- Xavier is playing the second game of a season-opening four-game homestand.
- Xavier is in its 20th season at Cintas Center, which opened for the 2000-01 season.
- Xavier won its 30th straight regular season opener with a 76-57 win over Jacksonville on Tuesday.
- Xavier is No. 19 in the preseason Associated Press Poll and No. 21 in the preseason *USA Today Sports* coaches poll.
- Xavier returned four starters from last year's team.
- Xavier junior **Naji Marshall**, preseason First Team All-BIG EAST, is on the preseason watch lists for the Wendy's Wooden Award, the Citizen Naismith Trophy and the Julius Erving Award. He tied for game-high scoring honors in the opener with 17.
- Xavier junior **Paul Scruggs**, a 2019 BIG EAST Championship All-Tournament Team member, was named 2019-20 preseason honorable mention All-BIG EAST.
- Xavier junior **Quentin Goodin** is looking to become just the second XU player to lead XU in assists four straight years. He is eighth on XU's all-time assist chart.
- Xavier junior **Tyrique Jones**, who led XU in rebounding (fourth in the BIG EAST at 7.7 rpg.) last season, posted a double-double in the opener with 17 points and 11 rebounds in 21 minutes of action.

20TH SEASON AT CINTAS CEN-

TER: Xavier is in its 20th season at Cintas Center, which opened for the 2000-01 season.

STREAKING: Xavier has now won 30 straight regular season openers after its win over Jacksonville (29 at home and one on the road) with its last loss in an opener coming in the 1989-90 "Sweet 16" season to Southern Utah State at Cincinnati Gardens. XU is now 20-0 in season openers at Cintas Center.

HOME COOKING: Xavier is playing the second game of a fourgame homestand when it hosts Siena. XU welcomes Mizzou on Nov. 12 and Missouri State on Nov. 15. The Missouri State game has been designated as Xavier's Charleston Classic Opening Game, a non-bracketed part of the tournament that sends XU to Charleston later this month.

XAVIER-SIENA SERIES: Xavier leads the series 3-1, including wins in each of the last three meetings. XU won the last meeting 96-88 at Siena in the 2002-03 season (12-23-02). XU won the only previous meeting at Cintas Center, 68-59 in the 2001-02 season (12-31-01).

FOR THE RECORD (XAVIER): Xavier, 1-0, recorded a 76-57 win over Jacksonville on Tuesday in XU's season opener, the Musketeers' 30th straight season-opening victory. Senior Tyrique Jones tied for game-high scoring honors with 17 points on 7-of-8 shooting and completed the double-double with a game-high 11 rebounds. Junior Naji Marshall shared scoring honors with 17 points to go with six rebounds, four assists and two steals.

FOR THE RECORD (SIENA): The Siena College Saints, 1-0 and members of the MAAC (Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference), opened the season with a 96-80 win over American on Tuesday.

NATIONALLY RANKED: Xavier checked in at No. 19 in the preseason Associated Press Poll and No. 21 in the preseason *USA Today Sports* coaches poll. Xavier's



NAJI MARSHALL EARNING PRESEASON ATTENTION

Junior **Naji Marshall**, a 2019-20 preseason First Team All-BIG EAST Conference selection, has been named to the Watch Lists for the 2020 Wendy's Wooden Award and the 2020 Citizen Naismith Trophy. Marshall is also on the Watch List for the Basketball Hall of Fame's 2020 Julius Erving Award for the nation's top small forward.

last preseason top 25 ranking in both polls was prior to the 2017-18 season when XU was ranked No. 17 in both polls. XU finished that season with a school-record No. 3 final AP Poll ranking, a school-record No. 8 final *USA Today Sports* Poll ranking and a No. 1 seed in the 2018 NCAA Tournament.

RETURNING TALENT: Xavier returned four starters from last year's team that finished 19-16 and made the second round of the NIT, while finishing tied for third in the BIG EAST Conference at 9-9 in Travis Steele's first season as head coach: seniors Quentin Goodin and Tyrique Jones and juniors Naji Marshall and Paul Scruggs.

BUILDING ON LAST SEASON'S STRONG FINISH: Xavier won eight of its last 11 games last season, including wins over Villanova, Toledo, at Seton Hall, St. John's (home and away), Creighton (home and neutral) and at Providence. All of those teams made the NCAA Tournament or NIT fields. XU's last three losses were at Butler (NIT), at Texas (NIT) in overtime and vs. Villanova (NCAA) in overtime on a neutral court.

MARSHALL EARNED PRESEASON ALL-BIG EAST HONORS: Junior Naji Marshall, who tied for game-high scoring honors in the season opener with 17 points, was named preseason First Team All-BIG EAST Conference by the league coaches. Marshall led Xavier in scoring last season at 14.7 ppg., which ranked 12th in the BIG EAST. Marshall ranked second on the team in rebounding at 7.2 rpg., which was eighth

in the BIG EAST, and assists at 3.4 apg., which was 10th in the BIG EAST. Marshall led the BIG EAST in defensive rebounding at 6.3 rpg. He was a 2018-19 All-BIG EAST Second Team selection.

