2019-20 BOSTON UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

BOSTON

THE STORYLINE

- With four games left in the non-conference slate, the Boston University women's basketball team will open up a four-game homestand to close the semester, first welcoming UMass for Education Day on Wednesday, Dec. 11.
- Opening tip from Case Gym is set for 11 a.m.

LAST TIME OUT

- BU battled tough with Cal, but dropped a 73-62 decision Saturday in Berkeley.
- Sydney Johnson led all players with a 19-point effort.
- Katie Nelson had a stellar all-around game, leading the team with nine rebounds and seven assists, and followed Johnson with 14 points.
- Nelson's nine rebounds set a new career high, while her seven assists were one short of setting a new career best.
- BU was able to get within a seven-point margin six times over the final 6:30 of play, but couldn't get over the edge as dropped its second straight road contest.

PINA PROOF

- Maggie Pina has led the Terriers in scoring in two of the last three games, posting 12 points against Harvard before dropping a season-high 22 points at UC Davis.
- Pina is the top scoring option off the bench (6.9) and is averaging 30.0 minutes over the last three games after averaging 10.25 minutes through the first three games.
- Additionally, she is averaging 13.3 points per game over the last three games after posting 2.0 points per game through the first four contests.

CHASE TO 1K

- Nia Irving surpassed 900 career points at Albany and is now just 68 points away from becoming the 23rd Terrier to reach the 1,000-career points milestone.
- The senior currently ranks 23rd all-time in scoring with 932 career points.
- Irving would become the first Terrier since Rashidat Agboola '14 to eclipse the 1K milestone.

IN THE POST

- Nia Irving leads the team in scoring (12.4) and is tied for the team leading in rebounding (6.0) with Riley Childs.
- Irving is efficient in the post as she has shot above .600 percent in three games this season.

FINDING HER SHOT

- Katie Nelson has found her stroke over the last two games, notching a pair of double-digit scoring efforts at UC Davis (20) and Cal (14).
- She went 11-for-22 (.500) from the floor and 7-for-13 (.538)

from 3-point range in California.

- Furthermore, she has filled out the stat sheet with an average of 7.0 rebounds and 6.5 assists over the last two games.

MINUTES MACHINE

- Prior to the Harvard game, Katie Nelson was the only student-athlete in the NCAA to play every minute of every game.
- The junior has played in 274 minutes this season and leads the team in assists per game (4.1) and ranks second in scoring average (12.3).
- Nelson has missed just 231 of a possible 2,400 career minutes over her first three

years.

ADDING DEPTH

- BU's bench has chipped in 22.3 points per game over the last three games, notching at least 18 points in each contest.
- Over the first four games, the bench added just 7.0 points per game and had posted double-digits just once in a 12-point effort at New Hampshire.
- Chiara Tibbitt led the charge in the most recent outing at Cal, notching eight points on 4-of-5 shooting.
- Maren Durant is the top rebounder off the bench (3.1) and has scored in all seven games.

20-POINT CLUB

- BU has seen four different 20-point scorers in each of its first seven games.
- Sydney Johnson notched 21 in the opener against Marist, Childs followed with her own 21-point outing at New Hampshire before Irving dropped 20 against Maine.
- Maggie Pina (22) and Katie Nelson (20) each surpassed the mark at UC Davis.

THE KIDS ARE ALL RIGHT

- Freshman Sydney Johnson has started in all seven games, while Maren Durant and Maggie Pina have come off the bench in each.
- Johnson is the leading rookie scorer in the Patriot League (11.6) and ranks 14th overall among league leaders in scoring average.
- Johnson is also tied for fourth in the Patriot League with 2.3 steals per game.

STARTING FIVE

- BU's primary starting rotation of Riley Childs, Nia Irving, Sydney Johnson, Annabelle Larnard and Katie Nelson accounted for 80.1 percent (306-of-382) of the team's point total through the first five games.
- Additionally, that lineup played 80.5 percent of the minutes through the first five games.
- Larnard missed the last two games due to injury, giving way for Tenisha Pressley to make her first career starts.

ROAD WARRIORS

- BU got off to its first 3-0 start in road games since the 2006-07 season.
- The Terriers went 0-6 in road non-conference games last season.

NO KIDDING AROUND

- Riley Childs was stellar at New Hampshire, going 9-for-12 from the floor and 2-for-2 from distance as part of a career-high 21 points.
- Childs has been pushing her game past the perimeter this season, as she has three 3-pointers after connecting on six last season.
- The sophomore currently ranks second on the team in rebounding (6.0) and ranks fourth in scoring (8.8).

ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

- Freshman Sydney Johnson made history in the season opener against Marist, scoring a team-high 21 points in her debut, the most points a Terrier freshman has scored since 1977, and was named the Patriot League Rookie of the Week on Nov. 11.
- Playing against the MAAC preseason favorites, Johnson also led the Terriers with four assists and played all but two minutes.
- Johnson overcame a 1-of-7 start from the floor to go 6-for-11 from the field and 3-of-5 from deep in the second half.

