# ABOUT GUSTAVUS ADOLPHUS COLLEGE



For over 150 years, Gustavus Adolphus College has been educating tomorrow's leaders to reason and act responsibly through its educational quality, accessible facilities, spiritual identity, and economic value.

Quality is a word that finds its way into many colleges' vocabularies. At Gustavus, quality is evident in its students, faculty, facilities, and programs, leading to recognition by a host of impartial critics. Forbes.com ranked Gustavus among the top 100 institutions in the country in its college report based upon several factors, including the average amount of student debt and the four-year graduation rate. The College is also included in other national guides and rankings, for example the Fiske Guide, U.S. News & World Report's Best College Guide, and the Princeton Review, which in addition has ranked the Gustavus Dining Service among the best in the nation in each of the past two years.

Gustavus students typically rank in the top third of their high school graduating class, and over 37 percent rank in the upper 10 percent of their class. Continuing their achievement at Gustavus, students find a challenging academic atmosphere where professors—98 percent of tenured faculty members have earned the highest degree in

their field—teach all classes (there are no graduate assistants) and serve as academic advisers. Collaborative learning is the norm, with exceptionally motivated students invited to conduct research independently or with a professor.

Top quality facilities complement educational quality. The National Review College Guide declares the two Gustavus science facilities to be “the envy of other small schools in its class,” while Schaefer Fine Arts Center houses the Anderson Theatre, acoustically perfect Björling Recital Hall, Kresge Dance Studio, a MIDI computerized composition lab, and plenty of practice rooms. The Bernadotte Library provides ample study space and access to literally millions of volumes through its holdings, the MnPALS system, and LEXIS-NEXIS. Computer facilities are vital no matter what a student's major, and Gustavus provides direct network access from more than 400 public-access terminals, with all individual student residential rooms hardwired for full Ethernet connectivity.

Founded by Swedish Lutheran immigrants, Gustavus has maintained its sense of spiritual identity through a daily service held in Christ Chapel (which many students choose to attend) and a one-course religion component built into the liberal arts core academic requirements. A Gustavus education challenges students to examine, develop, and strengthen their own spiritual and moral values, which for many students translates directly into service to others.

A number of factors combine to make Gustavus an outstanding economic value. Most importantly, Gustavus students graduate on time, with a four-year graduation rate of more than four times the national average. Moreover, Gustavus offers comprehensive financial assistance programs, including merit-based and need-based grants and scholarships.

## KING GUSTAV II ADOLF: THE NAMESAKE OF GUSTAVUS ADOLPHUS COLLEGE

Founded in 1862 by Swedish immigrants, Gustavus Adolphus College bears the name of the famous Swedish king Gustav II Adolf (1594-1632). Known as the “Warrior King,” Gustav ascended the throne at the tender age of seventeen and reigned from 1611 to 1632. In that short time span, he became more popular and powerful than any Swedish monarch before him. King Gustav was known as a friend of the people and a strong proponent of education. He died in battle at Lutzen, Germany, as he led his troops in the Thirty Years War, fighting for his faith and securing the future of Protestantism.

# 2019 HEAD COACH

## HEAD COACH PETER HAUGEN



Peter Haugen, a native of Minneapolis and a 1991 graduate of Bethel University, is in his 11th year as head football coach at Gustavus Adolphus College for the 2019 season.

Last season, the Gustavus football team posted a 6-4 overall record with a MIAC mark of 5-3. After a 1-3 start to the 2018 campaign, the Gusties rallied to win four in a row, averaging a total of 43.25 points per game in that span and allowing just 14.0. The Black and Gold then fell to St. Thomas 14-13 before defeating St. Olaf 29-20 in the snow to finish their

season.

