GUSTAVUS ADOLPHUS COLLEGE vs. HAMLINE

GAME NOTES

Court on the campus of Gustavus Adolphus College for today's MIAC Championship between the Golden Gusties and the visiting Pipers of Hamline University. The Gusties finished the regular season with a record of 15-10 overall and a 14-6 mark in the MIAC, while the Pipers finished 15-10 and 13-7 in the MIAC.



THE SERIES

Saturday's game marks the 190th all-time meeting between Gustavus and Hamline on the floor with the Gusties holding a 112-77 advantage in the series. Prior to last Saturday, Hamline had won three of the last four games over the Gusties. The two teams split this year's series, both winning on their home court. This is the first playoff game between the programs.

The Gusties enter today's game following a thrilling double-overtime 124-116 semifinal win over Carleton in the semifinals on Thursday. The game was the highest scoring in MIAC playoff history, and ranks second in Gustavus history. Four different players scored more than 20 points, a first in recorded program history. Spencer Swanson has been sensational in the Gusties' playoff run, averaging 22.5 points, 8.0 rebounds, 6.0 assists, and 45.0 minutes per game. The team is shooting 49.3 percent from the floor this season, good for top-10 in the nation, while their 39.3 percent from three ranks third in the country. The Gusties are averagine 79.1 points per game, and have held opponents to 73.1 points so far this season.

Hamline enters its first championship game since 1985 after an equally thrilling semifinal, upsetting No. 1 seed Saint John's 83-80 on a Bradley Cimperman buzzer beater. Cimperman and Austin Holt led the Pipers past Saint John's, scoring 26 and 24 points, respectively. Cimperman is the team's scoring leader, averaging 15.2 points in 25 games played on 45.9 percent shooting. Holt leads the team in rebounds (9.8/game) and assists (3.7/game). Brendan Ebel has led the Piper defense with 15 blocks and 42 steals this year.
