SCOUTING THE GUSTIES

The Gusties come into the game with a 2-4 record (2-3 MIAC) coming off two consecutive wins, over St. Olaf and St. Scholastica. When comparing common opponents between Hamline and the Gusties, Hamline also lost to Bethel, Concordia, and Carleton, but by larger margins than the Gusties. After this week, the Gusties host Saint John's, a team Hamline lost to, 59-0. Gustavus ranks 75th in the country in passing offense, good for 4th in the MIAC. The Gusties rank 6th in the country in punt returns, averaging 17.86 yards per return, thanks to Chance Swansson and Dom Mathies. The Gustie secondary has also been a strong point, ranking 19th in the country and first in the MIAC in passes intercepted with 10. Quarterback Dylan Blount is 36th in the country in passing touchdowns.

SCOUTING THE PIPERS

The Hamline Pipers enter the game with a record of 1-5 (0-5 MIAC) after a loss against Carleton, 63-14. In the game, Jacob Aki led the offense, passing for 145 yards, going 11-for-30, passing for a touchdown, and rushing for a touchdown. Will Priest was the leading rusher with 83 yards and Dawson Schaffer was the top receiving target, catching a touchdown pass. Defensively, Elijah Gingras had the most tackles with seven, followed closely behind by Croix Zacharias and Erik Aune with six. The Pipers forced a fumble and Gabriel Maes caught an interception. The leading statistic for the Gusties is their 4th down defense, only allowing opposing offenses to convert 21.4% of the time.





Peter Haugen

Head Football Coach

17th Season

Haugen's History

Head Football Coach Peter Haugen is in his 17th season at the helm. Haugen, a 1991 graduate of Bethel University, started his coaching career at his alma mater, coaching the offensive line for the 1992 and 1993 seasons. In 1994, he took the head coaching position at Minneapolis Washburn High School, where he stayed until 2008. While at Washburn, Haugen compiled an overall record of 111-44, while winning 11 league championships and posting a league record of 76-8. He directed the Millers to the Class AAAA quarterfinals in 2007 finishing with a mark of 9-3. In his last season as the Millers' head coach, Haugen's squad posted a mark of 8-2. While building the program at Washburn, Haugen increased player participation from 35 players in 1994 to 110 players in 2008. He also implemented academic monitoring and meal programs for student-athletes as well as creating and directing the highly successful Washburn Athletic Leadership Academy. He became the 17th head coach in the history of Gustavus Football in 2009 and has compiled a 83-73 (.532) record in his tenure as head coach. In 2019, Haugen helped elevate the program to a high society in Division III college football, joining a group of 58 institutions with 500 wins. Peter, and his wife, Brenda, live in Saint Peter and have three children, Zeke '20, Zoe '22, and Zetta '28.

STORYLINES

Last Time Out

Last week, the Gustavus football team hosted the St. Scholastica Saints and celebrated Hall of Fame Day at Hollingsworth Field. The Gusties got their first commanding win of the season, winning 45-6. The game started with a 22-yard field goal by senior Owen Forsythe, which was followed by a Jordan Wold touchdown catch to end the first quarter, 10-0. They stayed off the scoreboard for much of the second quarter, before a touchdown at 00:57 left in the half opened the floodgates. In the ensuing 57 seconds, Colton Loeschke picked off the first play of the St. Scholastica drive and the Gusties scored another touchdown with 10 seconds left to go into the half leading, 24-0. In the second half, after a punt on the first drive, Gustavus scored on three consecutive drives to extend the lead and seal the game, 45-6. Individually, sophomore quarterback Dylan Blount had the best game of his young career, going 27-for-37 passing for 305 yards and six touchdowns. The touchdown mark is tied for the second most touchdown passes in a game in school history. Both senior Caden Kleinschmidt and junior Jordan Wold caught two touchdowns. Defensively, seniors Connor McCormick and Bode Hogan led the way with six tackles each. Hogan also added a fumble recovery and interception, all with one hand wrapped in a club due to injury.

Long Time, No See

This matchup between the Gusties and the Pipers is the first since the 2022 season, when the Gusties won 44-7 at Klas Field in St. Paul. The first matchup between the two teams was in 1921, when the Pipers beat the Gusties 60-0. The largest margin of victory for the Gusties was just 14 years later, when the Gusties won 61-0. Gustavus leads the series with a record of 65-24 overall.
