FIRST-HALF FINALE

- Boston University closes out the first half of its schedule by welcoming Yale to Agganis Arena for the first time in over 10 years.
- The Terriers will attempt to enter the holiday break with at least 10 wins for the fourth time in the past six seasons.

SERIES HISTORY

- Tonight marks the 66th contest between Boston University and Yale, and the teams are an even 31-31-3.
- Five of the past seven meetings have gone to overtime.
- The Bulldogs' last visit to Agganis took place on Nov. 25, 2006, in Keith Allain's first season as head coach. An overtime goal by Matt Gilroy lifted BU to a 2-1 win.
- BU had a nine-game unbeaten streak (7-0-2) against Yale come to an end last season in a 3-2 road loss. The first game in that stretch was the last-ever ECAC tilt between the two schools during the 1983-84 season.
- The teams first met on Feb. 13, 1924, with Yale posting its first of 20 straight victories against the Terriers in a 6-0 shutout on Bishop's Pond in New Haven.
- The two teams have played eight overtime games with BU holding a 4-1-3 edge. There have been 10 shutouts in the series history and each team has five to its credit.

SCOUTING THE BULLDOGS

- Yale is coming off a weekend split at home, having earned a 7-3 home win over Rensselaer on Friday before falling to then No. 14/15 Union, 5-3, on Saturday.
- The Bulldogs earned another win over Rensselaer earlier this season and their other two victories came against

Sacred Heart and Holy Cross.

- Yale is one of the biggest shot generators in the country as its average of 35.5 shots per game ranks third in the nation. The Bulldogs average over nine shots per contest more than their opponents.
- The Bulldogs boast an impressive scoring line of senior John Hayden (9-6--15), sophomore Joe Snively (7-8--15) and junior Ryan Hitchcock (0-12--12). Hayden ranks fourth in the nation in goals per game (0.82) while Hitchcock's 1.09 assists per game ranks sixth.
- Junior Adam Larkin leads the blueliners on the offensive end with nine points on three goals and six assists.
- Senior Patrick Spano has started between the pipes in nine of Yale's 11 games and has a 2.85 goals-against average and a .892 save percentage.
- Keith Allain is in his 11th season as head coach of the Bulldogs and has accumulated 215 wins there.

LAST SEASON IN NEW HAVEN

- Boston University suffered a 3-2 loss at No. 15 Yale on Dec. 11 of last season at Ingalls Rink.
- John Hayden scored two goals, including the winner, for Yale.
- The Terriers opened the scoring 6:55 into the middle period on a goal from Ahti Oksanen
- The tables turned quickly, however, late in the second as Ryan Hitchcock tied it up for Yale at 18:13 and BU's Ryan Cloonan received a five-minute boarding major and game misconduct 50 seconds later.
- It was the first power play for either team and the Bulldogs took advantage of it right away with Hayden cashing in with 20 seconds left in the stanza.

- Hayden added his second of the night on a 3-on-2 rush at 6:31 of the third.
- Bobo Carpenter made it 3-2 but BU but was unable to come up with a late equalizer.

SPLIT IN BURLINGTON

- Boston University is coming off a weekend split at then-No. 12 Vermont, responding to a 4-2 loss on Friday with a 4-0 shutout win on Saturday.
- In the opener, UVM's Tom Forgione knocked home a loose puck in the crease in a delayed-penalty situation to give the home team a 3-2 lead with 12:29 left in the third and the Catamounts tacked on an empty-netter to secure a 4-2 win.
- BU scored a pair of power-play goals, including a strike from freshman Patrick Harper at 2:51 of the middle period to make it a 2-2 contest.
- Sophomore Bobo Carpenter opened the scoring just 3:17 into the contest.
- UVM held a 28-22 shot advantage and limited the Terriers to five third-period shots.
- This marked the Terriers' first loss in Burlington since Feb. 28, 2010, as they had won six straight games in the building.
- On Saturday, freshman Jake Oettinger stopped all 28 shots he faced to earn his first road shutout of his collegiate career.
- After taking a 1-0 lead into the second intermission, BU scored on all three of its shots in the final frame to secure the split.
- Freshman Clayton Keller recorded a power-play goal and an assist while junior Chase Phelps opened the scoring midway through the first.
- Senior Nick Roberto pushed the lead to 3-0 at 16:06 of the third. A long empty-netter by junior Brandon Hickey created the 4-0 final.
- BU, which came into the weekend 1-of-24 on the power play in league play, scored on three of eight chances over the weekend.

