Quick Hits

All-American DE Darin Greenfield is two TFL shy of the program's all-time record of 50.5

Greenfield has a sack in four consecutive games and is 4.0 shy of USD's all-time record

Austin Simmons stands 45 yards shy of 5,000 career passing yards. He would become the fifth USD quarterback to reach that plateau.

Thirty-eight FCS teams have attempted fewer passes than Austin Simmons has completed, including half of the MVFC programs

USD had four rushing scores for the first time in MVFC play last week (since 2012)

USD returned three cornerbacks from injury last week including two starters

Caleb Vander Esch has 16 catches for a team-high 227 yards in his last three games

The Coyotes got nine of their 13 sacks over the last two games (from seven different players)

About the Coyotes: USD is coming off back-to-back wins in which the Coyotes have outrushed their opponents 515-77 and outscored them 52-6 ... senior QB Austin Simmons ranks eighth nationally in total offense after rushing for a career-high 138 yards and passing for 210 while accounting for four scores last week ... senior DE Darin Greenfield is a two-time All-American who has registered a sack in four consecutive games ... the defense has totaled nine sacks in the last two games and 13 overall ... junior WR Caleb Vander Esch has led the team in receiving three games in a row

About the Bears: Missouri State is coming off a 37-31, triple-overtime win at Western Illinois, a game tied at 21-21 at the end of regulation ... senior QB Peyton Huslig passed for 315 yards and four scores ... he is the second-leading passer in the Valley behind Simmons at 256 yards per game and has surpassed 5,000 yards for his career ... Huslig returns his top-two receivers in Tyler Currie and Lorenzo Thomas ... two of the team's losses are to Tulane (FBS) and then-No. 6 Kennesaw State (35-24) ... the Bears are last in the Valley in rushing, averaging 76 yards per game and allowing 242 per game ... senior DE Matt McClellan has three of the team's four sacks and is the Bears' third-leading tackler

1 What a difference a few games can make. After surrendering 154 points thru three games, the Coyotes have allowed next to nothing in back-to-back wins. South Dakota allowed 613 yards per game in its first three, and permitted a total of 497 in its last two.

Certainly, **quarterback play** has a role. USD faced Montana senior Dalton Sneed (early candidate for Walter Payton Award), Oklahoma senior Jalen Hurts (early candidate for Heisman), and Houston Baptist junior Bailey Zappe (FCS's leading passer).

In the **last two games**, zero touchdown passes allowed and a run defense that limited Northern Colorado and Indiana State to a combined 77 yards on 66 carries. Even if you take out nine sacks, those two teams had 57 designed runs for 144 yards (2.5 ypc). Northern Colorado entered its game with a 121-yard rushing average. Indiana State entered with a 216-yard rushing average.

2 Start, then, with a **senior-laden defensive line** that was on full display last week at Indiana State. Two-time All-American defensive end Darin Greenfield has posted a sack in four straight games and had three tackles-for-loss last week against the Sycamores. Kameron Cline has lined up at both tackle and end and had a career-high nine tackles last week with two for loss. He also forced Indiana State's interception with pressure. Co-captain DeValon Whitcomb got his second sack of the season and had a career-best five stops a week ago. Indiana State's longest run last week was nine yards and it came off a quarterback scramble.

3 Enter **Missouri State**, a team averaging just 76 yards on the ground, but with a senior and three-year starter at the helm in Peyton Huslig. In a 35-28 loss at South Dakota last season, Huslig passed for 283 yards and two touchdowns, and ran for 91 yards and two scores. Donovan Daniels added 61 yards on 15 carries and the Bears totaled 478 yards in all. Tyler Currie and Lorenzo Thomas combined for 13 catches, 174 yards and a score.

4 **Austin Simmons** completed 28 of 38 passes for 337 yards and ran for 45 in last year's win against Missouri State on Dakota Days. The Coyotes got an unsung hero in running back **Ben Klett**, who ran 19 times for 96 yards and three touchdowns. **Dakarai Allen** and **Levi Falck** both caught five passes for 73 yards each. The game was decided by USD's goal-line stand with two minutes to go followed by a final defensive stop in the closing minute.

5 Another factor last week was the **return of starting cornerbacks Mark Collins Jr. and Bakhari Goodson**. Collins Jr. led the nation in passes defended per game last year. He was injured while making an interception in the opening quarter of the season and didn't return until last week. Goodson, a transfer from Massachusetts, started games two and three before being injured against Houston Baptist. Both players started and took the majority of the snaps last week against Indiana State.

