ROAD TRIP

- Looking to stay undefeated in December, Boston University heads north for a weekend Hockey East series with Vermont.
- This weekend marks the final road games of BU's first half as the Terriers won't leave Boston for a game again until they visit Boston College on Jan. 16.
- The Terriers have one loss or fewer in their first six Hockey East contests for just the fourth time since 2000 (2014-15, 2011-12, 2004-05).

SERIES HISTORY

- The Terriers and Catamounts have played 76 times since the 1971-72 season, with BU holding a 45-23-8 (.645) advantage.
- BU is 11-3-1 in the past 15 meetings.
- The Terriers are 19-9-4 (.656) in the 32 meetings that have taken place at Gutterson Fieldhouse.
- From 1974-84, the teams shared time in the ECAC, with BU posting a 13-4-1 record against the Catamounts during the span.
- Since the Catamounts joined Hockey East in 2005, the teams have met 35 times and BU holds an 18-12-5 advantage in those contests.
- Fifteen of the games in the all-time series have gone into overtime, and the Terriers are unbeaten (7-0-8) in those decisions.

SCOUTING THE CATAMOUNTS

 Vermont took last weekend off after most recently claiming the Friendship Four title in Belfast, North Ireland, with wins over Quinnipiac and Massachusetts.

- The Catamounts are on a six-game unbeaten streak (5-0-1) and are 3-1-1 at home this season.
- Vermont's defense ranks sixth in the country, allowing just 2.14 goals per game.
- The Catamounts are getting strong contributions from their freshman class both in goal and on the score-
- Freshman Stefanos Lekkas is 8-1-2 in goal with a .940 save percentage that ranks third in the nation. His 1.72 goals-against average is good for fourth.
- Fellow rookie Ross Colton leads the squad in both points (12) and assists (6) and shares the team lead in goals at six with sophomore Craig Puffer.
- Puffer (6g, 4a) and senior Mario Puskarich (5g, 5a) have each contributed 10 points while three others have added eight.
- In all, 25 UVM players have recorded at least one point this season. That total trails only Western Michigan (26).
- Kevin Sneddon is in his 14th season as head coach of the Catamounts and 213 of his 263 career victories have come at UVM.

LAST YEAR'S SERIES (Dec. 4-5, 2015)

- BU and Vermont split their series last season at Agganis Arena with the visiting Catamounts taking a 4-2 win in the opener before the Terriers answered with a 5-3 victory the following night.
- The losing team opened the scoring both nights.
- In the opener, Vermont answered an early Tommy

• On Saturday, the Catamounts had a 2-0 lead less than 11 minutes into the game, but the Terriers scored five of the next six goals, including Brandon Hickey's game-winner on the power play with 2:24 left in regulation.

OLSSON HELPS BU TAKE THREE OF FOUR VS. PC

- Thanks to two big goals from junior Nikolas Olsson, the Terriers took three of four points from Providence last weekend in a home-and-home series.
- Returning from injury, Olsson scored the game-winning goal in a 2-1 road win on Friday before adding the game-tying tally in a 2-2 draw at Agganis Arena on Saturday.
- Olsson's goals were his first since the 2015 Hockey East title game. Due to injuries, he missed 32 of the 55 games that had taken place since then.
- Thanks to goals 81 seconds apart in the second period from Jakob Forsbacka Karlsson and Olsson and a career-high 38 saves from Jake Oettinger, BU earned the win in the opener.
- The Terriers' penalty kill was impressive all night, keeping the PC power play scoreless on seven chances, including a five-minute major that was intensified by a 5-on-3 advantage that lasted for 1:40.
- The Friars scored 4:46 into the game and held a commanding 39-18 shot advantage.
- On Saturday in Boston, the Friars took a 2-0 lead into the first intermission only to have the Terriers rally late with goals from Brandon Hickey and Olsson at the 14:50 and 17:11 marks of the third period.

• BU is now undefeated against Providence in the four games (1-0-3) that have taken place since they met in the 2015 NCAA title game.

