THE X FACTORS

- Xavier, 9-5 overall and 1-0 in the BIG EAST Conference, won its league opener on Saturday at DePaul, 74-65, thanks to a 19-4 run to end the game.
- Xavier junior **Quentin Goodin** leads XU in scoring (13.7 ppg.), assists (second in the BIG EAST at 5.7 apg.) and steals (fourth in the BIG EAST at 1.8 spg.).
- Xavier sophomore **Naji Marshall** was named BIG EAST Player of the Week after contributing a game-high 19 points and a career-high 14 rebounds to go with four assists at DePaul on Dec. 29, the third straight week for an XU honoree. **Quentin Goodin** was on BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll each of the previous two weeks.
- Xavier's **Naji Marshall** leads the team in rebounding (tied for second in the BIG EAST at 8.1 rpg.) and is second on the team in scoring (13.0 ppg.) and assists (tied for 10th in the BIG EAST at 3.5 apg.).
- Xavier junior **Tyrique Jones** is second on the team and sixth in the BIG EAST in rebounding (7.5 rpg.). He is second in the BIG EAST in offensive rebounding (3.2 rpg.) and leads the nation in offensive rebounding percentage at 18.5 (KenPom).
- Xavier graduate transfer **Zach Hankins**, who has started two straight games, leads the BIG EAST Conference in field goal percentage (.716) and is third in the BIG EAST in blocks (1.4 bpg.).
- Xavier graduate transfer **Ryan Welage** connected on 5-of-8 3-pointers at DePaul on his way to 17 points, tied for his best scoring game since the season opener.
- Xavier has four players averaging in double figures in scoring through 14 games and two more at 9.5 ppg. or more.
- Xavier played in its fifth straight NCAA Tournament and its 12th in 13 years in 2018. XU earned a No. 1 seed in the 2018 NCAA Tournament.
- Xavier has graduated 109 straight men's basketball seniors dating back to the 1985-86 school year.

XAVIER IN BIG EAST PLAY: Xavier, which is in its sixth year in the BIG EAST Conference, is 58-33 (.637) in BIG EAST regular season action, including 1-0 this season and a 15-3 mark last season that earned the Musketeers their first-ever BIG EAST Regular Season Championship.

CONSISTENT CONFERENCE SUCCESS:

Xavier, 15-3 and winner of the 2017-18 BIG EAST Conference Regular Season Championship, has recorded 36 straight seasons at .500 or better in conference play (MCC, Atlantic 10 and BIG EAST). No other school in NCAA Division I has an active streak of more than 31 years.

40TH YEAR OF CONFERENCE PLAY: Xavier has been a member of a conference since the 1979-80 season. XU was in the MCC (now Horizon League) for 16 years (1980-1995) and the Atlantic 10 for 18 years (1996-2013). This season marks Xavier's sixth year in the BIG EAST.

XAVIER IN BIG EAST OPENERS: Xavier is a perfect 5-0 in BIG EAST Conference home openers, including a 77-72 win over DePaul last season at Cintas Center (12-30-17). Xavier's win at DePaul on Saturday raised XU's record to 5-1 in BIG EAST Conference regular season openers, including 2-1 on the road and 3-0 at home.

THE XAVIER-SETON HALL SERIES: Seton Hall leads the series 10-8, although Xavier won both meetings last season.

XAVIER WON A HIGH-SCORING BATTLE LAST SEASON AT CINTAS CENTER: Xavier recorded a 102-90 victory over Seton Hall on Wednesday, Feb. 14, 2018, XU's first 100-point game ever in a BIG EAST game. Xavier used an impressive offensive and defensive effort on both ends of the court to build a 45-25 halftime lead and held off a Seton Hall second-half rally to capture the win. Senior Trevon Bluiett hit 8-of-11 from 3-point range (one shy of the XU single-game 3-point field goal record that Bluiett shares with Romain Sato) and 13of-13 from the free-throw line on his way to 37 points (second-highest total of his career). Freshman Naji Marshall contributed 20 points on 7-of-11 shooting to go with six rebounds.

MACURA LED XAVIER TO VICTORY IN LAST SEASON'S MEETING IN NEWARK:

Xavier erased a 10-point second-half deficit on its way to capturing a 73-64 win at then-No. 19 Seton Hall on Saturday, Jan. 20, 2018 at the Prudential Center. The Pirates led 42-32 with under 18 minutes left and still led by five, 57-52 with 6:44 left. Senior **J.P. Macura**, who scored a game-high 27 points, hit a 3-pointer to start a 15-3 run and an offensive rebound and dunk that ended it. XU had control of the game at 67-60 with 1:28 left.

