KEY STORYLINES

GW VS. KANSAS STATE

- GW opens up the U.S. Virgin Islands Paradise Jam with a Friday night showdown against Big 12 foe Kansas State. Tip is scheduled for 9 p.m. local (8 p.m. ET) with streaming coverage on ESPN+.
- GW is a perfect 4-0 on the year with four home victories by an average of 17.5 ppg, including an 84-64 win over NJIT Monday.
- Kansas State is 3-1 following a victory over Mississippi Valley State on Tuesday with its lone loss coming at home vs. LSU.

LAST TIME OUT

- GW utilized a 15-0 second-half run to pull away from NJIT on Monday in its third win by 17 points or more this season.
- The Buff & Blue had five players reach double figures, led by Darren Buchanan Jr.'s stat-stuffing display of 20 points, six assists, four steals and four rebounds.
- Monday marked the second time in four games that GW had at least five players in double digits, also doing so when six players reached the mark vs. Hampton (11/12).

SWIPER KEEP SWIPING

- GW recorded 10 steals in Monday's victory over NJIT, the fourth straight game to begin the season with at least nine steals.
- The Revolutionaries are second in the A-10, and 40th nationally, with 10.0 swipes per contest.
- · Individually, Darren Buchanan Jr. and Rafael Castro are tied for sixth in the A-10 with nine steals apiece, accounting for 45% of the team's 40 steals on the campaign.
- As a result, GW ranks third in the A-10 with 15.0 turnovers forced per game and leads the league in turnover margin at +4.0.

A GW WIN WOULD...

- · Improve GW to 5-0 for the second straight year and match the longest winning streak under Coach Caputo (done twice previously).
- Mark the second victory over a "Power 4" school in Coach Caputo's three seasons, joining a win over South Carolina on Nov. 30, 2022.
- Be the second win in program history over Kansas State the first neutral-site win over a "Power 4" school since 2015.
- Improve GW's non-conference record to 22-9 under Coach Caputo.
- · Be better than a loss.



HISTORY VS. KANSAS STATE

- GW and Kansas State are meeting for the sixth time in program history on Friday night and for the first time since a neutral site clash in Las Vegas in 2017.
- The Buff & Blue won the first matchup in the 1940-41 season, but have since lost four straight, including when the teams met three straight years on home floors from 2011-13.

HISTORY IN MULTI-TEAM EVENTS

- GW went 2-1 with wins over Ohio and Delaware in the Baha Mar Hoops Nassau Championship last year to earn a third-place finish.

- Kansas State enters its time at the Paradise Jam at 3-1 following a 76-59 victory over Mississippi Valley State on Monday.
- The Wildcats were projected to finish eighth in the Big 12 this year following a 19-15 (8-10) season a year ago that finished with a loss to lowa in the NIT.
- Head Coach Jerome Tang is in his third year leading Kansas State, reaching the Elite Eight in his first campaign in 2022-23.
- K-State overhauled its roster this offseason with 11 transfers (eight from D-I). The most notable is preseason Big 12 Co-Newcomer of the Year Coleman Hawkins, who transferred in from Illinois.
- Hawkins, who was an All-Big Ten honoree for the Fighting Illini last year, is averaging 6.8 ppg and 7.0 rpg thus far.
- David N'Guessan, who began his career at Virginia Tech, is the team's leading scorer through four games at 14.8 ppg and is shooting 74.3% from the field.
- Villanova transfer Brandon Hausen averages 13.8 ppg and has connected at a 40% clip from beyond the arc.

MR. DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- Redshirt sophomore **Darren Buchanan Jr.** notched three straight double-doubles to begin the season, becoming the first GW player to do so in Stathead's game log database (since '04-'05).
- Buchanan was the first Revolutionary since Tyler Cavanaugh (Feb. 4-11, 2017) to tally three straight double-doubles at any point.
- The D.C. native is one of just 12 players in the nation with three double-doubles and is one off the national lead of four.
- Buchanan has tallied consecutive 20-point efforts vs. NC A&T and NJIT and ranks sixth in the league in total points. He also is second in the A-10 in rebounding (9.0 rpg) and third in steals (2.3 spg).