PENALTY KILL EXCELS

- The Terriers' penalty kill ranks third in the nation with a 91.1-percent success rate (82-of-90) and has successfully killed off 31 of its opponents' past 33 power plays.
- Earlier this season, BU killed off 22 straight opponent power plays, its longest such streak since 25 straight in March 2011.
- BU has already scored five shorthanded goals after totaling just two all of last season. That total is tied for second in the country.

BLANKING THE COMPETITION

- The Terriers are 8-2-1 in their past 11 games and three of the wins were shutouts.
- The three shutouts came in BU's first three home games, marking the first time in the Terriers' 95-season history that they blanked their first three home opponents.

ROOKIE NETMINDER IMPRESSES

- Freshman Jake Oettinger was named Hockey East Defensive Player of the Week on Monday after stopping 68 of 71 shots in the series against Providence.
- He currently ranks seventh in the nation in goals-against average (1.92) and ninth in save percentage (.930).
- This weekend's series pits the top two goaltenders in Hockey East statistically and they are both freshmen. UVM's Stefanos Lekkas leads league goaltenders in both goals-against average (1.72) and save percentage (.940).
- Oettinger did his part to excite the Agganis



GREAT EIGHT

- A record eight Terriers have been named to preliminary rosters for the 2017 World Junior Championship, which will be held Dec. 26 Jan. 5 in Montreal and Toronto.
- BU has seven of the 27 players named to the preliminary roster for the U.S. National Junior Team.
- In all, 12 Hockey East players were among the group that will head to Buffalo for training camp on Dec. 16-20.
- The group of seven Terriers consists of four forwards (Kieffer Bellows, Jordan Greenway, Patrick Harper, Clayton Keller), two defensemen (Chad Krys, Charlie McAvoy) and freshman goaltender Jake Oettinger.
- Freshman Dante Fabbro is one of two NCAA players (North Dakota's Tyson Jost) who was named to Team Canada's 2017 World Junior Selection Camp, which will be held Dec. 10-14.
- Fabbro will look to become just the third Terrier to play for Canada at World Juniors. The other two Adrian Aucoin in 1993 and Brandon Hickey in 2016 were also defensemen.
- The record for the highest number of BU players participating at a World Junior Championship is five, achieved three times, including last year when McAvoy and Krys were on Team USA with Brandon Fortunato, Hickey was playing for Canada and Jakob Forsbcaka Karlsson become the first Terrier to play for Sweden in the WJC.

- His points-per-game average of 1.21 ranks sixth in the nation among rookies.
- Harper was named Hockey East Rookie of the Week on Nov. 14 after putting up a goal and two assists in the Terriers' 4-2 victory at Michigan.

TERRIER TIDBITS

- Seniors Tommy Kelley and Nick Roberto and junior Brandon Hickey are the only current Terriers who have scored a goal against Vermont.
- Sophomore Jordan Greenway, who recorded three assists in last year's series with the Catamounts, has 13 points (5g, 8a) in his past 10 games and he is tied for second in the nation in game-winning goals with three.
- Sophomore Charlie McAvoy has at least one as-

sist in 10 of BU's 14 games thus far this season.

- Freshman Clayton Keller is one of 15 Division I players with two shorthanded goals this season.
- Half (21) of BU's 42 goals thus far have come in the third period.
- Junior Brandon Hickey (four) and sophomore Bobo Carpenter (five) have already surpassed their assist totals from last season.

HOME, SWEET HOME

- The Terriers had a nine-game home winning streak, the longest in Agganis Arena history, come to an end on Nov. 19 against UConn.

- Saturday's result marked BU's first win at Yost Ice Arena in seven tries.
- In the opener, Michigan scored on its first two power plays and never looked back, adding an even-strength goal and an empty-netter in the third to record the first regular-season shutout in the teams' all-time series.
- The Terriers held a 30-21 shot advantage on Friday and took 75 shot attempts while allowing only 38.
- In the win on Saturday, sophomores Jordan Greenway and Charlie McAvoy and freshman Patrick Harper each recorded a goal and two
- McAvoy broke a 1-1 tie midway through the third before Greenway gave the Terriers the lead for good at 3-2 with 7:23 left in regula-
- Harper added an insurance goal on a redirect with just under five minutes to play.
- After Michigan dominated the play in the opening period and took a 1-0 lead into the first intermission, freshman Dante Fabbro potted a power-play goal at 5:28 of the second to make it a 1-1 contest.

