- · George Washington women's basketball wraps up its four game road stretch on Wednesday when it heads west to the Steel City for a clash with long-time A-10 rival Duguesne. Coverage of Wednesday's conference tilt can be seen on ESPN+.
- Wednesday night will mark the 72nd meeting between GW and Duguesne. The Colonials have faced off with their Pittsburgh A-10 rival more than any other team in the conference, and currently boast an impressive 56-15 record against the Dukes. Last season, GW won the two teams' only game, 63-45.
- •SCHEDULE NOTE: GW's game against Saint Louis, which was postponed due to Covid-19 Health and Safety Protocols, has been rescheduled for Monday, February 14th at 2 p.m..
- In GW's last game, the Colonials, still looking for their first A-10 win of the season, traveled down to Richmond to face off with VCU. The Colonials and Rams locked-up in a back-and-forth affair, but it was VCU's 30-10 free throw advantage, and their subsequent ability to hit those free throws, that gave VCU a 56-53 victory.
- •On Sunday, **Kyara Frames** became the most recent member of the Buff & Blue to reach the 1,000 point plateau. Frames connected on a free throw late in the third quarter that gave her point number 1,000. Frames finished the game with 12 points, and has now scored 112 of her 1,005 career points in a GW uniform.

 Sunday marked the first career start for first-year Maxine Engel. The Memphis native has continued to play key minutes in A-10 play for GW, currently averaging over 16 minutes a game since Jan. 12. She scored a careerhigh 19 points in GW's game against St. Bonaventure last Wednesday.

 Sheslanie Laureano played a key role in GW's second half efforts against the Rams. The junior scored 13 second half points on Sunday and chipped in with 7 rebounds. Laureano finished Sunday's game with 15 points.

OFF THE SCHNEID

On Sunday against VCU, there were several positive signs for the GW offense. GW knocked down six threes against VCU, the team's most in a game since Dec. 21 against Lehigh. The Colonials also brought down 18 offensive rebounds and 42 total rebounds, the most in both categories since their game on Dec. 28 against West Chester.

Sunday also saw a pair of individual breakout performances from Kyara Frames and Sheslanie Laureano. Frames, who scored her 1000th career point against VCU, finished Sunday with 12 points, marking her highestscoring game since Dec. 21 vs. Lehigh. Meanwhile, Laureano finished Sunday with 15 points, including 13 in the second half, for her highest-scoring performance since Dec. 9 at Georgetown.

MEDIA COVERAGE

Sunday's game will be available via streaming on ESPN+. Live stats will be available on GWSports.com.

Wednesday will mark the latest chapter in GW's longest-running A-10 rivalry. The Colonials and Dukes have met 71 times since 1983, which is the most games GW has played against a single A-10 opponent. Additionally, GW's 56 wins against Duquesne are more than the program has against any other team.

GW will enter Wednesday having won its last three games against the Dukes. The most recent meeting was last February at the Charles E. Smith Center. Current Colonial Maddie Loder put on a show in that game, scoring 15 points and shooting a perfect 4-4 from three to help lead GW to a 63-45 win.

DETAILS ON THE DUKES

Duquesne, who was tabbed to finish ninth in the conference in the A-10 preseason poll, enters Wednesday's game with a record of 9-13, and 4-6 in the A-10. While at times Duquesne has struggled to find consistency, its most recent run of success came to close out January, and it saw Duguesne take home three straight A-10 wins against Saint Louis, George Mason and La Salle.

Personnel wise, Duquesne is led by grad student Fatou Pouye and impressive first-year Tess Myers. Pouye, a transfer from Western Kentucky, leads the Dukes in scoring (12.7) and is 10th in the A-10 in field goal percentage (.469). Myers on the other hand averages 12.6 points nightly and is turning into one of the best 3-point shooters in the conference. She's currently fourth in the A-10 in 3-point field goal percentage, shooting at a 40.0 percent clip.

George Washington will return to the Charles E. Smith Center for the first time in four games to take on St. Bonaventure in its annual "Pink Game". Tip-off between the Colonials and Bonnies is scheduled for 2 p.m. on Saturday, February 12th.