CASTRO STUFFING THE STAT SHEET

- Providence transfer **Rafael Castro** has enjoyed a fast start to his campaign as well with two double-doubles in four games.
- Castro, who played sparingly for two years at PC, has set or matched new career-highs in points, field goals made (tied), rebounds, assists, blocks (tied) and steals (tied).
- Castro sits alongside Buchanan in a tie for second in the A-10 in rebounding (9.0 rpg) and is also second in the in loop in offensive rebounding with 3.8 per game. He has recorded at least five rebounds in every game and has collected multiple offensive boards in every contest.
- The New Jersey native is also tied for fourth in the A-10 with 2.3 steals per game and has tallied multiple swipes three times including consecutive outings with three steals the last two games.

PAINT EQUALS GREAT

- GW has dominated the interior in four games this season, outscoring its opponents in the paint, 176-106 (44-26.5 average).
- The Buff & Blue have recorded at least 38 points in the paint in every game this season and have crossed 40 paint points on three occasions already this year after doing so just three times last year.
- GW opened the season with a Caputo-era best 15 offensive rebounds vs. Mercyhurst, the most since Dec. 7, 2020 vs. UMBC.
- GW has posted at least nine offensive boards in each game, which has led to 60 second chance points (15 per game).
- GW is 59th in the country, grabbing 36.1% of its own misses, and ranks 14th in 2-point field goal percentage at 63.4%.

BALANCING THINGS OUT

- GW recorded its second game of the season with at least five players in double figures on Monday vs. NJIT, something it did only three times last year.
- The Buff & Blue saw six different players reach double digits vs. Hampton on Nov. 8, marking the first time for the program to do so since Feb. 21, 2018 vs. Richmond.
- Notably, Rafael Castro (4 games) has already tallied more double-digit outings in four games at GW than he did in 60 games at Providence (3 games). He's also surpassed his previous careerhigh of 12 at PC twice.
- Additionally, Trey Autry (2 games) is one shy of matching his double-digit efforts from a year ago and reset his career-high with 14 points vs. Hampton on Nov. 8.

ISLAND BOY

- This week marks a homecoming of sorts for **Jacoi Hutchinson**, whose maternal side of the family is from St. Croix.
- Hutchinson has made multiple trips to the Virgin Islands as a child and expects to have at least 20 friends and family in attendance.

PROVIDE FOR THE COMMON DEFENSE

- GW has limited its first four opponents to 64.3 ppg and opened the year by holding back-to-back opponents under 60 points for the first time since Nov. 26-30, 2022.
- The Buff & Blue are 37th nationally in 2-point percentage defense (42.5%) and 60th in effective FG% defense (45%).
- Last year, by comparison, the GW Revs were 86th in 2-point percentage defense (48.3%) and 134th in effective FG percentage defense (49.8%).

SHIFT IN IDENTITY

- Known for its 3-point prowess the last two years, including making a school record 287 triples last year, GW has struggled to start the year, making just 24-of-96 (25%) in the first four games.
- GW won vs. Mercyhurst when shooting below 20% from deep for the first time since Dec. 13, 2021 vs. Radford (4-of-21, 19%).
- The Revolutionaries have not hit more than six 3-pointers in a game yet this year after hitting at least six 19 times a year ago.

G5 1K

- Graduate transfer Gerald Drumgoole Jr. crossed the 1,000-point threshold in his career in the season-opening win vs. Mercyhurst.
- Now in his sixth year of college basketball, Drumgoole tallied just 48 total points in his first three years between Pittsburgh (2019-21, 30 games) and Albany (2021-22, 1 game).
- He then broke out with 488 points in 2022-23 with Albany (15.7 ppg) and 458 points in 2023-24 with Delaware (13.9 ppg) to sit on the doorstep of the threshold with 994 points entering this season.
- Drumgoole now sits at 1,043 points in 99 career games (10.5 ppg).

