## OPENING TIP

The Idaho men's basketball team (6-6) kicks off its 18-game conference schedule Thursday night when the Vandals host Sacramento State for their Big Sky opener at 6 p.m. PST inside the ICCU Arena. Following Thursday's action, UI will close the 2023 year with a Saturday afternoon home matchup against Portland State at 2 p.m. PST.

Idaho closed non-conference play with a 6-6 record, which is the best 12-game start to a regular season for an Idaho team since 2017. The Vandals earned wins over teams from the Big West, WAC and WCC, and opened the month of December 3-0 for the first time since 2010.

Junior forward Julius Mims is the only player in the Big Sky to average at least 10 points, seven rebounds and 1.5 blocks per game.

Mims has been one of the most consistent scorers in the league (Minimum 4 FGM/G average), shooting the third best field goal percentage in the conference at 59.6 percent.

Coming off a career-high nine assists against UC Riverside, D'Angelo Minnis moved up to second in the Big Sky in total assists (45) and third in assists per game at 3.8. He has dished out at least four assists in five games this season.

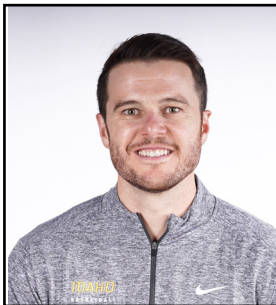

**VANDAL TIDBITS**

Idaho is 6-2 when leading at halftime and 6-0 when outrebounding their opponent.

Mims has been super efficient around the rim, making 53 of 89 shots and most recently scoring a Division 1 career-high of 23 points on 9-of-13 against UC Riverside. The 6-9 transfer from North Idaho College leads the conference in total blocks (20) and blocks per game (1.67). He also ranks fourth with three double-doubles and sixth in total rebounds (88) and rebounds per game (7.3).

The Vandals are the Big Sky's leading shot-blocking team, averaging 4.1 blocks per game. They have recorded at least four blocks in nine games and have been primarily led by Mims, who has recorded two or more blocks in seven games.

Redshirt freshman Tyler Linhardt continues to lead the second unit in scoring as of late, posting double figures in four of his last five and averaging 11.6 points in his last five games. His effectiveness off the bench has Idaho ranked third in the Big Sky in bench scoring at 27.6.

The 2023-24 season marks the 119th year of Vandal men's basketball.

**STAT SHEET STUFFER**

First-year Vandal Julius Mims finds his name amongst the top of multiple stat categories for Idaho, as he leads the way in field goal percentage (59.6 - min 4FGM/per game) rebounding (7.3) and blocks (20).

He has scored at least 10 points in six games, including a season-high 23 points at UC Riverside.

The 6-9 forward has been the best rim protector in the Big Sky, ranking first with 20 total blocks and a 1.7 per-game average. He has posted 2 or more blocks in seven games this season.

Mims rebounds at a high rate, securing 5-plus rebounds in 11 of 12 games and recorded 10 or more in three games. He ranks sixth in the Big Sky with 88 total rebounds and fifth with an average of 2.3 offensive rebounds per game.

Alex Pribble was named the 31st head men's basketball coach in University of Idaho program history on March 20, 2023.

Pribble joins the Vandals after serving as an associate head coach for four seasons at Seattle U, where he helped lead the Redhawks to back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since the 1960s and the programs' first-ever Western Athletic Conference regular season title.

During the 2022-23 season, Pribble helped guide the Redhawks to their second consecutive 20-win season and a 7-0 start in WAC play. Seattle U's hot start in conference action received national attention as the Redhawks were among the top teams in the nation to receive votes in the USA TODAY Sports Coaches Poll.

Throughout the season, Pribble was pivotal in the development of First Team All-WAC guard Cameron Tyson, who went on to average 18.6 points per game and total the most three-pointers among all players in the Western Athletic Conference at 97.

The run through the 2021-22 season saw the Redhawks achieve a 23-9 overall record and a 14-4 mark in the WAC, en route to earning a regular season conference championship. Seattle U started WAC play 8-0 for the first time in 10 years and saw the program reach 23 wins for the first time since 1957-58.

Prior to his time with the Redhawks, Pribble spent four highly successful years as the head men's basketball coach at NCAA Division II Saint Martin's University in Lacey, Washington. He took over a program that went 6-22 overall in the year before Pribble's arrival to quickly rebuild a program that put together four-straight winning seasons, two consecutive trips to the NCAA Tournament, the program's first-ever Sweet 16 berth and achieve the school's highest national ranking (No. 8) in program history.

In the 2018-19 season, Pribble led the Saints to a school record 26 wins and the school's first Great Northwest Athletic Conference regular-season championship. Pribble went on to be named the GNAC Coach of the Year and boast four players who would receive All-GNAC postseason honors and regional

recognition.

Before his tenure at Saint Martin's, Pribble spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Eastern Washington from 2013 to 2015. During the 2014-15 season, Pribble helped cap off a historic season for the Eagles, who finished 26-9 overall and 14-4 in the Big Sky Conference to clinch a share of the regular-season title and garner the school's second NCAA Tournament appearance in school history.