SCOUTING UMASS

- UMass has won six of its last seven to boost its record to 6-3 overall.
- Freshman Maeve Donnelly swatted a single-game program record 10 shots and added in 12 rebounds, while four different Minutewomen notched double-digit scoring efforts to pace a 75-72 victory over Holy Cross on Sunday.
- Hailey Leidel is the top scoring option (16.6) and has four 20-point games.
- Destiny Philoxy follows in scoring (15.0) and leads the team with 4.8 assists per game.
- The Minutewomen have used the same starting five in all nine games, with that group contributing 75.8 percent of the team's scoring total (505-of-666).
- Head coach Tori Verdi is in his fourth season at the helm of the program and is coming off a 16-win season, the most wins UMass has posted since the 2006-07 season.

THE SERIES

- UMass took last season's matchup in Amherst to even the series at 15-all.
- Neither team has won more than two straight games since BU won three straight from 1981-91.

WHERE WE LEFT OFF

- BU recorded its first winning season in five years, finishing at 15-14, which included an 11-7 mark in conference games to match its best regular season record in Patriot League games.
- The Terriers hosted a Patriot League Tournament quarterfinal game for the first time, though it fell to Holy Cross, 72-70.

PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

- BU earned its highest selection in the Patriot League preseason poll in being selected fourth.
- This is the highest selection for the Terriers since the 2013-14 season, its last as a member of the America East, where they were predicted to finish third.

ADDING TO THE RESUME

- Reigning Patriot League Coach of the Year Marisa Moseley is in her second season guiding the Terriers.
- Moseley is the first Patriot League Coach of the Year in program history, and was just the second coach in the program's 43-year history to be named the conference coach of the year.
- Furthermore, Moseley became the first first-year head coach of the Terriers to post a winning record since JoAnn O'Callaghan went 18-9 during the 1979-80 season.

LEADERS OF THE PACK

- Riley Childs, Vanessa Edgehill, Nia Irving and Katie Nelson will serve as captains for the 2019-20 season.
- Childs is in position to be the first three-year captain since Corrine Williams '18.

GOLDEN MILES

- BU played California for the first time since 2003 in December, where it squared off against UC Davis and Cal Berkeley.

WELCOME TO BOSTON

- BU will rely on five freshmen in Maren Durant, Maggie Pina, Sydney Johnson, Annabelle Larnard and Liz Shean to make an impact.
- Redshirt sophomore Emily Esposito is also on the roster for the 2019-20 season following transferring from Villanova, where she played in all 32 games as a redshirt freshman last year.
- The five-member rookie class is BU's largest incoming class since the 2009-10 season.

LEADING THE WAY

- Nia Irving led the Terriers in rebounding (8.5) for the second straight season and is the team's leading returning scorer (11.8).

- The All-Patriot League Second Team honoree produced eight double-doubles last season caught fire down the stretch, scoring in double figures in 20 of the final 25 games.
- The senior is an efficient scorer, owning a career .465 field goal percentage and shot above .500 percent 14 times during the 2018-19 campaign.

BACK FOR MORE

- BU returns 52.4 percent of its scoring from last season, highlighted by Irving (11.8) and Nelson (10.3).
- This is the first since the 2012-13 campaign where the Terriers will return two student-athletes who averaged double-digits scoring figures.
- The trio of Riley Childs, Irving and Nelson accounted for 46.3 percent of the team's scoring last year, and represent 88.3 percent (791-of-895) of the returning scoring total.

AT THE POINT

- Katie Nelson led team with 3.7 assists per game last season, good for third among league leaders.
- The sophomore has started all 58 games of her career.
- A threat from deep, she ranked sixth in the Patriot League in 3-pointers per game (1.8).
- The Falmouth, Massachusetts native heated up offensively in the second half of the season, recording double-digit scoring figures in 11 of the last 18 games after scoring in double figures four times through the first 10 games.

CLOCKING IN

- Katie Nelson has led the Patriot League in minutes in both her freshman (34.8) and sophomore (38.3) season.
- Nelson played every second in 11 games last season and missed just 225 of a possible 2,335 career minutes over her first two years.

SUDDENT IMPACT

- Riley Childs asserted herself into the starting lineup down the stretch of the season en route to being named to the Patriot League All-Rookie squad.
- Childs was the second-leading freshman in the Patriot League in rebounding with 7.2 boards per game, and posted two double-doubles over the last five games of the regular season.

TURNING IT AROUND

- BU posted a winning season for the first time since the 2012-13 season last year.
- The Terriers also swept four Patriot League opponents (Army, Lafayette, Lehigh, Navy), the most since the 2016-17 season when they collected five sweeps.

