THE TRIPLE CROWN

Victoria didn't horse around in basketball's 'Run for Roses'

Victoria didn't wait to get into its championship gait.

The Vikings and Vikettes exploded out of the gate, back there in November - and, galloped to their third straight Canadian Interuniversity Athletic Union titles.

The success of coach Ken Shields' Vikings is unprecedented in CIAU history.

Only one other school - Windsor, 1966 and 1967 - had won as many as two straight crowns.

Victoria, then, becomes the first school to win three in a row.

The Vikings completed their 'Run for the Roses' on March 20, at Victoria's Memorial Arena, with a 74-60 triumph over Saint Mary's (Atlantic).

Two weeks earlier, at Saskatoon, coach Kathy Shield's Vikettes had put the heat on the men's team, dumping Bishop's (Quebec) 70-55 for a third straight national jewel.

The Vikettes' string equalled that of another Canada West school, British Columbia, which won three in a row (1972-73-74). But, it also left Victoria two short of tying Laurentian, which captured five straight national titles (1975-76-77-78-79).

Victoria's wrapping up its Triple Crowns wasn't unexpected.

Both zipped through Canada West with identical 19-1 records and, then, each hosted and defeated Saskatchewan in the division finals.

The Huskies, though, made the Nationals as a wild-card team and the Huskiettes, of course, were automatic as the host team of the women's showdown.

Calgary's Karl Tilleman established a Canadian intercollegiate scoring record in an amazing season in which averaged 32.8 points-per-game.

That earned the Dinosaurs' guard the Mike Moser Memorial Trophy as the outstanding player in the country.

It was the first time in the award's eight-year history that it was won by an athlete from Canada West.

While ice was being broken in that area, the CWUAA continued its monopoly in the women's section.

Victoria's Luanne Hebb took the Nan Copp Award, as the top player in the nation.

That chunk of silverware has been on the line for only three years - and, Canada West reps have been No. 1 each season. Previous winners were Carol Turney-Loos of Victoria and Calgary's Janis Paskevich.

Victoria, which excels more as a team rather than individually, had two players named to the all-Canadian team - guard Eli Pasquale and Gerald Kazanowski. Also achieving national status was Saskatchewan's Murray Redekop.

Shields also was honored as the CIAU's Coach-of-the-Year. It was his third such success. He had been toasted previously in 1976 (Laurentian) and 1979.

No other coach has won that trophy, the Stuart W. Aberdeen Memorial, more than twice.

Being honored at the women's awards banquet at Saskatoon, along with Hebb, were all-Canadians Paskevich and Saskatchewan's Sheila Brennan.

It was for so many, team and individual, a season to remember in Canada West.

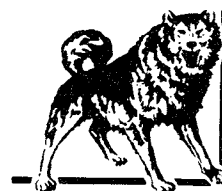