- Oettinger made 27 saves to pick up his fifth win of the year.
- BU committed a season-low three penalties.

WIN & DRAW WITH NORTHEASTERN

- Boston University took three out of four points in a weekend home-and-home series with crosstown rival Northeastern on Nov. 4-5.
- Despite holding three separate one-goal leads in the third period, the Terriers settled for a 4-4 draw with the Huskies on Friday at Matthews
- BU rebounded with a 3-0 shutout victory at home on Saturday thanks to a three-goal second period.
- On Friday, freshman Clayton Keller gave the Terriers a 4-3 lead at 15:44 of the third with his second goal of the night but the Huskies potted an extra-attacker goal with 55.6 seconds left to force the third tie of the final stanza and sent the gave to overtime.
- Freshman Patrick Harper opened and closed the scoring on Saturday and freshman Jake Oettinger (24 saves) and junior Connor LaCouvee (3) combined for the shutout.

TERRIERS BLANK QUINNIPIAC

- Boston University got a goal from a sophomore in each period and freshman Jake Oettinger saved all 22 shots he faced to earn his second shutout of the year in a 3-0 victory over No. 4/3 Quinnipiac on Oct. 22.
- Sophomore Jakob Forsbacka Karlsson had a hand in all three goals, assisting on the first two before tacking on a shorthanded empty-netter with just under a minute left in regulation.
- The Terriers allowed the Bobcats to have 12 power-play opportunities, but the penalty kill was up to the task each time.
- For the second straight night, Jordan Greenway opened the scoring, capping a give-and-go with Forsbacka Karlsson in transition with a backhander from the slot at 6:11 of the opening
- Bobo Carpenter extended the lead to 2-0 halfway through the second period when he converted a slick feed from freshman Patrick Harper. Forsbacka Karlsson added his second helper of the night on the play.
- Junior John MacLeod and sophomore Charlie McAvoy each picked up an assist on the night.
- It marked Quinnipiac's first shutout loss during the regular season in over four years (10/14/12 vs. Robert Morris).
- Oettinger became the first BU netminder since Sean Maquire in March 2013 to post back-toback shutouts.

IN THE HOME OPENER

- Boston University opened the scoring with goals 20 seconds apart in the first period before tacking on five more in the final stanza to post a 7-0 victory over Sacred Heart in its home opener on Oct. 21.
- Freshman Jake Oettinger made 24 saves to earn his first collegiate shutout while two other rookies, defensemen Dante Fabbro and Chad Krys, picked up their first goals as Terriers.

- Sophomore Jordan Greenway earned first-star honors, scoring the game's first goal at the 7:48 mark before earning the primary assist on freshman Clayton Keller's tally 20 seconds later. Greenway added an assist in the third to match his career high in points.
- Senior Nick Roberto also equaled a career high in points, recording a goal and two assists.
- Freshman Kieffer Bellows also found the back of the net while sophomore Bobo Carpenter capped the night with a shorthanded marker with 1:33 to play.
- This was BU's most decisive shutout victory since an 8-0 rout at Providence on Jan. 21, 2012.
- BU had seven different goal scorers for the first time since a 7-3 triumph over Wisconsin on Oct. 19, 2013.
- Four freshmen found the back of the net, marking the first time that feat has been accomplished by a BU team since Jan. 28, 1992, when Steve Thornton, Rich Brennan, Mike Prendergast and Mike Pomichter (hat trick) each scored.

SWEPT IN DENVER

- The Terriers dropped a pair of contests at then-No. 10 Denver on Oct. 14-15.
- A late comeback effort fell just short on Friday as the Pioneers held on for a 4-3 win.
- On Saturday, Denver broke a 1-1 tie halfway through the third and added an empty-netter for a 3-1 final.
- Down 4-1 entering the third on Friday, BU got goals from sophomore Jordan Greenway and freshman Clayton Keller to make it a one-goal game before Denver hung on for the win.
- Freshman Jake Oettinger made 31 saves in goal for the Terriers while Tanner Jaillet turned aside 23 BU shots for the Pioneers.
- Freshman Kieffer Bellows tied the game at 1-1 on Saturday with his first collegiate goal 43 seconds into the third but Henrik Borgstrom scored his second goal of the night with 9:37 left in to lift the Pioneers to the weekend sweep.
- Both of those goals came on the power play and Denver added an empty-netter from Tyson McLellan with 25 seconds left.
- Oettinger tallied 20 saves for the Terriers while Tanner Jaillet picked up the win in goal with a 24-save performance.

