### ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Georgetown University men's basketball team picked up its first win of the season and first at Capital One Arena since Feb. 8, 2020, after downing the American University Eagles, 79-57, on Tuesday evening.
- Three players finished in double figures as **Aminu Mohammed** registered his first career double-double by tallying a game-high 14 points with 10 rebounds and a pair of rejections.
- **Dante Harris** recorded 13 points to go along with four assists and four boards while **Donald Carey** rounded out the double-digit scorers with 12 points on 4-of-5 shooting from the floor and added a contest-leading six assists.
- **Timothy Ighoefe** made his season debut, grabbing a career-high 11 boards to go along with six points on a perfect 3-of-3 shooting.
- Freshmen **Tyler Beard**, **Jalin Billingsley** and **Jordan Riley** tallied eight points apiece while combining for 10 rebounds.

## DOUBLE TROUBLE

**BIG EAST PRESEASON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR AMINU MOHAMMED** HAS TURNED IN A **PAIR OF DOUBLE-DIGIT SCORING** PERFORMANCES THROUGH TWO GAMES, PUTTING UP **17 POINTS AND SIX BOARDS AGAINST DARTMOUTH** BEFORE REGISTERING A **DOUBLE-DOUBLE AGAINST AMERICAN (14P, 10R)**. **MOHAMMED** IS A **TWO-TIME GATORADE MISSOURI PLAYER OF THE YEAR (2019, 2021)**.



## FIRST CAPTAIN UNDER EWING - DONALD CAREY

HEAD COACH **PATRICK EWING** NAMED GRADUATE STUDENT **DONALD CAREY** AS HIS **TEAM CAPTAIN FOR THE 2021-22 SEASON** ON OCT. 19, 2021, BECOMING THE **FIRST INDIVIDUAL CAPTAIN SINCE GUARD JOSEPH TOUOMOU** EARNED IT IN THE **1998-99 SLATE**. THE **6-FOOT-5 GUARD** BECAME THE **FIRST PLAYER IN EWING'S COACHING TENURE** AND THE **FIRST SINCE RYAN DOUGHTERY, AUSTIN FREEMAN AND CHRIS WRIGHT** AS TRI-CAPTAINS IN THE **2010-11 CAMPAIGN**.



## EWING MAKES HISTORY

HEAD COACH **PATRICK EWING** BECAME THE **FIRST PERSON EVER TO WIN THE BIG EAST TITLE AS BOTH A PLAYER AND A COACH**. EWING LIFTED THE CONFERENCE'S ILLUSTRIOUS TITLE **THREE TIMES AS A PLAYER (1982, 1984, 1985)** AND THEN LED HIS TEAM TO A **LEAGUE-BEST EIGHTH TITLE** IN 2021.

## LAST TIME OUT

- **Donald Carey** opened the scoring on a layup down the lane after **Dante Harris** forced a turnover at midcourt.
- Following a 4-1 run by American, **Mohammed** drained a shot from behind the arc to jump start a 5-0 run by the Hoyas.
- Both teams exchanged buckets through the middle portion of the first half with the Blue & Gray holding a 21-16 edge (7:52).
- With 6:19 remaining, **Harris** drove to his left and slid a pass down low to **Ighoeffe** who slammed home an emphatic dunk to push the Georgetown lead to five, 27-22.
- A **Mohammed** block propelled the Hoyas up the court and Harris finished with a layup to put Georgetown ahead by five, 29-24.
- **Ewing's** squad closed out the half on a 9-4 run to put the Hoyas ahead 38-29 at the half. Mohammed led all scorers at the break with 10 points, followed by **Harris** with nine.
- Georgetown and American exchanged points through the first five minutes of the second half with the Eagles pulling to within three, 44-41.
- With 13:20 left, the Hoyas stepped on the gas pedal, scoring 18 unanswered points over four minutes, forcing American to take a trio of timeouts and putting the home squad up, 71-45.
- Georgetown continued to match what American put forth in the final minutes of the game and secured its first win, 79-57.

## PRESIDENTS' AWARD:

- Georgetown University captured its second-straight BIG EAST Presidents' Award.
- Ninety percent of Georgetown's BIG EAST eligible student-athletes earned All-BIG EAST Academic Team recognition.
- The Hoyas finished 63rd in the Learfield IMG College Directors' Cup Standings, which was tops in the BIG EAST and fourth among non-FBS institutions nationally.
- Four Hoya athletic programs garnered NCAA Tournament team bids.
- There were five BIG EAST team titles, including men's basketball, 14 individual conference champions, 16 BIG EAST major award winners and 55 All-BIG EAST performers.

