KEY STORYLINES

GW VS. DELAWARE

• GW welcomes Delaware to the Smith Center on Wednesday for a 7 p.m. tip on ESPN+ and Monumental Sports Network.

• The Buff & Blue look to maintain their perfect home record, having won each of their five home games by double digits and by an average margin of 26.6 points per game.

• Delaware is 2-6 on the year and is coming off an overtime loss to in-state foe Delaware State, 75-72, on Saturday.

LAST TIME OUT

• GW returned home and outpaced William & Mary on Saturday night, 99-86, in the Smith Center's 50th Anniversary celebration.

• **Jean Aranguren** became the fourth Revolutionary to score 20 points in a game this season and the fifth different player to lead the team in scoring through the first 10 games.

• GW shot 53% on the day, scored 62 points in the paint and had five in double figures overall, including three off the bench (Aranguren, **Luke Hunger** and **Tyrone Marshall Jr.**).

RECORD-SETTING OFFENSE

• Saturday was already GW's sixth game crossing the 90-point threshold, tied for the 7th most 90+ games in a single season and most times doing so since 2000-01 (6).

• The next game scoring 90 would be the most since doing so eight times in 1999-00. The school record is 10 times set twice in 1968-69 and 1952-53.

• The Buff & Blue have scored at least 84 points in nine consecutive games and are averaging 91.4 ppg, 5.5 more points than the current school record of 85.9 ppg set back in 1952-53. GW hasn't averaged even 80.0 ppg in a season since 1999-00 (80.6).

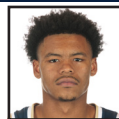

HISTORY VS. DELAWARE

• GW and Delaware meet for the fourth time in the last seven seasons and the first time since a neutral-site clash in the Bahamas two years ago.

• The Blue Hens are visiting Smith Center for the first time since 2019. GW is 3-0 in home games vs. Delaware at Smith.

• GW's marquee non-conference game awaits on Saturday when the Buff & Blue travel to Sunrise, Fla., for a matchup with the defending national champions and #18 Florida.

• Tip is scheduled for 2:30 p.m. on ESPN2 from Amerant Bank Arena, the home of the NHL's Florida Panthers.

A LOOK AT THE BLUE HENS

• Delaware enters play on Wednesday with a 2-6 mark following an overtime loss at Delaware State on Saturday.

• The Blue Hens are in their first year in Conference USA after being a longstanding CAA member and advancing to the conference championship game a year ago.

• Martin Inglesby is in his 10th year in charge of the Blue Hens, having advance to the NCAA Tournament in 2022 after winning the CAA Championship.

• Four players are averaging double figures this year, led by Macon Emery's 14.5 ppg. Christian Bliss and Justyn Fernandez chip in 14.4 ppg each and Tyler Houser provides 12.8 ppg.

• UD is 22nd nationally in 3-point percentage at 39.1% and gets 42% of their points from beyond the arc, 11th-most nationally.

MORE ON THE OFFENSE

• The Buff & Blue rank within the top-25 nationally in multiple offensive categories including free throws per game (21.8, 6th), free throw attempts per game (28.5, 10th), scoring offense (91.4, 14th), effective field goal percentage (58.8%, 21st), bench points (37.2, 21st) and field goal percentage (51.2%, 22nd).

• GW currently ranks 20th nationally in KenPom's adjusted offensive efficiency, the highest ranking and overall efficiency (120.7).

• GW's 107 points on Nov. 12 vs. American were the most for the program in regulation since putting up 108 vs. Maine in 2013.

CASTRO ON THE CLIMB

• **Rafael Castro** has showcased his A-10 Player of the Year capability, reaching double figures in nine consecutive games with three 20-point efforts and two double-doubles sprinkled in.

• Castro is the only player in the country putting up at least 16.0 ppg and 7.5 rpg while playing less than 23.0 mpg.

• Since being held to seven points in the season opener vs. Maine, Castro is averaging 17.1 ppg, 8.0 rpg, 1.8 apg and 1.2 spg while shooting 67.1% from the field.

• Despite the lower workload than last year, the redshirt senior is third the A-10 in total rebounds (76) and rebounds per game (7.6) while ranking second in defensive rebounds per game (5.9).

• A Preseason First Team All-A-10 selection, Castro also paces the league in field goal percentage (66.7%), free throw makes (57) and free throw attempts (78).

