THE X FACTORS

- Xavier is playing the fourth game of a six-game homestand.
- Xavier is looking to snap a two-game losing streak after falling 66-60 to No. 6 Houston on Friday night. Graduate student **Quincy Olivari** led XU with 17 points and four assists.
- Xavier sophomore **Desmond Claude** leads the team at 16.4 ppg. (tied for eighth in the BIG EAST), including 24 vs. Oakland. Claude, the only Musketeer who has scored in double figures in every game, is the only returnee from last season that has played a game.
- Xavier grad student **Quincy Olivari** has scored in double figures seven times, including five straight games. Olivari, who is second on the team in scoring (13.9 ppg.) and rebounding (4.9 rpg.), is tied for sixth in the BIG EAST in 3-point field goals at 2.4 per game.
- Xavier senior **Dayvion McKnight** leads the BIG EAST Conference in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.55. He is fifth in the BIG EAST in assists at 4.88 per game.
- Xavier freshman **Trey Green**, who is second on the team in 3-point field goals at 1.29 per game, missed the Houston game due to illness. He has connected on at least one 3-pointer in each of his last six games.
- Xavier head coach **Sean Miller** holds a 151-61 (.712) mark in his seventh season leading Xavier, which is good for third place on Xavier's all-time wins list.
- Xavier has 10 newcomers on the 2023-24 roster, including six freshmen and four transfers. All 10 newcomers have played this season. Freshman **Lazar Djokovic**, who sat out the first three games with a hand injury, has played in the last five games.
- Xavier has three international players on its 2023-24 roster, including freshmen **Lazar Djokovic** (Serbia) and **Saša Ciani** (Slovenia) and senior **Gytis Nemeikša** (Lithuania).

THE XAVIER-DELAWARE SERIES: The series is tied 1-1, although the two teams have not played since meeting in the Daiwa NCAA Ball Tournament in Tokyo, Japan, in the 1992-93 season. XU won that game 74-66 behind 26 points and 11 rebounds from future NBA Draft lottery pick **Brian Grant**.

FOR THE RECORD (DELAWARE): Delaware, 5-3, is coming off a 74-73 loss at Ohio on Saturday.

FOR THE RECORD (XAVIER): Xavier, 4-4, lost 66-60 to No. 6 Houston on Friday in a BIG EAST-Big 12 Battle game. XU fell behind 16-4 early in the game due to four early Cougar 3-pointers. The Musketeers, who trailed 36-31 at halftime, fell behind by 13 points (UH 46-33 at the under 16-minute media timeout) but battled all the way back to take the lead, 52-51 with 6:57 left, on a pair of free throws from sophomore **Desmond Claude**. It proved to be XU's final lead of the game. Graduate student **Quincy Olivari** led Xavier with 17 points, four assists and no turnovers.

CHALLENGING THE BEST: Xavier has now played No. 1 (Houston) and No. 2 (at Purdue) in the kenpom rankings. Among XU's future games are home-and-away series with No. 4 UConn, No. 6 Marquette and No. 11 Creighton.

XAVIER SPLIT TWO GAMES IN LAS VEGAS: Xavier bounced back from a tough 74-71 setback vs. Washington on Nov. 17 and defeated WCC preseason favorite Saint Mary's 66-49 on Nov. 19 at the Continental Tire Main Event in Las Vegas. XU placed four players in double figures in scoring led by senior **Dayvion McKnight** with 14 points. Sophomore **Desmond Claude** contributed a career-high seven assists with only one turnover to go with 11 points.

OLIVARI EARNED ALL-TOURNAMENT HONORS: Xavier graduate student **Quincy Olivari** earned a spot on the Continental Tire Main Event All-Tournament Team after averaging 12.5 points and a team-high 7.0 rebounds for XU's two games in Las Vegas.

OLIVARI NUMBERS IMPROVING: Xavier graduate student **Quincy Olivari** is second on the team in scoring at 13.9 ppg. Olivari

has scored in double figures in seven of Xavier's eight games, including each of the last five games. He scored a season-high 22 vs. Bryant on Nov. 24 and a team-high 17 vs. No. 6 Houston on Dec. 1. Olivari is second on the team in rebounding (4.9 rpg.) and leads the team and is tied for sixth in the BIG EAST in 3-point field goals at 2.4 per game.