In the MIAC's 2018 postseason honors, linebacker Matt Berkner (Sr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.), tight end Brayton Finch (Jr., Mount Morris, Ill.), wide receiver Brice Panning (Jr., Hamburg, Minn.), and quarterback Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) earned first team all-conference honors. Second team members included Jordan Kahlow (Sr., Le Sueur, Minn.), Brady Miller (Sr., Delano, Minn.), and Blake Sikes (Jr., Valrico, Fla.). In addition, Dutch Claybaugh (Sr., Kaneohe, Hawaii), Zeke Erickson (Jr., Clarks Grove, Minn.), and Josh Kirk (Jr., Garvin, Minn.) were named honorable mention honors.

In 10 seasons at the head of the Gustavus Adolphus football program, Haugen has compiled an overall record of 48-52 and a MIAC record of 35-45.

Haugen, who was the head football coach at Washburn High School for 15 years prior to coming to Gustavus, compiled an overall record of 111-44 during that span, while winning 11 league championships and posting a league record of 76-8. He directed the Millers to the Class AAAA quarterfinals in 2007 finishing with a mark of 9-3. In his last season as the Millers' head coach, Haugen's squad posted a mark of 8-2. While building the program at Washburn, Haugen increased player participation from 35 players in 1994 to 110 players in 2008. He also implemented academic monitoring and meal programs for

student-athletes as well as creating and directing the highly successful Washburn Athletic Leadership Academy. He has also served as the chair of the Minneapolis Football Conference and he is an active clinician working at many local and regional clinics including the NIKE Coach of the Year clinic. Haugen was also a member of the Metro coaching staff for the Minnesota All-Star game in 1998. He started his coaching career at his alma mater, serving as the offensive line coach during the 1992 and 1993 seasons.

A three-sport standout at Bethel, Haugen was a starting tight end on the football team, a starting goaltender on the hockey team, and a starting catcher on the baseball team in the late '80s and early '90s. In his senior year, he earned all-conference honors in football, and was selected Most Valuable Player of the hockey team.

Haugen became the 17th head coach in the 101-season history of Gustavus football in 2009. The Golden Gusties have a long and storied football tradition that includes 22 MIAC titles. The program ranks in the top-50 all-time in Division III (out of 235 institutions) with a 58.0 winning percentage (496-356-21). The Last season, the Gusties joined an elite group of 58 NCAA Division III institutions whose football teams have won 500 games.

Along with great teams, Gustavus has also been blessed with many outstanding individual players, which includes 25 players who have received All-America honors, 11 who have received CoSIDA Academic All-America honors, and five who have received NCAA Postgraduate Scholarships.

Peter, and his wife, Brenda live in St. Peter and have three children, Zeke, Zoe, and Zetta.

Charlie Cosgrove is in his 11th season on the Gustavus football coaching staff in 2019, serving as the team's co-offensive coordinator and offensive line coach. Prior to coming to Gustavus, Cosgrove served as a graduate assistant at St. Cloud State University for two years.

A 2005 graduate of St. Cloud State with a major in mass communications, Cosgrove was a standout defensive end for the Huskie football squad. He played in a total of 42 games, making 162 tackles (81 solo, 81 asst.) and earning All-Conference honors three times. He was named to the National Football Coaches Association All-America Team in 2005, and was also named the North Central Conference Defensive Lineman of the Year his senior season. In St. Cloud State football history, Cosgrove ranks first in tackles for loss (47.5) and quarterback hurries (28), and second in sacks (23.5) and forced fumbles (7).

Carlin Shoemaker is in his eighth season on the Gustavus football coaching staff in 2019, serving as the team's co-offensive coordinator, quarterbacks coach, and recruiting coordinator.

A 2003 graduate of Bethel High School in Spanaway, Washington, Shoemaker brings an extensive offensive background to the Gustavus coaching staff. A native of Graham, Washington, Shoemaker completed his undergraduate studies in the spring of 2007, earning a degree in psychology from Kenyon College. While at Kenyon, Shoemaker went on to have one of the best careers in the history of Lords football. A two-time captain in 2006 and 2007, Carlin made a total of 239 catches for 3,000 yards with 18 receiving touchdowns over his four-year career. His 239 receptions ranks second all-time at Kenyon, while his total yards mark ranks third. To go along with his offensive production, he is also the program's top kick returner, recording 93 returns for 1,873 yards. A three-time All North Coast Athletic Conference (NCAC) performer in 2004, 2006, and 2007, Carlin concluded his career by being named the team's MVP his senior season. In addition to his career on the football field, Shoemaker also competed on the Kenyon baseball team, earning All-Conference honors once as the Lords' second baseman.