MORE ATTENTION FOR MARSHALL:

Junior forward **Naji Marshall**, who made Andy Katz's list of the five most important players in the BIG EAST Conference, was listed as the No. 8 ranked wing in the nation by *The Athletic*.

JONES IS A FORCE INSIDE: Senior Tyrique Jones, who finished last season with a career-high 22 points with 11 rebounds

at Texas on March 24, posted his 12th career double-double to open the season with a game-high 17 points on 7-of-8 shooting and a game-high 11 rebounds on Tuesday vs. Jacksonville. Jones led the team and was fourth in the BIG EAST Conference in rebounding last season at 7.7 rpg. Jones was first in the BIG EAST and 20th in the nation in offensive rebounding at 3.4 per game. He ranked second on the team and third in the BIG EAST in field goal percentage at 62.4 percent. Jones, who was ranked third on the team in scoring at 11.3 ppg. (24th in the BIG EAST), recorded 20 doublefigure scoring games as a junior.

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced that senior **Tyrique Jones** has been named to the Watch List for the 2020 Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year Award. Named after Class of 2010 Hall of Famer and two-time NBA Most Valuable Player Karl Malone, the annual honor in its sixth year recognizes the top power forwards in Division I men's college basketball.

GOODIN MAKES A POINT ... TOP 10 ON XU'S ALL-TIME ASSIST LEADER CHART: Senior Quentin Goodin, who had 29 assists and only five turnovers over the last five games last season, led the team in assists at 4.8 apg. (third in the BIG EAST) and assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.8 (fifth in the BIG EAST). Goodin has 452 career assists, which is good for eighth place on

Xavier's all-time assist chart.

GOODIN PASSED 100 ASSISTS AGAIN: Senior Quentin Goodin dished off 149 assists in 31 games last season, which was tied for the 16th-best single-season total in Xavier history and marked the third straight season that Goodin had passed the 100-assist mark. Goodin is only the third player in Xavier history to reach 100 assists as an XU freshman, sophomore and junior. The other two are Anthony Hicks (1979-80, 1980-81 and 1981-82) and Dedrick Finn (2002-03, 2003-04 and 2004-05). Hicks is the only XU player who has recorded 100 assists in four straight seasons.

GOODIN IS A LEADER: Senior **Quentin Goodin** has led Xavier in assists three straight years and is looking to become just the second player to lead XU in assists four straight years. **Gary Lumpkin** accomplished that feat in each of his four seasons (1995-99).

PAUL SCRUGGS EARNS THE ATTENTION OF BIG EAST COACHES: Junior Paul Scruggs, who scored 12 points to go with three steals in the opener vs. Jacksonville on Tuesday, was named preseason Honorable Mention All-BIG EAST by the league coaches. Scruggs, who made the 2019 BIG EAST Championship All-Tournament Team, is the only Xavier player who started all 35 games last season. Scruggs

was second on the team in scoring (21st in the BIG EAST at 12.3 ppg.) and led the team in steals (10th in the BIG EAST at 1.2 spg.), while ranking third in assists (12th in the BIG EAST at 3.3 apg.). He also contributed 4.9 rebounds per game (fourth on the team). Scruggs was second on the team in 3-point field goal percentage (.375).

FIRST CAREER START:

Senior **Leighton Schrand** made his first career collegiate start on Tuesday vs. Jacksonville and logged 17 minutes of action. Schrand earned a scholarship as a junior and senior after spending two years as a Musketeer walk-on.

FREEMANTLE CONTRIBUTES IN FIRST GAME: Freshman **Zach Freemantle**contributed 11 points and five rebounds in 19 minutes of action in the opener vs. Jacksonville on Tuesday.

CONSISTENT CONFERENCE SUCCESS:

Xavier's win over St. John's on March 9, 2019 clinched its 37th straight season at .500 or better in regular season conference play (MCC, Atlantic 10 and BIG EAST). No other school in NCAA Division I has an active streak of more than 32 years. Murray State is at 32 straight seasons at .500 or better in league play, while Kansas and Kentucky are at 30 and Gonzaga is at 28.

EVERY BIG EAST TEAM MADE THE 2019 POSTSEASON: All 10 BIG EAST Conference schools made postseason play in 2019, including four NCAA Tournament berths, five NIT berths and one berth in the CBI. Marquette, Villanova, Seton Hall and St. John's were NCAA Tournament teams, while Butler, Creighton, Georgetown, Providence and Xavier were in the NIT field. DePaul made the CBI.

TRAVIS STEELE RADIO SHOW: The next Travis Steele Radio Show will air live from Dilly Bistro in Mariemont on Monday, November 11. The show airs from 7-8 p.m. on 55KRC. The popular radio tandem of Joe Sunderman and Byron Larkin host the show along with head coach Travis Steele.