THE ROAD AHEAD

- The 2019-20 non-conference slate will be BU's most challenging in years, as five of the 11 non-conference opponents qualified for postseason competition, with three of those squads making the NCAA Tournament.
- Additionally, the non-conference schedule features five 20-win teams from a season ago and two Power Five conference opponents.

DEFENDING THE ROOF

- BU closed out its 2018-19 non-conference home slate with a perfect 4-0 record, marking its first unblemished home non-conference games record since the 2011-12 season.

RULES OF THE ROAD

- After going winless on the road in non-conference games at 0-6, BU went 7-2 in Patriot League games on the road.
- Three of those six wins were decided by four points or less, while both losses were decided by two possessions or less.

TOURNEY TIME

- BU earned a first-round bye for just the second time in its six seasons as a member of the Patriot League last year, avoiding the first round for the first time since the 2016-17 season.
- The Terriers are 1-6 all-time in the Patriot League Tournament.
- Its lone win came in its first-ever Patriot League Tournament contest, a 40-35 triumph over Loyola in the first round on March 4, 2014.

ROTATION IS KEY

- BU relied upon its primary rotation of Childs, Hauck, Irving, Nelson, Lauren Spearman and Naiyah Thompson.
- That six-woman rotation accounted for 91.7 percent of the team's minutes last season.
- In Patriot League games, those six are responsible for 95.0 percent of the team's total minutes.
- Nelson (39.0), Spearman (37.4) and Hauck (35.4) are three of the top four leaders in minutes in Patriot League games.

UP NEXT

- BU will return to action on Sunday, Dec. 15 for a 2 p.m. tilt against Boston College.

MARISA MOSELEY

HEAD COACH
SECOND SEASON • BOSTON UNIVERSITY '04



Marisa Moseley '04, a standout on Boston University's 2003 NCAA Tournament team and a nine-year assistant coach at UConn, is in her second year as head coach of the Terriers.

Moseley made an impact during her first season, guiding the team to finish fourth in the Patriot League regular season standings, its highest finish ever, while matching its best conference record at 11-7. The eighth head coach, and first alumna, in program history, additionally led BU to its first winning season in five years with a 15-14 overall record.

Moseley was named the first Patriot League Coach of the Year in program history, and was just the second coach in the program's 45-year history to be named the conference coach of the year. Additionally, she was one of two NCAA DI women's basketball first-year head coaches to collect conference of the year honors in 2019.

A two-year captain during her playing days with the Terriers, Moseley has been on Geno Auriemma's staff in Storrs since 2009, helping the Huskies claim five national championships (2010, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016) while reaching the Final Four all nine seasons.

She coached three national players of the year and 11 All-Americans while assisting UConn to a 331-14 record and two of the longest winning streaks in NCAA basketball history (111 and 90 consecutive games).

A native of Springfield, Massachusetts, Moseley completed her four-year (2000-04) playing career as the Terriers' third-leading shot blocker (114 blocks). The defensive specialist earned All-America East Conference Third Team honors in 2002-03 after leading BU in both steals and blocked shots.

Moseley helped the Terriers win the 2003 America East championship and make their first and only appearance in the NCAA Tournament. She was voted the defensive player of the year by her teammates and was also a four-year member of the America East Honor Roll.

Her primary responsibilities at UConn were coaching the post players, creating individual and skill development workouts, preparing scouting reports, and working with marketing and video services on digital media platforms, presentations and highlight films. In 2012, she assisted in scouting for Coach Auriemma and the gold-medal winning U.S. National Team at the London Olympics.

Prior to serving as an assistant coach at UConn, Moseley filled the same capacity at Minnesota (2007-09), where she led the Golden Gophers to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances while posting an overall record of 40-24. While serving in her role as academic liaison, a total of 11 student-athletes earned selection to the Big Ten Academic Honor Roll.

Moseley first broke into the coaching ranks during the 2005-06 season as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Denver, helping guide the Pioneers to a 20-11 record, marking their first 20-plus win campaign in six years. Her responsibilities included assisting with the Pioneers' recruiting and team travel, as well as monitoring the players' academic progress.

In addition to her coaching duties, Moseley served as a member of the University of Connecticut Diversity Council and was on director of athletics David Benedict's Leadership Team. Furthermore, she was a member of the Student-Athlete Development Diversity Committee and was the athletics department's liaison to the Office of Diversity.

She was also a member of Denver's Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committee. The committee was instrumental in the establishment of a new associate athletic director position overseeing diversity and community relations.

Prior to joining the staff at Denver, Moseley worked a one-year stint as a production assistant at ESPN in Bristol, Connecticut, where she served as a creative contributor to shows such as SportsCenter, ESPNNews and ABC NewsOne.

Moseley graduated from BU's College of Arts & Sciences in 2004 with a degree in sociology and returned to campus in 2012 to serve as a panelist for the "Pass It On: A Celebration" event that honored milestones and accomplishments in women's athletics.