6 After averaging 93 yards on the ground through three weeks, the Coyotes ran for 203 yards at Northern Colorado and for 312 yards last week against Indiana State. USD's 8.4-yard average against the Sycamores was its **best since 2011**. The Coyotes also ran for four scores, the first time they have achieved that feat inside MVFC play.

7 **Austin Simmons** and **Kai Henry** both eclipsed 100 yards rushing last week and both did so by the end of the third quarter. Simmons had touchdown runs of 4, 37 and 44 yards and also had a 33-yard carry. Henry had four runs of at least 10 yards including a 42-yard touchdown run in the first half. It marked the first time USD had two 100-yard rushers in 18 games dating back to 2017.

8 **Kody Case** stole the headlines during the first two games of the season when he totaled 17 catches for 212 yards and three touchdowns. But he was injured in the second half against Oklahoma and did not return. He missed two games and started last week against Indiana State. He played nine snaps in the first quarter before being tackled following his second catch of the game and did not return.

After the game, Head Coach Bob Nielson said Case could have returned, but wasn't needed as the lead grew. He is expected to make his fourth start of the season Saturday.

9 **Austin Simmons** (284 ypg) and **Peyton Huslig** (256 ypg) are the only Valley quarterbacks averaging better than 215 yards passing. Simmons set program single-game records for passing yards (537), attempts (65) and completions (48) in the game against Houston Baptist. The 537 yards in one game is the second-highest total by any player at any level of the NCAA this season.

10 For **16 consecutive games** dating back to 2017, USD's offense had passed for more yards than it had run. That has not been the case during these last two wins.

11 Seven Coyotes in program history have **caught 11 passes in a single game**. It has happened twice in each of the last three seasons (since 2017). Kody Case caught 11 passes in the season opener and Randy Baker caught 11 passes against Houston Baptist. Levi Falck (vs. Kansas State in 2018) is the other active Coyote to achieve the feat.

12 South Dakota's offense has converted 25 of 47 **third downs** during its last three games (53 percent). USD converted 3 of 21 during its first two games.

13 South Dakota is working in a **new "positionless" defense** headed by coordinator Travis Johansen, who was the defensive coordinator at Grand View (Iowa) from 2013-18. In those six seasons, the Vikings were 61-11 with five conference championships, six NAIA playoff appearances and the 2013 national title (14-0).

14 **Darin Greenfield's** 48.5 career tackles-for-loss are 2.0 shy of the program record held by Bill Gassen (1999-2002). His 23.0 career sacks trail only Tyler Starr (2011-13) and A.J. Schable (2002-05) who share the all-time mark with 27.0.

15 Five different Coyotes registered a **sack** against Northern Colorado two games ago. Four different Coyotes registered a **sack** last week against Indiana State. Missouri State has allowed seven **sacks** thru four games.

16 There are no seniors in USD's 18-member linebacker crew. **Jack Cochrane** is a true junior and an all-MVFC Academic Team honoree who serves as the Coyotes' second-leading tackler. Junior **Jake Matthew** and redshirt freshman **Jakari Starling** have started all five games and redshirt freshman **Brock Mogensen** has started the last three.

17 Right guard **Mason Scheidegger** has started all 29 games since the start of the 2017 season, and has played all five positions during his career. Redshirt freshman **Isaac Erbes** is the reigning Valley Offensive Lineman of the Week. Sophomore **Alex Jensen** is starting at left tackle after competing at tight end the previous two seasons. Another redshirt freshman, **Kian Rexroat-Potts**, starts at center.

18 On special teams, **Brady Schutt** has the nation's fourth-best punting average at 46.9 yards per boot. **Mason Lorber** made a career-long 44-yarder in last week's win.

19 **Austin Simmons** ranks eighth nationally in total offense (333 ypg), ninth for completion percentage (68.2 percent) and 15th for passing (284 ypg). His 10 touchdown passes rank 29th nationally.

Head Coach Bob Nielson



Bob Nielson was introduced as the 30th head coach in the history of University of South Dakota football in December of 2015. It is the sixth head coaching stint for Nielson, who has enjoyed success at every level of college football. He is a three-time national coach of the year recipient, a two-time national champion head coach, and was Missouri Valley Football Conference Coach of the Year in 2016. The 2019 season is the 27th for Nielson as a head coach.

Nielson has been labeled a builder throughout his career and 2017 certainly added to that legacy. In just his second season with the Coyotes, Nielson led the program to a record eight wins at the Division I level and to the FCS playoffs for the first time. It marked the fifth consecutive program that has reached the playoffs within four years of Nielson taking the helm. The Coyotes won their FCS playoff debut and reached the final 16.

