SCOUTING THE GUSTIES

The Gusties come into the week after a tough loss to a very good Carleton team, 45-28. Sophomore quarterback Dylan Blount was 29/42 passing, with three touchdowns and two interceptions. He found Dom Mathies, Caden Kleinschmidt, and Jordan Wold for touchdowns in the air. Defensively, senior captain Bode Hogan found his stride, bringing in 17 tackles for the Gusties. The return game has been a strength for the team, being 35th in the country and second in the conference in punt returns, averaging 13.67 yards per return. Gustavus has also been very efficient when they get into the red zone, scoring 88.9% of the time this season, which is good for 39th in the country and third in the conference. Blount also is 24th in the country in completion percentage at 68.2%.

SCOUTING THE OLES

The Oles come into the contest after a 44-13 loss to Augsburg in Minneapolis. In the game, junior quarterback Luke Crosby threw two interceptions while senior running back Guz Gartzke scored the touchdown. Sophomore kicker Ethan Hess kicked two field goals, which brings him up to 6-for-8 on the year. So far this season, the Oles have prided themselves on their special teams. Besides field goal, they have the 19th best net punting average in the country at 38.83 and have blocked two punts, which is good for fifth in the country. The offensive line is particularly strong as well, ranking fourth in the country in sacks allowed, averaging only 0.25 sacks allowed per game, and ranking ninth in tackles for loss allowed at 3.00 per game, good for second in the conference behind Saint John's.





Peter Haugen

Head Football Coach

17th Season

Haugen's History

Head Football Coach Peter Haugen is in his 17th season at the helm. Haugen, a 1991 graduate of Bethel University, started his coaching career at his alma mater, coaching the offensive line for the 1992 and 1993 seasons. In 1994, he took the head coaching position at Minneapolis Washburn High School, where he stayed until 2008. While at Washburn, Haugen compiled an overall record of 111-44, while winning 11 league championships and posting a league record of 76-8. He directed the Millers to the Class AAAA quarterfinals in 2007 finishing with a mark of 9-3. In his last season as the Millers' head coach, Haugen's squad posted a mark of 8-2. While building the program at Washburn, Haugen increased player participation from 35 players in 1994 to 110 players in 2008. He also implemented academic monitoring and meal programs for student-athletes as well as creating and directing the highly successful Washburn Athletic Leadership Academy. He became the 17th head coach in the history of Gustavus Football in 2009 and has compiled a 81-73 (.526) record in his tenure as head coach. In 2019, Haugen helped elevate the program to a high society in Division III college football, joining a group of 58 institutions with 500 wins. Peter, and his wife, Brenda, live in Saint Peter and have three children, Zeke '20, Zoe '22, and Zetta '28.

STORYLINES

Last Time Out

Last week, the Gusties faced Carleton College, dropping the game, 45-28. The Gusties got off to a hot start, scoring on the first drive with a 15 play, 75 yard drive, capped by a four-yard pop pass to Jordan Wold. On the next drive, the Gusties would recover a muffed punt, but be forced to punt it away again. Carleton scored on back-to-back drives, but sophomore Dylan Blount found senior Dom Mathies on a 61-yard pass to tie the game up at 14. From there, the game would never be tied again, with the Knights slowly creating seperation. In the first game with Dylan Blount at quarterback full-time, Blount was 29/42 passing for 303 yards, three touchdowns, and two interceptions. Mathies led the way with 125 receiving yards and senior linebacker Bode Hogan paced the Gustie defense with 17 tackles and one tackle for loss.

Gusties vs. Oles

The rivalry between Gustavus and St. Olaf goes back over 100 years, to 1919, when the Gusties played at home against the Oles. It took until 1925 for the Gusties to win a game, beating St. Olaf in Saint Peter, 9-6. This year, the game will take place on October 11th in Northfield, the same time and place as in 2014, when Gustavus won 37-29 off of two touchdowns by Leeland Louti and three in the hands of Gabriel Boyce receiving. The last time the Gusties went to Manitou Field, it took a goal line stop in overtime by Taylor Stroh to win the game in overtime, 41-40, the week after the Gusties had beaten Saint John's. Overall, Gustavus owns the advantage over St. Olaf, 46-25. When playing at St. Olaf, the Gusties are 22-12 and the last time they lost was 2012 when the Oles defeated Gustavus, 17-14.
