THE SERIES

Northwest Missouri State leads the all-time series with Grand Valley State by a 4-2 margin. The teams have played five times since 2005 in either the National Championship game (3 times) or in a semifinal at Northwest Missouri State (2 times). GVSU has claimed wins in two National Championship games versus the Bearcats, 2005 - GV 21, NWMS 17; 2006 - GV 17, NWMS 14.

GVSU IN THE NCAA PLAYOFFS

Grand Valley State is making its 19th trip to the NCAA DII Playoffs, the second highest total among active DII schools. In addition, GVSU's 35 wins and .714 winning percentage both rank second all-time in DII playoff history. GVSU is 35-14 all-time in the NCAA DII playoffs, including a 35-9 mark since 2001. The Lakers are 21-2 at Lubbers Stadium in the NCAA Playoffs since 2001.

GVSU has won four NCAA Division II Football National Championships, captured nine NCAA regional titles, made nine trips to the NCAA DII semifinals and six to the NCAA DII title game.

MITCHELL IN THE NCAA PLAYOFFS

• GVSU is 8-4 in the NCAA playoffs under head coach Matt Mitchell. The Lakers have won four NCAA DII National Championships since 2002 and advanced to the NCAA title game six times since 2001. GVSU has advanced to at least the semifinals nine times since 2001. The Lakers have advanced to the NCAA DII Semifinals twice since 2013.

10 WIN SEASONS

• Grand Valley State has won 10 or more games 16 times in the 48 year history of the program, including 14 times since 2001.

NATIONS LEADING WINNING %

• Grand Valley State is the winningest FBS, FCS and Division II program in the country, boasting a record of 401-143-3 (.737) in 48 years of playing football. In addition, GVSU is also the winningest GLIAC program all-time with a 293-73-3 mark (.798).

WINNING WAYS

• Grand Valley State is the only GLIAC team to win at least 12 games three times

since 2013 and make two NCAA DII Playoff semifinal appearances.

ATTENDANCE LEADERS

• The Lakers are well on their way to leading the NCAA DII ranks in attendance for the 7th consecutive year. The Lakers have drawn 74,830 in total attendance for an average of 12,472.

MITCHELL MOVING UP

• GVSU head football coach Matt Mitchell is second in all-time wins at GVSU with 87. Current Notre Dame head coach Brian Kelly is first with 118 career wins.

LAST WEEK

#7 Grand Valley State scored early and often en route to a 45-21 GLIAC home win. GVSU built a 14-0 first quarter lead and turned four Wayne State turnovers into 17 points. QB Bart Williams completed 20-of-26 passes for 250 yards and three TDs. RB Chawntez Moss rushed for 100 yards and two TDs on 12 carries, while WR Nick Dodson caught seven passes for 104 yards and a TD. LB Tyler Bradfield recorded eight tackles and recovered a fumble. FS Thad Little returned a fumble 51 yards that led to a touchdown, while LB Antonio Strong and SS Jailyn Harden each picked off a pass.

LAKER FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

FAST START

• The Lakers have gotten off to a quick start offensively, with a stingy defense in the first half. GVSU has outscored its opponents 203-68 (18.4-6.1) in the opening half, including a 85-10 advantage in the first quarter.

LONG PLAYS

• Grand Valley State has tallied 98 plays of 20 yards or more this season, including 61 via the pass and 20 rushing. Austin Paritee (22), Brandon Wadley (21), Nick Dodson (21) lead the way on the 20-plus plays.

GVSU IN THE NCAA RANKINGS

• The Lakers rank 13th in scoring defense (17.0 ppg) and 35th in scoring offense (34.2 ppg).

• Grand Valley State ranks 33rd in total offense (433.0) and 46th in total defense (328.2).

• The Lakers rank 64th in rushing offense (163.4) and 62nd in rushing defense (139.9). GVSU ranks 25th in passing offense (269.6) and 42nd in Pass Effic. Defense (114.16).

• Grand Valley State ranks 18th nationally in third down conversion defense (47-for-16/29.0) and 48th in third down conversion offense (56-141/40.0).

• The Lakers have converted 45-of-52 (87.0) redzone opportunities, including 35-of-52 (67.0) that have resulted in touchdowns.

• The GVSU defense has 90 tackles for loss (-312) and 21 QB sacks (-131). Twenty-seven different Lakers have recorded a TFL and 14 have a QB sack.

LAKER BYTES

• QB Bart Williams has continued to rewrite the Lakers' passing record charts for single-game, season and career. Williams' 487 passing yards vs. Ferris State broke the previous single-game record of 434 yards held by Curt Anes (2001/Michigan Tech) and was the fifth-best, single-game total in GLIAC history. Williams is GVSU's all-time leader in career passing yards (12,302) and passing TDs (126). Williams moved in third in all-time GLIAC passing yards (8,814) and second in passing TDs (90). Williams, who is 41-8 as a starting QB for the Lakers, was a semifinalist for the William V. Campbell Trophy.

GLIAC OFFENSIVE HONORS

• Grand Valley State senior quarterback Bart Williams was named the GLIAC Offensive Player of the Week three times this season, including back-to-back games vs. Michigan Tech and Northern Michigan. Williams completed 23-of-37 passes for 382 yards and five TDs as GVSU claimed a 45-20 win over the Huskies. Just one week earlier in the Lakers' 47-14 victory at Northern Michigan, Williams completed 17-of-28 passes for 280 yards and four touchdowns, while toting the ball three times for 16 yards and his first career rushing TD, a six yard scamper. Williams closed his career in GLIAC play with the weekly honor after completing 20-of-26 passes for 250 yards and three TDs vs. Wayne State in the regular season finale.

TRIPLE THREAT AT WR

The WR unit consisting of Nick Dodson (57-928-9), Austin Paritee (48-904-9) and Brandon Wadley (20-546-0) have combined for 125 catches for 2,378 yards and 18 TDs.

• Senior WR Nick Dodson has caught 54 passes for 898 yards and nine TDs in the last nine games. He has broke the 100-yard receiving mark four times.

Dodson, who has seven career 100-yard receiving games, is 4th in all-time receptions with 165. In addition, Dodson is third in all-time receiving yards (2,486).

• Junior RB Chawntez Moss has rushed for 989 yards and 11 TDs on 153 carries this season. Moss has broke the 100-yard mark four times and the 92-yard mark eight times.

• Freshman RB Jack Provencher has 562 rushing yards and eight TDs, while catching 35 passes for 305 yards and three TDs. His 876 all-purpose yards is fifth on the squad.

• Senior DE Dylan Carroll has 161 career tackles, 32.0 tackles for loss and 14.5 QB sacks.

• Senior safety Jacob Studdard has 136 career tackles and four interceptions.

• Junior safety Jailyn Harden has 126 career tackles and two interceptions.

• Senior place kicker J.J. McGrath is 10-12 in field goals this season, while also recording 32 touchbacks in 71 kickoffs this season and is averaging 61.1 yards per kick.

• Senior punter Collin Cribley has punted 46 times for a 39.3 yards per punt average, including eight of plus 50 yards and 12 inside the 20 yard line. Cribley set the GVSU single-game record for punting yards (12-541) at Delta State.

• The Grand Valley State pass defense limited its first five opponents to 642 passing yards (109 yards-Indianapolis; 110-Delta State; 103- Northern Michigan; 214-Michigan Tech; Northwood 106).