McKNIGHT MAKING A POINT: Senior **Dayvion McKnight** leads the BIG EAST in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.55. He is fifth in the BIG EAST in assists at 4.88 apg. He has recorded two eight-assist games this season, vs. Brant on Nov. 24 and Oakland on Nov. 27.

CAREER NIGHT FOR GYTIS: Senior **Gytis Nemeikša** scored a career-high and game-high tying 20 points vs. Washington on Nov. 17. He is third on the team in scoring at 9.4 ppg. and leads the team in rebounding at 5.4 rpg. Nemeikša has started every game.

CLAUDE IS THE LONE FAMILIAR FACE: Xavier sophomore **Desmond Claude** leads the team and is tied for eighth in the BIG EAST Conference in scoring at 16.4 ppg. after eight games. Claude, who led Xavier with 24 points, six rebounds, four assists and three steals vs. Oakland on Nov. 27, is the only Musketeer who has scored in double figures in every game this season. He is the only returnee from last season that has played in a game this season. Claude, a 2022-23 BIG EAST All-Freshman Team selection, averaged 4.7 ppg. last season.

CLAUDE EARNED A BIG EAST HONOR: Xavier sophomore **Desmond Claude** was named to the first BIG EAST Conference Honor Roll of the season after averaging 18.5 points, 2.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists in the wins over Robert Morris on Nov. 6 and Jacksonville on Nov. 10. He more than doubled his previous career-high scoring effort (12) with a game-high 25 points vs. Robert Morris. He nearly matched that effort with 24 points vs. Oakland on Nov. 27.

PLENTY OF NEW FACES: Xavier has 10 newcomers on the roster, including six freshmen and four transfers. Xavier has only two returning scholarship letterwinners on the active roster. Sophomore **Desmond Claude**, a member of the 2022-23 BIG EAST All-Freshman Team, averaged 4.7 ppg. last season while playing in 35 games. Fellow sophomore **Kam Craft** was limited to 15 games last season due to injury and has not played this season. Two other returnees, **Zach Freemantle** (78 starts in four years) and **Jerome Hunter** (32 starts in two years at

XU) are both inactive due to medical issues. Freemantle had surgery on his left foot in September.

DJOKOVIC EARNED A BIG EAST HONOR: Freshman **Lazar Djokovic** was named the BIG EAST Conference Freshman of the Week after scoring 10 points to go with four rebounds and two assists in the win over Bryant on Nov. 24. It marked his first double-figure scoring game as a Musketeer. Djokovic sat out the first three games due to an injury to his shooting hand. He made his Xavier debut in XU's two games in Las Vegas.

24TH SEASON AT CINTAS CENTER: The Xavier men's basketball team holds a 315-57 (.847) record in its 24th season in its on-campus home, the 10,224-seat Cintas Center, including 3-2 this season.

TOUGH TICKET: Xavier has recorded 221 sellouts at full arena capacity at Cintas Center, including four home games this season. Xavier has averaged 10,036 fans for its 359 games played at full capacity since it opened for the 2000-01 season (all but the attendance-restricted pandemic year of 2020-21). Xavier, which welcomed a Cintas Center record standing room only



27TH-STRAIGHT WINNING SEASON: The Xavier Musketeers, 27-10 last season, have recorded 27-straight winning seasons. XU's 27-year streak is tied for fourth-best in all of NCAA Division I according to official NCAA records entering the 2023-24 season. XU's last losing season was in the 1995-96 season.

crowd of 10,817 for the Cincinnati game in the 2017-18 season, has averaged over 98 percent capacity of Cintas Center since the building opened for all non-pandemic years. The Georgetown, Cincinnati and Creighton home games this season are also already officially sold out.

PRESEASON HONORS FOR CLAUDE: Sophomore **Desmond Claude** was named a Top 15 Breakout Player for the 2023-24 season by *The Athletic*. In addition, he was selected to the preseason BIG EAST Conference Second Team in the annual preseason preview *The Almanac*, the college basketball season preview produced by The Field of 68 staff.