## SCORING MACHINE

- Georgetown's **Aminu Mohammed**, the BIG EAST Preseason Freshman of the Year, has put up back-to-back performances as the team's scoring leading, posting 17 points against Dartmouth and 14 against American.
- He recorded his first career double-double against American on Nov. 16, registering 14 points and 10 rebounds on the night.
- The Hoya newcomer put up 17 points on 8-of-15 shooting from the floor against the Big Green. His 17 points were the most by a freshman on opening night during Head Coach Patrick Ewing's tenure.
- The product out of Temple Hills, Maryland pulled down six rebounds and dished out two assists in his team-high 33 minutes of action.
- **Mohammed** will look to become just the eighth player in program history to secure the conference honor. is a two-time Gatorade Missouri Player of the Year (2019, 2021) and finished his senior year averaging 23.3 points and 10.0 rebounds per game.

## HERE W-IGHO

- **Timothy Ighoeffe** made his season debut against American, grabbing a career-high 11 boards to go along with six points on a perfect 3-of-3 shooting.
- The Hoya center made just his second career start for Georgetown against the Eagles and his first since Jan. 30, 2021 against Providence.
- **Ighoeffe** tallied seven rebounds in the first half, the most in a regular season contest since **Jamorko Pickett** tallied seven in the opening frame against Creighton on Feb. 9, 2021.

## OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

- Head Coach **Ewing** named graduate student **Donald Carey** as his team captain for the 2021-22 season on Oct. 19, 2021, becoming the first individual captain since guard **Joseph Toumou** earned the honor prior to the 1998-99 slate.
- The 6-foot-5 guard became the first player in **Ewing's** coaching tenure and the first since former play-caller **John Thompson III** named **Ryan Dougherty**, **Austin Freeman** and **Chris Wright** as tri-captains in the 2010-11 campaign.
- Opened the season with 14 points and seven rebounds in 33 minutes of action against Dartmouth.
- **Donald Carey** rounded out the double-digit scorers against American with 12 points on 4-of-5 shooting from the floor and added a contest-leading six assists.

## QUOTED QUOTABLES

- "It was a total team effort. I thought that Tyler Beard, Jordan Riley, Ryan Mutombo when he was in there, Malcolm - all those guys did a great job of helping us to go on that run. They were making shots, they were also doing a great job on the defensive end, got a couple of steals and also dropping it off to the bigs." - Head Coach **Patrick Ewing** on his bench production.
- "I've got a great group of guys around me. Nobody is trying to say 'It's got to be me' - we all like each other, we all encourage each other. That's what we do - push each other every time in practice. Preseason, not preseason - the goal is all about the team. Whatever it is, we have to do a better job. If your number is called, you have to step up. That's just how it is." - Guard **Aminu Mohammed** on the freshman class mentality.

## DOUBLE-DIGIT DANTE

- **Dante Harris** recorded 13 points to go along with four assists and four boards against American on Tuesday. With his 13-point performance, the Hoyas bumped their record to 7-1 when **Harris** scores in double-digits.
- The 2021 Most Outstanding Player in the BIG EAST Tournament **Dante Harris** is only a sophomore, and in the BIG EAST Tournament he averaged 11.8 points, 4.8 rebounds and 3.3 assists per game in his four starts en route to conference glory.
- He recorded a team-high five assists to go along with eight points in his season debut against Dartmouth.

## MUTOMBO FLIES UNDER THE RADAR

- **Ryan Mutombo** will look to make an immediate impact on the Hoyas' roster this season after being named to Jon Rothstein's 20 under-the-radar freshmen list.
- Following in his father's footsteps, the son of NBA and Georgetown Hall of Famer **Dikembe Mutombo** brings an instant height advantage to D.C. at 6-foot-11. ESPN's 94th-rated prospect out of 100 and 15th-ranked center in the country is slated to "have an instant opportunity to help the Hoyas," according to Rothstein.
- **Mutombo** is one of five freshmen brought in by head coach Patrick Ewing for the 2021-22 campaign, joining Beard, Billingsley, Riley and BIG EAST Preseason Freshman of the Year Aminu Mohammed.

