KEY STORYLINES

GW AT THE BAHA MAR HOOPS NASSAU CHAMPIONSHIP

- Off to its best start in eight years, GW opens its time in the Bahamas with a 7 p.m. tip against Ohio on Friday night.

- The Buff & Blue are 4-0 for the first time since 2015-16 after defeating New Hampshire, 79-67, on Saturday.

- GW rallied from a 13-point, first-half deficit and pulled away in the second half thanks to 18 points and 10 rebounds from **Garrett Johnson** and 14 points, eight assists and seven rebounds from **James Bishop IV**.

- Ohio comes to the Bahamas with a 2-1 mark with home wins over Troy and Detroit Mercy around a road loss at Cleveland State.

JOHNSON REPEATS AS A-10 ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

- Garrett Johnson** earned the A-10's weekly accolade on Monday for the second-straight week to begin his collegiate career.

- Johnson leads GW in scoring (17.3 ppg) and rebounding (8.3 rpg). He ranks second in the A-10 in FG% (59.0%) and 3PT% (50.0%), fourth in rebounding, fifth in FT% (92.3%) and sixth in scoring.

- He is the first GW player to start the season with four 15-point performances since **James Bishop IV** in 2020-21 and the first rookie since at least 2010.

- Johnson is one of just two freshmen nationally currently averaging 17.0 ppg and 8.0 rpg (Tyler Harris, Portland) and one of just three players in the country to have recorded 15 points, six rebounds and at least one made 3-pointer in the first four games.

- All the more remarkable is Johnson's story of four surgeries and nine rounds of chemotherapy endured over the last two years to battle a benign tumor in his left hip. The tumor is now mitigated enough to allow him a full return to basketball.

A GW WIN WOULD...

- Give GW five consecutive victories for the first time since Feb. 19 - March 9, 2017, when the Buff & Blue won six straight.

- Extend GW's best start since the 2015-16 season when it opened that year 6-0 en route to the 2016 NIT Championship.

- Be GW's first win on a neutral court under Coach Caputo (0-4) and first neutral site win since Nov. 2021 vs. Wright State in Naples, Fla.

- Improve GW to 3-1 all-time in games played in the Bahamas.

- Be better than a loss.

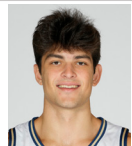

• The Baha Mar Hoops Nassau Championship will be streamed on FloHoops. Jonny Wincott and Sam Hyman will split play-by-play duties with Beth Dunkenberger providing analysis

HISTORY VS OHIO

• GW and Ohio meet for the seventh time in program history and for the third time on a neutral court.

• The two teams have not played each other since the opening round of the 2014 Diamond Head Classic, a 77-49 win for the Buff & Blue en route to the tournament championship.

• That matchup is the only one since the turn of the century between the two foes when the teams played a home-and-home in 1998 and 1999.

HISTORY IN MULTI-TEAM EVENTS

• GW went 0-3 in the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic last year and is looking to snap a five-game losing streak in MTE games.

• The Buff & Blue are returning to the Bahamas for the second time after going 2-1 at the 2019 Islands of the Bahamas Showcase with victories over Evansville and Milwaukee.

A LOOK AT THE BOBCATS

• Ohio was projected third in the preseason MAC poll and has opened the year with a pair of home wins over Troy and Detroit Mercy sandwiched around a loss at Cleveland State.

• Senior Jaylin Hunter (First Team) and sophomore AJ Brown (Second Team) were both named to the Preseason All-MAC team.

• The duo is two of four double-digit scorers for the Bobcats, who are led by Elmore James at 14.3 ppg. Brown and AJ Clayton have averaged 13.0 ppg with Hunter pouring in 12.7 ppg.

• Jeff Boals is in his fifth year as the head coach of Ohio, having guided the Bobcats to the second round of the 2021 NCAA Tournament as well as 25 wins and an NIT appearance in 2022.

THE ROAD AHEAD

• GW will square off with either Middle Tennessee State or Illinois-Chicago on Saturday in the second game of the tournament. A win on Friday puts the Buff & Blue in the semifinals at 7 p.m. while a loss will send GW to the consolation bracket at 1:30 p.m.