PENALTY KILL EXCELS

- The Terriers' penalty kill ranks third in the nation with a 90.8-percent success rate (89-of-98) and has successfully killed off 38 of its opponents' past 41 power plays.
- Earlier this season, BU killed off 22 straight opponent power plays, its longest such streak since 25 straight in March 2011.
- BU has already scored six shorthanded goals after totaling just two all of last season. That total is tied for first in the nation with Harvard.
- The Terriers lead in the nation in combined special teams at 58 percent (102-of-176).

BLANKING THE COMPETITION

- The Terriers are 8-3-2 in their past 13 games and half of the eight wins were shutouts.
- For the first time in the Terriers' 95-season history, they blanked their first three home opponents.

ROOKIE NETMINDER IMPRESSES

- Freshman Jake Oettinger was named Hockey East Rookie of the Week after earning Defensive Player of the Week honors the previous week.
- He has saved 120 of the 126 shots he has faced over the past two weekends.
- He currently ranks fifth in the nation in goals-against average (1.86) and 10th in save percentage (.932).
- Oettinger did his part to excite the Agganis faithful as he put together a home shutout skein of 204:41 to start his career.
- He was named the Hockey East Stop It Goaltending Co-Goaltender of the Month for October after posting a .947 save percentage and a 1.42 goals-against average in the month.
- He closed out the month with back-to-back shutouts as part of a 134:14 shutout skein that

- A record eight Terriers have been named to preliminary rosters for the 2017 World Junior Championship, which will be held Dec. 26 Jan. 5 in Montreal and Toronto.
- BU has seven of the 27 players named to the preliminary roster for the U.S. National Junior Team.
- In all, 12 Hockey East players were among the group that will head to Buffalo for training camp on Dec. 16-20.
- The group of seven Terriers consists of four forwards (Kieffer Bellows, Jordan Greenway, Patrick Harper, Clayton Keller), two defensemen (Chad Krys, Charlie McAvoy) and freshman goaltender Jake Oettinger.
- Freshman Dante Fabbro is one of two NCAA players (North Dakota's Tyson Jost) who was named to Team Canada's 2017 World Junior Selection Camp, which is currently taking place.
- Fabbro will look to become just the third Terrier to play for Canada at World Juniors. The other two Adrian Aucoin in 1993 and Brandon Hickey in 2016 were also defensemen.

- Olsson's goals were his first since the 2015 Hockey East title game. Due to injuries, he missed 32 of the 55 games that had taken place since then.
- Thanks to goals 81 seconds apart in the second period from Jakob Forsbacka Karlsson and Olsson and a career-high 38 saves from Jake Oettinger, BU earned the win in the opener.
- The Terriers' penalty kill was impressive all night, keeping the PC power play scoreless on seven chances, including a five-minute major that was intensified by a 5-on-3 advantage that lasted for 1:40.
- The Friars scored 4:46 into the game and held a commanding 39-18 shot advantage.
- On Saturday in Boston, the Friars took a 2-0 lead into the first intermission only to have the Terriers rally late with goals from Brandon Hickey and Olsson at the 14:50 and 17:11 marks of the third period.
- BU is now undefeated against Providence in the four games (1-0-3) that have taken place since they met in the 2015 NCAA title game.

- The Terriers held a 30-21 shot advantage on Friday and took 75 shot attempts while allowing only 38.