## EWING AND AI = NBA75 TEAM

- Georgetown Head Coach and legendary New York Knick **Patrick Ewing** joined fellow Hoya **Allen Iverson** on the National Basketball Association's 75 Team to honor the top players over the last 75 years of existence.
- With two alums on the list, Georgetown is in familiar company with Indiana, Kansas, Ohio State, Syracuse and Wake Forest as the only other schools with two on the list. The only schools with more are North Carolina (4), UCLA (4), Houston (3) and LSU (3).
- The duo have combined for 27 seasons and nearly 50,000 points in the NBA, each earning a Rookie of the Year trophy and 11 All-Star selections while ranking inside the league's top 25 list for scoring.
- During their respective tenures in the District, **Ewing** and **Iverson** remain among the best players to don a Hoya uniform, racking up six of the university's 10 BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Years honors and earning a combined four First Team All-BIG EAST selections.

## HOYAS EARN BIG EAST JOHN THOMPSON JR. AWARD

- Georgetown's athletic department earned the inaugural **John Thompson Jr. Award** for its outstanding success in combating prejudice and discrimination while advancing positive societal change.
- GU's players, coaches and executive staff members collaborated to provide open dialogue and programming to promote inclusivity and carry out the ideals and values of the esteemed Georgetown head coach.
- Those opportunities included social justice gear worn by the men's and women's basketball teams and the formation of the Black Student-Athlete Coalition (BSAC) to go along with many more alliances across the university's campus.
- The **John Thompson Jr. Award** was created in October 2020 to annually recognize a BIG EAST athletic department, team or individual who has demonstrated outstanding leadership, perseverance and creativity in promoting an environment of inclusiveness or championing the end of discrimination, racism or bigotry.

## TEAM USA, MEET OTHELLA HARRINGTON

- Georgetown alumnus **Othella Harrington** reclaimed his spot on Team USA's coaching staff as an assistant, joining Ty Ellis under the direction of new head coach Jim Boylen for the 2023 FIBA World Cup Qualifiers.
- The 12-year NBA veteran and sixth all-time leading scorer in Hoyas' history will make his third appearance for USA Basketball after serving as a team scout in 2018-19 under Jeff Van Gundy and as an assistant coach for all three of the squad's 2020-21 FIBA AmeriCup Qualifying windows.
- **Harrington** will look to build upon his 9-1 international record as Team USA gears up for contests in back-to-back contests on Nov. 28-29, 2021 against Cuba and host-Mexico in Chihuahua.

## JESSIE GOVAN IGNITES G-LEAGUE

- Former Georgetown standout **Jessie Govan** returns to the G-League's Ignite for his second year, looking to bounce back from a season-ending injury suffered after just eight games in 2020.
- In his shortened campaign during Ignite's inaugural season, the 6-foot-11 center averaged 7.8 points and 2.6 rebounds in 11.1 minutes per game.



## BIG EAST GLORY

- The tournament championship is the eighth all-time for Georgetown, the most in BIG EAST history. It is the first time that a #8 seed has won the BIG EAST Tournament.
- Georgetown's appearance in the championship game marked a first in league history for a team that was picked to finish last in the preseason poll.
- The 25-point victory was the second largest scoring margin in a BIG EAST Championship Game, dating back to 1993 (Seton Hall, 33 points).
- Sophomore **Dante Harris** earned the Dave Gavitt Trophy as the Most Outstanding Player of the BIG EAST Tournament, becoming the 10th Hoya to earn the award and first since **Jeff Green** in 2007.

## HISTORY-MAKING EWING

- In the team's 112-year history, Georgetown's men's basketball Head Coach **Patrick Ewing** became the first person in the program's existence to win a BIG EAST title as both a player and a coach with his 2021 Championship run.
- The NBA Hall of Famer led his eighth-seeded Hoyas past No. 9 Marquette, No. 1 Villanova, No. 4 Seton Hall and No. 2 Creighton to lift the team's first BIG EAST trophy since 2007 and eighth in program history.
- **Ewing** lifted the conference's illustrious title three times as a player (1982, '84, '85) and led the Hoyas to its first NCAA Championship in 1984, where he was named Most Outstanding Player in the tournament.

## #NBAHOYAS OPEN 2021-22 SEASON

- **Jeff Green**, **Omer Yurtseven** and **Jamorko Pickett** tipped off their respective 2021-22 campaigns at the beginning of October.
- **Green** entered his 14th season in the NBA and first with the Denver Nuggets. Through 14 games this year, the veteran forward has racked up 8.1 points and 2.4 rebounds per game while averaging 21.2 minutes a night.
- **Yurtseven** made his NBA debut with the Miami Heat on Oct. 11, scoring eight points and pulling down eight rebounds in seven minutes off the bench against the Charlotte Hornets. In his nine games, the Heat center is averaging just under two points per contest in 3.5 minutes of play.
- **Pickett** also made his professional debut in the Detroit Pistons season opener on Oct. 11 against Memphis and picked up his first career point against the New York Knicks two nights later when he registered seven tallies in 17 minutes of action.

