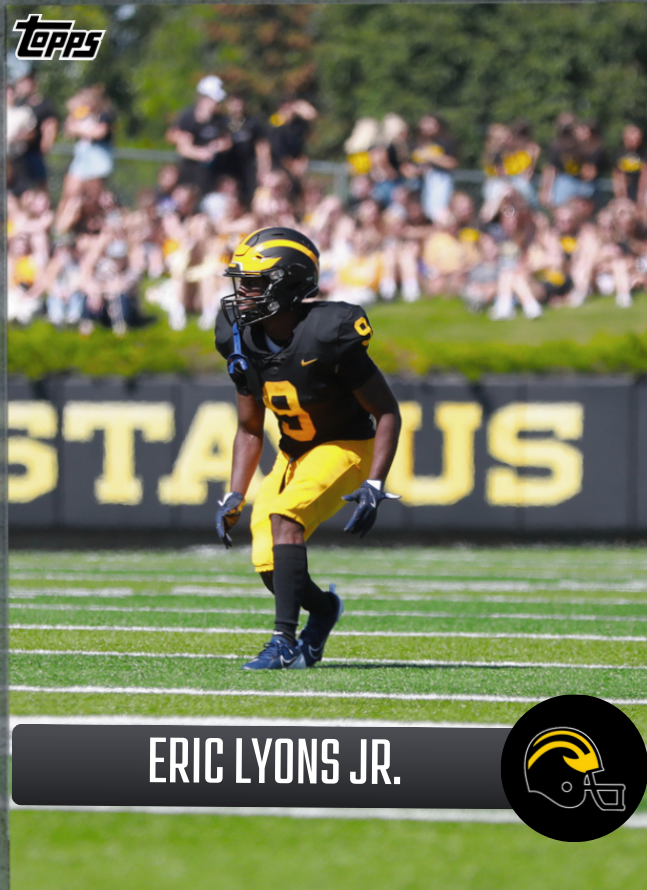

SCOUTING THE GUSTIES

The Gustavus football team is coming into the game after winning their first game of the season last week, 35-21 against St. Olaf. Sophomore quarterback Dylan Blount has shined for the team, passing for 858 yards this season, going 82-for-125 with eight touchdowns and three interceptions. Blount found his stride last week, passing for 333 yards, adding three touchdowns and no interceptions. Defensively, Eric Lyons and Chance Swansson have held down the secondary, combining for 55 tackles. The front seven has been steady as well, with the seven starters attributing 170 tackles of the 360 total. The return game has been strong for the Gusties on special teams, with returners averaging 20.6 yards per return on kickoff and 12.33 yards per return on punt.

SCOUTING THE SAINTS

St. Scholastica comes into the game with a 2-3 (1-3 MIAC) record, with their sole MIAC win being against Macalester. The Saints will make the trip down from Duluth after a 41-14 loss to Carleton on their Homecoming. The Saints are led by the tandem of senior quarterback Donald West and sophomore running back Jevon Williams. West, so far this season, is 78-for-172 passing with 1126 yards, eight touchdowns and two interceptions, ranking second in the MIAC in passing yards. Williams has 671 net rushing yards and seven touchdowns this season, averaging 6.6 yards per rush. Last season, West was 14-for-30 passing in the matchup, passing for 192 yards, two touchdowns, and one interception, where Williams was limited to five yards on three rushing attempts.





Peter Haugen

Head Football Coach

17th Season

Haugen's History

Head Football Coach Peter Haugen is in his 17th season at the helm. Haugen, a 1991 graduate of Bethel University, started his coaching career at his alma mater, coaching the offensive line for the 1992 and 1993 seasons. In 1994, he took the head coaching position at Minneapolis Washburn High School, where he stayed until 2008. While at Washburn, Haugen compiled an overall record of 111-44, while winning 11 league championships and posting a league record of 76-8. He directed the Millers to the Class AAAA quarterfinals in 2007 finishing with a mark of 9-3. In his last season as the Millers' head coach, Haugen's squad posted a mark of 8-2. While building the program at Washburn, Haugen increased player participation from 35 players in 1994 to 110 players in 2008. He also implemented academic monitoring and meal programs for student-athletes as well as creating and directing the highly successful Washburn Athletic Leadership Academy. He became the 17th head coach in the history of Gustavus Football in 2009 and has compiled a 82-73 (.529) record in his tenure as head coach. In 2019, Haugen helped elevate the program to a high society in Division III college football, joining a group of 58 institutions with 500 wins. Peter, and his wife, Brenda, live in Saint Peter and have three children, Zeke '20, Zoe '22, and Zetta '28.

STORYLINES

Last Time Out

Last week, the Gustavus football team got their first win of the season, beating St. Olaf, 35-21. The game was highlighted by a pick-six by junior defensive back Chance Swansson to start the game. Just before halftime, sophomore quarterback linked up with Dom Mathies on a 10 play, 70-yard drive to take the lead 14-10 into halftime. In the second half, a 20 yard punt return by Swansson set up the Gusties on the St. Olaf 44-yard line, where they scored on the first play to extend their lead to 21-10. Kleinschmidt struck again just 3:49 later, catching another pass from Blount. After St. Olaf closed the margin to 28-21, the Gusties shut the door with a 7 play, 78-yard drive, finished with a 54-yard touchdown from sophomore running back Walker Hennen. Blount threw for 333 yards in the rivarly game, going 22-for-37 passing with four touchdowns and no interceptions. Defensively, the Gusties picked off three passes by St. Olaf quarterback Luke Crosby. Swansson started the day, before senior defensive back Connor McCormick caught one on the next drive. Sophomore linebacker Carson Boike then caught one late in the fourth quarter to help the clock tick down.