• Sunday's final round will feature a matchup with either Brown, Delaware, Kansas City or UNCG.

WINNING WITH DEFENSE

• GW has limited all four of its opponents to 40% shooting or worse to begin the year, ranking first in the A-10 and fourth nationally in field goal percentage defense at 33.9%.

• The Revolutionaries are 14th nationally in effective field goal percentage defense (39.9%) and rank third in the NCAA in block percentage (18.5%) and fourth in defensive free throw rate (14.3).

• Last Saturday vs. New Hampshire was the 10th time under Coach Caputo that GW has held its opponent under 40% as they remained a perfect 10-0 in such games.

• GW's 3-point defense was also superb against the Wildcats, limiting UNH to 4-of-31 (12.9%) from beyond the arc.

• 47% of opponent's field goals have come from behind the arc this year, 13th-most in the country. However, opponents have connected at just a 25.2% clip on 3s, good enough for 29th nationally.

NOT UP IN HERE

• **Babatunde Akingbola** has been the defensive anchor as advertised for GW this season. The graduate transfer from Auburn has registered multiple blocks in every game this year, including tying a career-high with five rejections last time out vs. UNH.

• Akingbola ranks third in the NCAA with 3.5 swats per game and is also among the country's top 10 with 14 total rejections.

• As a team, the Revolutionaries have averaged 7.0 blocks per game this season, best in the A-10 and sixth nationally.

• GW recorded 10 blocks vs. UNH, its first game with double-digit swats since recording 11 at St. Bonaventure in Jan. 2018.

• The Buff & Blue are the nation's leader in defensive rebounds per game at 36.5. GW has grabbed 76% of opponent's misses this year.

FRESH PERSPECTIVE

• GW saw three first-years reach double digits in the Nov. 14 win over Hofstra in **Garrett Johnson** (15 points), **Trey Autry** (10) and **Darren Buchanan Jr.** (10).

• It marked the first time that three GW freshmen scored double digits in the same game since Feb. 8, 2020 (Jameer Nelson Jr., Chase Paar, Shawn Walker).

• Through four games, GW has received 49.7% of its offense (166 of 334 points) from freshmen and redshirt freshmen.

• Autry and Johnson have started the first four games and became the first pair of freshmen to start the opener for the Buff & Blue since 2012-13 (Joe McDonald and Patricio Garino).

I WANNA GO FAST

• GW is averaging 83.5 ppg, which ranks second in the A-10 and 51st nationally through the first two-plus weeks of the campaign.

• The Revolutionaries currently rank 18th the nation in KenPom adjusted tempo at 74.1 possessions per game, and are 21st in average offensive possession length at 15.0 seconds.

• Last season, GW posted an adjusted tempo of 68.9 possessions per game, its highest since the 2005-06 team (71.2 poss. per game). The end result was the Buff & Blue averaging 76.3 points per game, which was the highest for the program since the 2005-06 A-10 Champions averaged 78.9 ppg.

DEPTH SHOWING UP EARLY

• GW has had six different double-digit scorers in four games with **Maximus Edwards** and **Garrett Johnson** the only Revolutionaries to reach double figures in both contests.

• Last season, GW had just six different double-digit scorers all season and only seven efforts of 10 or more points from reserves.

• The Buff & Blue have already received four double-digit effort off the bench with **Benny Schröder** doing so in the opener vs. Stonehill and **Darren Buchanan Jr.** having reached the mark in the last three contests (William & Mary, Hofstra, New Hampshire).

• GW is averaging 23.5 bench points per game this season and has outscored opponents' reserves, 94-67.

THANKS FOR THE CHARITY

• GW has paraded to the free throw line with regularity this season, averaging 21.5 free throw attempts per contest. The highlight came on Nov. 11 vs. William & Mary when GW made 33-of-38 free throw attempts, its first game with 30 makes since Jan. 2016.

• The Buff & Blue have taken advantage by shooting an A-10-leading 81.4% at the charity stripe, good for 11th nationally. They have averaged 17.5 makes per game, second-best in the league and 58th nationally.