SUCCESSFUL SEASON OPENER

- Freshman Patrick Harper picked up where he left off in the preseason, scoring two goals to help Boston University earn a 6-1 triumph in its season opener at Colgate on Oct. 8.
- Harper opened the scoring on his first official shot as a Terrier and added another goal in the second period.
- Playing in his first game since the 2015 national championship, senior Nick Roberto recorded a shorthanded goal with 2:33 remaining in the opening period to give BU a 2-0 lead.
- Rookie Clayton Keller also notched his first collegiate goal in addition to assisting on Harper's second tally.

- The Terriers scored three goals in a span of 2:13 early in the third to put the game away.
- The fourth line produced BU's fourth goal of the night as freshman Gabriel Chabot found senior Tommy Kelley at the right post at 5:12.
- Keller got his goal at the left crease, finishing off a great pass by junior Brandon Hickey from the right corner at the 7:06 mark.
- Just 19 seconds later, sophomore Jakob Forsbacka Karlsson potted a goal of a rebound in front to create a 6-0 cushion and cap the threeqoal spurt.
- Colgate spoiled freshman Jake Oettinger's shutout bid with 8:13 remaining in the contest on a goal by Mike Panowyk.
- Oettinger finished the night with 29 saves while Charlie Finn (22) and Bruce Racine (2) combined for 24 stops for the Raiders.
- BU killed off all eight of Colgate's power-play chances and went 1-for-7 with the man advantage with the conversion coming on the first goal of the night, which was a 5-on-3 opportunity. Both teams recorded 30 shots on the night.
- In all, 13 Terriers registered at least one point in the contest.
- The Terriers have now won five of their past six season openers.

- Under David Quinn, BU has had its three lowest penalty-minute averages since the 1973-74 campaign.
- The Terriers averaged 10.6 penalty minutes per game last season after posting 11.4 per contest in 2014-15.
- BU averaged just 10.8 penalty minutes per contest in 2013-14 after averaging at least 15 penalty minutes per game in each of the previous five seasons.
- This season, however, BU has struggled to stay out of the box, averaging 16.9 penalty minutes per game the 12th-highest total in the country.

DAVID QUINN HEAD COACH BOSTON UNIVERSITY '89

FOURTH SEASON



Career Record: 67-46-16 (4th season)

One of the most respected hockey coaches in the country, David Quinn enters his fourth season as the head coach at his alma mater, Boston University.

Quinn has led the Terriers to back-to-back appearances in the NCAA tournament (2015, 2016) and orchestrated the biggest turnaround in BU hockey history in 2014-15, including Hockey East and Beanpot titles and a spot in the national title game.

During the 2014-15 campaign, the Terriers enjoyed an 18-win improvement from previous season, marking the fifth-best turnaround in NCAA men's hockey history. BU posted a 28-8-5 record with the .744 winning percentage ranking second in the country. After leading BU to its 30th Beanpot crown, Quinn guided the Terriers to the Hockey East regular-season and tournament titles before earning the No. 3 overall seed in the NCAA tournament.

Quinn became just the fourth men's coach ever to win his first three NCAA tournament games, as the Terriers won the NCAA Northeast Regional before defeating top-ranked North Dakota in the Frozen Four to reach the NCAA title game. He was named runner-up for the Spencer Penrose Award, given annually to the top Division I coach in the nation, and was selected as both the Hockey East and New England Coach of the Year.

In each of the past two seasons, Quinn has coached a pair of Terriers to All-America status. Matt Grzelcyk earned first-team honors in both 2015 and 2016 while Danny O'Regan closed out his career this past spring with second-team accolades. Jack Eichel, a first-team All-American in 2015, became just the second freshman to capture the Hobey Baker Award, given annually to the nation's top player.

