinn came back to campus in 2004 to become the team's associate head coach, a role he served in for five seasons.

Quinn's recruiting efforts were instrumental in helping build BU's 2009 national championship team. During his time as associate head coach, he worked primarily with the team's defensemen, turning the unit into arguably the best in the nation. All six of the defensemen from the 2009 title squad have reached the National Hockey League.

After helping the Terriers reach the pinnacle of college hockey, Quinn left to join the Avalanche organization as the head coach of its American Hockey League affiliate in Cleveland, the Lake Erie Monsters. He compiled a 115-94-7-20 record

in three seasons with Lake Erie and guided the Monsters to their first-ever playoff berth in 2010-11. He was named an assistant coach on former BU teammate Joe Sacco's staff at Colorado prior to this season.

Quinn's coaching career, which began as an assistant at Northeastern University at 1994, has also been highlighted by several successful stints with USA Hockey. Prior to serving as the Terriers' associate head coach, he spent two years as head coach of the Under-17 Team.

Playing against older opponents, the U17 team qualified for the North American Hockey League playoffs for only the third time in program history, finishing with a record above .500 for the first time ever. The squad owned a 10-3 record in international play, including a first-place finish at the Four Nations Cup in Magnitogorsk, Russia, and at the Under-18 Four Nations Vlado Druzilla in Piestany, Slovakia, where the team played up an age group. For his accomplishments, USA Hockey named Quinn as the 2003 USA Hockey Developmental Coach of the Year.

Quinn's coaching career began prematurely, as it was thought he would enjoy an excellent playing career both on the international and professional levels. A member of the U.S. National Junior Team that captured the bronze medal at the 1986 IIHF World Junior Championship, Quinn made himself a strong candidate for the 1988 and 1992 U.S. Olympic Men's Ice Hockey Teams. In addition, he was the 13th player selected in the 1984 NHL Entry Draft when the Minnesota North Stars made him their first-round selection.

However, his hopes for an Olympic Team berth and a career in the NHL came to an end prior to his senior year at BU when he was diagnosed with a blood disorder called Christmas Disease that ultimately ended his hockey-playing career. After trying to play two seasons of professional hockey, he took the assistant position at Northeastern, where he was responsible for recruiting, off-ice conditioning, scouting and video coordination.

In July 1996, Quinn was named the top assistant coach and head recruiter for the University of Nebraska Omaha. There he helped establish the school's first Division I men's ice hockey program, which began playing during the 1997-98 season.

Quinn then joined the USA Hockey National Team Development Program in Ann Arbor, Mich. The program, designed to prepare student-athletes under the age of 18 for participation on U.S. National Teams and to develop their future hockey careers, focuses its efforts on high-caliber participation on the ice and creating well-rounded individuals off the ice.

Quinn served as an assistant coach for the U.S. National Team at four IIHF World Championships -- two with the men's team (2007, 2012) and two with the women's squad (1999, 2000). He helped the women earn the silver medal at both tournaments and also served as an on-ice assistant at the 2001 U.S. Women's Olympic Trials and as a boys' coach at the 1995 and 1996 USA Hockey Select Festivals. His involvement with the USA Hockey coaching ranks began in 1995, when he served as a member of the coaching staff for the U.S. Women's Select Camp.

A native of Cranston, R.I., Quinn earned a bachelor's degree in sociology from BU in 1989.

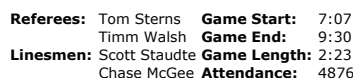
