Quick Hits

South Dakota beat UNC 43-28 in week two of last season inside the DakotaDome

QB Austin Simmons passed for 462 yards and accounted for five TDs in that game

Simmons passed for a record 537 yards and four scores last week against Houston Baptist

Randy Baker tied a program record with 11 catches and had a career-high 102 yards last week. Caleb Vander Esch had 103 yards.

Dakarai Allen is an all-Valley WR, and Kody Case combined for 212 yards and three TDs in the first two games of the year

USD and UNC were NCC foes from 1980 to 2002 when the Bears jumped to Division I

This is USD's first trip to Greelev since 2009. USD's last win in Greeley was 1988 (0-8 since).

USD former player, coach and Hall of Famer Joe Glenn led Northern Colorado to back-to-back NCAA Division II national championships in 1996 and 1997 (he was 9-2 against South Dakota)

RB Milo Hall carried 31 times for 113 yards and a score against Washington State ... LB Luke Nelson is approaching 200 career tackles ... CB Michael Walker boasts 20 career pass breakups

Two teams seeking their first win of the season meet at Nottingham Field Saturday in Greeley. It is a **rematch from last season** where South Dakota defeated Northern Colorado 43-28 in Vermillion behind the arm of Austin Simmons and wide outs Shamar Jackson and Trystn Ducker, who each surpassed 130 yards receiving and a score. Defensively, South Dakota got two sacks from All-American defensive end Darin Greenfield and an interception from safety Phillip Powell.

Last year's game was a **shootout between Simmons and Northern Colorado quarterback Jacob Knipp**. Simmons passed for 462 yards, ran for 80 and accounted for five touchdowns. He went on to be named FCS National Player of the Week for that performance. Knipp completed 26 of 35 passes for 331 yards and three touchdowns. His top wide out, Alex Wesley, had 10 catches for 184 yards and a score. Wesley was cut by the New York Giants last week after being granted an injury settlement which will allow him to seek a new team.

The Coyotes were stunned at home a week ago against Houston Baptist, 53-52. The Huskies converted a **two-point conversion with 1:14 remaining** in the fourth quarter and intercepted Simmons on a 2nd-and-long throw on the ensuing possession. The two teams combined for 1,238 yards of total offense (USD - 642 yards; HBU - 596 yards).

Austin Simmons set program, single-game records for passing yards (537), attempts (65) and completions (48) last week against Houston Baptist. His 537 yards passing are the **most by any player** at any NCAA level this season.

5 South Dakota's strength on offense is tied to a **deep receiving corps**, and that was certainly proven true a week ago. Playing without Levi Falck (second-leading receiver in 2018) and Kody Case (17 catches, 212 yards, 3 TDs in first two games of 2019), the Coyotes got career highs from five different receivers. Caleb Vander Esch and Randy Baker became USD's first 100-yard receiving tandem since Shamar Jackson and Trystn Ducker acheived the feat last year against Northern Colorado. Tight ends Connor Herrmann and Brett Samson combined for 11 catches, 153 yards and two scores. All-Valley wide out Dakarai Allen also reached the end zone.

6 Phillip Powell, who missed much of last season, returned to form last week against Northern Colorado. He had two first-half interceptions, notched his 100th career tackle, and was credited with a pass breakup. Powell has seven interceptions in 20 career games as a Coyote.

Despite the quick passes to the edges, **Darin Greenfield** continues to be a disrupter for quarterbacks. He has had a sack and been tackled to prevent sacks (drawing penalties) in each of the last two games, and last week, he helped force a fourth-quarter interception by hitting HBU quarterback Bailey Zappe before a release to the red zone. Greenfield has 21.0 career sacks and 43.5 tackles-for-loss in his career, which rank fourth and fifth all-time at USD, respectively.

8 The injury bug has hit **Coyote cornerbacks** the hardest in the first weeks of the season. The veteran, Mark Collins Jr., hasn't returned since injuring his ankle while making an interception back in week one. Bakhari Goodson, a transfer from Massachusetts, and true sophomore Cameron Tisdale were injured during Saturday's game and did not return.

True freshman Cori Fant Jr. has started each of the last two games in place of Collins and is USD's fifth-leading tackler thru three weeks. Sophomore Darion Bolden and redshirt-freshman Rodney Sivils Jr. rotated in at the other corner position last week and both made their first tackles as Coyotes.

9 South Dakota is working in a **new "positionless" defense** headed by coordinator Travis Johansen, who was the defensive coordinator at Grand View (Iowa) from 2013-18. In those six seasons, the Vikings were 61-11 with five conference championships, six NAIA playoff appearances and the 2013 national title (14-0).