PRESEASON HONORS FOR MCKNIGHT: Senior **Dayvion McKnight**, who transferred to Xavier from Western Kentucky, was selected as the BIG EAST Preseason Newcomer of the Year in the annual preseason preview *The Almanac*, the college basketball season preview produced by The Field of 68 staff. In addition, a panel of anonymous BIG EAST coaches selected him as a league breakout star in *The Almanac*.

PRESEASON HONORS FOR THREE XAVIER FRESHMEN: Freshman **Lazar Djokovic** was named one of the top 10 incoming international players by ESPN. Freshman **Trey Green** was named one of the top 25 impact freshmen nationally according to **Jon Rothstein** of CBS Sports and the College Hoops Today Podcast. In addition, Rothstein listed freshman **Dailyn Swain** as one of the top 20 under-the-radar freshmen nationally.

INTERNATIONAL IMPACT: Xavier has three international players on its 2023-24 roster, including freshmen **Lazar Djokovic** and **Saša Ciani** and senior **Gytis Nemeikša**. This is the first time on record that Xavier has welcomed any international men's basketball student-athlete directly from their home country. Previous international players like Hall of Famer **Romain Sato** (native of Central African Republic who played at Dayton Christian before coming to Xavier) did not come directly from their homeland.

MILLER OVER 150 WINS AS XAVIER'S HEAD COACH: Xavier seventh-year head coach **Sean Miller**, who was the XU head coach for five seasons from 2004-09, led XU to a 27-10 record and a NCAA Sweet 16 berth last season. Miller now holds a 151-61 (.712) mark in his seventh season leading Xavier. He won his 150th vs. Saint Mary's on Nov. 19. His 151 wins at XU rank third on Xavier's all-time wins list. He passed the late **Skip Prosser** (148 wins in seven years from 1994-01) with the win over Jacksonville on Nov. 10. Miller has taken Xavier to at least the Sweet 16 in each of his last three sea-

sons as the Xavier head coach (2023 Sweet 16, 2009 Sweet 16 and 2008 Elite Eight).

POSTSEASON REGULAR: Xavier made its 34th postseason appearance in the last 40 postseasons in 2023 (2020 cancelled by the pandemic), including 28 NCAA Tournament berths and six NIT berths during that time. XU only made the NCAA Tournament field one time (1961) before the 1982-83 season. Xavier, 27-10 overall last season, finished in second place at 15-5 in the BIG EAST Conference regular season race and runner-up to Marquette at the BIG EAST Tournament. Xavier earned a spot in the 2023 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 with wins over Kennesaw State and Pittsburgh in the NCAA Tournament.

SWEET SUCCESS: Xavier is one of only 11 schools that have made at least seven NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 appearances in the last 15 tournaments (since 2008). The list includes Kansas (9), North Carolina (9), Duke (9), Gonzaga (9), Michigan State (9), Kentucky (8), Xavier (7), Arizona (7), Wisconsin (7), Syracuse (7) and Michigan (7). Of those 11 schools only Xavier, Michigan State and Gonzaga made the 2023 Sweet 16. Xavier made its ninth appearance in the NCAA Sweet 16. XU's first appearance came in 1990 against Texas in a Regional Semifinal in Dallas, Texas.

FOUR-STAR STANDOUT SIGNS ON FOR NEXT SEASON: Head Coach **Sean Miller** has received a signed National Letter of Intent from **Jonathan Powell**, a four-star combo guard from Centerville (Ohio) High School. The 6-6 Powell is ranked as the nation's No. 98 prospect overall, No. 22 shooting guard nationally and number four overall in Ohio for 2024, according to 247Sports. Powell, a 2022-23 First Team All-Ohio selection in Division I, led Centerville at 16.7 points per game as a junior to go with 3.1 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 1.4 steals per game. He hit 49 percent of his shots from the floor, including 41 percent of his threes (87 of 214). He had 11 20-point games for the year, including a string of six straight at midseason. The Elks ended the season at 25-4 after a state semifinal loss to Pickerington Central. Powell was a star on the Chaminade-Julienne varsity team as a sophomore in 2021-22, earning Third Team All-Ohio honors in Division II, before transferring to Centerville.

