QUICK HITTERS

- South Dakota kicks off the 2025-26 season with four of its first five games inside the Sanford Coyote Sports Center, a venue they held a 14-2 record at a season ago.
- The Coyotes have an early road test in their second game of the year at preseason #23 Creighton Wednesday in Omaha, Nebraska.
- South Dakota was picked to finish fifth in the Summit League Preseason Coaches' Poll and received one first place vote. **Isaac Bruns** was named to the conference's preseason first team. He was an All-Summit League Honorable Mention a season ago.
- Bruns ranked No. 10 in the conference in scoring a season ago, and is the league's leading returner scorer at 14.6 points per game.
- South Dakota averaged 89.3 points per game on its home court a season ago, while holding visiting teams to a 77.3 points per game average. While the Yotes still averaged over 80 points per game on the road (81.6), they surrendered 89.5 points per game to the host teams.
- In 16 home games last year, Bruns averaged 16.1 points per game while shooting .492 percent from the field. **Cameron Fens** appeared in just 10 home games last year, due to a season ending injury, but averaged 8.8 points, 4.7 rebounds and 1.2 blocks per game, while shooting .571 percent.
- Eric Peterson enters year four as the head coach of the South Dakota men's basketball team and holds a 43-53 overall record.

Back for Year 3

- Isaac Bruns** is back for year three as a Coyote and is the Summit League's leading returner scorer after averaging 14.6 points per game in his sophomore season.
- Bruns led the bench unit for the first half of the season that ranked inside the top-10 in the NCAA in points per game (30.88).
- He entered the starting lineup in the third Summit League regular season game and would start the final 16 games of the season, including both Summit League Tournament games.
- Bruns scored in double-figures in 14 of 16 games to close out the season, including six games with 20+ points.
- Bruns recorded his first career double-double with 21 points and 10 rebounds on 8-of-12 shooting in the Summit League Tournament Quarterfinals against North Dakota State.
- He was named to the Preseason All-Summit League First Team, after being named an All-Summit League Honorable Mention last year.

Pushing the Pace

- South Dakota ended the 2024-25 season as the No. 3 team in the country and the Summit League leader with an 85.2 points per game average.
- Alabama (90.7) and Gonzaga (86.4) were No. 1 and 2 last year.
- The Yotes ranked No. 3 in the NCAA in possessions per game (77.0), trailing only Alabama (78.5) and Cal Poly (77.5).
- Behind a full court press, the Coyotes ranked No. 16 in turnover margin (+3.8) and took care of the ball offensively, ranking No. 16 in fewest turnovers per game (9.6).
- With the high tempo, pressing defensive style of play, the Coyotes depth was on display a season ago as they ranked No. 10 in the NCAA in bench points per game (30.88).

Fresh Faces in Verm

- While South Dakota brings back eight players from last year's squad, the Coyotes return just 35% of the scoring.
- Isaac Bruns and Cameron Fens are the team's leading returning scorers. Bruns totaled 482 points in his sophomore season, while Fens scored 163 in 19 games.
- The Coyotes brought in four transfers in **Ethan Kizer, Caleb Kizer, Josiah Dotzler** and **Jordan Crawford**.
- The Kizer brothers transferred in from South Alabama. Ethan Kizer spent two seasons as a Jaguar, while Caleb Kizer spent one season at South Alabama.
- Dotzler redshirted last season after appearing in five games before suffering a season-

- ending injury. Dotzler, an Omaha, Nebraska native, spent his freshman season at Creighton where he appeared in 19 games.
- Crawford appeared in 30 games last year for Eastern Kentucky, making 15 starts. He averaged 7.8 points, 1.8 rebounds and 1.4 steals per game. He spent his first two years of college ball at the College of Charleston.
- South Dakota added five freshmen to the roster in **Vince Buzelis, Jesse McIntosh, Uzziah Buntyn, Luke Bruns** and **Jonah Funk**.
- Buzelis was an all-conference honoree for Hinsdale Central while averaging 11.3 points and 6.7 rebounds per game for the Red Devils. He was a member of the U16 Lithuania National Team. His brother, Matas, was a first round selection by the Chicago Bulls in the 2024 NBA Draft.
- McIntosh comes to Vermillion from Melbourne, Australia. He represented his home country of Australia and helped them win the U18 Asia Cup.
- Buntyn lead Stony Point HS to a Texas HS State Championship Runner-Up finish. Buntyn was named First Team All State, a three-time All Region Selection, the Centex Player of the Year, District MVP and a four-time First Team All District selection. He recorded over 2100 points, 650 assists, and 300 steals in high school career.
- Bruns scored 1,060 career points in his prep career at Dakota Valley HS. Won back-to-back South Dakota State Championships in his freshman and sophomore seasons alongside his brother and current teammate Isaac Bruns.
- Funk was named a unanimous First Team All-Mid-Illini Conference selection. He helped lead Metamora to a Mid-Illini Conference Championship and to the Class 3A Washington Sectional basketball title game.

Home Sweet Home

- South Dakota put together a 14-2 overall record and a 6-2 mark in Summit League play on its home floor last season.
- The Coyotes averaged 89.3 points per game in the SCSC on a .480 shooting percentage, while holding visiting teams to a 77.3 average and a .436 shooting percentage.
- Isaac Bruns** averaged 16.1 points per game in the SCSC on a .492 shooting percentage and was 52-for-62 at the free throw line.
- The Yotes often got out in front after the first half of play, averaging 42.3 points per game in the first 20 minutes of action, while holding teams to 34.4 points in the first half.
- The Coyotes started 10-0 in the SCSC last year, which was the best start in the Sanford Coyote Sports Center. USD's previous best start at home was during the 2016-17 season when they started 8-0.
- Previous to last year, the last time the Yotes started 10-0 or better at home was in the 2008-09 season when they 14 straight in the DakotaDome.