JOHNSON SHINING IN RETURN TO COURT

• **Garrett Johnson** made his official return to the court on Nov. 12 vs. American, appearing for the first time since Feb. 13, 2024. He has made up for lost time by jumping in as GW's second-leading scorer, averaging 14.9 ppg and shooting 37% from deep.

• In the Cayman Islands Classic opener vs. McNeese, Johnson set a new career-high with 26 points off the bench, making 7-of-10 shots overall and 5-of-8 from beyond the arc.

• It marked the fourth time in Johnson's career that he's hit five 3-pointers in a game as he has hit 2+ 3s in 19 of 30 career games.

• Johnson missed the final eight games of his redshirt freshman season due to pain stemming from a benign desmoid tumor in his left hip that he's undergone 22 rounds of chemotherapy for to minimize the effect. He then missed all of last season due to a torn ACL and did not appear in either of the first two games this season.

• In total, Johnson missed 44 straight games and went 638 days between appearances for the Revolutionaries before returning.

BENCH BOSSES

• GW's bench has scored 30 or more points in seven games this season, including a pair of 50+ performances against American (54) and McNeese (53).

• Two of GW's top four scoring leaders - **Garrett Johnson** and **Tre Dinkins** - have come off the bench in 15 of their 18 appearances.

• The Revolutionaries are 21st nationally (3rd A-10) with 37.2 bench points per game and 17 of the 46 double-digit performances have come from reserves.

ARANGUREN'S BREAKOUT

• **Jean Aranguren** became the fourth different Revolutionary with a 20-point game, tallying a season-best 20 points and five assists on Saturday vs. William & Mary.

• It marked the 11th 20-point game of his career, having done so seven times last year at Hofstra and thrice in 2023-24 with Iona.

• Aranguren has reached double digits four times this year and is shooting a robust 57.7% from the field after entering the season as a career 43% shooter.

UNMATCHED BALANCE

• George Washington is one of three teams in the country (Alabama, Eastern Kentucky) to boast nine players averaging at least 7.0 ppg. Impressively, all nine are doing so while only playing between 16.5 and 27.0 mpg.

• All nine players have reached double figures at least once this season with five different leading scorers in the first 10 games. Additionally, four of the nine are averaging double figures, one off the national lead of 34 teams with five double-figure scorers.

• GW put seven in double digits vs. American, the first time doing so since at least 2004 and tied for the most by any team in any game across the nation this season.

TRE'S TREYS

• **Tre Dinkins** set a new career-high with seven made 3-pointers vs. American (11/12), surging to his second-straight, 20-point performance while coming off the bench.

• Dinkins is third in the A-10 in 3-point attempts (61), fourth with 26 made 3s and 3-point % (42.6) and fifth in 3s per game (92.6)

• Dinkins has led his teams in 3-pointers each of the last two seasons, making 85 at Canisius in 2023-24 and 77 at Duquesne last year. For his career, the graduate student has made 221 triples at the D-I level in 104 games (2.1 per game).

HUNGRY FOR MORE

• Graduate transfer **Luke Hunger** tallied his first career double-double on Nov. 19 vs. UMBC, registering 13 points to go along with a career-best 10 rebounds.

• Hunger has scored 22 points in the last two games (11.0 ppg) combined in just 23:32 of playing time, going a perfect 7-of-7 from the field and 8-of-9 at the free throw line.

• The season has been a coming-out party for the Northwestern transfer, who has now posted four double-digit scoring efforts in 10 games after doing so just five times in 58 games for the Wildcats.

• Hunger tied his career-high with 15 points in the opener against Maine, his first 10+ performance since Nov. 12, 2024 vs. UIC.

NEW HEIGHTS

• The Buff & Blue are 47th in the NCAA's NET rankings as of Friday, ranking third in the A-10. This past Sunday's ranking of 42 was the highest for the program since the inception of the NET, surpassing the previous high of 86 set in December 2024.

• GW has continued to climb the analytic rankings found on the NCAA's team sheet come March, currently ranking 56th in Bart Torvik (#3 A-10) and 61st in Kenpom (#3 A-10).

Caputo helped author GW's best season in nearly a decade in 2024-25, culminating in the program's first postseason bid in eight seasons with a trip to the College Basketball Crown. GW posted 20 wins in the regular season for the first time since 2015-16 and finished with 21 triumphs on the year, its most in nine years.

The 16th 20-win season in program history was headlined by the development of Second Team All-Conference selection Rafael Castro in his first year with the program after transferring in prior to the year. Castro was also named to the A-10 All-Defensive team and redshirt freshman Christian Jones earned a spot on the league's All-Rookie team.