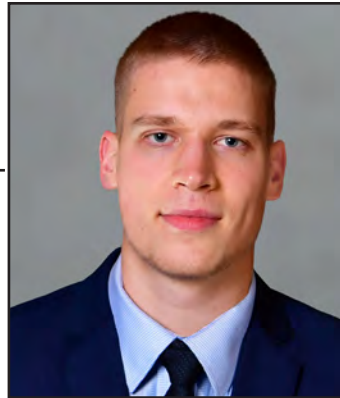

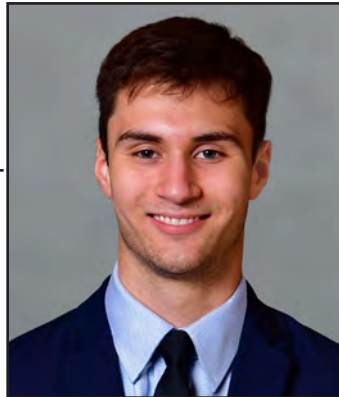

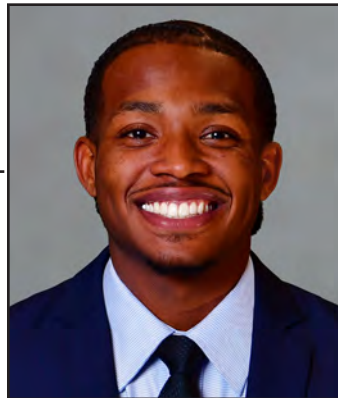

Sean Miller, the Sedler Family Men's Basketball Head Coach, returned to Xavier in 2022 after 12 seasons (2009-21) as the head coach at Arizona. His first season back he led Xavier to one of the top five winningest seasons in school history at 27-10, tied the school record for BIG EAST wins in a season at 15-5 and led the Musketeers back to the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16.

Xavier University announced a contract extension for Miller in October, adding two years to the previous deal. The new contract runs through the 2028-29 season.

Miller, who earned a spot on the 2023 Werner Ladder Naismith Men's College Coach of the Year Late Season Watch List, owns a 453-170 (.727) on-court record and is in his 19th season as a head coach. In his first 18 years as a head coach, including six at Xavier (2004-09 and the 2022-23 season), Miller had eight Regular Season Conference Championships, four Conference Tournament Championships and 12 NCAA Tournament appearances, including four Elite Eights and four Sweet 16s.

Miller holds a 151-61 (.712) mark in his seventh season leading Xavier. His 151 wins at XU rank him third on Xavier's all-time wins list. He passed the late Skip Prosser (148 wins in seven seasons from 1994-01) with the Jacksonville win on Nov. 10.

Miller has taken Xavier to at least the Sweet 16 in each of his last three seasons as the Xavier head coach (2023 Sweet 16, 2009 Sweet 16 and 2008 Elite Eight). Miller was the Xavier head coach previous-

ly for five seasons from 2004-09 and XU has now made the NCAA Tournament in five of his six years as the XU head coach.

In 2023, Miller coached in his 12th NCAA Tournament as a head coach, including his fifth at Xavier. He served as a head coach in his eighth Sweet 16, including his third at Xavier. He reached five Sweet 16s (three that advanced to Elite Eights) in 12 seasons at Arizona. Miller has a 21-12 on-court record as a head coach in NCAA Tournament play, including 13-7 at Arizona and 8-5 at XU.

NATIONAL LEADER ON OFFENSE

Xavier led the nation in assists for the 2022-23 season at 19.1 apg., while ranking in the top 10 in scoring offense (10th at 80.9 ppg.), field goal percentage (seventh at .492) and 3-point percentage (fifth at 39.0). XU led the BIG EAST Conference in all four categories.

SECOND STINT AS XAVIER HEAD COACH

Xavier, 27-10 overall for the 2022-23 season, tied the 2008-09 Sweet 16 team coached by Miller for the fifth-best win total in Xavier history. The school record of 30 wins was set by the 2007-08 Elite Eight team, also under Miller. Xavier finished 15-5 and in second place in the BIG EAST Conference, tying the school record for most BIG EAST wins.