Miles, 6-11 freshman forward from Walton, Ky., and Walton-Verona High School, will redshirt this season. "After discussing Dieonte Miles' future with him, his family and our coaching staff, we decided that redshirting this season is in his best interest," said head coach **Travis Steele**. "Dieonte is a talented young man who has a very bright future. Our coaching staff will work very hard with him during his redshirt year to get him physically stronger and continue to develop his game at both ends of the court. Dieonte has a chance to be a special player and this extra year of development will do wonders for him." Miles, a 2019

All-Region, while earning Eighth Region Player of the Year (Kentucky Association of Basketball Coaches), 32nd District MVP honors and NKCK Conference Player of the Year as a senior. Miles averaged 14.7 points, 6.7 rebounds, 4.0 blocks and 3.0 assists as a senior, while shooting 64.4 percent from the field. He led Walton-Verona to the state tournament for the first time since 1942.

CELEBRATING 20 YEARS AT CINTAS CEN-

TER: Xavier is in its 20th season in Cintas Center, which opened for the 2000-01 season. Opening Night vs. Jacksonville on Nov. 5 marked the 300th game at Xavier's on-campus home.

OVER THREE MILLION FANS: Xavier has drawn 3,021,408 fans for men's basketball since Cintas Center opened, an average of 10,071 fans per game for the 300 games played in the arena. XU honored its three millionth fan at the St. John's game on March 9, 2019, which had a standing-room only crowd of 10,391.

CINTAS CENTER MAGIC: Xavier is 259-41 (.863) all-time at Cintas Center, including 1-0 this season. Xavier's all-time winning percentage at Cintas Center is ranked seventh in the nation.

SELLING OUT: Xavier, which sold out 13 of its 18 home games in the 2018-19 season, has sold out 180 games at Cintas Center since it opened for the 2000-01 season. XU posted a school record 18 sellouts in the 2017-18 season in 18 games.

BIG EAST GAMES ARE AN EVEN TOUGHER

TICKET: 19 of the top 25 all-time singlegame attendance totals in Cintas Center history were BIG EAST games. All nine BIG EAST rivals are represented on this list: Butler (3), Creighton (3), DePaul (1), Georgetown (1), Marquette (3), Providence (2), Seton Hall (1), St. John's (1) and Villanova (4).

- + Xavier has won or shared 18 regular season conference championships over its years in the BIG EAST, Atlantic 10 and MCC (one BIG EAST, nine A-10 and eight MCC), while winning 10 conference tournament championships (four A-10 and six MCC). XU was in the MCC for 16 years (1980-1995) and the A-10 for 18 years (1996-2013). This season marks Xavier's sixth year in the BIG EAST.



Steele was a finalist for the 2019 Joe B. Hall National Coach of the Year Award, which is given annually to the nation's top first-year head coach in Division I. Steele, who finished 19-16 in his first

season as the Xavier head coach, led XU to eight wins in its last 11 games, including an NIT win. All of those opponents for those 11 games were in either the NCAA Tournament or NIT fields, including seven road and neutral site games.

Steele and his staff have put together one of the nation's top 20 recruiting classes in his first year at the helm. That's not a surprise since he was named one of the top two recruiters in the BIG EAST Conference by *Sporting News* basketball magazine in each of his final two seasons as a Xavier assistant.

The 37-year-old Steele was named the Sedler Family Men's Head Basketball Coach at Xavier on Saturday, March 31, 2018. Steele spent the previous 10 seasons at Xavier, including nine on the staff of his predecessor, Chris Mack. Steele is the 18th head coach in Xavier basketball history.

Steele has been a part of nine NCAA Tournament teams in his 11 years at Xavier, including five teams that reached at least the Sweet 16. Last year's team won XU's first BIG EAST Regular Season Championship, a school-record final AP ranking of No. 3 and the first NCAA Tournament No. 1 seed in school history.

Steele has participated in the Nike-produced Villa 7 consortium, which annually brings together the country's elite assistant basket-ball coaches to build the next generation of great basketball leaders.

Former Xavier head coach Sean Miller hired Steele prior to the 2008-09 season as Xavier's Director of Basketball Operations. Mack promoted Steele to assistant coach after he took over the program prior to the 2009-10 season. Steele was promoted to Associate Head Coach following the 2015-16 season.

Prior to Xavier, Steele worked on the staff at Indiana. He joined the Hoosiers in August of 2006, taking on the duties of the video coordinator. After serving as the video coordinator for a season and a half while at IU, he was promoted to the position of assistant coach in February, 2008.

Prior to his time with the Hoosiers, Steele served as an assistant men's basketball coach at Wabash Valley College (2005-06) and spent a year with the Ohio State basketball program as a graduate manager (2004-05) under former XU head coach Thad Matta.

From 2001-06, Steele was a coach for the Spiece/Indiana Adidas Elite AAU Basketball program. Steele also was an assistant varsity coach at Ben Davis High School while attending Butler University from 2001-04.

Steele, the brother of former XU assistant and current Akron head coach John Groce, graduated cum laude from Butler in May 2004, earning a bachelor of science degree in marketing. Steele was born Nov. 12, 1981 in Danville, Indiana. He and his wife Amanda reside in Cincinnati with their sixyear-old son, Winston, and Anderson Michael, who was born September 30, 2019.