Thanks to a quick start in the 2023-24 campaign, Caputo became the fastest GW bench boss to 30 wins since Mike Jarvis in 1990-91, winning 30 of his first 49 games as head coach. GW posted a 14-3 start to the season, its best start since 2015-16 and just the 11th time in program history the Buff & Blue won at least 14 of its first 17 games. Included in the 2023-24 season was an 84-82 road victory at VCU, just the program's second-ever victory at the Siegel Center.

Under Caputo's guidance, three Revolutionaries earned postseason honors from the A-10, including James Bishop IV placing on the All-Conference Third Team, Darren Buchanan Jr. earning All-Rookie honors and Babatunde Akingbola landing on the All-Defensive team after tying the program record for blocks in a season.

Caputo immediately made his mark on the GW basketball in his first year with the program in 2022-23. Under his leadership, the Buff & Blue posted their best regular season in six years, enjoying the most overall wins (16), most Atlantic 10 conference wins (10) and first A-10 winning record since the 2016-17 season.

Caputo recorded the second-most A-10 wins (10) for a first-year GW bench boss in program history and the fourth-most overall wins (16) in GW's A-10 era.

All five starters for the Buff & Blue during 2022-23 enjoyed career seasons, highlighted by First Team All-Conference performer James Bishop IV, A-10 Most Improved Player of the Year and Third Team All-Conference member Brendan Adams and A-10 Rookie of the Year Maximus Edwards.

On April 1, 2022, GW Director of Athletics Tanya Vogel proudly named Chris Caputo as Head Coach of The George Washington University's men's basketball team. Caputo came to the District as the next step in a coaching career that spans more than two decades, has taken him to a Final Four and, most recently, the Elite Eight of the 2022 NCAA Tournament.

As the world of college basketball continues to evolve, Caputo exhibited a masterful ability to adapt in an ever-changing landscape. Through player development skills honed after more than 20 years in the business, plus a thorough understanding of how to augment a program through the transfer

portal, he placed Miami in a position of success as Associate Head Coach in that program's recent March run.

As co-pilot with Final Four coach Jim Larrañaga, Caputo prioritized a style of play that put five players on the court who can be interchangeable and versatile. Caputo recently noted that "putting five guys on the floor that can pass, dribble and shoot makes it very difficult to defend at times when we're able to spread you out. The ability to share the ball, be selfless, (previous teams) taken to that."

Miami's Associate Head Coach since 2015, Caputo has had experience in every area that is required to build a winning program. A skilled scout, recruiter and Xs and Os tactician who served as the team's defensive coordinator, he helped coach the Hurricanes to seven postseason berths, five NCAA appearances, three Sweet 16s and an Elite Eight. Miami was ranked as high as No. 2 in the national polls during his tenure, while numerous coaching peers and outlets have identified him as a premier assistant and soon-to-be head coaching star, highlighted by a CBS Sports poll of 100-plus college coaches who ranked Caputo as one of the three assistants in the nation most likely to someday become a coaching star.

Sports Illustrated also identified Caputo as one of the top assistants ready to make the jump to a head coaching position after his Miami teams joined Duke as the lone ACC programs to have a student-athlete drafted into the NBA every year from 2016-19.

Dating back to his time with Larrañaga at George Mason, Caputo's recruiting chops have yielded success in landing the area's top talent, along with McDonald's All-Americans, Jordan Brand Classic players, and international talent from Australia and New Zealand, countries where emerging athletes have taken the basketball world by storm in recent years.

The architect of Top 25 defenses nationally, Caputo has shown his commitment to academics in his mentorship of a previous Skip Prosser Award recipient, presented annually to the top scholar-athlete in ACC men's basketball, a conference that boasts some of the finer academic institutions of higher education in the country. Graduation success has been a priority throughout Caputo's decorated assistant coaching career.

A multi-time participant in the esteemed Villa 7 Consortium, an educational symposium and networking opportunity for some of the nation's top assistants, Caputo has done everything from serving as a video coordinator, to managing databases and mailing systems, while serving in various administrative capacities.

Originally from Elmhurst, N.Y., Caputo is a 2002 graduate of Westfield (Mass.) State University with a degree in finance and economics. He was a four-year letter winner as a point guard for the Division III Owls, served as captain and earned the team's Outstanding Contributor Award as a senior. He is a 1998 graduate of Archbishop Molloy High School.