Big Sky Player of the Year Tyler Harvey helped facilitate the Eagles' run as the nation's leading scorer at 23.1 points per game, en route to being selected as a second-round pick in the NBA Draft in 2015.

Prior to arriving at Eastern Washington, Pribble was the top assistant for two seasons at San Francisco State. He began his collegiate coaching career as a graduate assistant at California-Berkeley under then-head coach Ben Braun.

Pribble graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree in sociology in 2007 and a master's degree in education in 2008 from California-Berkeley. A walk-on at Cal before receiving a scholarship after his sophomore season, Pribble played in 76 games for the Bears under

against UC San Diego and Denver. He ranks fourth in the league with three double-doubles.

## COLLECTIVE EFFORT

The Vandals have had four players score in double figures in a single game in five different contests this season.

All 14 Vandals who have made an appearance this season have scored at least three points while nine different players have scored 10 or more in a single game this season - Trevon Blassingame, Quinn Denker, Terren Frank, Tyler Mrus, Julius Mims, D'Angelo Minnis, EJ Neal, Kyson Rose and Titus Yearout.

## MINNIS THE MENACE

Graduate guard D'Angelo Minnis is starting to find his stride as of late, scoring in double figures in seven straight games. He posted his highest Division I scoring output against Pacific, recording 20 points on 6-of-9 from the field.

Minnis continues to be one of Idaho's best defenders, posting a team-high in steals with 15 while generally guarding the opposing team's best backcourt player.

## DEFENSIVE SUCCESS

The Vandals have forced their opponent into 10+ turnovers in 8 out of 12 games and 14 or more in three games.

UI forced Pacific into 21 turnovers to tally the most in a single game against a Division I opponent in more than three years (21 vs. Portland State, 1/02/2020).

The Vandals have allowed 53 or fewer points in three games this season.

The Vandals held Evergreen State (42) and Pacific Lutheran (52) to 52 points or fewer in back-to-back games, marking the first time an Idaho team has allowed such scoring output in consecutive games since 2004 (Santa Barbara, 45 points and Cal Poly, 44 points).

Idaho posted a 46-point win (88-42) over Evergreen State on Nov. 14 to give first-year head coach Alex Pribble his first victory as a Vandal. Idaho's defensive effort stood out in the win, holding its opponent to 42 points or fewer for the first time since Dec. 18, 2014 (Walla Walla, 39).

## BENCH MOB

Idaho's second unit is third in the league and 57th nationally in bench points with 27.6 per game.

The Vandals have scored at least 20 points off the bench in 11 games and over 50 points in two games.

## BIG SKY RANKINGS

The Vandals rank first in the Big Sky in blocks per game with 4.1. Protecting the rim has been a strong suit for this Idaho team, posting five or more blocks in four games.

## SCOUTING THE HORNETS

Sacramento State is 3-8 overall and 1-4 on the road. During non-conference play, the Hornets earned wins over Pacific Union (128-66), UC Davis (69-63) and Bethesda (100-45). Sac State and Idaho met two common opponents in preseason action - Stanford and UC San Diego. The Hornets fell to Stanford (73-91) on the road and lost at home to UC San Diego, 52-83.

As a team, the Hornets enter Thursday's matchup as one of the top teams in the Big Sky at rebounding the basketball and knocking down shots from behind the arc. They rank first in three-point makes (9.8), rebound margin (10.3), defensive (27.6) and offensive (13.5) rebounds per game, and total rebounds (41). Offensively, Sac State scores the fourth most points per game in the league at 74.3, while allowing the seventh most at 73.7 per game.

Three Hornets average in double figures, including a team-high 13.5 points per game from Duncan Powell. The sophomore forward also leads the team on the glass with the third most rebounds in the conference at 9.5. Zee Hamoda adds 12.9 points while Brandon Betson posts 11.2 to round out their top 3 scorers.

## SERIES HISTORY

The all-time series between Idaho and Sacramento State totals 33 meetings, with Idaho leading 22-11 and winners of three of the last five games at home.

The two programs first met in 1968 in Moscow where Idaho earned a 65-57 victory. They would cross paths 13 more times as regional competitors before the two teams would become conference foes in 2014-15 when Idaho rejoined the Big Sky.

The two split the home-and-home series in 2022-23, as each team won on the road in a pair of overtime affairs. The Hornets earned an 85-83 win over Idaho on Jan. 5, 2023, before the Vandals won in Sacramento, 82-76 a month later on Feb. 4.

## SCOUTING THE VIKINGS

Portland State matched its best start to a season in program history and sits atop the Big Sky with a 9-3 overall mark and a 4-2 record away from Portland. The Vikings are winners of three of their last four, including an overtime win over Fresno State (75-72) at the buzzer last time out. The Viks have been as good as anyone in end-of-game situations winning three games at the buzzer.