FOR THE RECORD (SETON HALL): Seton Hall, 10-3 overall and 1-0 in the BIG EAST Conference, is coming off a last-second 76-74 come-from-behind win over previously unbeaten St. John's on Saturday. The Pirates also own wins over Kentucky and the University of Miami on neutral courts and a road win at Maryland.

FOR THE RECORD (XAVIER): Xavier, 9-5 overall and 1-0 in the BIG EAST Conference, is coming off a 74-65 win at DePaul on Saturday. The Musketeers led 38-32 at halftime but fell behind by six points, 61-55, with 5:12 left. XU closed the game on a 19-4 run fueled by junior Tyrique Jones, who contributed six points, two rebounds, two blocks and steal during the run. Sophomore Naji Marshall led Xavier with a double-double (his third of the season) with a game-high 19 points to go with a game-high and career-high 14 rebounds and four assists. Marshall's 3-pointer with 3:39 left put XU ahead for good at 63-61. Both Jones and Marshall had missed Xavier's last game on Dec. 21 vs. Detroit Mercy due to injuries. Graduate transfer Ryan Welage hit 5-of-8 3-pointers on his way to 17 points, tied for his best scoring output since the season opener.

BIG EAST ROAD WARRIORS: Xavier won 74-65 at DePaul on Saturday, the Musketeers' seventh straight road win in BIG EAST Conference play dating back to last season. XU won its final six BIG EAST road games last season and finished 7-2 on the road and 15-3 overall, winning the BIG EAST Regular Season Championship.

NEAR SCHOOL-RECORD SHOOTING EFFORT VS. EASTERN KENTUCKY: Xavier rolled to a 95-77 win over Eastern Kentucky on Dec. 15 at Cintas Center. Xavier shot 71.4 percent (35-of-49) from the field (still the highest single-game effort by any team in the nation so far this season), just shy of the school record (72.2 percent vs. Butler in the 1990-91 season). Six Musketeers scored in double figures, including two that posted double-doubles. Junior Quentin Goodin led XU with 16 points on 6-of-8 shooting to go with 10 assists and

a career-high seven steals. Sophomore **Naji Marshall** contributed 15 points, 10 rebounds, six assists and two steals.

SCHOOL-RECORD TYING BALLHANDLING:

Xavier tied the school record for fewest turnovers in a game with three in the 82-55 win over Miami (Ohio) on Nov. 28. XU has done that two other times, including vs. Dayton (2004 Atlantic 10 Tournament Championship Game at UD Arena on 3-13-04) and vs. Massachusetts (3-2-02).

XAVIER ENJOYED A WINNING FINISH IN

MAUI: Xavier won its final of three games in the Maui Invitational on Nov. 21, 83-74 over Illinois. XU enjoyed a strong second half against Illinois, using a 20-7 surge from 14:53 to 6:02 to stretch a 55-52 lead into a comfortable 75-59 advantage. Sophomore Elias Harden contributed a career-high 14 points on the strength of a career-high four 3-pointers, his second straight game setting a career scoring high. In Xavier's second game in Maui on Nov. 20, XU suffered a 79-74 loss to San Diego State despite building a 19-point lead, 32-13, with 9:21 left in the first half. In Xavier's opener in Maui on Nov. 19, XU suffered an 88-79 overtime loss to No. 8 Auburn. XU battled back from an 11-point second-half deficit to force overtime. Ryan Welage led Xavier with 17 points.

BALANCED ATTACK: Xavier, which placed six players in double figures in scoring in the Oakland win on Dec. 1 and again in the Eastern Kentucky win on Dec. 15, has four players averaging in double figures in scoring and two more at 9.5 ppg. or more: Junior Quentin Goodin (13.7 ppg.) leads Xavier in scoring, including his career-high 22-point game vs. Detroit Mercy on Dec. 21. Sophomores Naji Marshall (13.0 ppg.) and Paul Scruggs (11.9 ppg.) are next followed by junior Tyrique Jones (10.6 ppg.), graduate transfer Ryan Welage (9.6 ppg.) and graduate transfer Zach Hankins (9.5 ppg.).

OH CAPTAIN MY CAPTAIN: Xavier's tricaptains (as voted by the players) are juniors **Tyrique Jones** and **Quentin Goodin** and graduate transfer **Kyle Castlin**.