10 There are no seniors in USD's 18-member linebacker crew. Jack Cochrane is a true junior and an all-MVFC Academic Team honoree who returns as the Coyotes' second-leading tackler. Junior Jake Matthew and redshirt freshmen Jakari Starling have started all three games and redshirt freshman Brock Mogensen earned his first collegiate start last week against Houston Baptist.

THIS WEEK'S NOTES

1 1 Eight Coyotes in program history have caught 11 passes in a single game. It has now happened twice in each of the last three seasons (since 2017). Kody Case caught 11 passes in the season opener, and Randy Baker caught 11 passes last week against Houston Baptist. Levi Falck (vs. Kansas State in 2018) is the other active Coyote to achieve the feat.

12 Kody Case missed all but four games last season due to injury after posting 25 catches for 430 yards and five touchdowns as a true freshman in 2017. He totaled 144 yards and two scores in the season opener against Montana, and came back with six catches for a team-high 68 yards and a score in week two at Oklahoma. He missed last week's game due to injury, but is listed on the two-deep this week.

13 Right guard Mason Scheidegger has started all 27 games since the start of the 2017 season, and has played all five positions during his career. Left guard Michael Bianchi is the only senior within the position group. Other members of this year's line include redshirt freshmen Kian Rexroat-Potts (center) and Isaac Erbes (right tackle). Sophomore Alex Jensen is at left tackle after competing at tight end the previous two seasons.

14 South Dakota's offense recorded a **program-record 43 first downs** last week, four more than the team posted in a double-overtime loss at Indiana State last season. The 27 first downs by passing is also a record.

15 After going 3 of 21 on third downs through two games, the Coyotes **converted 10 of 16** last week against the Huskies. Austin Simmons passed for eight of the 10 and Kai Henry ran for the other two. Randy Baker totaled four catches for 53 yards in moving the chains four times.

16 Austin Simmons **leads the nation** with 96 completions through three games. He is second in attempts (132), third in yards (1,027), fifth in completion percentage (.727) and eighth in touchdown passes (8).

17 On special teams, **Brady Schutt** has the nation's fourth-best punting average at 46.9 yards per boot. **Mason Lorber** had made eight consecutive kicks dating back to last season before missing a 33-yarder last week at home against Houston Baptist.

Northern Colorado and South Dakota first met in Greeley, Colorado, in 1959. The teams competed nine times before becoming conference foes in 1980, and met every year for 23 consecutive seasons until 2003. The teams met in a home-and-home series in 2009 and 2010, and are completing the back end of a home-and-home series that began last season.

19 Joe Glenn led Northern Colorado to back-to-back national championships in 1996 and 1997. He was 98-35 in 11 seasons at UNC, and won three consecutive NCC titles from 1997-99 before taking the head gig at Montana in 2000. Glenn was the coach of the Coyotes for four years from 2012-15.

Head Coach Bob Nielson



Bob Nielson was introduced as the 30th head coach in the history of University of South Dakota football in December of 2015. It is the sixth head coaching stint for Nielson, who has enjoyed success at every level of college football. He is a three-time national coach of the year recipient, a two-time national champion head coach, and was Missouri Valley Football Conference Coach of the Year in 2016. The 2019 season is the 27th for Nielson as a head coach.

Nielson has been labeled a builder throughout his career and 2017 certainly added to that legacy. In just his second season with the Coyotes, Nielson led the program to a record eight wins at the Division I level and to the FCS playoffs for the first time. It marked the fifth consecutive program that has reached the playoffs within four years of Nielson taking the helm. The Coyotes won their FCS playoff debut and reached the final 16.

Nielson crossed yet another milestone in 2018.

The Coyotes' 31-24 win at Southern Illinois in their conference opener marked Nielson's 200th career win and he needed less than 300 games to get there. Nielson became the 91st college football coach to reach the plateau and starts 2019 as one of 14 active head coaches with 200 wins.

Prior to arriving in Vermillion, Nielson served as head coach at Western Illinois University for three seasons from 2013-15. He led the Leathernecks to a 7-6 record in 2015 and to the second round of the FCS playoffs. It was the first playoff appearance for the Leathernecks since 2010. While at Western, Nielson coached seven all-MVFC first-team selections including four in 2015.

Nielson grew up in Marion, lowa, and received his bachelor's degree from Wartburg College in Waverly, lowa, in 1982. He began his career as an offensive line coach at his alma mater before being promoted to defensive coordinator in 1987.

Ripon College in Wisconsin gave Nielson his first head coaching position. He was 2-6-1 in his first season and improved to 7-2 in year two. It was the first season the Red Hawks had posted more than four victories in eight years.

Nielson returned to Wartburg in 1991 to serve as head coach and athletic director of the Knights. In 1993, his third season, Wartburg won an lowa Conference title, Nielson earned his first conference coach of the year award, and the Knights returned to the NCAA Division III playoffs for the first time in 11 years. In 1994, Wartburg recorded its first NCAA playoff victory.