THE 2024-25 REVOLUTIONARIES

- GW embarks on year three of the **Chris Caputo** era in 2024-25 with a young core intact, augmented by the addition of four transfers and two scholarship freshmen.
- The Revolutionaries will rely heavily upon their five scholarship sophomores, who represent the team's top five returning scorers.
- **Darren Buchanan Jr.**, a four-time Rookie of the Week and Atlantic 10 All-Rookie selection, is the team's top returner after posting 15.6 ppg, 6.6 rpg and 2.4 apg a year ago.
- After ranking 13th in the A-10 in KenPom's D-I experience metric a year ago, GW added a combined 13 years of experience in transfers Rafael Castro (Providence), Gerald Drumgoole Jr. (Delaware), Sean Hansen (Cornell) and Trey Moss (William & Mary).
- Coach Caputo also transformed his coaching staff in the offseason, elevating **Matt Colpoys** (3rd season at GW) and **Aaron Thompson** (2nd season) to full-time assistant coach roles. **Eric Sebastian** has joined the program as Director of Basketball Operations and **Sam Ebersold** is GW's new Director of Player Development.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

- GW ranked third in the nation in points scored by freshmen last season, behind only Saint Francis and Kentucky, and was fourth in the country in minutes played by first-years, trailing Saint Francis, Kentucky and Army.
- The Revolutionaries accrued 69 starts from first-years in 2023-24, far and away the most in the league. GW was the only school in the A-10 to start four different freshmen at some point last season.
- GW started at least two freshmen in all 31 games and was one of just two schools in the country to have three first-years with 600 or more minutes played (Saint Francis 4).
- The group produced 48% of GW's offense and played 49% of the team's minutes.
- GW received 54 double-digit performances from four different freshmen **Darren Buchanan Jr.** (25), **Garrett Johnson** (16), **Jacoi Hutchinson** (10) and **Trey Autry** (3).

YEAR TWO FOR BUCHANAN

- **Darren Buchanan Jr.** posted one of the strongest seasons of any A-10 player, let alone freshmen, last year and is now ready to ascend into a leadership role in his second year at GW.
- Buchanan led the A-10, among qualifiers, in field goal percentage (54.6) and also ranked among A-10 leaders in rebounding (6.6 rpg, 7th) and scoring (15.6 ppg, 9th).
- He also led all A-10 rookies in scoring and minutes played and became the first A-10 rookie to average 15.5 ppg and 6.5 rpg since UMass' Tre Mitchell in 2019-20. He was the only freshman in the country to put up 15.0 ppg and 6.0 rpg last year.

POINTS A PLENTY

- Through two years under Coach Caputo, GW has established itself as one of the highest-scoring teams in the Atlantic 10.
- In Caputo's first season (2022-23), the Buff & Blue paced the A-10 and ranked 66th nationally with 76.3 ppg. The 2,441 points are the fifth-most scored in a season in program history.
- Last year (2023-24) was on par with GW pouring in 76.8 ppg to rank second in the A-10 and 87th nationally. The Revolutionaries' 2,457 total points are the third-most in program history.
- GW is 28-10 when shooting at least 45% under Coach Caputo (5-23 when it doesn't) and is also 19-3 when scoring at least 80 points (14-30 when it doesn't).

SETTING THE MARK FROM BEYOND THE ARC

- GW set a new program record with 287 3-pointers made and also set the new bar to beat with 796 3-point attempts last season.
- The previous all-time makes record came during the 2016-17 season when GW made 276 triples in 35 games, three more contests than last year's team.
- The top two 3-point makers from last year's team James Bishop IV (71) and Maximus Edwards (53) are no longer with GW and Garrett Johnson (52), who finished third, is out for the season.
- In their place steps Gerald Drumgoole Jr., who has made at least 75 3-pointers in each of his last two seasons, and Trey Moss, who was third on William & Mary with 43 trifectas a year ago.

