### SCOUTING THE GUSTIES

The Gusties come into the game with an 0-3 (0-2 MIAC) record, playing one of the toughest schedules to open a season in the country. Last week against Concordia, the Gusties were halted



on the 1-yard line on a crucial two-point conversion to take the lead with a minute left. This week, sophomore quarterback Dylan Blount will step into the starting role after three weeks of a two-quarterback system. Yet again, the Gusties have shined with their discipline, being the sixth least penalized team in Division III. Dom Mathies has also shown his prowess and athleticism, ranking second in the MIAC in punt return yards, second in kick return yards, and 12<sup>th</sup> in the conference in all-purpose yards with 290, averaging 96.7 all-purpose yards per game.

### SCOUTING THE KNIGHTS

The Knights come to Saint Peter with a 2-1 (2-0 MIAC) record, with their only loss coming to UW-Whitewater during Week 1. Starting quarterback Jack Curtis has been one of the best quarterbacks



in the country this year, all while battling late-Stage II unfavorable Hodgkin's Lymphoma. We wish Jack the best in his battle with cancer. Curtis is the only quarterback with 1000 passing yards this season and his main target has been senior Tyler Dimond, a returning All-Conference player. Dimond has three touchdowns on 20 receptions this year, leading the conference in receiving yards. Carleton as a team ranks second in the conference in offensive yardage per game and offensive efficiency, along with second in the same defensive categories.



# Peter Haugen

### Head Football Coach 17th Season

#### Haugen's History

Head Football Coach Peter Haugen is in his 17<sup>th</sup> season at the helm. Haugen, a 1991 graduate of Bethel University, started his coaching career at his alma mater, coaching the offensive line for the 1992 and 1993 seasons. In 1994, he took the head coaching position at Minneapolis Washburn High School, where he stayed until 2008. While at Washburn, Haugen compiled an overall record of 111-44, while winning 11 league championships and posting a league record of 76–8. He directed the Millers to the Class AAAA quarterfinals in 2007 finishing with a mark of 9–3. In his last season as the Millers' head coach, Haugen's squad posted a mark of 8–2. While building the program at Washburn, Haugen increased player participation from 35 players in 1994 to 110 players in 2008. He also implemented academic monitoring and meal programs for student-athletes as well as creating and directing the highly successful Washburn Athletic Leadership Academy. He became the 17<sup>th</sup> head coach in the history of Gustavus Football in 2009 and has compiled a 81-71 (.533) record in his tenure as head coach. In 2019. Haugen helped elevate the program to a high society in Division III college football, joining a group of 58 institutions with 500 wins. Peter, and his wife, Brenda, live in Saint Peter and have three children, Zeke '20, Zoe '22, and Zetta '28.

### **STORYLINES**

#### Last Time Out

Last week, the Gusties lost a heartbreaker to Concordia, 14-13. On the first drive of the game, Jacob Ginskey led a, 11 play, 74 yard drive that was capped off by a 20-yard pass to first-year Brayden Sturm. The rest of the first half stayed quiet and in the second half, Concordia scored 14 points of their own to send the Gusties into the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter down 7. Dylan Blount led the Gustie offense down the field on a 10 play, 87 yard drive over 2:45 of game clock when he found junior Simon Morgan for a touchdown. After an offside penalty by the Cobbers, the Gusties elected to go for two to take the lead with 1:17 left. The play was stopped short of the endzone and an onside kick attempt was thwarted which meant Concordia could kneel out the game. For the Carleton Knights, they captured the Goat Trophy in the battle for Northfield against St. Olaf, 35-28.

#### Homecoming

This week marks Homecoming in Saint Peter, meaning alumni will come from near and far to take in this week's matchup. Last year on Homecoming, the Gusties faced St. Scholastica and won 51-13. That game was stamped with the River Wood '24 stamp of approval, where he rushed for two touchdowns and caught one more. The Gusties have been highly successful on Homecoming weekend, winning every game since the COVID-19 pandemic, except for 2023, when Augsburg defeated the Gusties on a Hail Mary to end the game. In 2022, the Gusties scored 77 points against St. Scholastica, the third most points in a single game in school history, only behind a 94 point performance against Parker in 1917 and an 80-58 win against Buena Vista in 2021.
