Game Notes

- The Pride dropped their third straight contest, falling to Guilford 104-56 at the First Horizon Coliseum. Ary Ingram led the Pride with 12 points off the bench, but Greensboro had no answer for the Quakers, who made 19 more shots despite taking 13 fewer.

- Raining 3's: Greensboro is on pace for 212 made three point shots this year, which would be the third most in a single season. They are on pace to obliterate their previous high in attempts by more than 200 threes.

- Everybody In: 15 players saw time against Guilford, with 12 finding the score column on the box score.

-Both Ends of the Spectrum: Greensboro has forced the most turnovers-per-game in the USA South (3rd most nationally) but are 9th (of 10) in the conference in turnovers committed per game.

Aaron Fernandez - Head Coach



PROFILE:

Aaron Fernandez arrived at Greensboro College in 2024 and enters his second season leading the Greensboro College Women's Basketball team. He most previously served as the Guilford College Assistant Women's Basketball Coach in 2023-2024 season. In his lone season with the Quakers, he helped lead the program to a 18-8 record. Guilford finished in the top 20 nationally in several categories including turnovers forced (6th), steals per game (6th), 3-point % defense (13th), bench points (14th), and team 3-point FG% (17th).

Prior to his time at Guilford College, Fernandez served two seasons as the Assistant Women's Basketball Coach at Roanoke College from 2021-2023. While there, Fernandez helped lead the Maroons to a 20-win season during the 2021-2022 campaign, the most wins for the program in over 10 years.

Before joining the staff at Roanoke, he spent the 2019-2020 season as the Director of Women's Basketball Player Development at Davidson College. In that role, he assisted with player development and scouting while also serving as the team's video coordinator.

Fernandez arrived at Davidson from Mars Hill University where he served as the Assistant Women's Basketball Coach/Interim Head Coach for the 2018-2019 season. Fernandez spent the first nine years of his coaching career as a high school coach in western North Carolina. From 2009-2017, he was the Varsity Boy's Assistant Coach at his alma mater Tuscola High School. While there, Tuscola saw an impressive turnaround culminating in a school record 24 wins during the 2012-2013 campaign. In 2016, Fernandez and the Tuscola staff were selected as coaches for the regional Blue/White All-Star Game. The 2017-2018 season saw Fernandez take over as the Head Varsity Girl's Basketball Coach at Charles D. Owen High School. In his one season, before joining the college coaching ranks, he helped guide Owen to a 20-7 record and a second-place conference finish. The 20 wins and second-place finish were the best marks for the program in over a decade. Fernandez has twice been selected as a speaker at the Women's Basketball Coaches Association Final Four Convention (2023 and 2024). He holds a M.Ed in Coach Education and Athlete Development from Xavier University and a B.Ed. In Health and Physical Education from Western Carolina University. He is an active member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association and the Latino Association of Basketball Coaches.

Assistant Coaches



Eron Lutterloh- ASSISTANT COACH

Coach Eron Lutterloh, from Siler City, NC, is in his third year for the Pride and works with the team's post players. Previously, he spent six seasons at Western Guilford High School as an assistant coach.

Coach Lutterloh continues to serve his country as a Logistics Officer for the US Army. Entering his 23rd year, he has completed several overseas tours to Iraq, Afghanistan, Kuwait, and Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.

Eron is a two-time graduate of North Carolina A&T State University where he has a BS in Sports Science and Masters in Teaching Physical Education with a focus on Adapted Physical Education. He was a member of the North Carolina A&T State University's Track and Field team in 2000 before he departed to pursue a career in the Army.

Coach Lutterloh is a lifetime member of the Association of Quartermasters, an active member of the NC High School Coaches Association, the NC Basketball Coaches Association and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association.



Karen Holmes- ASSISTANT COACH

Coach Karen Holmes, a native of Pompton Lakes, NJ, joined the Greensboro College Women's Basketball staff for a second time in 2023. Her first stint was in the early 1990s, serving as an assistant coach under then head coach, Steve Johnson.

Prior to joining the Greensboro College staff in the 1990s, Coach Holmes earned experience on both the AAU and high school circuits, as she coached the Greensboro Emeralds and served as the assistant coach for both Grimsley High School and Western Guilford High School. She also completed a stint as the junior varsity head coach at Southeast Guilford High School. Coach Holmes took a break from coaching to start a family and complete a successful 33-year career with Procter & Gamble.

Holmes is a 1988 graduate from the United States Military Academy at West Point where she played basketball for one year for the Black Knights before her career was cut short due to injury.

As a decorated multi-sport athlete in her home state of New Jersey, Holmes was a four-year letter winner at DePaul High School in both basketball and softball. Her legacy at DePaul remains etched in the school's record books due to her 1,000-point basketball career and First Team All-County selections. Holmes was also an integral part of two state champion softball squads.

Coach Holmes, who has called Greensboro her home for the past 35 years, brings with her a love of the game, a desire to teach fundamentals and a passion to serve as a role model for the next generation of players and leaders.

Coach Holmes and her husband of 29 years, Brent Holmes, have four children and four grandchildren.



Jordan Rogers- VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT

Coach Rogers joins the Pride with five seasons of college coaching experience as an assistant coach from 2015-2020. Following his two year career playing for Birmingham-Southern College, he transitioned to coaching and helped lead the women's basketball team at Birmingham-Southern College to back-to-back conference championship wins, an overall record of 42-15, and an NCAA Tournament appearance. From there he moved back to his hometown of Memphis, TN and spent two seasons coaching the men's team at Christian Brothers University and his most recent coaching stint was with the women's team at the University of Central Arkansas for one season.

Since 2020, Coach Rogers has been working for NCSA College Recruiting helping high school student-athletes and their families navigate the college recruiting process. He received his Bachelor of Science from Birmingham-Southern College in 2017 and his Master of Business Administration from Christian Brothers University in 2019.

As a younger but still experienced coach, Coach Rogers has a passion for developing student-athletes and fostering their growth for life after college.

He and his fiancé Taylor, who works for Wake Forest Baptist Health, have been living in Greensboro since 2022 with their two dogs.