- McAvoy broke a 1-1 tie midway through the third before Greenway gave the Terriers the lead for good at 3-2 with 7:23 left in regulation.
- Harper added an insurance goal on a redirect with just under five minutes to play.
- After Michigan dominated the play in the opening period and took a 1-0 lead into the first intermission, freshman Dante Fabbro potted a power-play goal at 5:28 of the second to make it a 1-1 contest.
- Oettinger made 27 saves to pick up his fifth win of the year.
- BU committed a season-low three penalties.

WIN & DRAW WITH NORTHEASTERN

- Boston University took three out of four points in a weekend home-and-home series with crosstown rival Northeastern on Nov. 4-5.
- Despite holding three separate one-goal leads in the third period, the Terriers settled for a 4-4 draw with the Huskies on Friday at Matthews
- BU rebounded with a 3-0 shutout victory at home on Saturday thanks to a three-goal second period.
- On Friday, freshman Clayton Keller gave the Terriers a 4-3 lead at 15:44 of the third with his second goal of the night but the Huskies potted an extra-attacker goal with 55.6 seconds left to force the third tie of the final stanza and sent the gave to overtime.
- Freshman Patrick Harper opened and closed the scoring on Saturday and freshman Jake Oettinger (24 saves) and junior Connor LaCouvee (3) combined for the shutout.

TERRIERS BLANK QUINNIPIAC

- Boston University got a goal from a sophomore in each period and freshman Jake Oettinger saved all 22 shots he faced to earn his second shutout of the year in a 3-0 victory over No. 4/3 Quinnipiac on Oct. 22.
- Sophomore Jakob Forsbacka Karlsson had a hand in all three goals, assisting on the first two before tacking on a shorthanded empty-netter with just under a minute left in regulation.
- The Terriers allowed the Bobcats to have 12 power-play opportunities, but the penalty kill was up to the task each time.
- For the second straight night, Jordan Greenway opened the scoring, capping a give-and-go with Forsbacka Karlsson in transition with a backhander from the slot at 6:11 of the opening

period.

- Bobo Carpenter extended the lead to 2-0 halfway through the second period when he converted a slick feed from freshman Patrick Harper. Forsbacka Karlsson added his second helper of the night on the play.
- Junior John MacLeod and sophomore Charlie McAvoy each picked up an assist on the night.
- It marked Quinnipiac's first shutout loss during the regular season in over four years (10/14/12 vs. Robert Morris).
- Oettinger became the first BU netminder since Sean Maguire in March 2013 to post back-to-back shutouts.

IN THE HOME OPENER

- Boston University opened the scoring with goals 20 seconds apart in the first period before tacking on five more in the final stanza to post a 7-0 victory over Sacred Heart in its home opener on Oct. 21.
- Freshman Jake Oettinger made 24 saves to earn his first collegiate shutout while two other rookies, defensemen Dante Fabbro and Chad Krys, picked up their first goals as Terriers.
- Sophomore Jordan Greenway earned first-star honors, scoring the game's first goal at the 7:48 mark before earning the primary assist on freshman Clayton Keller's tally 20 seconds later. Greenway added an assist in the third to match his career high in points.
- Senior Nick Roberto also equaled a career high in points, recording a goal and two assists.
- Freshman Kieffer Bellows also found the back of the net while sophomore Bobo Carpenter capped the night with a shorthanded marker with 1:33 to play.
- This was BU's most decisive shutout victory since an 8-0 rout at Providence on Jan. 21, 2012.
- BU had seven different goal scorers for the first time since a 7-3 triumph over Wisconsin on Oct. 19, 2013.
- Four freshmen found the back of the net, marking the first time that feat has been accomplished by a BU team since Jan. 28, 1992, when Steve Thornton, Rich Brennan, Mike Prendergast and Mike Pomichter (hat trick) each scored.