Nielson crossed yet another milestone in 2018. The Coyotes' 31-24 win at Southern Illinois in their conference opener marked Nielson's 200th career win and he needed less than 300 games to get there. Nielson became the 91st college football coach to reach the plateau and starts 2019 as one of 14 active head coaches with 200 wins.

Prior to arriving in Vermillion, Nielson served as head coach at Western Illinois University for three seasons from 2013-15. He led the Leathernecks to a 7-6 record in 2015 and to the second round of the FCS playoffs. It was the first playoff appearance for the Leathernecks since 2010. While at Western, Nielson coached seven all-MVFC first-team selections including four in 2015.

Nielson grew up in Marion, Iowa, and received his bachelor's degree from Wartburg College in Waverly, Iowa, in 1982. He began his career as an offensive line coach at his alma mater before being promoted to defensive coordinator in 1987.

Ripon College in Wisconsin gave Nielson his first head coaching position. He was 2-6-1 in his first season and improved to 7-2 in year two. It was the first season the Red Hawks had posted more than four victories in eight years.

Nielson returned to Wartburg in 1991 to serve as head coach and athletic director of the Knights. In 1993, his third season, Wartburg won an Iowa Conference title, Nielson earned his first conference coach of the year award, and the Knights returned to the NCAA Division III playoffs for the first time in 11 years. In 1994, Wartburg recorded its first NCAA playoff victory.

Nielson's Duluth Dynasty began in 1999. In year three, Duluth made its first postseason appearance by competing in the Mineral Water Bowl. The following season, the Bulldogs won the 2002 Northern Sun Championship with a perfect 9-0 record and qualified for the NCAA Division II playoffs for the first time in school history.

Duluth was 38-19 in its first five years under Nielson, who turned in his whistle after the 2003 season to serve as the Bulldogs' athletic director. He remained the AD when he returned to coach the football team in 2008. That year, Duluth earned its first national championship with a 15-0 record. The Bulldogs duplicated the feat in 2010.

Nielson was 100-26 in 10 seasons at Duluth. In his second five-year stint, the program was 62-7 with five NCAA playoff appearances, five NSIC titles and two undefeated seasons. Nielson was named national coach of the year in both championship years and totaled three Northern Sun Coach of the Year awards.

Nielson and his wife, Terri, have two daughters, Amanda and Kasey, a son, Kyle, and three grandchildren, Cash, Rowan and Finley Taylor. He holds a master's degree from UNI, which he completed in 1988. He served as chair of the NCAA Football Rules Committee from 2015-17, and is a member of the University of Minnesota Duluth and Linn-Mar High School Athletic Hall of Fames.

Game 1
No. 25 Montana 31, South Dakota 17
Aug. 31 (Vermillion, S.D. / DakotaDome / 5193)

VERMILLION, S.D.—Montana senior quarterback Dalton Sneed passed for a career-high 427 yards and three touchdowns to lead the 25th-ranked Grizzlies to a 31-17 win against South Dakota in the season opener for both teams.

It marked the first loss by the Coyotes in a home opener since 2002, ending a streak of 16 consecutive games, which was tied for sixth in the FCS entering the season. South Dakota started its season at home for the first time since 2013.

It was a career day for Sneed and his top two playmakers. All-Big Sky receiver Samuel Akem caught nine passes for a career-high 158 and a score. Junior Samori Toure also had nine receptions, netting a career-high 142 yards and a touchdown. Sneed completed 37 of 52 passes. He also ran 10 times for 11 yards including a 2-yard touchdown run in the first half.

South Dakota quarterback Austin Simmons threw for 246 yards and two touchdowns on 23-of-33 passing. Kody Case, a redshirt sophomore who missed much of last season with an injury, tied USD's single-game record with 11 catches. Case caught a 3-yard touchdown and a 9-yard touchdown while totaling a career-high 144 yards. It was the second 100-yard game of his career.

Converting third downs and finishing drives was the difference in the two offenses. Montana was 11 of 17 on third down while the Coyotes were 2 of 10. USD settled for a field goal following a 1st-and-goal from the 2 early in the second quarter, and had two of its four second-half drives stall inside the Grizzlies' 30.

No. 4 Oklahoma 70, South Dakota 14
Sept. 7 (Norman, Okla. / Memorial Stadium / 82,181)

NORMAN, Okla.—Oklahoma quarterback Jalen Hurts passed for 259 yards and three scores in a little more than one half of work to lead the fourth-ranked Sooners to a 70-14 win over South Dakota at Memorial Stadium.