## EWING'S HOYAS ARE DOING WHAT?

- Detroit Pistons assistant coach JD DuBois on **Jamorko Pickett**: "He puts the time in, he's a great person and I was really happy to watch his confidence grow as the week went on. I think he has the talent, and now it's him being present, not worried about the last shot he may have missed, not being concerned if he's going to make or miss the next one, taking one possession at a time. Really was proud to watch the results follow the time that he put into his game."
- Miami Heat President Pat Riley on **Omer Yurtseven**: "Omer is one of [Miami Heat Vice President of Basketball Operations and Assistant General Manager] Adam Simon's great finds for our club. He will be a great developmental center/power forward to play alongside Bam, and has shown his willingness to commit to the work needed to get to the next level."

- On Dec. 11, 2021, when the Hoyas take on former BIG EAST foe Syracuse at noon, Georgetown Athletics will officially dedicate and rename its courts in Capital One Arena and McDonough Arena to honor legendary coach John Thompson Jr.

## NATIONAL VIEWERSHIP IS A GO

- All Georgetown games are broadcast nationally, highlighted by the Hoyas making five appearances on CBS or FOX this season. The Hoyas will square off with four opponents on Fox, facing former BIG EAST foe Syracuse at home on Dec. 11 at noon, St. John's at the Garden on Jan. 16 and reigning conference regular-season champion Villanova in both matchups on Jan. 22 and Feb. 19.
- CBS will play host to Georgetown's Senior Day when Connecticut comes to town on Feb. 27. **Ewing's** squad will also be featured 13 times on Fox Sports 1, five on Fox Sports 2 and three on CBS Sports Network.