SWEPT IN DENVER

- The Terriers dropped a pair of contests at then-No. 10 Denver on Oct. 14-15.
- A late comeback effort fell just short on Friday as the Pioneers held on for a 4-3 win.
- On Saturday, Denver broke a 1-1 tie halfway through the third and added an empty-netter for a 3-1 final.
- Down 4-1 entering the third on Friday, BU got goals from sophomore Jordan Greenway and freshman Clayton Keller to make it a one-goal game before Denver hung on for the win.
- Freshman Jake Oettinger made 31 saves in goal for the Terriers while Tanner Jaillet turned aside 23 BU shots for the Pioneers.
- Freshman Kieffer Bellows tied the game at 1-1 on Saturday with his first collegiate goal 43 seconds into the third but Henrik Borgstrom scored his second goal of the night with 9:37 left in to lift the Pioneers to the weekend sweep.
- Both of those goals came on the power play

and Denver added an empty-netter from Tyson McLellan with 25 seconds left.

 Oettinger tallied 20 saves for the Terriers while Tanner Jaillet picked up the win in goal with a 24-save performance.

SUCCESSFUL SEASON OPENER

- Freshman Patrick Harper picked up where he left off in the preseason, scoring two goals to help Boston University earn a 6-1 triumph in its season opener at Colgate on Oct. 8.
- Harper opened the scoring on his first official shot as a Terrier and added another goal in the second period.
- Playing in his first game since the 2015 national championship, senior Nick Roberto recorded a shorthanded goal with 2:33 remaining in the opening period to give BU a 2-0 lead.
- Rookie Clayton Keller also notched his first collegiate goal in addition to assisting on Harper's second tally.
- The Terriers scored three goals in a span of 2:13 early in the third to put the game away.
- The fourth line produced BU's fourth goal of the night as freshman Gabriel Chabot found senior Tommy Kelley at the right post at 5:12.
- Keller got his goal at the left crease, finishing off a great pass by junior Brandon Hickey from the right corner at the 7:06 mark.
- Just 19 seconds later, sophomore Jakob Forsbacka Karlsson potted a goal of a rebound in front to create a 6-0 cushion and cap the three-goal spurt.
- Colgate spoiled freshman Jake Oettinger's shutout bid with 8:13 remaining in the contest on a goal by Mike Panowyk.
- Oettinger finished the night with 29 saves while Charlie Finn (22) and Bruce Racine (2) combined for 24 stops for the Raiders.
- BU killed off all eight of Colgate's power-play chances and went 1-for-7 with the man advantage with the conversion coming on the first goal of the night, which was a 5-on-3 opportunity. Both teams recorded 30 shots on the night.
- In all, 13 Terriers registered at least one point in the contest.
- The Terriers have now won five of their past six season openers.

- Freshman goaltender Jake Oettinger is the second-youngest player in the nation, as he won't turn 18 until Dec. 18.

DAVID QUINN HEAD COACH

BOSTON UNIVERSITY '89
FOURTH SEASON

Career Record: 68-47-16 (4th season)

One of the most respected hockey coaches in the country, David Quinn enters his fourth season as the head coach at his alma mater, Boston University.

Quinn has led the Terriers to back-to-back appearances in the NCAA tournament (2015, 2016) and orchestrated the biggest turnaround in BU hockey history in 2014-15, including Hockey East and Beanpot titles and a spot in the national title game.

During the 2014-15 campaign, the Terriers enjoyed an 18-win improvement from previous season, marking the fifth-best turnaround in NCAA men's hockey history. BU posted a 28-8-5 record with the .744 winning percentage ranking second in the country. After leading BU to its 30th Beanpot crown, Quinn guided the Terriers to the Hockey East regular-season and tournament titles before earning the No. 3 overall seed in the NCAA tournament.

Quinn became just the fourth men's coach ever to win his first three NCAA tournament games, as the Terriers won the NCAA Northeast Regional before defeating top-ranked North Dakota in the Frozen Four to reach the NCAA title game. He was named runner-up for the Spencer Penrose Award, given annually to the top Division I coach in the nation, and was selected as both the Hockey East and New England Coach of the Year.

In each of the past two seasons, Quinn has coached a pair of Terriers to All-America status. Matt Grzelcyk earned first-team honors in both 2015 and 2016 while Danny O'Regan closed out his career this past spring with second-team accolades. Jack Eichel, a first-team All-American in 2015, became just the second freshman to capture the Hobey Baker Award, given annually to the nation's top player.