THREE STRAIGHT WEEKS OF BIG EAST HONORS FOR THE MUSKETEERS: Sophomore Naji Marshall led Xavier with a double-double, his third of the season and of his career, in the win at DePaul on Saturday. Marshall finished with a gamehigh 19 points to go with a game-high and





career-high 14 rebounds and four assists, earning Xavier's first BIG EAST Conference Player of the Week selection this season. But this marks the third straight week that a Musketeer has earned a BIG EAST honor. Junior Quentin Goodin was named to the BIG EAST Conference Weekly Honor Roll for the two previous weeks. Goodin averaged 21.5 points, 7.5 assists, 6.0 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game in games at Missouri on Dec. 18 and vs. Detroit Mercy on Dec. 21. The week before Goodin earned a spot on the BIG EAST Conference Weekly Honor Roll after leading XU with 16 points on 6-of-8 shooting to go with 10 assists and a career-high seven steals vs. Eastern Kentucky on Dec. 15.

GOODIN IS A LEADER: Junior captain Quentin Goodin leads the team in scoring at 13.7 ppg. (18th in the BIG EAST), assists at 5.7 apg. (second in the BIG EAST), assist-to-turnover ratio at 2.3 (fifth in the BIG EAST) and steals at 1.8 spg. (fourth in the BIG EAST). Goodin, who has nine double-figure scoring games, scored a then-career high 21 points at Missouri on Dec. 18 and followed that up with a near triple-double with a career-high 22 points, a career-high nine rebounds and nine assists vs. Detroit Mercy on Dec. 21. Goodin, who had eight assists and no turnovers vs. Miami on Nov. 28. hit 7-of-11 from field en route to 20 points vs. San Diego State on Nov. 20. Goodin scored a team-high 15 points in the Illinois win on Nov. 21. Goodin, who entered this season with a streak of 52 straight starts, sat out the Ohio game on Dec. 5 with an illness and missed the opener vs. IUPUI on Nov. 6 with a shoulder injury.

MARSHALLING IN A STRONG START:

Sophomore Naji Marshall, who sat out the Detroit Mercy game on Dec. 21 with an injury, returned in a big way on Saturday at DePaul with a double-double (third of the season and his career) with a gamehigh 19 points to go with a game-high and career-high 14 rebounds and four assists. His 3-pointer with 3:39 left put XU ahead for good at 63-61. Marshall leads the team in rebounding at 8.1 rpg. (tied for second in the BIG EAST) and is second on the team in scoring (13.0 ppg.) and assists (tied for 10th in the BIG EAST at 3.5 apg.). Marshall, who has nine double-figure scoring games this season, recorded his first career double-double with a career-high 24 points to go with 13 rebounds in the Wisconsin game on Nov. 13. Marshall hit 10-of-15 from the field. Marshall recorded

his second career double-double with 15 points, 10 rebounds and six assists vs. Eastern Kentucky on Dec. 15. Marshall, who was selected 2018-19 preseason All-BIG EAST Honorable Mention, was a unanimous selection to the 2017-18 BIG EAST All-Freshman Team.

SCRUGGS STARTING WELL: Sophomore Paul Scruggs, who is one of only two players who has started all 14 games this season, leads the team with 10 doublefigure scoring games and leads the team in 3-point field goal percentage (fifth in the BIG EAST at .463). Scruggs led Xavier with 21 points vs. Ohio on Dec. 5 on 8-of-9 shooting from the field to go with five rebounds and career highs of eight assists and four steals. Scruggs, who hit all five of his shots from the field vs. Eastern Kentucky on Dec. 15 as part of a 14-point effort, ranks third on the team in scoring (11.9 ppg.), third in assists at 3.0 apg. and second in steals at 1.5 spg. (eighth in the BIG EAST). He is also contributing 4.6 rebounds per game (tied for third on the team). Scruggs scored a career-high 24 points in the Evansville win on Nov. 10, while setting new career highs for 3-pointers (4) and field goals (8). He contributed 16 points and four assists vs. Auburn on Nov. 19.

ZACH ATTACK: Graduate transfer Zach Hankins, who has made his first two starts as a Musketeer in the last two games, leads the BIG EAST Conference in field goal percentage at 71.6 percent and is third in blocked shots at 1.4 bpg. Hankins made his first start as a Musketeer on Dec. 21 vs. Detroit Mercy, contributing a double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds to go with a Xavier career-high six blocks. Hankins contributed 14 points on 6-of-7 shooting to go with two blocks in the EKU win on Dec. 15. Hankins, who is sixth on the team in scoring at 9.5 ppg., scored a Xavier career-high 15 points on the strength of 6-of-8 shooting from the field vs. San Diego State on Nov. 20 and recorded a double-double vs. Wisconsin on Nov. 13 with 11 points and 10 rebounds to go with four blocks.

