All-Time Series: First Career Meeting between the programs

- · George Washington will spend their Thanksgiving weekend in the Caribbean as the program participates in the San Juan Shootout. GW will face UT Martin and Florida during the event, with their first game against UT Martin tipping off at 12:15 p.m. EST on on Friday. live coverage can be found on Flosports.
- •Friday's meeting against the Skyhawks will be the first in program history for GW and UT Martin.
- George Washington took home another exciting victory in their last contest against Quinnipiac, defeating the Bobcats by the final score of 54-50. The Colonials stormed back from down nine points in the third quarter in order to secure the win.
- Offensively, GW was led by Aurea Gingras and Essence Brown, who each scored a career high in points on Monday. Gingras led all scorers with 16 points on the night, which easily surpassed her previous career high of 12 points, while Brown contributed 11 points of her own.
- •Graduate student Ty Moore chipped in 10 points and 13 rebounds for her second double-double of the season.
- •GW's defense continued to dominate opposing offensives, as they held an opponent to 50 points or less for the fourth time in five games. Additionally, GW locked down Quinnipiac's main offensive attackers, MAAC Player of the Year Mackenzie Dewees and

preseason All-MAAC first team member Mikala Morris. The duo shot a combined 5-21 from the field and only yielded 13 points.

•GW dominated the free throw battle against Quinnipiac, canning 14-17 freebies compared to just 3-4 for the Bobcats.

AUREA'S OFFENSE UNLOCKED:

In Monday's game against Quinnipiac, sophomore Aurea Gingras was GW's offensive catalyst. Gingras scored a career-high 16 points against the Bobcats, shooting an impressive 55 percent from the field (5-9) and converting six of her eight free throw attempts. Gingras has now scored 33 points in her last three games and is averaging 8.2 points per game this year. Additionally, three of the top five highest-scoring games of Gingras' career have come in GW's last three contests.

WELCOME BACK TO THE TOP 50:

Following GW's impressive defensive performance against Quinnipiac on Monday, GW's defense is now limiting its opponents to just 53 points per game, once again giving Caroline McCombs a team ranked in the top-50 nationally in scoring defense (GW is currently ranked 44th). This is now the 8th straight year that McCombs' team has occupied a top-50 spot in scoring defense. Furthermore, McCombs' 2021 squad becomes the first GW team since 1975-76 to limit its opponents to 50 or less points in four of its first five games.



LAST TIME OUT



Head Coach Caroline McCombs' patented defense was in fine form Monday evening, as the GW women's basketball team looked to make it two in a row after stifling Old Dominion on the road in its last contest. GW entered play having allowed just 53.8 points per game on the season while holding opponents to a .395 shooting percentage. The visiting Quinnipiac Bobcats learned what all the hype is about in a 54-50 Buff and Blue win at the Charles E. Smith Center.

Still without the services of Mayowa Taiwo, who led the team with 10.0 ppg on .529 shooting in the first two contests, and senior Maddie Loder, GW turned to another pair of returnees on the fresh-faced roster to secure the win. Sophomore Aurea Gingras (16 points) and junior Essence Brown (11) put up matching 5-of-9 efforts from the floor in career-high performances from both. The duo also combined to shoot 7-of-9 from the free throw line on a night when GW dominated the free throw battle and canned 14-of-17 freebies (.824) compared to the Bobcats 3-of-4 evening at the charity stripe.

Quinnipiac brought in reigning MAAC Player of the Year Mackenzie Dewees, and unanimous preseason All-MAAC first team member Mikala Morris, but the pair was stunted in a combined 5-of-21 performance that only yielded 13 points. As a team, Quinnipiac struggled to just .292 shooting, as the latest to see why GW is off to a 3-2 start with a 2-1 home record.

Gingras kept GW close in the first 20 minutes with eight of her squad's 18 points, but the visitors held a five-point cushion at halftime. Dewees was held in check early with just three points on 1-of-6 shooting in the first two quarters, but Morris picked her up with six points and 10 rebounds before intermission.

Ty Moore took over for Gingras in the third as the grad student and D.C. native netted eight of her own in the period, sending GW into the final stanza down four, 36-32. From there, a veritable offensive explosion boomed from the home club with GDUB netting 22 points in the fourth guarter alone. Sheslanie Laureano (nine points) and Brown teamed up for a highlight reel and-one as GW looked to close it out late, while Moore double-doubled with 10 points and 13 rebounds.

The back-and-forth affair saw 11 lead changes and neither side led by more than nine at any point.

HISTORY VS. UT MARTIN

Friday's matchup between GW and UT Martin will be the first chapter in the head-to-head history of the two programs. The two teams have never had a meeting before Friday's contest.

