**This Week:** The University of Mary Men's Soccer team opens up their conference schedule when they host Montana State University Billings at the MDU Resources Bowl on Saturday, September 19, at 3 PM.

**MSUB:** The Yellowjackets own a 2-1-1 record on the year so far after a visit to St. George, Utah, where they played California State University-San Marcos to a 1-1 double overtime draw and lost to Metropolitan State University of Denver 4-1. MSU-Billings bounced back the next week when they hosted a four-team tournament that the Marauders took part in. The Yellowjackets defeated Carroll College 5-0 and followed that up with a 5-1 win over South Dakota School of Mines. Leading the charge on the offensive end of the pitch is #28 Ricardo Palomino with six goals and one assist on the year so far for 13 points. Palomino has taken 20 total shots with 11 coming on goal and is credited with one game winner on the season. #24 Julian Toenges and #14 David Loeung will aid Palomino on the offense as they both have two goals apiece while Toenges has recorded four assists for eight total points and Loeung only has one assist on the year so far for five total points. #2 Garret Robinson and #7 Sam Butterworth will anchor the defense as they have totaled 346 and 351 total minutes, respectively. #20 Tom Saltwell will join them on defense as he leads all players with 370 minutes played while #1 Tom Lohmann will get the start in the keepers box with 342 total minutes played. Lohmann has only given up six goals on the year with 14 saves for a .700 save percentage on 35 shots faced. As a team, the Yellowjackets have outscored their opponents 12-6 with a 55-40 shot advantage as the defenders have done a good job keep the ball out of the defensive end of the pitch. MSU-Billings does struggle at times with fouls as they have been charged with 70 fouls on the year while opponents have only committed 54 fouls, suggesting the heat of the moment can and will get to the players. Corner kicks have been even on the year with opponents taking 18 total corners and the Yellowjackets recorded 17 of their own. The key stat comes from MSU-Billings recording 33 shots in the first half of the match while only giving up 19, so the Marauders will need to either rely on the defense to survive the onslaught, or let the midfielders control the ball and keep the pressure on the offense to outscore the Yellowjackets.

**Next Week:** The Marauders will continue the conference portion of the schedule as they host Simon Fraser University on Thursday, September 24, at the MDU Resources Bowl, followed by another home match against Western Washington University on Saturday, September 26.

**Last Week:** U-Mary held the early lead against former GNAC opponent South Dakota School of Mines as Christoffer Nogueira scored the first goal of the game in the 12th minute. Unfortunately, the Hardrockers came right back and notched the equalizer in the 33rd minute off a cross to stay even with the Marauders at 1-1. Neither team could leverage an advantage the rest of the way but it came down to defense as Mitch Taveira recorded two saves in the overtime periods to maintain the draw. The Marauders followed that up with a 3-2 win over Carroll College as Migel Bartolo recorded two goals, both in the first half, and all three U-Mary goals came by the 23rd minute for the first win.

**Nogueira:** Christoffer Nogueira returns for his sophomore season after leading the Marauders in goals, assists, and points last year. He finished his first year in a U-Mary uniform with nine goals on 50 shots, six assists, and 24 points. For the 2015 season, Nogueira has taken 17 shots, nine on goal, recording one goal in 389 minutes of play.

**Pearce:** Jordan Pearce returns for his junior season after leading the team in goals scored and second in points as he finished the year with nine goals, three assists and 21 points. For the 2015 season, Pearce has registered one assist and seven shots, three on goal, in 208 minutes of action

**Brennan:** Aaron Brennan is back for his junior year at U-Mary after a solid sophomore season in the midfield. He was third on the team in points with 13 and third in goals with four. Brennan has recorded one goal and one assist on the year so far with eight shots in 370 minutes on the pitch.

**Sellars:** Jonathan Sellars enters his final season on the pitch for U-Mary after an accolade-laced junior year that saw him with a Second Team All-GNAC and Third Team All-NSCAA West Region awards. For the year so far, Sellars continues to anchor the midfield with 388 minutes played to go with four shots, one on goal

**Liddiard/Bartolo:** James Liddiard and Migel Bartolo lead the offense with two goals apiece while Bartolo also adds one assist. Liddiard has started in all four games with 318 minutes play and Bartolo has 208 minutes with one start.

**Head Coach Dave Cook**



A former U-Mary men's soccer All-American, Dave Cook returned to his roots as the Marauders head men's soccer coach in 2008. After much success at the high school level and as an assistant with the Marauders women's program, Cook is now in his eighth season running the

men's program. Quickly putting his mark on the program, Cook doubled the team's win total from four in 2008 to eight in 2009 while playing a much more difficult schedule.

In 2014 Cook led the Marauders in their second season as part of the Great Northwest Athletic Conference (GNAC). U-Mary finished with a 4-9-1 record in GNAC play.

Cook was an assistant coach with the U-Mary women's soccer program for four years (2004-07). During that time, the Marauders advanced to the 2007 NCAA regional tournament in their first year of eligibility and won the Northern Sun conference tournament twice in two opportunities. The U-Mary women's team finished 2007 16-7-0 and ranked fourth in the region. While the assistant coach, the U-Mary women recorded a record of 48-31-7 and twice advanced to national tournament play.

The Bismarck Century High School co-head girls soccer coach from 2005-08, Cook guided the Patriots to a state championship in 2007 and four WDA titles. In his four years as head coach, CHS compiled a record of 58-8-5. The Technical Director for Dakota United, Cook has a United States Soccer Federation "A" License, United States Soccer Federation "Y" License, a United States Soccer Federation Goalkeeping License, as well as an Advanced National Diploma from the National Soccer Coaches Association of America.

Currently pursuing his Master of Business Administration degree at his alma mater, Cook is a 2005 University of Mary graduate, where the Bismarck, ND, native earned NAIA honorable mention All-America honors for the Marauders as a senior.