OL' RELIABLE

• After registering GW career-lows in points (5) and field goal attempts (6) in the season opener, **James Bishop IV** has returned to his A-10 Player of the Year-caliber ways with 21.0 ppg, 5.3 avg and 5.0 rpg over the last three games.

• He started the stretch with a 32-point, 5-rebound, 5-assist effort vs. William & Mary on Nov. 11, the first 30-5-5 game for a GW player since at least 2010.

• He then took over the UNH game late, scoring all 14 of his points in the second half and adding eight assists and seven rebounds.

• Bishop, the A-10's reigning scoring champion, now leads the league in assists this year with a career-high 5.2 per game.

• His 14 points on Saturday moved him to the precipice of becoming just the 10th player in GW history to score 1,600 points in his career. His 1,586 career points are 22 points shy of surpassing Dirk Surlis for ninth all-time on the GW scoring list.

FIRING ON ALL CYLINDERS

• GW shot 50% or better in its first two games this season, ranking third in the A-10 in both effective field goal percentage (54.3%) and overall FG percentage (46.3%).

• The Buff & Blue are now 10-1 when shooting at least 50% under Coach Caputo and are also 12-1 when scoring at least 80 points.

OPENING STATEMENT

• GW's 45-point victory vs. Stonehill was its first by 40 or more points since Feb. 2016 against La Salle (90-50).

• The margin of victory was GW's largest since opening the 2014-15 season with a 92-40 thumping of Grambling State.

• The Buff & Blue limited Stonehill to 21.4% (15-of-70) shooting and no Skyhawk reached double figures. It marked the first time GW held a foe below 30% shooting since Feb. 2022 at Duquesne.

BLAZING THE NETS

• GW knocked down 15 3-pointers in the season opener vs. Stonehill, one off the school record of 16 set against Yale on Nov. 24, 2001.

• The 15 threes were the most in a single game since the 2016 A-10 Tournament against Saint Joseph's.

• **Garrett Johnson** and **Maximus Edwards** connected on five each to lead the way while five additional GW Revs nailed a triple.

NEW CREW IN YEAR TWO

• GW welcomes 11 newcomers, including four scholarship freshmen and five transfers, in year two under head coach **Chris Caputo**.

• **Babatunde Akingbola** (Auburn), **Benny Schröder** (Oklahoma) and **Antoine Smith** (Evansville) are three of the transfers who come to GW with prior Division I experience under their belt.

• GW returns just three scholarship players from a year ago. Included in the group, though, is First Team All-Conference performer, and A-10 Player of the Year candidate, **James Bishop IV** and reigning A-10 Rookie of the Year **Maximus Edwards**.

• Bishop was named to the Preseason All-Conference First Team and Edwards earned Preseason All-Conference Second Team honors.

IMMEDIATE IMPROVEMENT UNDER CAPUTO

• In year one under Head Coach **Chris Caputo**, the Buff & Blue posted their best regular season in six years, going 16-16 (10-8).

• GW enjoyed its most overall wins (16), most Atlantic 10 conference wins (10) and first A-10 winning record since the 2016-17 season when it advanced to the CBI.

• The Buff & Blue's offense paced the league in scoring at 76.3 points per game and ranked fourth in program history with 2,441 points.

• The Buff & Blue also led the Atlantic 10 in field goal percentage (47.0) and effective FG percentage (53.2), ranking 41st and 63rd nationally in the categories, respectively.

• Caputo agreed to a contract extension with GW prior to the 2023-24 season beginning. Terms of the deal were not disclosed per department policy.

YEAR FOUR FOR JBIV

• Last season, **James Bishop IV** became the first member of the Buff & Blue to win the A-10 scoring title since SirValiant Brown in 1999-00 and was GW's first representative on the All-Conference First Team since 2005-06 (Pops Mensah-Bonsu).

• Bishop's 691 points were the third-most in a single season in program history and the most since the all-time record of 738 set by Brown in his 1999-00 campaign.

• He became GW's first player ever to register 650+ points and 150+ assists in the same year and the first in the A-10 since 2015-16.

• Bishop finished 12th in the country at 21.6 ppg and led the NCAA with 10 games of at least 25 points and eight assists.

• The Baltimore native was the first A-10 player to average 21.0 ppg and 5.0 apg since St. Bonaventure's Marques Green in 2002-03.