A LOOK AT THE SKYHAWKS:

UT Martin enters the 2021-22 season as a strong contender in the Ohio Valley Conference, having been picked fourth in the OVC preseason poll, in part due to the brillant coaching of reigning (and four time) OVC Coach of the Year, Kevin McMillan. Despite the expectations in the preseason, the Skyhawks offense will face an up-hill battle, having lost 70 percent of their scoring offense from last year, including two time OVC Player of the Year and WNBA draft pick Chelsey Perry.

The Skyhawks enter Friday's matchup at 3-2 and winners of three of their last four games. Their only loss in that span was a road defeat to #10 Louisville. Graduate student Holly Forbes leads the UT Martin attack, averaging 11.8 points per game, while junior Paige Pipkin comes in right behind Forbes in points per game with 11.6.

CAROLINE MCCOMBS HEAD COACH

FIRST SEASON // YOUNGSTOWN STATE '98

GW Director of Athletics Tanya Vogel named Caroline McCombs as the 11th head coach in the history of the Buff & Blue's prestigious women's basketball program on April 2, 2021.

A proven winner at every stop during her 22-year coaching career, McCombs comes to GW after seven years as the head coach at Stony Brook where she led the Seawolves to their first NCAA Tournament appearance in 2021.

"I am thrilled to welcome Caroline McCombs to GW," Vogel said.
"Our women's basketball program is rich with history that serves
as an outstanding display of both discipline and excellence for the
university, winning 23 Atlantic 10 regular season and tournament
championships. Caroline's passion for our program and her ability
to build a culture grounded in love, service and value addition is
an ideal match for our program as we strive to return GW women's
basketball to the national conversation."

The 2020 America East Coach of the Year, McCombs won 130 games in seven years at Stony Brook. This past season, she led the Seawolves to a 15-6 mark, winning the America East Tournament Championship and earning a No. 14 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

"First off, I'd like to thank President LeBlanc, Mark Diaz, Tanya Vogel and John Square for the belief in me to lead this program," McCombs said. "In all of my conversations, it was evident that my values would fit seamlessly with the established culture at GW. Furthermore, I'd like to thank Shawn Heilbron for the opportunity to become a head coach and the position he put me in to lead the Stony Brook program.

"GW has a storied tradition. Having worked under Joe McKeown at Northwestern, I was able to learn what a special place GW is. I look forward to helping restore this program as contenders in the Atlantic 10 and across the country."

McCombs had the Seawolves on the precipice of an NCAA Tournament berth in 2020, winning the program's first-ever America East regular season championship and advancing to the America East Championship game with a 28-3 record before the remainder of the season was canceled due to COVID-19.

The Seawolves won 22 consecutive games in 2019-20, garnering votes in the national polls for the first time in program history. McCombs leaves Stony Brook as the program's winningest Division I coach and second-winningest overall having coached 19 all-conference selections.

McCombs' teams have made their mark on the defensive end of the floor, ranking in the top 40 nationally in scoring defense each of her seven years on campus. This past year, the Seawolves held opponents to just 52.4 ppg, the fifth-best mark in the nation.

"Our expectations for GW women's basketball are high, and Caroline McCombs clearly displays the excellence that we are looking for in a leader," said GW President Thomas LeBlanc. "With a proven track record of recruiting and developing student-athletes who excel on the court and in the classroom, Caroline is an excellent match for our program, and we look forward to welcoming her to GW."

Prior to becoming a head coach, McCombs gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach for 15 years at the Division I level. She assisted four different programs and appeared in five NCAA tournaments, including two Sweet 16 appearances. She has also developed a pair of AP All-Americans and three WNBA players.

Before her time at Stony Brook, McCombs spent 2012–14 as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn, assisting the Tigers to a pair of WNIT berths. She was influential in signing a recruiting class that ranked 16th nationally in 2012.

McCombs came to Auburn from Northwestern where she was an assistant under former GW head coach and Hall of Famer Joe McKeown from 2010-12. Under her tutelage, Amy Jaeschke was an AP All-American and made history as the program's first WNBA draft pick. McCombs helped lead the team to a WNIT berth in her first season and assisted in bringing in a top-25 recruiting class.

Prior to Northwestern, McCombs spent five seasons as an assistant at Pittsburgh from 2005-10, aiding the program to five straight postseason appearances that included three NCAA Tournaments and a pair of Sweet 16 berths. With the Panthers, she coached Shavonte Zellous, who earned All-America honors

and was a 2009 WNBA Draft pick.

McCombs started her coaching career as an assistant coach at Valparaiso in 1999, holding the title for five years before being elevated to associate head coach in 2004-05. The Crusaders won two conference championships and advanced to consecutive NCAA Tournaments under her watch. She also coached Marlous Nieuwveen, who became the first player in school and conference history to reach the WNBA.

A native of Medina, Ohio, McCombs was an all-conference performer for Youngstown State, where she graduated in 1998 with a degree in dietetics. McCombs was a two-time Mid-Continent Conference Second Team selection in 1996-97 and 1997-98 and played in two NCAA tournaments, including with the 1998 team that pulled off a first-round upset as a #12 seed.
