# **Media Information**

#### CREDENTIALS

All credential requests can be made online. Contact the communications office for information on how to access the page. Credentials requested after Monday of the game week will not be mailed. Instead, they will be available for pickup at a location agreeable to both parties. The Kivisto Field at Memorial Stadium Media Will Call distribution location is at the base of the elevator, below the pressbox, on the west side of the stadium.

#### **PHOTOGRAPHERS**

Credentials for sideline photographers will be issued on the basis of circulation, with priority granted to agencies covering the participating schools on a regular basis. All photographers must pick up a photo sticker in order to be admitted to the sidelines. This may be done at the gate at the southwest corner of Memorial Stadium.

#### PARKING

Media parking is located in the Mississippi Street Parking Garage just south of the Kansas Union on the southeast side of Memorial Stadium. The garage is approximately two blocks away from the stadium.

#### PRESSBOX AND GAMEDAY SERVICES

The Kivisto Field at Memorial Stadium pressbox is located on the west side of the stadium. Entrance is at the base of the elevator located just off of Maine Street. Level eight is reserved for the print media, home and visiting radio, home and visiting booths for coaches and athletics directors, along with game and scoreboard operations. Level nine serves as the photo deck and the location for television booths. Packets with pregame information will be distributed in advance of kickoff on the day of the game. Quarter, halftime, and final statistics, game books, coaches and player quote sheets are all regular services on game day. Stat monitors with live, updated statistics are available throughout the print media level and in booths for electronic media. In addition, television monitors are also part of the fixtures in both home and visiting radio booths.

#### WIRELESS INTERNET

Complimentary access to wireless internet is available at Memorial Stadium and information about how to access it will be available in the pressbox.

#### **TELEPHONES**

Writers wanting phone lines at their seat locations should contact the KU Telecommunications Office at (785) 864-9300 regarding installation. For specific line location, please list Katy Lonergan as the contact. Allow at least two weeks notice prior to the game.

#### **WEEKLY NEWS CONFERENCE**

Kansas head football coach David Beaty will conduct a weekly press conference each Tuesday during the season. A media luncheon is held at 12 p.m., in the Chancellor's Lounge located in the Anderson Family Football Complex south of Kivisto Field at Memorial Stadium. The weekly press conferences follow in the George R. Mrkonic Auditorium at 1 p.m. Offensive coordinator Rob Likens and defensive coordinator Clint Bowen will be available at 1:30 p.m., and requested players will be made available each week following the coordinators (approximately 1:40 p.m.). Freshmen and redshirt freshmen are not available for interviews.

Coach Beaty will also be available on the weekly Big 12 Teleconference on Mondays at 10 a.m. Central. Information on how to take part in the teleconference is available through the Big 12 Conference office.

#### INTERVIEWS

Contact the communications office for all player or coach interview requests. All interviews with players during the season will take place at 1:40 p.m., on Tuesdays in the Chancellor's Lounge at the Anderson Family Football Complex. To request players, media should contact Katy Lonergan, Director of Football Communications, by noon each Monday at katyl@ku.edu or (785) 864-7314. Out-of-town media wishing to interview Kansas players should also contact the communications office with their requests by noon the day prior to the interview. Freshmen and redshirt freshmen are not available for interviews.

Home and cell phone numbers for players will not be provided and players have been instructed not to accept calls from media without prior notice from the communications office. Please do not contact a player or coach without scheduling the interview through the communications office.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

Saturday marks the first time the Jayhawks and Tigers will square off on the gridiron. In the 125-year history of the program, Kansas has played 25 games against current American Athletic Conference foes dating back to 1933. In those contests, KU holds a record of 13-12, with its last win coming in 2006 in 13-7 fashion over South Florida (Sept. 23).

#### **SCOUTING THE TIGERS OFFENSE**

Memphis is coming off arguably one of the best seasons in school history that included a 10-3 mark and a program-best seven wins in conference play en route to the American Athletic Conference title. Memphis returns eight starters from a 2014 squad that scored a school-record 471 points (36.2 ppg) compared to the 234 points scored all of 2013. Of those starters returning is quarterback Paxton Lynch. The redshirt-junior has racked up 5,165 yards passing and completed 61-percent of his passes (470-of-774) since being named the starter in 2013. On the receiving end of 47 of those passes in 2014 was wide receiver Mose Frazier. Returning for a fifth year as a redshirt-senior, Frazier led all Memphis receivers with 47 catches and ranked second with 506 yards and three touchdowns. Against Missouri State (Sept. 5), Frazier caught six passes for a game-high 89 yards and two touchdowns. The ground assault returns running backs Jarvis Cooper and Sam Craft, who combined for 709 yards a year ago. In the season-opening bout with Missouri State (Sept. 5), Cooper paced the offensive attack with 102 yards rushing and two touchdowns.