It's been an all-around scoring effort for the Vikings, as five players average at least nine points per game - KJ Allen (10.6), Isaiah Johnson (10.3), Jorell Saterfield (10), Bobby Harvey (9.7) and Ismail Habib (9.3). Allen not only scores the ball at a high rate, but he also leads PSU in rebounding (6.1) and steals (13). He played hero in the team's win over Fresno State, knocking down a three from the left wing as time expired.

The Vikings score the seventh most points per game in the Big Sky at 73.8 while allowing the third fewest with 66.9 per game. PSU grabs the second most rebounds (38.9), while ranking second in blocks (4), offensive rebounds (12.1), total rebounds (38.9) and turnover margin (3.2).

## SERIES HISTORY

Saturday's meeting between Idaho and Portland State will be the 37th time the two teams have faced off since 1965. PSU holds a slight 20-16 edge over the Vandals and has won four of the last five contests.

Since the two programs became conference foes in 2014-15, Idaho is 7-9 and looks to snap a three-game losing streak at home.

Idaho fell in both games last season to Portland State, dropping a home contest by a score of 58-74 on Jan. 7, before falling on the road, 66-69 on Feb. 2.

## PRESEASON NOTES

The Vandals welcome impact transfers Julius Mims (North Idaho College), Trevon Blassingame (Fairleigh Dickinson), Tyler Mrus (Alaska Fairbanks), Quinn Denker (Cal-State San Marcos), EJ Neal (CC San Francisco), D'Angelo Minnis (Western Washington), Tyler Linhardt (Washington), Cooper Church (Arizona Western) and Kyson Rose (Walla Walla CC) to the fold. Freshman newcomers Kristian Gonzalez, Takai Hardy and Miles Klapper will also suit up for the first time in a Vandal uniform.

Significant additions in the front court feature Kyson Rose and Julius Mims. The two junior college transfers posted successful sophomore campaigns and will fill in at the forward position with proven scoring and rebounding ability. Rose is fresh off of receiving NWAC Player of the Year honors at Walla Walla Community College after averaging 22.6 points and 10.5 rebounds a game. The Kennewick, Wash. native led the league with 678 total points and 258 field goals while shooting 62 percent from the field. Mims makes the short trek south from Coeur d'Alene, where he spent two seasons at North Idaho College. He started in 44 of 45 games over his tenure while posting 16.9 points, 9.9 rebounds and 1.8 blocks over his sophomore campaign in 2022-23.

The backcourt and wing positions showcase a mix of veteran leadership along with a versatile group of underclassmen. Minnis will be the lone senior on the roster using his last year of eligibility to play for the Silver and Gold after spending four seasons at Western Washington. Minnis totaled 83 starts and 1,081 points in three seasons while recording his best season in 2022-23 with a team-high 14.3 points and career highs in shooting with a 49.3 percent clip from the field and 44.4 percent mark from three. Denker makes his debut at Idaho after

spending a season each at Cal State San Marcos and West Valley College. The San Jose native made the most of his time at San Marcos, averaging 14.5 points per game and posting efficient shooting numbers that included 43.9 percent from the field, 40 percent from three and 92.2 percent from the foul line.

Key wing transfers in Trevon Blassingame, Tyler Mrus and EJ Neal will give Idaho versatility on the perimeter with previous success at their last stops on both the offensive and defensive end. Blassingame played in 24 games at Fairleigh Dickinson, an NCAA Tournament team that knocked off the #1 Purdue Boilermakers in the first round. Mrus is a proven three-level scorer by way of Alaska Fairbanks. The Seattle native started in all 24 games for the Nanooks while averaging the second most points on the team at 11.9. After spending two seasons at City College of San Francisco, Neal looks to bring his two-way approach to the court in Moscow. The Bay area product averaged over 11 points per game in 2022-23 and became the program's charge record holder after taking over 100 charges in his two seasons.

The freshman class is led by Kristian Gonzalez, a guard from Mater Dei Catholic High School. Joining Gonzalez is 6-7 forward Takai Hardy and lefty specialist Miles Klapper.

## 2023-24 SLATE

The Vandals will compete in 31 games over the course of the 2023-24 season before heading to the Big Sky Tournament. Idaho will host the most home games since the 2011-12 season with 16 contests tipping off at the ICCU Arena while traveling to compete on the road for 14 road games and one neutral site contest.

Idaho features two power five opponents on their 2023-24 schedule, as the squad is set to travel to face Washington State (Nov. 6) and Stanford (Dec. 17). It will be the first time since the 2009-10 season Idaho will open the regular season against a Power Five competitor (94-87 win at Utah).

UI will start close to home to begin the season with three of their first four games and six of their first nine contests being played at the ICCU Arena.

Idaho starts its conference stretch at home on Dec. 28 against Sacramento State, beginning an 18-game home-and-home schedule against each of its respective conference opponents before concluding regular season play on Mar. 4.

The majority of Idaho's contests will be played in the west with scheduled matchups against four teams from the Big West; two teams each from the Pac-12 Conference, Summit League and Western Athletic Conference, and one from the West Coast Conference.

Idaho makes the short trip south to Boise to compete at the annual Big Sky Conference Tournament, Mar. 9-13 at Idaho Central Arena.