The former BU associate head coach and Colorado Avalanche assistant was named the 11th head coach in the storied history of BU hockey on March 26, 2013. Since returning to campus, Quinn and his staff have strengthened the future of the program by securing commitments from some of the very best prospects in North America.

At the 2016 NHL Entry Draft in Buffalo, the Terriers tied an NCAA record with four players being selected in the first round (Clayton Keller, Charlie McAvoy, Dante Fabbro, Kieffer Bellows).

Quinn, who played at BU from 1984-88, replaced his former head coach and mentor, Jack Parker. An All-Hockey East and All-New England defenseman at BU and a co-captain during his senior year of 1987-88, Quinn came back to campus in 2004 to become the team's associate head coach, a role he served in for five

Quinn's recruiting efforts were instrumental in helping build BU's 2009 national championship team. During his time as associate head coach, he worked primarily with the team's defensemen, turning the unit into arguably the best in the nation. All six of the defensemen from the 2009 title squad have reached the National Hockey League.

After helping the Terriers reach the pinnacle of college hockey, Quinn left to join the Avalanche organization as the head coach of its American Hockey League affiliate in Cleveland, the Lake Erie Monsters. He compiled a 115-94-7-20 record



in three seasons with Lake Erie and guided the Monsters to their first-ever playoff berth in 2010-11. He was named an assistant coach on former BU teammate Joe Sacco's staff at Colorado prior to this season.

Quinn's coaching career, which began as an assistant at Northeastern University at 1994, has also been highlighted by several successful stints with USA Hockey. Prior to serving as the Terriers' associate head coach, he spent two years as head coach of the Under-17 Team.

Playing against older opponents, the U17 team qualified for the North American Hockey League playoffs for only the third time in program history, finishing with a record above .500 for the first time ever. The squad owned a 10-3 record in international play, including a first-place finish at the Four Nations Cup in Magnitogorsk, Russia, and at the Under-18 Four Nations Vlado Druzilla in Piestany, Slovakia, where the team played up an age group. For his accomplishments, USA Hockey named Quinn as the 2003 USA Hockey Developmental Coach of the Year.

Quinn's coaching career began prematurely, as it was thought he would enjoy an excellent playing career both on the international and professional levels. A member of the U.S. National Junior Team that captured the bronze medal at the 1986 IIHF World Junior Championship, Quinn made himself a strong candidate for the 1988 and 1992 U.S. Olympic Men's Ice Hockey Teams. In addition, he was the 13th player selected in the 1984 NHL Entry Draft when the Minnesota North Stars made him their first-round selection.

However, his hopes for an Olympic Team berth and a career in the NHL came to an end prior to his senior year at BU when he was diagnosed with a blood disorder called Christmas Disease that ultimately ended his hockey-playing career. After trying to play two seasons of professional hockey, he took the assistant position at Northeastern, where he was responsible for recruiting, off-ice conditioning, scouting and video coordination.

In July 1996, Quinn was named the top assistant coach and head recruiter for the University of Nebraska Omaha. There he helped establish the school's first Division I men's ice hockey program, which began playing during the 1997-98 season.

Quinn then joined the USA Hockey National Team Development Program in Ann Arbor, Mich. The program, designed to prepare student-athletes under the age of 18 for participation on U.S. National Teams and to develop their future hockey careers, focuses its efforts on high-caliber participation on the ice and creating well-rounded individuals off the ice.

Quinn served as an assistant coach for the U.S. National Team at four IIHF World Championships -- two with the men's team (2007, 2012) and two with the women's squad (1999, 2000). He helped the women earn the silver medal at both tournaments and also served as an on-ice assistant at the 2001 U.S. Women's Olympic Trials and as a boys' coach at the 1995 and 1996 USA Hockey Select Festivals. His involvement with the USA Hockey coaching ranks began in 1995, when he served as a member of the coaching staff for the U.S. Women's Select Camp.

A native of Cranston, R.I., Quinn earned a bachelor's degree in sociology from BU in 1989.