#### **SCOUTING THE TIGERS DEFENSE**

Memphis returns just three starters from a defense that allowed just 19.5 points and 349.5 yards of offense per game and has been on the rise the last three seasons since head coach Justin Feuente took the reins. Among those returning is DAWG Jackson Dillon who finished 2014 with 43 tackles (33 solo, 10 asst), 9.0 TFLs for a loss of 50 yards and 3.5 sacks. Safety Reggis Ball returns in the secondary where he recorded 35 stops, one interception and recovered two fumbles in 2014. In week one against Missouri State (Sept. 5), the Tigers had 27 different players record a tackle, with the SAM linebacker position turning out most of the production with six stops, 1.0 TFLs and a fumble recovery combined between Phillip Sumpter and Wynton McManis.

#### **ABOUT MEMPHIS HEAD COACH JUSTIN FUENTE**

On December 8, 2011, the University of Memphis named Justin Fuente the program's 23rd head coach after the Tigers had won just five combined games between 2009-11. Since taking the reins, Fuente and the Tigers have made momentous strides in his first three seasons, including the school's first conference title in more than 40 years, along with a come-from-behind bowl victory against BYU in the 2014 Miami Beach Bowl. In 2014, Fuente led the Tigers to a school-record 471 points (36.2 ppg) and matched a program-best 10 wins that was established in 1938. He guided the Tigers to close out the year with a seven-game winning streak, and ranked among the top-25 in both the AP and *USA Today*/Amway Coaches Polls, a first for the program. He was named the 2014 American Athletic Conference Coach of the Year unanimously by his peers, as well as the College Football Coach of the Year by the Tennessee Sports Writers Association.

#### **COZYING UF**

After a rough first three series to start the 2015 season, junior quarterback **Montell Cozart** regrouped and led a high-powered offensive attack to nearly complete the come-from-behind victory over South Dakota State (Sept. 5). During the first three possessions of the game, Cozart managed just 57 yards in the air with an interception, ran for 14 yards with a fumble and posted a three-and-out in the other series. However, following the fumble, Cozart was lights out. He completed 70 percent of his passes (21-of-38) for 234 yards and a touchdown. If that wasn't enough, Cozart legged out 16 rushes for 80 yards. As a result, Cozart set career highs in completions (25), attempts (38), passing yards (291) and rushing yards (94). He had his hands involved in 65 percent of the offensive production for a combined 385 yards.

#### **FAST PACED, UP TEMPO**

Since day one, head coach **David Beaty** has wanted to run as many offensive plays as possible over the course of a game. In his first game at the helm Saturday, Sept. 5, the Jayhawks ran 90 plays. Kansas was one of seven teams in college football during week one that ran 90 or more plays in a game, that amounts to just five-percent of all the FBS schools. Since 2006, the Jayhawks have ran 90 or more plays in a single game six times, with two of those contests playing into overtime.

#### **576 AND CHAINS**

In Saturday's (Sept. 5) loss to South Dakota State, the Jayhawks racked up 576 yards of total offense, the most since Sept. 22, 2007, when Kansas gained 615 yards from scrimmage in a 55-3 win over Florida International. As a result, KU recorded 29 first downs tying the totalwith last year's win over lowa State (Nov. 8, 2014) for the most since Sept. 10, 2011, when Kansas moved the chains 32 times in a 45-42 win over Northern Illinois. Since that game against NIU, Kansas has only recorded 25 or more first downs in 4-of-47 games, while eclipsing the 20 mark in 16 of those contests.

#### **RUNNING BACK U**

Kansas has turned out some of the best running backs in college football in the likes of June Henley, Tony Sands, James Sims, Laverne Smith, Clark Green, Gale Sayers and John Riggins. Among KU's top six rushers of alltime, only two of them can say they did something that junior running back **Ke'aun Kinner** did Saturday (Sept. 5) vs. South Dakota State. In his debut, Kinner rushed for 157 yards and two touchdowns, averaging 5.8 yards per carry. James Sims (101 yards) and Gale Sayers (114 yards) are the only other two running backs among the top six who debuted with a 100-plus yard performance. Kinner's 157 yards ranked fifth among the FBS for week one rushers and first in the Big 12 Conference.

Schadler lined up as a kick returner and took South Dakota State's second boot of the game 91 yards untouched for KU's first score of the game. The last time a Kansas player returned a kickoff for a touchdown was Sept. 25, 2010, versus New Mexico State (D.J. Beshears, 96 yards).

#### **FRESH START**

After losing NFL caliber corners JaCorey Shepherd and Dexter McDonald to the 2014 draft, head coach **David Beaty** and his staff had some big holes to fill in the secondary. No sweat for true freshman CB **Tyrone Miller, Jr.** Making his collegiate debut against South Dakota State (Sept. 5), Miller led the Jayhawk defense with eight stops and two pass breakups, which both led all freshman DBs in the conference that week.