The former BU associate head coach and Colorado Avalanche assistant was named the 11th head coach in the storied history of BU hockey on March 26, 2013. Since returning to campus, Quinn and his staff have strengthened the future of the program by securing commitments from some of the very best prospects in North America.

At the 2016 NHL Entry Draft in Buffalo, the Terriers tied an NCAA record with four players being selected in the first round (Clayton Keller, Charlie McAvoy, Dante Fabbro, Kieffer Bellows).

Quinn, who played at BU from 1984-88, replaced his former head coach and mentor, Jack Parker. An All-Hockey East and All-New England defenseman at BU and a co-captain during his senior year of 1987-88, Quinn came back to campus in 2004 to become the team's associate head coach, a role he served in for five seasons

Quinn's recruiting efforts were instrumental in helping build BU's 2009 national championship team. During his time as associate head coach, he worked primarily with the team's defensemen, turning the unit into arguably the best in the nation. All six of the defensemen from the 2009 title squad have reached the National Hockey League.

After helping the Terriers reach the pinnacle of college hockey, Quinn left to join the Avalanche organization as the head coach of its American Hockey League affiliate in Cleveland, the Lake Erie Monsters. He compiled a 115-94-7-20 record

in three seasons with Lake Erie and guided the Monsters to their first-ever playoff berth in 2010-11. He was named an assistant coach on former BU teammate Joe Sacco's staff at Colorado prior to this season.

Quinn's coaching career, which began as an assistant at Northeastern University at 1994, has also been highlighted by several successful stints with USA Hockey. Prior to serving as the Terriers' associate head coach, he spent two years as head coach of the Under-17 Team.

Playing against older opponents, the U17 team qualified for the North American Hockey League playoffs for only the third time in program history, finishing with a record above .500 for the first time ever. The squad owned a 10-3 record in international play, including a first-place finish at the Four Nations Cup in Magnitogorsk, Russia, and at the Under-18 Four Nations Vlado Druzilla in Piestany, Slovakia, where the team played up an age group. For his accomplishments, USA Hockey named Quinn as the 2003 USA Hockey Developmental Coach of the Year.

Quinn's coaching career began prematurely, as it was thought he would enjoy an excellent playing career both on the international and professional levels. A member of the U.S. National Junior Team that captured the bronze medal at the 1986 IIHF World Junior Championship, Quinn made himself a strong candidate for the 1988 and 1992 U.S. Olympic Men's Ice Hockey Teams. In addition, he was the 13th player selected in the 1984 NHL Entry Draft when the Minnesota North Stars made him their first-round selection.

However, his hopes for an Olympic Team berth and a career in the NHL came to an end prior to his senior year at BU when he was diagnosed with a blood disorder called Christmas Disease that ultimately ended his hockey-playing career. After trying to play two seasons of professional hockey, he took the assistant position at Northeastern, where he was responsible for recruiting, off-ice conditioning, scouting and video coordination.

In July 1996, Quinn was named the top assistant coach and head recruiter for the University of Nebraska Omaha. There he helped establish the school's first Division I men's ice hockey program, which began playing during the 1997-98 season.

Quinn then joined the USA Hockey National Team Development Program in Ann Arbor, Mich. The program, designed to prepare student-athletes under the age of 18 for participation on U.S. National Teams and to develop their future hockey careers, focuses its efforts on high-caliber participation on the ice and creating well-rounded individuals off the ice.

Quinn served as an assistant coach for the U.S. National Team at four IIHF World Championships -- two with the men's team (2007, 2012) and two with the women's squad (1999, 2000). He helped the women earn the silver medal at both tournaments and also served as an on-ice assistant at the 2001 U.S. Women's Olympic Trials and as a boys' coach at the 1995 and 1996 USA Hockey Select Festivals. His involvement with the USA Hockey coaching ranks began in 1995, when he served as a member of the coaching staff for the U.S. Women's Select Camp.

A native of Cranston, R.I., Quinn earned a bachelor's degree in sociology from BU in 1989.