THE ASCENDING FLOOR GENERAL

- Sophomore point guard **Jacoi Hutchinson** seems primed to take the next step this season after closing the 2023-24 season strong.
- Hutchinson started the final nine games last year, reaching double figures six times and averaging 12.0 ppg, 4.0 rpg and 3.6 apg during the stretch after tallying 5.4 ppg, 2.5 rpg and 1.9 apg over the season's first 23 contests.
- The Laurel, Md., native set all of his career-highs from Feb. 6 on last year, including five steals vs. Rhode Island (Feb. 6), 18 points and seven rebounds at Saint Louis (Feb. 24) and seven assists vs. St. Bonaventure (March 6).
- His shooting numbers also took off in the season's final stretch, making more total field goals (41) and nearly as many threes (17) in the final nine games as he did in the season's first 23 contests (40 FG and 21 3s).
- Hutchinson shot 49% from the floor and 41% from deep in the final month-plus compared to 38% overall and from three prior to moving into the starting lineup full-time.

REPLACING JAMES BISHOP IV

- This season marks the turning of a page with the program's #3 all-time leading scorer, James Bishop IV, graduating after four years with the program.
- Bishop finished his career with 2,103 points in 111 games (18.9 ppg) and also ranked among GW's all-time top 10 in minutes per game (35.8, 1st), 3s made (220, t-3rd), FTs made (471, 4th), FGs made (706, 4th), scoring (18.9, 7th), and assists (447, t-6th).
- Bishop is one of just two players in program history to rank in the top five in points, field goals, 3-pointers, and free throws, joining all-time leading scorer Chris Monroe (2000-03).
- After participating in the NBA2K25 Summer League with the Minnesota Timberwolves, Bishop signed his first professional contract with Kouvot in Finland.

REPPIN' THE DMV

- The Revolutionaries' priority of recruiting home-grown talent has resulted in four players from Washington, D.C., Maryland and Virginia on the roster this season: **Ty Bevins** (Clinton, MD), **Darren Buchanan Jr.** (Washington, DC), **Jacoi Hutchinson** (Laurel, MD) and **Garrett Johnson** (Oakton, VA).
- Additionally, Trey Autry was born in Reston, VA and spent his early childhood living in the DMV before moving to New York.

INTERNATIONAL FLAIR

- Beyond the local recruiting, GW's international footprint expanded this year with the additions of Dayan Nessah (Switzerland) and Mohamed Binzagr (Saudi Arabia) joining Zamoku Weluche-Ume (England) and Keegan Harvey (Australia).
- GW has a storied history with international talent, including Yuta Watanabe (Japan), Patricio Garino (Argentina), Pops Mensah-Bonsu (England) and Yinka Dare (Nigeria), among others.
- Nessah represented Switzerland in the FIBA U18 European Championship this summer, ranking third in the tournament in scoring with 21.4 ppg.
- Binzagr, a junior walk-on, is believed to be the first NCAA basketball player from Saudi Arabia since at least 2014-15.

Chris Caputo enters his third season in charge of the George Washington Men's Basketball program in 2024-25.

Thanks to a quick start in the 2023-24 campaign, Caputo become the fastest GW bench boss to 30 wins since Mike Jarvis in 1990-91, winning 30 of his first 49 games as head coach. GW posted a 14-3 start to the season, its best start since 2015-16 and just the 11th time in program history the Buff & Blue won at least 14 of its first 17 games. Included in the 2023-24 season was an 84-82 road victory at VCU, just the program's second-ever victory at the Siegel Center.

Under Caputo's quidance, three Revolutionaries earned postseason honors from the A-10, including James Bishop IV placing on the All-Conference Third Team, Darren Buchanan Jr. earning All-Rookie honors and Babatunde Akingbola landing on the All-Defensive team after tying the program record for blocks in a season.