It was Oklahoma's fifth game against an FCS opponent since 1999 and this one had a similar result as the previous four. The Sooners outgained the Coyotes 390-112 in the first half and took a 28-0 lead into the break. A pick-six from Oklahoma defensive back Brendan Radley-Hiles began the second half and the rout was on.

South Dakota's scores came in the third quarter from the arm of Austin Simmons. He connected with Kody Case on a 23-yard strike with 5:46 left in the frame to make it 49-7. It was the third time Simmons and Case have hooked up this season. Simmons hit Caleb Vander Esch with a 27-yard strike on 4th-and-12 the next time USD had it to make it 56-14.

Simmons completed 25 of 34 passes for 244 yards. He had the two touchdown tosses and was intercepted twice. Simmons became the seventh Coyote quarterback to reach 4,000 yards passing. He finished the night with 4,024.

Case caught six passes for 68 yards one week after tying USD's single-game record with 11. Drew Greenhaw caught three passes for a career-best 40 yards. Ben Klett ran eight times for 20 yards to lead Coyote running backs on the ground. USD passed for 269, ran for 70 and totaled 339 yards.

South Dakota linebacker Elijah Reed had a career-high 12 tackles and linebacker Jake Matthew totaled nine including a 9-yard tackle-for-loss following an errant snap from center. Darin Greenfield, USD's All-American defensive end, sacked Hurts in the first half and drew a number of holding penalties. Oklahoma was flagged 12 times for 105 yards.

South Dakota 14, Northern Colorado 6
Sept. 21 (Greeley, Colo./ Nottingham Field / 5,745)

GREELEY, Colo.—South Dakota's offense mustered two long touchdown drives while the defense limited Northern Colorado to 223 yards of offense in a 14-6 Coyote victory at Nottingham Field.

South Dakota quarterback Austin Simmons threw a 10-yard touchdown pass to Connor Herrmann in the first half and Ben Klett rumbled for a 12-yard score early in the fourth quarter to produce the Coyotes' two touchdowns. Both drives were 13 plays and 70-plus yards.

Defensively, the Coyotes sacked Northern Colorado quarterback Jacob Knipp five times and limited running back Milo Hall to 75 yards on 21 carries. The sacks came from five different players, but the big ones came from Stephen Hillis and Jakari Starling on third-down plays in the fourth quarter that forced the Bears to punt.

It was 7-0 when Hall ran in from five yards out with 4:47 left in the third quarter to produce Northern Colorado's lone score. It capped a 7-play, 80-yard drive aided by a pair of personal fouls. Hall ran five times for 20 yards on the possession. But Kameron Cline blocked the extra point to keep South Dakota in the lead.

Simmons accounted for 59 yards on a 13-play, 87-yard drive that extended the lead to 14-6 with 12:15 remaining. Tight end Austin Goehring made a tough 6-yard catch on 3rd-and-5 at the start of the possession, and Klett's run to the end zone came on 3rd-and-2. Simmons was 5-for-6 on the drive for 38 yards and used designed runs to gain 21 more.

The Bears had two drives for a tying score. They reached the USD 31 with nine minutes left before Hillis blew through the line untouched for a 10-yard sack on 3rd-and-16. Cline and Starling produced back-to-back sacks on Northern Colorado's final possession to force a punt with less than five minutes to play.

South Dakota 38, Indiana State 0
Oct. 5 (Vermillion, S.D./ DakotaDome / 5,255)

VERMILLION, S.D.—Austin Simmons and Kai Henry combined to run for 239 yards and four scores and South Dakota's defense shut down Indiana State in a 38-0 Dakota Days win inside the DakotaDome.

It was the fourth straight homecoming win for the Coyotes, who have won their Valley opener for the third consecutive season. South Dakota has won 15 of its last 19 Dakota Days games and improved to 65-33-5 all-time on homecoming.

Simmons ran nine times for a career-high 138 yards with touchdown runs of 4, 37 and 44 yards. He also completed 15 of 25 passes for 210 yards and a score. Henry chipped in with 14 carries for 101 yards. Included in his tally was a nifty 42-yard touchdown run late in the first quarter that extended USD's lead to 14-0.

In another phase, it was South Dakota's defense, led by a senior-laden front line, that limited Indiana State's ground game to 40 yards on 33 carries. The Sycamores averaged 216 yards rushing in their four non-conference games – good for 20th best in the nation. But playing without their two leading rushers in quarterback Ryan Boyle and running back Peterson Kerlegrand proved too much to overcome. Titus McCoy ran 12 times for a team-high 21 yards for Indiana State.