JONES IS HITTING THE BOARDS ... LEADS THE NATION IN OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING PERCENTAGE: Junior Tyrique Jones, who sat out the Detroit Mercy game on Dec. 21 after starting each of the first 12 games, came up big at DePaul on Saturday with 13 points off the bench. He was a big part of the decisive, game-ending 19-4 run,

contributing six points, two rebounds, two blocks and steal during the run. Jones is second on the team and sixth in the BIG EAST Conference in rebounding at 7.5 rpg. and is second in the BIG EAST in offensive rebounding at 3.2 per game. Jones' offensive rebounding percentage (18.5) is ranked first in the nation (KenPom.com). He ranks second on the team and fourth in the BIG EAST in field goal percentage at 65.5 percent. Jones recorded back-to-back double-doubles with 13 points and 13 rebounds vs. Miami on Nov. 28 and 11 points and 11 rebounds vs. Oakland on Dec. 1 followed by a 15-point game vs. Ohio on Dec. 5.

BIG EAST HONOR FOR JONES: Junior Tyrique Jones earned a spot on the BIG EAST Conference Honor Roll for his efforts in XU's first two games. Jones averaged 18.0 points and 13.0 rebounds per game in season-opening wins over IUPUI on Nov. 6 and Evansville on Nov. 10. He had a career-high 20 rebounds in the Evansville win, while tying career highs for points (19), blocks (4) and field goals (8). This was XU's first 20-rebound game since David West grabbed 21 vs. George Washington (2-3-01).

CASTLIN MAKING HIS MARK AS A STARTER: Graduate transfer Kyle Castlin, who is one of only two players who has started all 14 games this season, scored a Xavier career-high 10 points in the Oakland win on Dec. 1 and matched that with 10 vs. Ohio on Dec. 5.

DEEP WELLY: Graduate transfer Ryan Welage has hit 20-of-38 (.526) from 3-point range over the last seven games. Welage leads the team and is 10th in the BIG EAST in 3-point field goals made at 2.4 per game, while ranking second on the team and 10th in the BIG EAST in 3-point field goal percentage (.442). Welage, who is fifth on the team in scoring at 9.6 ppg., is coming off back-to-back big games. Welage hit 5-of-8 3-pointers on his way to 17 points at DePaul on Saturday, tying his best scoring effort since the season opener. The game before that he posted a 16-point game vs. Detroit Mercy on Dec. 21. Welage led Xavier with 17 points in the tough overtime loss to then-No. 8 Auburn on Nov. 19 at the Maui Invitational.





KENNEDY EARNING MAJOR TIME:

Freshman **Keonte Kennedy** has played in all 14 games this season, averaging 15.6 minutes per game.

HARDEN BROKE OUT IN MAUI: Xavier sophomore Elias Harden scored a careerhigh 14 points in the Illinois win on Nov. 21 at the Maui Invitational on the strength of a career-high four 3-pointers. Harden scored a combined 23 points and hit 7-of-9 3-pointers in XU's final two games in Maui, including 4-of-4 vs. the Illini. Harden had scored just 18 points in the first 21 games of his career.

NCAA TOURNAMENT ELITE COMPANY:

Xavier, a No. 1 seed in the 2018 NCAA Tournament, has made five straight NCAA Tournaments and 12 of the last 13 NCAA Tournaments. Only eight schools have been to at least 12 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years: Duke, Kansas, Gonzaga and Michigan State are at 13, while Xavier, North Carolina, Villanova and Wisconsin are at 12.

XAVIER SIGNED ONE OF THE NATION'S TOP RECRUITING CLASSES: Head coach Travis Steele has a five-member recruiting class that was ranked No. 11 in the country by 247Sports. The group includes four four-star prospects that are ranked among the top 106 recruits in the country by 247Sports: **Dahmir Bishop**, a 6-5 guard from Philadelphia, Zach Freemantle, a 6-9 forward from Oradell, N.J., Daniel Ramsey, a 6-8 forward from Norcross, Ga. and Dekeyvan "KyKy" Tandy, a 6-1 guard from Hopkinsville, Ky. Local product Dieonte Miles, a 6-11 center, is a threestar recruit from Walton, Ky. Bishop, a Pennsylvania Sports Writers Class AAAA First Team All-State selection, averaged 9.5 ppg. and 4.5 rpg. for a balanced Imhotep Institute Charter School team that finished 31-2 for the second straight year and won a second straight PIAA Class AAAA State Championship. Freemantle averaged 18.9 points, 10.3 rebounds, 1.4 blocks, 1.3 assists and 1.3 steals as a junior at Bergen Catholic in Oradell, N.J., one of only three underclassmen chosen as First Team All-Bergen County by the area coaches. Miles, a standout at Walton-Verona High School who missed most of his junior year to injury, blocked 4.0 shots per game as a sophomore and earned a spot on the All-Region and All-District teams. Ramsey, who will play his senior season at Norcross High School in Norcross, Ga., enjoyed a standout career at Deerfield-Windsor High

