SCOUTING THE GUSTIES

The Gustavus football team has now won three games in a row, bringing their record to 3-4 (3-3 MIAC). In the month of October, the Gusties averaged 303.25 passing yards, settling in with sophomore quarterback Dylan Blount. Last week, Blount was responsible for four more touchdowns, this time two passing and two rushing. Walker Britz had the best game of his year so far, bringing in three touchdowns and 70 total yards, both season-highs. The Gustie defense has forced 11 interceptions, the most in the MIAC and ranks 15th in the country. Another shining spot for the Gusties has been their punt return unit, ranking 17th in the country, avergaing 15.63 yards per return and continued their pressure last week, blocking a punt to give the Gusties the ball on the 3-yard line.

SCOUTING THE JOHNNIES

Saint John's embarks on Saint Peter after a Week 8 win over Carleton, 49-10. In the game, junior quarterback Trey Feeney passed for 409 yards and six touchdowns, good enough to be named to the D3football.com National Team of the Week. Since being named the full-time starter, Feeney has averaged 391.5 yards and five touchdowns per game. As a team, Saint John's ranks fourth in the country in total offense with 525.6 yards per game. Defensively, their pass defense has been ranked nationally as well, allowing only 130.9 passing yards per game. In their sole loss to Bethel, Saint John's was stopped on the 1-yard line with the score tied in the third quarter, missed a field goal late in the game as well, and were held to 82 total rushing yards.





Peter Haugen

Head Football Coach

17th Season

Haugen's History

Head Football Coach Peter Haugen is in his 17th season at the helm. Haugen, a 1991 graduate of Bethel University, started his coaching career at his alma mater, coaching the offensive line for the 1992 and 1993 seasons. In 1994, he took the head coaching position at Minneapolis Washburn High School, where he stayed until 2008. While at Washburn, Haugen compiled an overall record of 111-44, while winning 11 league championships and posting a league record of 76-8. He directed the Millers to the Class AAAA quarterfinals in 2007 finishing with a mark of 9-3. In his last season as the Millers' head coach, Haugen's squad posted a mark of 8-2. While building the program at Washburn, Haugen increased player participation from 35 players in 1994 to 110 players in 2008. He also implemented academic monitoring and meal programs for student-athletes as well as creating and directing the highly successful Washburn Athletic Leadership Academy. He became the 17th head coach in the history of Gustavus Football in 2009 and has compiled a 84-73 (.535) record in his tenure as head coach. In 2019, Haugen helped elevate the program to a high society in Division III college football, joining a group of 58 institutions with 500 wins. Peter, and his wife, Brenda, live in Saint Peter and have three children, Zeke '20, Zoe '22, and Zetta '28.

STORYLINES

Last Time Out

Last week, the Gustavus football team traveled to St. Paul to play against the Hamline University Pipers on a cold and wet Saturday afternoon. The Gusties got out to a hot start, finding the end zone on every drive of the first half. This is the first time this has been achieved since 2022 against St. Scholastica, when the Gusties found themselves up 61-0 at halftime. This time, the score was 47-7, courtesy of three first-quarter touchdowns by senior running back Walker Britz, a pair of rushing touchdowns by sophomore quarterback Dylan Blount, a passing touchdown to senior Caden Kleinschmidt, and a rushing touchdown by Walker Hennen, the first of the season for the Alexandria native. The offense slowed in the second half, but touchdowns by Alex Gross and Trevor Johnson, coupled with a 22-yard field goal by Owen Forsythe. The Gustie offense brought in 445 yards and limited the Pipers to 187 total yards offensively. Notably, the Gustavus defense held Hamline to 62 total rushing yards, averaging 2.2 yards per carry, and held the Pipers to a 1-for-12, or an 8.3% 3rd-down conversion rate throughout the day. The Gusties were 9-10 in the red zone during the day and helped themselves out with 22 first downs and forced three turnovers.

First-Timers at the Forefront

The matchup this weekend will feature two quarterbacks who are both first-year starters for their school for the first time since 2017. Gustavus sophomore quarterback Dylan Blount was out last season due to injury and has moved into the role of full-time starter since the Carleton game. For Saint John's, Trey Feeney, a transfer from the University of North Dakota will start at quarterback after setting himself apart after five games in a dual-quarterback system to open the season for the Johnnies.