Chris Caputo immediately made his mark on the GW basketball in his first year with the program in 2022-23. Under his leadership, the Buff & Blue posted their best regular season in six years, enjoying the most overall wins (16), most Atlantic 10 conference wins (10) and first A-10 winning record since the 2016-17 season.

Caputo recorded the second-most A-10 wins (10) for a first-year GW coach in program history and the fourth-most overall wins (16) in GW's A-10 era. He was named a finalist for the Joe B. Hall National Coach of the Year Award, given annually to the top first-time head coach in the country.

All five starters for the Buff & Blue during 2022-23 enjoyed career seasons, highlighted by First Team All-Conference performer James Bishop IV, A-10 Most Improved Player of the Year and Third Team All-Conference member Brendan Adams and A-10 Rookie of the Year Maximus Edwards.

On April 1, 2022, GW Director of Athletics Tanya Vogel proudly named Chris Caputo as Head Coach of The George Washington University's men's basketball team. Caputo comes to the District as the next step in a coaching career that spans more than two decades, has taken him to a Final Four and, most recently, the Elite Eight of the 2022 NCAA Tournament.

As the world of college basketball continues to evolve, Caputo exhibited a masterful ability to adapt in an ever-changing landscape. Through player development skills honed after more than 20 years in the business, plus a thorough understanding of how to augment a program through the transfer portal, he placed Miami in a position of success as Associate Head Coach in that program's recent March run.

As co-pilot with Final Four coach Jim Larrañaga, Caputo prioritized a style of play that put five players on the court who can be interchangeable and versatile. Caputo recently noted that "putting five guys on the floor that can pass, dribble and shoot makes it very difficult to defend at times when we're able to spread you out. The ability to share the ball, be selfless, (previous teams) taken to that."

Miami's Associate Head Coach since 2015, Caputo has had experience in every area that is required to build a winning program. A skilled scout,

recruiter and Xs and Os tactician who served as the team's defensive coordinator, he helped coach the Hurricanes to seven postseason berths, five NCAA appearances, three Sweet 16s and an Elite Eight. Miami was ranked as high as No. 2 in the national polls during his tenure, while numerous coaching peers and outlets have identified him as a premier assistant and soon-to-be head coaching star, highlighted by a CBS Sports poll of 100-plus college coaches who ranked Caputo as one of the three assistants in the nation most likely to someday become a coaching star.

Sports Illustrated also identified Caputo as one of the top assistants ready to make the jump to a head coaching position after his Miami teams joined Duke as the lone ACC programs to have a student-athlete drafted into the NBA every year from 2016-19.

Dating back to his time with Larrañaga at George Mason, Caputo's recruiting chops have yielded success in landing the area's top talent, along with McDonald's All-Americans, Jordan Brand Classic players, and international talent from Australia and New Zealand, countries where emerging athletes have taken the basketball world by storm in recent years.

The architect of Top 25 defenses nationally, Caputo has shown his commitment to academics in his mentorship of a previous Skip Prosser Award recipient, presented annually to the top scholar-athlete in ACC men's basketball, a conference that boasts some of the finer academic institutions of higher education in the country. Graduation success has been a priority throughout Caputo's decorated assistant coaching career.

A multi-time participant in the esteemed Villa 7 Consortium, an educational symposium and networking opportunity for some of the nation's top assistants, Caputo has done everything from serving as a video coordinator, to managing databases and mailing systems, while serving in various administrative capacities.

Originally from Elmhurst, N.Y., Caputo is a 2002 graduate of Westfield (Mass.) State University with a degree in finance and economics. He was a four-year letter winner as a point guard for the Division III Owls, served as captain and earned the team's Outstanding Contributor Award as a senior. He is a 1998 graduate of Archbishop Molloy High School.

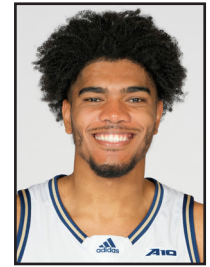

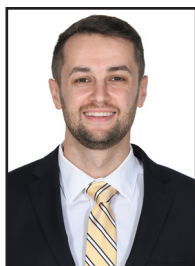