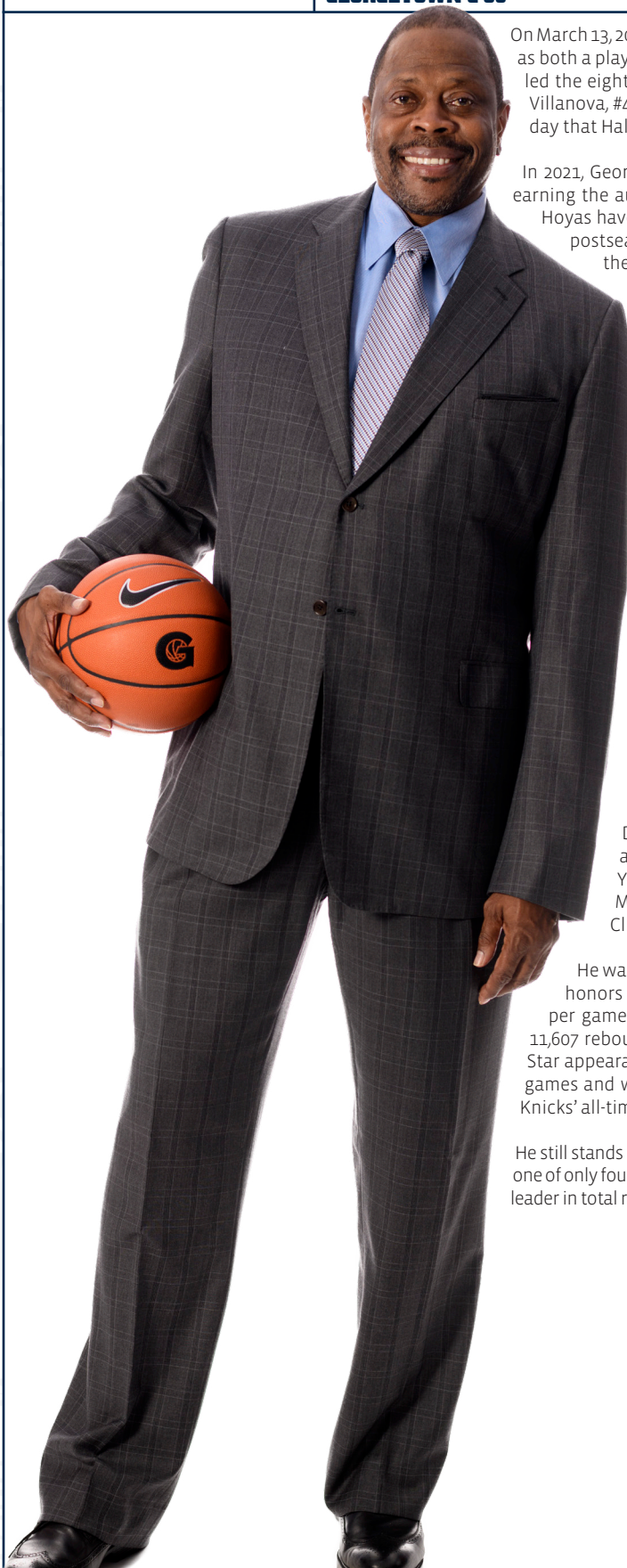

# PATRICK EWING

**HEAD COACH | FIFTH SEASON  
GEORGETOWN C'85**



On March 13, 2021, Patrick Ewing (C'85) became the first person to win the BIG EAST Tournament as both a player and head coach. Having won three titles as a player (1982, 1984, 1985), Ewing led the eighth-seeded Hoyas to the BIG EAST Tournament title defeating #9 Marquette, #1 Villanova, #4 Seton Hall and #2 Creighton along the way. It was the 49th anniversary of the day that Hall of Fame Coach John Thompson Jr. was hired at Georgetown.

In 2021, Georgetown returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2015 after earning the automatic berth upon winning the BIG EAST Tournament. In four seasons the Hoyas have picked up two major awards from the league. Ewing's teams have made the postseason (2021 NCAA Tournament, 2019 National Invitation Tournament) in two of the three years a postseason was available. In his first four years, Ewing has led the Hoyas to eight wins over opponents ranked in the Associated Press Top 25, including a trio during the 2020-21 campaign.

Ewing returned to the Hilltop on April 3, 2017 as its new head men's basketball coach. Ewing came back to Georgetown after spending the previous 15 years as an assistant coach in the NBA. He served as an assistant coach for the Washington Wizards (2002-03), Houston Rockets (2003-06) and Orlando Magic (2007-12) and as the associate head coach for the Charlotte Hornets (2013-17).

Ewing is recognized as the greatest men's basketball player to ever don the Blue & Gray. He was selected as one of the top 50 players in the history of the National Basketball Association (NBA) and was elected to the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 2008. In 2021, the basketball legend was named to the NBA75 team for the top players across the league's 75-year history.

Ewing was a three-time consensus First Team All-American (1983, 1984, 1985) on the Hilltop, leading the Hoyas to three NCAA Championship Game appearances and the 1984 National Championship title. He was named Most Outstanding Player of the 1984 NCAA Championships. His play propelled Georgetown into one of the most respected basketball programs in the country.

During his illustrious career, Ewing had the opportunity to play for, and coach, alongside some of the great coaches in basketball, including Pat Riley (New York Knicks), Jeff Van Gundy (Knicks, Houston Rockets), Stan Van Gundy (Orlando Magic), Tom Thibodeau (Chicago Bulls, Minnesota Timberwolves) and Steve Clifford (Charlotte).

He was the first pick in the 1985 NBA Draft and went on to earn NBA Rookie of the Year honors in 1986 with the New York Knicks after averaging 20.0 points and 9.0 rebounds per game. Ewing scored 24,815 points during his 17-year NBA career to go along with 11,607 rebounds. Ewing spent 15 years with the Knicks and made 10-consecutive NBA All-Star appearances. Ewing averaged 21.0 points, 9.8 rebounds and 2.45 blocks in 1,183 career games and was a member of the NBA's 50th Anniversary Team. He remains the New York Knicks' all-time leader in points, rebounds, blocked shots, steals and field goals made.

He still stands second all-time in scoring at Georgetown, averaging 15.3 points in 143 games. He is one of only four players in program history to score at least 2,000 points (2,184). Ewing is the all-time leader in total rebounds (1,316), blocked shots (493) and games played (143).

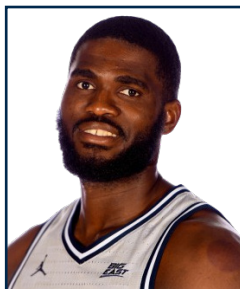

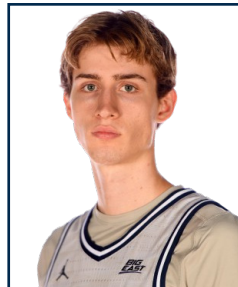