Nielson's Duluth Dynasty began in 1999. In year three, Duluth made its first postseason appearance by competing in the Mineral Water Bowl. The following season, the Bulldogs won the 2002 Northern Sun Championship with a perfect 9-0 record and qualified for the NCAA Division II playoffs for the first time in school history.

Duluth was 38-19 in its first five years under Nielson, who turned in his whistle after the 2003 season to serve as the Bulldogs' athletic director. He remained the AD when he returned to coach the football team in 2008. That year, Duluth earned its first national championship with a 15-0 record. The Bulldogs duplicated the feat in 2010.

Nielson was 100-26 in 10 seasons at Duluth. In his second five-year stint, the program was 62-7 with five NCAA playoff appearances, five NSIC titles and two undefeated seasons. Nielson was named national coach of the year in both championship years and totaled three Northern Sun Coach of the Year awards.

Nielson and his wife, Terri, have two daughters, Amanda and Kasey, a son, Kyle, and three grandchildren, Cash, Rowan and Finley Taylor. He holds a master's degree from UNI, which he completed in 1988. He served as chair of the NCAA Football Rules Committee from 2015-17, and is a member of the University of Minnesota Duluth and Linn-Mar High School Athletic Hall of Fames.

2019 Game Summaries

Game 1 No. 25 Montana 31, South Dakota 17 Aug. 31 (Vermillion, S.D. / DakotaDome / 5193)

VERMILLION, S.D.—Montana senior quarterback Dalton Sneed passed for a career-high 427 yards and three touchdowns to lead the 25th-ranked Grizzlies to a 31-17 win against South Dakota in the season opener for both teams

It marked the first loss by the Coyotes in a home opener since 2002, ending a streak of 16 consecutive games, which was tied for sixth in the FCS entering the season. South Dakota started its season at home for the first time since 2013.

It was a career day for Sneed and his top two playmakers. All-Big Sky receiver Samuel Akem caught nine passes for a career-high 158 and a score. Junior Samori Toure also had nine receptions, netting a career-high 142 yards and a touchdown. Sneed completed 37 of 52 passes. He also ran 10 times for 11 yards including a 2-yard touchdown run in the first half.

South Dakota quarterback Austin Simmons threw for 246 yards and two touchdowns on 23-of-33 passing. Kody Case, a redshirt sophomore who missed much of last season with an injury, tied USD's single-game record with 11 catches. Case caught a 3-yard touchdown and a 9-yard touchdown while totaling a career-high 144 yards. It was the second 100-yard game of his career.

Converting third downs and finishing drives was the difference in the two offenses. Montana was 11 of 17 on third down while the Coyotes were 2 of 10. USD settled for a field goal following a 1st-and-goal from the 2 early in the second quarter, and had two of its four second-half drives stall inside the Grizzlies' 30.

Game 2 No. 4 Oklahoma 70, South Dakota 14 Sept. 7 (Norman, Okla. / Memorial Stadium / 82,181)

NORMAN, Okla.—Oklahoma quarterback Jalen Hurts passed for 259 yards and three scores in a little more than one half of work to lead the fourthranked Sooners to a 70-14 win over South Dakota at Memorial Stadium.

It was Oklahoma's fifth game against an FCS opponent since 1999 and this one had a similar result as the previous four. The Sooners outgained the Coyotes 390-112 in the first half and took a 28-0 lead into the break. A pick-six from Oklahoma defensive back Brendan Radley-Hiles began the second half and the rout was on.

South Dakota's scores came in the third quarter from the arm of Austin Simmons. He connected with Kody Case on a 23-yard strike with 5:46 left in the frame to make it 49-7. It was the third time Simmons and Case have hooked up this season. Simmons hit Caleb Vander Esch with a 27-yard strike on 4th-and-12 the next time USD had it to make it 56-14.

Simmons completed 25 of 34 passes for 244 yards. He had the two touchdown tosses and was intercepted twice. Simmons became the seventh Coyote quarterback to reach 4,000 yards passing. He finished the night with 4,024.

Case caught six passes for 68 yards one week after tying USD's single-game record with 11. Drew Greenhaw caught three passes for a career-best 40 yards. Ben Klett ran eight times for 20 yards to lead Coyote running backs on the ground. USD passed for 269, ran for 70 and totaled 339 yards.

South Dakota linebacker Elijah Reed had a career-high 12 tackles and linebacker Jake Matthew totaled nine including a 9-yard tackle-for-loss following an errant snap from center. Darin Greenfield, USD's All-American defensive end, sacked Hurts in the first half and drew a number of holding penalties. Oklahoma was flagged 12 times for 105 yards.