The 2023-24 season featured one of the voungest teams in the country with GW ranking third in the NCAA in points scored by first-years and fourth nationally in minutes played by freshmen. GW started at least two freshmen in every game and saw 49% of the offense come from rookies.

Caputo immediately made his mark on the GW basketball in his first year with the program in 2022-23. Under his leadership, the Buff & Blue posted their best regular season in six years, enjoying the most overall wins (16), most Atlantic 10 conference wins (10) and first A-10 winning record since the 2016-17 season.

Caputo recorded the second-most A-10 wins (10) for a first-year GW bench boss in program history and the fourth-most overall wins (16) in GW's A-10 era.

All five starters for the Buff & Blue during 2022-23 enjoyed career seasons, highlighted by First Team All-Conference performer James Bishop IV, A-10 Most Improved Player of the Year and Third Team All-Conference member Brendan Adams and A-10 Rookie of the Year Maximus Edwards.

On April 1, 2022, GW Director of Athletics Tanva Vogel proudly named Chris Caputo as Head Coach of The George Washington University's men's basketball team. Caputo comes to the District as the next step in a coaching career that spans more than two decades, has taken him to a Final Four and, most recently, the Elite Eight of the 2022 NCAA Tournament.

As the world of college basketball continues to evolve, Caputo exhibited a masterful ability to adapt in an ever-changing landscape. Through player development skills honed after more than 20 years in the business, plus a thorough understanding of how to augment a program through the transfer portal, he placed Miami in a position of success as Associate Head Coach in that program's recent March run.

As co-pilot with Final Four coach Jim Larrañaga, Caputo prioritized a style of play that put five players on the court who can be interchangeable and versatile. Caputo recently noted that "putting five guys on the floor that can pass, dribble and shoot makes it very difficult to defend at times when we're able to spread you out. The ability to share the ball, be selfless, (previous teams) taken to that."

Miami's Associate Head Coach since 2015, Caputo has had experience in every area that is required to build a winning program. A skilled scout, recruiter and Xs and Os tactician who served as the team's defensive coordinator, he helped coach the Hurricanes to seven postseason berths, five NCAA appearances, three Sweet 16s and an Elite Eight. Miami was ranked as high as No. 2 in the national polls during his tenure, while numerous coaching peers and outlets have identified him as a premier assistant and soon-to-be head coaching star, highlighted by a CBS Sports poll of 100-plus college coaches who ranked Caputo as one of the three assistants in the nation most likely to someday become a coaching star.

Sports Illustrated also identified Caputo as one of the top assistants ready to make the jump to a head coaching position after his Miami teams joined Duke as the lone ACC programs to have a student-athlete drafted into the NBA every year from 2016-19.

Dating back to his time with Larrañaga at George Mason, Caputo's recruiting chops have yielded success in landing the area's top talent, along with McDonald's All-Americans, Jordan Brand Classic players, and international talent from Australia and New Zealand, countries where emerging athletes have taken the basketball world by storm in recent

The architect of Top 25 defenses nationally, Caputo has shown his commitment to academics in his mentorship of a previous Skip Prosser Award recipient, presented annually to the top scholar-athlete in ACC men's basketball, a conference that boasts some of the finer academic institutions of higher education in the country. Graduation success has been a priority throughout Caputo's decorated assistant coaching career.

A multi-time participant in the esteemed Villa 7 Consortium, an educational symposium and networking opportunity for some of the nation's top assistants, Caputo has done everything from serving as a video coordinator, to managing databases and mailing systems, while serving in various administrative capacities.

Originally from Elmhurst, N.Y., Caputo is a 2002 graduate of Westfield (Mass.) State University with a degree in finance and economics. He was a four-year letter winner as a point guard for the Division III Owls, served as captain and earned the team's Outstanding Contributor Award as a senior. He is a 1998 graduate of Archbishop Molloy High School.