Following his playing career at Kenyon, Shoemaker served as a graduate assistant coach at St. Cloud State University from 2008-10. While on staff at St. Cloud State, he served as the wide receivers coach. With his masters in sports management on the way, Shoemaker made his way into the MIAC with Carleton

College in 2010 where he served as the quarterbacks coach. After a year in Northfield and prior to taking the job at Gustavus, he took a position as the co-offensive coordinator at his alma mater, Kenyon, for the 2011 season

Staley played two years of Division I collegiate football at the University of Tennessee in 1994 and 1995, catching passes from future NFL Hall of Fame quarterback Peyton Manning. Staley played in 22 games for the Vols with 29 receptions, 352 yards, and a touchdown



**KELVIN MELGAR**, Defensive Backs

Kelvin Melgar is in his first season on the Gustavus football staff in 2019, coaching the defensive backs. A native of Houston, Texas, Melgar graduated from Houston Baptist University with a degree in kinesiology and wellness management. Melgar was a free safety at Houston Baptist before transitioning to a coach. He spent the past three years as a coach at HBU, producing six All-Conference players, one All-

American, and one NFL product. Kelvin lives in Mankato, Minn.

# 2019 SEASON PREVIEW



The Gustavus football team will kick off its 2019 campaign Saturday at Hollingsworth Field as the Gusties host the Martin Luther College Knights for a 1 p.m. contest. Last season the Gusties finished 6-4 overall including a 5-3 mark in the MIAC to finish fourth.

## **Offensive Line**

**Key loss:** Tommy Jech

**Players to watch:** Logan Holley (Jr., Fort Worth, Tex.) and Blake Sikes (Sr., Valrico, Fla.)

### **Notes:**

- The Gusties return five linemen who all started at least three games last season
- Holley will make the transition to center this season after starting at right guard last year while Sikes will start at left guard for the third straight year

**Coach's Peter Haugen's comment:** "The offensive line group is a smart group of guys who understand our scheme and are technicians. It's a group we're very excited about. Holley will be the center making all the calls and we bring guys back like Sikes, Tommy Bigaouette (Jr., North Mankato, Minn.), Gunnar Johnson (Jr., St. Cloud, Minn.), and Jordan Grovum (Sr., Cottage Grove, Minn.). Then after our starting five the depth behind that is some of the most encouraging we've ever had."

## **Running Backs**

**Key loss:** Rafael Soriano

**Players to watch:** David Peal (So., Worcester, Mass.) and Dalton Thelen (So., Cold Spring, Minn.)

### **Notes:**

- Peal assumed starting duties in the fourth game last season and toted the majority of the carries after that. The sophomore ran for 436 yards last season on 113 carries, scoring eight touchdowns in the process
- Thelen saw action in seven games last year, notching 27 carries for 122 yards while catching six passes for 88 yards and a touchdown

**Coach's comment:** "David and Dalton will be the primary two guys right now. David brings back a lot of experience from last season and we moved Dalton positionally so we're excited about that tandem."

## **Quarterback**

**Key losses:** none

**One to watch:** Michael Veldman (Sr., Becker, Minn.) and Brett Hufendick (Jr., Edina, Minn.)

### **Notes:**

- Veldman earned MIAC All-Conference honors last season after starting all 10 games. He completed 195-of-335 passes for 2,615 yards, 19 touchdowns, and nine interceptions
- Brett Hufendick will serve as the backup and has appeared in three career games

**Coach's comment:** "Having Michael back is exciting and we can build upon last year's momentum. He brings experience and leadership to this critically important position."