Xavier, which reached the 2023 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, has made the NCAA Tournament in each of Miller's last five seasons at the helm (including his first stint from 2004-09 that ended with the Elite Eight in 2008 and the Sweet 16 in 2009). That gives him three straight years making at least the Sweet 16 as the XU head coach. Miller won four Atlantic 10 Championships, including three regular season titles and one tournament title, during his first stint at XU. XU won a school-record 30 games in 2008 on the way to the Elite Eight. Miller was named the 2007-08 Atlantic 10 Conference Coach of the Year after leading Xavier to a 14-2 record and a second straight A-10 Regular Season Title. The National Association of Basketball Coaches named Miller as its 2008 NABC District 10 Coach of the Year and he was a finalist for numerous National Coach of the Year awards.

WINNING AND POSTSEASON SUCCESS

As a head coach, Miller's teams have made it to 12 NCAA Tournaments since 2006. In nine of those 12 years, the team advanced beyond the NCAA Tournament's First Round, with four trips culminating in the Sweet 16 and four others in the Elite Eight.



INTERNATIONAL SUCCESS

Recruiting has evolved into a worldwide effort for Sean Miller and staff. During his 12 seasons at Arizona, Miller signed a total of 13 international players. This group included six that would go on to play in the NBA - highlighted by the first pick in the 2018 NBA Draft, Deandre Ayton (Bahamas), 2023 NBA All-Star and the 2023 NBA Most Improved Player Award winner Lauri Markkanen (Finland) and Bennedict Mathurin (Canada). Nine of Miller's international signees would be named All-Conference including 2022 Pac-12 Conference Player of the Year Bennedict Mathurin (Canada) and 2018 Pac-12 Conference Player of the Year Deandre Ayton (Bahamas).

MILLER PLAYERS IN THE NBA

With the exception of only Kentucky's John Calipari, no other active head coach can claim a deeper roster of NBA players than Sean Miller. Over the last 18 seasons as a head coach, Miller has seen 26 players that he has signed and/or coached move on to play professionally in the NBA, including Colby Jones, a 2023 NBA Draft second round selection (34th overall selection). Of these 26, 12 were selected in the First Round of the NBA Draft, including six NBA Lottery picks. The Lottery selections include the first overall pick in 2018 (Deandre Ayton), the second overall pick in 2011 (Derrick Williams) and the fourth overall pick in 2014 (Aaron Gordon).

SUCCESS WITH TRANSFERS

Miller's recruiting success hasn't been limited to only high school aged prospects, domestic and abroad. Several key pieces to his programs at both Xavier and Arizona have been added via transfer.

During Miller's first tenure at Xavier, key transfers paved the way for an incredible run that would see five straight Atlantic 10 Regular Season Championships on Victory Parkway. All five transfers signed under Miller would be recognized as All-Conference players in the Atlantic 10 Conference. Jordan Crawford, an Indiana transfer signed under Miller, would lead the 2010 Musketeers to the NCAA Sweet 16 under Xavier first-year head coach Chris Mack. A 2010 NBA First Round Draft pick, Crawford would go on to be named the *Sporting News* and FoxSports.com Atlantic 10 Conference Player of the Year and *Sporting News* Third Team All-American. Crawford also earned a spot on the five-member NCAA Tournament All-West Region Team after averaging 29.0 ppg. for Xavier's three games, including a career-high 32 against Kansas State in the Regional Semifinal.

At Arizona, Miller continued his trend of bolstering rosters with transfers. During the 12-year span in Tucson, five more incoming transfers would be named All-Conference by the Pac-12. Two of the five, T.J. McConnell and Kadeem Allen, would propel their time at Arizona to a career in the NBA.

Back at Xavier for a second time, Miller has quickly added to his run of transfer success. Miller added transfer guard Souley Boum to the Xavier roster before last season. Boum, a 2023 First Team All-BIG EAST Conference selection, was on the Jersey Mike's Naismith Men's Midseason Team, a Top 10 candidate for the 2023 Bob Cousy Award and selected to the U.S. Basketball Writers Association's Oscar Robertson Trophy Midseason Watch List. At the end of the 2022-23 season, Boum was named an Associated Press Honorable Mention All-American and earned Third Team All-America honors from The Field of 68, Stadium and College Hoops Today.

SUCCESS IN THE CLASSROOM

Since becoming the Xavier head coach in 2004, every single player Sean Miller coached that has exhausted their eligibility has gone on to graduate. Standing at 52 straight graduates, this streak is comprised of 20 straight graduates from Xavier University and 32 straight graduates from the University of Arizona.