School in Albany, Ga. where the three-time *Albany Herald* Super Sixer averaged 16.0 points and 7.9 rebounds per game as a junior. **Tandy**, who plays at University Heights Academy, averaged 30.5 points and 5.0 rebounds per game as a junior, while shooting 48 percent from 3-point territory and 61 percent overall. Tandy will be one of this season's top candidates for Kentucky's Mr. Basketball Award.

XAVIER WILL BE A PART OF NEXT YEAR'S CHARLESTON CLASSIC: The Charleston Classic announced the eight-team field for the 2019 tournament to be held Nov. 21, 22 and 24, at TD Arena in Charleston, S.C. The field will include UConn, Florida, Miami (Fla.), Missouri State, Penn State, Saint Joseph's, Towson and Xavier.

THE BIG EAST AND BIG 12 ANNOUNCED A SERIES STARTING IN 2019-20: The BIG EAST and Big 12 Conferences announced the creation of a non-conference scheduling series for four seasons, beginning in 2019-20 and continuing through 2022-23. Ten games between the two leagues will be played each season during the month of December.

Travis Steele, who was named the Sedler Family Men's Head Basketball Coach at Xavier on Saturday, March 31, picked up his first career win on Nov. 6 vs. IUPUI. Steele celebrated his 37th birthday on Nov. 12.

Steele spent the past 10 seasons at Xavier, including nine on the staff of his predecessor, Chris Mack. Steele is the 18th head coach in Xavier basketball history.

"As we completed our national search process, it became clear that the best head coach for our program was the person we knew the best, Travis Steele," said Xavier University Vice President

and Director of Athletics Greg Christopher. "Travis brings passion, personality and organizational leadership skills to our head coaching position, which is really the CEO of our basketball program. He has earned a reputation as one of the brightest young offensive minds in the game and one of the future stars in this profession."

Steele has been a part of nine NCAA Tournament teams in his 10 years at Xavier, including five teams that reached at least the Sweet 16. Last year's team won XU's first BIG EAST Regular Season Championship, a school-record final AP ranking of No. 3 and the first NCAA Tournament No. 1 seed in school history.

Steele, who was named over the last two years as one of the top two recruiters in the BIG EAST Conference by *Sporting News* basket-ball magazine, is a big part of the reason Xavier's recent recruiting classes have earned national attention. He has played a key role in multiple nationally-ranked recruiting classes in recent years, including three straight classes ranked among the top 20 in the country.

Steele has participated in the Nike-produced Villa 7 consortium, which annually brings together the country's elite assistant basket-ball coaches to build the next generation of great basketball leaders.

Former Xavier head coach Sean Miller hired Steele prior to the 2008-09 season as Xavier's Director of Basketball Operations. Mack promoted Steele to assistant coach after he took over the program prior to the 2009-10 season. Steele was promoted to Associate Head Coach following the 2015-16 season.

Prior to Xavier, Steele worked on the staff at Indiana. He joined the Hoosiers in August of 2006, taking on the duties of the video coordinator. After serving as the video coordinator for a season and a half while at IU, he was promoted to the position of assistant coach in February, 2008.

Prior to his time with the Hoosiers, Steele served as an assistant men's basketball coach at Wabash Valley College (2005-06) and spent a year with the Ohio State basketball program as a graduate manager (2004-05) under former XU head coach Thad Matta.

From 2001-06, Steele was a coach for the Spiece/Indiana Adidas Elite AAU Basketball program. Steele also was an assistant varsity coach at Ben Davis High School while attending Butler University from 2001-04.

Steele, the brother of former XU assistant and current Akron head coach John Groce, graduated cum laude from Butler in May 2004, earning a bachelor of science degree in marketing. Steele was born Nov. 12, 1981 in Danville, Indiana. He and his wife Amanda reside in Cincinnati with their five-year-old son, Winston.