# 2019 SEASON PREVIEW

## **Tight Ends/Fullbacks**

**Key loss:** none

**Players to watch:** Brayton Finch (Sr., Mount Morris, Ill.), Ethan Sindelir (So., Wells, Minn.), and Hunter O'Bert (Jr., Eden Prairie, Minn.)

**Notes:**

- Finch returns as the starter after leading tight ends last season in catches (39) and yards (362), and touchdowns (5). He also carried the ball 47 times for 171 yards and three touchdowns, and was named D3football.com All-West Region First Team

- Sindelir and O'Bert return to the group with Sindelir catching five passes for 30 yards and O'Bert catching one pass for a touchdown last season

**Coach's comment:** "It's a talented group of tight ends between Brayton, Ethan, and Hunter. They understand our system well and have a good relationship with each other out there and it shows. Brayton's leadership of this group has been evident in camp and he is ready for a strong season with his teammates."

## **Wide Receivers/Tight Ends**

**Key losses:** Key losses: Ellis Hirman, Jamison Beulke

**Players to watch:** Brice Panning (Sr., Hamburg, Minn.), Josh Kirk (Sr., Garvin, Minn.), and Anthony Massman (So., Sauk Rapids, Minn.)

**Notes:**

- Panning returns as the team's leading receiver from last season, catching 48 passes last year for 992 yards and three touchdowns. The 992 yards are the fifth most in a single season in Gustavus history

- Kirk currently has 93 receptions in his career at Gustavus. He looks to join elite company this year as just 11 players have eclipsed 100 career catches at Gustavus

**Coach's comment:** "I think the biggest thing we've seen so far is that they've shown great effort in how they practice and prepare. That is what we want to see out of a talented group of experienced receivers. Panning and Kirk will lead that group and then we've got a handful of guys behind them ready to take that next step. We've got some depth there but I've been especially impressed by the senior leadership from Brice and Josh."

## **Defensive Line**

**Key losses:** Key losses: Michael Hensch and Tanner Sparrow

**Players to watch:** Zachary Jakes (So., Mankato, Minn.), Sam Jones (Jr., Jacksonville, Fla.), and Zeke Erickson (Sr., Clarks Grove, Minn.)

**Notes:**

- Jakes led all defenders last season with four sacks and was second with 9.5 tackles for loss

- Erickson notched six tackles for loss from the tackle position to go along with 3.5 sacks

**Coach's comment:** "That defensive line comes back with

a lot of experience with Sam Jones, Zeke Erickson, Taylor McDonald (Sr., Wayzata, Minn.) and Zach Jakes. Those guys come back with a lot of playing time last year and we've got some really good depth there as well."

## **Linebackers**

**Key losses:** Matt Berkner and Ben Rengel

**Players to watch:** Jake Boykin (Sr., Las Cruces, N.M.), Avery Bachman (Sr., Saint Peter, Minn.), and Tamir Beeler (Jr., Roseville, Minn.)

**Notes:**

- Boykin returns as the team's second leading tackler last season with 59 total, including four for loss

- Bachman returns this year after a 47-tackle performance last year with three tackles for loss and a pair of quarterback hurries

**Coach's comment:** "The linebacker group has a couple captains with Jake and Avery. They will be really key with Tamir on the outside to go along with the group behind those guys. We have a solid group of leaders at that position but also a bunch of guys who've played a lot of football and have talent."

## **Defensive Backs**

**Key losses:** Brady Miller, Jordan Kahlow, and Dutch Claybough

**Players to watch:** Matthew Montplaisir (Sr., Buffalo, Minn.) and Kaleb Scott (Jr., Gardena, Calif.)

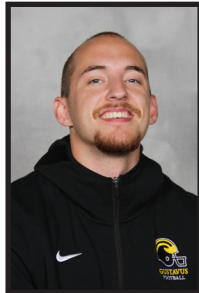