Man in the Middle

- Cameron Fens** was a pivotal piece on both ends of the floor for the Coyotes before suffering a season-ending injury just past the halfway point of the season.



- Despite playing in just 19 of 33 games, Fens still ranked No. 2 on the team and tied for fifth in the conference with 21 blocked shots. He had six games with 2+ blocks.
- Fens tallied his first career double-double with a 16-point, 10-rebound game at Western Michigan on 7-of-9 shooting with two blocks and two steals.
- Fens had seven games in double-digit scoring and 10 games with 5+ rebounds.

Getting to the Line

- The Coyotes were elite at getting to the free throw line in 2024-25.
- USD ranked No. 2 in the NCAA in free throws per game (28.0) and No. 1 in free throw makes per contest (20.0).
- Against Denver last season, South Dakota got to the line frequently with 51 attempts at the charity stripe, which was tied for the seventh most in a single game in the NCAA.
- The Yotes had two matches last year with 30+ makes at the line against Denver (32-for-51) and vs. St. Thomas (31-for-43).

A Family Affair

- Brothers Paul and Isaac Bruns shared the court as Coyotes over the last two seasons, with Paul Bruns graduating as a Coyote following last season.
- Freshman Luke Bruns becomes the third Bruns brother to don a Coyote jersey, joining Isaac on this year's squad following his prep career at Dakota Valley High School.

Welcome back, Triston!

- South Dakota alum Triston Simpson joined the Coyote coaching staff this season.
- Simpson played 124 games as a Coyote from 2016-20.
- He averaged double figures in each of his final two seasons, including a career-best 14.0 points per game in 2018-19.
- Simpson was a part of the lineup the last time the Coyotes had three players score 20+ points in a single game on Nov. 12 as he scored 24 points alongside Tyler Peterson (23) and Brandon Armstrong (22).

THE COACHING STAFF

HEAD COACH ERIC PETERSON



Eric Peterson was named head coach of the Coyotes in March of 2022. He returns to South Dakota where he served as an assistant to Craig Smith for four seasons from 2014-18. The Coyotes won their first Summit League title in year three during the 2016-17 season and won 26 games while advancing to the championship game of the Summit League Tournament during the 2017-18 campaign.

In the 2024-25 season, Peterson guided the Coyotes to a 19-14 record and nearly unblemished 14-2 record at home in the Sanford Coyote Sports Center. Newcomer Chase Forte was honored as a NABC All-District Second Team selection, the Summit League's Defensive Player of the Year, All-Summit League First Team, All-Summit League Defensive Team and the Summit League's All-Newcomer Team. Dre Bullock and Isaac Bruns were also named All-Summit League Honorable Mentions. The trio of guards helped lead the Coyotes to the No. 3 scoring offense in the NCAA at 85.2 points per game. The Coyotes led the Summit League with

7.5 steals per game and ranked No. 16 in the NCAA in both turnover margin (+3.8) and least amount of turnovers per game (9.6). USD finished the year as the No. 1 team in the country at free throws made per game (20.0) and No. 2 with 28.0 free throws attempted per contest. During the nonconference season, the Coyotes picked up an 82-81 win over Wyoming in the SCSC behind 25 points from Forte. After earning the No. 5 seed in the conference tournament, the Coyotes poured in 51 second half points to push past North Dakota State for an 85-84 win, before falling to eventual Summit League Tournament Champions, Omaha, in the semifinal round.

South Dakota went 12-20 and 5-11 in the conference in year two under Peterson and held an 8-6 record at the Sanford Coyote Sports Center. Peterson guided a pair of newcomers, Kaleb Stewart and Lahat Thioune, to the Summit League All-Newcomer Team and as Honorable Mention All-Summit League selections. In a double overtime thriller at Denver, the Coyotes put up 110 points which is tied for No. 17 all-time in program history and the most in a game since January 15, 2022 when the Coyotes won 105-70 over Omaha.

The Coyotes went 12-19 and 7-11 in Summit League play in Peterson's first year at the helm and earned the No. 6 seed in the Summit League Tournament. Kruz Perrott-Hunt and Tasos Kamateros were named to the All-Summit League Team for the second straight season as honorable mentions. The Coyotes earned a 69-68 win over BYU at the Vivint Arena in Salt Lake City, Utah behind 26 points from Perrott-Hunt.

Peterson has remained on Smith's staff through three seasons at Utah State and during the 2021-22 season at Utah. Utah State won one Mountain West regular season title, two Mountain West tournament titles and qualified for the NCAA tournament all three seasons with Peterson on staff. He was also instrumental in the development of Neemias Queta, who has logged 10 games with the Sacramento Kings this season. Queta was an AP All-America honorable mention honoree for the Aggies.

The Coyotes are Peterson's second head coaching position. He was the athletic director and head men's basketball coach at Williston State College in western North Dakota for two seasons from 2012-14. In that time, the Tetons were 52-15 with a 2014 Mon-Dak Conference championship and a 2013 Region XIII championship. He coached two NJCAA All-Americans and was named Region XIII and Mon-Dak Coach of the Year.

Peterson served as an assistant coach at Williston from 2005-09. He spent two years at MSU-Moorhead from 2009-11 before returning to Williston to serve as athletic director and head coach.

Peterson hails from West Salem, Wisconsin, and graduated from UW-La Crosse in 2006 with a bachelor's degree in physical education. He earned a master's degree at USD in 2016 in interdisciplinary studies with a concentration in sports management and education.

Peterson and his wife, Lindsey, have a daughter, Flynn, and three sons, Isaiah, Briggs and Bowen.