CAROLINE MCCOMBS HEAD COACH

FIRST SEASON // YOUNGSTOWN STATE '98

GW Director of Athletics Tanya Vogel named Caroline McCombs as the 11th head coach in the history of the Buff & Blue's prestigious women's basketball program on April 2, 2021.

A proven winner at every stop during her 22-year coaching career, McCombs comes to GW after seven years as the head coach at Stony Brook where she led the Seawolves to their first NCAA Tournament appearance in 2021.

"I am thrilled to welcome Caroline McCombs to GW," Vogel said.
"Our women's basketball program is rich with history that serves as an outstanding display of both discipline and excellence for the university, winning 23 Atlantic 10 regular season and tournament championships. Caroline's passion for our program and her ability to build a culture grounded in love, service and value addition is an ideal match for our program as we strive to return GW women's basketball to the national conversation."

The 2020 America East Coach of the Year, McCombs won 130 games in seven years at Stony Brook. This past season, she led the Seawolves to a 15-6 mark, winning the America East Tournament Championship and earning a No. 14 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

"First off, I'd like to thank President LeBlanc, Mark Diaz, Tanya Vogel and John Square for the belief in me to lead this program," McCombs said. "In all of my conversations, it was evident that my values would fit seamlessly with the established culture at GW. Furthermore, I'd like to thank Shawn Heilbron for the opportunity to become a head coach and the position he put me in to lead the Stony Brook program.

"GW has a storied tradition. Having worked under Joe McKeown at Northwestern, I was able to learn what a special place GW is. I look forward to helping restore this program as contenders in the Atlantic 10 and across the country."

McCombs had the Seawolves on the precipice of an NCAA Tournament berth in 2020, winning the program's first-ever America East regular season championship and advancing to the America East Championship game with a 28-3 record before the remainder of the season was canceled due to COVID-19.

The Seawolves won 22 consecutive games in 2019-20, garnering votes in the national polls for the first time in program history. McCombs leaves Stony Brook as the program's winningest Division I coach and second-winningest overall having coached 19 all-conference selections.

McCombs' teams have made their mark on the defensive end of the floor, ranking in the top 40 nationally in scoring defense each of her seven years on campus. This past year, the Seawolves held opponents to just 52.4 ppg, the fifth-best mark in the nation.

"Our expectations for GW women's basketball are high, and Caroline McCombs clearly displays the excellence that we are looking for in a leader," said GW President Thomas LeBlanc. "With a proven track record of recruiting and developing student-athletes who excel on the court and in the classroom, Caroline is an excellent match for our program, and we look forward to welcoming her to GW."

Prior to becoming a head coach, McCombs gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach for 15 years at the Division I level. She assisted four different programs and appeared in five NCAA tournaments, including two Sweet 16 appearances. She has also developed a pair of AP All-Americans and three WNBA players.

Before her time at Stony Brook, McCombs spent 2012–14 as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn, assisting the Tigers to a pair of WNIT berths. She was influential in signing a recruiting class that ranked 16th nationally in 2012.

McCombs came to Auburn from Northwestern where she was an assistant under former GW head coach and Hall of Famer Joe McKeown from 2010-12. Under her tutelage, Amy Jaeschke was an AP All-American and made history as the program's first WNBA draft pick. McCombs helped lead the team to a WNIT berth in her first season and assisted in bringing in a top-25 recruiting class.

Prior to Northwestern, McCombs spent five seasons as an assistant at Pittsburgh from 2005-10, aiding the program to five straight postseason appearances that included three NCAA Tournaments and a pair of Sweet 16 berths. With the Panthers, she coached Shavonte Zellous, who earned All-America honors

and was a 2009 WNBA Draft pick.

McCombs started her coaching career as an assistant coach at Valparaiso in 1999, holding the title for five years before being elevated to associate head coach in 2004-05. The Crusaders won two conference championships and advanced to consecutive NCAA Tournaments under her watch. She also coached Marlous Nieuwveen, who became the first player in school and conference history to reach the WNBA.

A native of Medina, Ohio, McCombs was an all-conference performer for Youngstown State, where she graduated in 1998 with a degree in dietetics. McCombs was a two-time Mid-Continent Conference Second Team selection in 1996-97 and 1997-98 and played in two NCAA tournaments, including with the 1998 team that pulled off a first-round upset as a #12 seed.