#### O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

At the conclusion of Fall Camp in late August, the Jayhawks voted on three captains to lead the team in 2015. Senior defensive end **Ben Goodman, Jr.** and juniors, quarterback **Montell Cozart** and safety **Fish Smithson** were all appointed by their peers for captain's duties this season. Goodman is KU's lone returner to have started each of the 24 games the past two seasons, Cozart was named the starting quarterback for the second-consecutive season and Smithson is the squad's leading returning tackler with 49 stops a season ago.

The Jayhawks will also employ a rotating captain each of the 12 games. The coaching staff's Special Teams Player of the Week will hold the honorary captain title during the next week's contest. This week's fourth captain is none other than freshman running back **Ryan Schadler** after his 91-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against South Dakota State (Sept. 5).

#### #EARNIT

Head coach **David Beaty** preaches a simple philosophy to his players, "You have to go out and earn everything you get. Nothing in life is going to be handed to you — on the football field or in the professional world — it has to be earned." That simple statement is a pillar that the Kansas players strive to uphold on a daily basis and is the foundation for the type of player Beaty wants to recruit at the University of Kansas. His go-to sermon to the Jayhawk community is "We are going to earn the support of our fans one person at a time, and we are not going to sleep until we can give everyone something to be proud of at Memorial Stadium." As a result, a simple #EarnIt hashtag is plastered on everything Kansas football to show the new culture Beaty brings to the table.

### **UP NEXT**

The Jayhawks will take advantage of a bye week during week three of the college football season. Kansas will then hit the road for one final non-conference matchup at Rutgers (Sept. 26) before the Big 12 gauntlet begins. Kickoff at High Point Solutions Stadium is set for 11 a.m.

# **Head Coach David Beaty**



David Beaty took the reigns of the Kansas football program Dec. 5, 2014, with more than 20 years of coaching experience, including two previous stints as an assistant coach with the

A native of Garland, Texas, Beaty takes over the KU program after spending three previous seasons as the Texas A&M wide receivers coach, where he also coordinated all the recruiting efforts during the 2013-14 seasons.

Under Beaty's tutelage, the Aggies' wide receivers were a recordsetting group. With first-team All-American Mike Evans leading the way in 2013, the Aggies set team records for receiving yards, receiving touchdowns and completion percentage. Evans set the A&M record with 1,394 receiving yards and matched the receiving touchdowns record with 12. He also shattered and re-broke the single-game receiving record with 279 yards vs. Alabama and 287 yards against Auburn. Evans went on to become the Aggies' first wide receiver to be selected in the first round of the NFL Draft. Texas A&M was the only team in the nation with four 50-catch, 600-yard receivers in 2013.

Beaty went to Texas A&M after serving as offensive coordinator at both Kansas and Rice. He was the co-offensive coordinator and wide receivers coach at KU in 2011, and helped develop one of the Big 12's top all-purpose threats in wideout D.J. Beshears.

Beaty spent the 2010 season as the offensive coordinator at Rice, where he helped the team average 28.7 points and 375.3 yards per game. Prior to his second stint at Rice, Beaty was the wide receivers coach at Kansas during the 2008 and 2009 seasons.

**RECORD AT KU RECORD AT D1** 

During his first tour at KU, he helped receivers Kerry Meier and Dezmon Briscoe develop into NFL-caliber players. Meier, who was taken in the fifth round of the 2010 NFL Draft, received All-Big 12 accolades in 2008 and 2009. Briscoe, a sixth-round selection in the 2010 NFL Draft, was an All-American and All-Big 12 First Team pick in 2009.

Beaty spent the 2006 and 2007 seasons as the wide receivers coach at Rice. In 2006 he served as passing game coordinator as the team made its first bowl game in 45 years (the New Orleans Bowl). He had two players - Jarett Dillard and James Casey - drafted by NFL teams following the 2007 season.

Prior to joining the Owls' staff, Beaty was a successful head coach at MacArthur (Irving, Texas) High School from 2002-05. He began his coaching career as an assistant coach at Naaman Forest High School in Garland, Texas, from 1994-96. He was also an assistant at Garland High School from 1997-2000.

Beaty assumed his first head coaching job at North Dallas High School in 2001. He coached there for one season, posting a 6-4 record, before taking over at MacArthur.

Beaty is a 1994 graduate of Lindenwood (St. Charles, Missouri) College, where he played football and served as a team captain from 1992-93. He was a four-year starter at wide receiver and led the team in receptions for three-straight seasons.

Beaty and his wife, Raynee, have two daughters, Averie (15) and Alexa (10).