In 2023 Jack Nunge became the first Xavier player ever named BIG EAST Conference Men's Basketball Student-Athlete of the Year. In 2005, Xavier's Brian Thornton (now Commissioner of the Western Athletic Conference) was named the Atlantic 10 Conference's Student-Athlete of the Year in addition to being recognized as a CoSIDA Academic All-American. In 2020, Arizona's Stone Gettings was named the Pac-12 Conference Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

PLAYER DEVELOPMENT: STAFF LISTED AS THE BEST IN THE BIG EAST

Sean Miller and his staff received high honors in *The Almanac*, the annual college basketball season preview produced by The Field of 68 staff. A panel of anonymous BIG EAST coaches named the XU staff as the best development staff in the league.

Individual player development has long been a staple of the Sean Miller program. The player-focused, 12-month emphasis on individual on-court development, strength and conditioning, nutrition and recovery has paid dividends for countless athletes over Miller's years as head coach.

DECORATED INDIVIDUAL SUCCESS

Individual recognition often goes hand-in-hand with team success and players under Sean Miller have seen this year-in and year-out. Over his 18 seasons as head coach, Miller has seen players honored at both the national level and conference level.

Nationally, Miller has had 11 players, including three last season (Souley Boum, Colby Jones and Jack Nunge), named as a finalist for one of the Basketball Hall of Fame's prestigious position awards. On two occasions (Stanley Johnson in 2015 and Deandre Ayton in 2018), the player would be named the award's winner at season's end.

Additionally, Miller has had two players recognized as finalists for the Naismith Trophy and three recognized as finalists for the Wooden Award.

On a conference level, Miller has seen four players named Pac-12 Conference Player of the Year and five players named Pac-12 Conference Freshman of the Year.

BEFORE XAVIER

Miller came to Xavier for the first time in 2001 as Associate Head Coach under Thad Matta after coaching stops at North Carolina State, Pittsburgh, Miami (Ohio) and Wisconsin.

In 1992, the year after finishing his playing career at Pittsburgh, Miller served on Stu Jackson's Wisconsin staff as a graduate assistant. Jackson now serves as the Executive Associate Commissioner for the BIG EAST Conference.

USA BASKETBALL SUCCESS

Miller made his mark with USA Basketball as well. Miller was elevated from assistant coach to head coach of the U.S. Men's U19 National Team in 2015, leading the United States to the gold medal at the FIBA U19 World Championship in Crete, Greece, and was named the 2015 USA Basketball National Co-Coach of the Year. Miller's first gold medal with USA Basketball came as a player in 1991, when he helped propel the U.S. to gold in men's basketball at the World University Games in Sheffield, England.

BIG EAST SUCCESS AS A PLAYER

Miller, a 1992 graduate of the University of Pittsburgh, was the 1987-88 BIG EAST Freshman of the Year and helped lead Pitt to the 1988 BIG EAST regular season title, as well as three NCAA Tournament appearances. A member of the Pitt All-Centennial Team that was convened in 2005, Miller ranks in the top 20 on the program's career scoring chart with 1,282 points. He also ranks in the top 30 on the NCAA Division I free throw shooting list (.885), fourth in career free-throw percentage in BIG EAST games (.909) and stands fourth on the BIG EAST career assists chart for league play with 401.

A legend at Blackhawk High School in the Pittsburgh area, Miller was inducted into the Western Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic League Hall of Fame in 2012.

PERSONAL

Miller and his wife, Amy, have three boys, Austin (27), Cameron (24), Braden (21). Miller, 54, is a native of Beaver Falls, Pa. He celebrated his 55th birthday on Nov. 17.

+ Xavier's last 44 years of conference play include 103-75 (.579) BIG EAST, 209-79 (.726) Atlantic 10 and 132-60 (.688) MCC records. XU's first conference affiliation was the Ohio Athletic Conference (1920-36). The OAC is still active as an NCAA Division III conference.

+ Xavier has won or shared 18 regular season conference championships over its years in the BIG EAST, Atlantic 10 and MCC (one BIG EAST, nine A-10 and eight MCC), while winning 10 conference tournament championships (four A-10 and six MCC).
