SCOUTING UT MARTIN

UT Martin comes into the contest with a 2-3 overall record and 0-1 in Big South/OVC action. The Skyhawks lost a heartbreaking 45-42, double-overtime contest at league-leading Southeast Missouri on September 7. However, UTM picked up wins over North Alabama (43-28) and Kennesaw State (24-13). Heading into the contest with Gardner-Webb, UT Martin is led by Patrick Smith who has rushed for a conference-leading 476 yards and six touchdowns. Smith averages just under 100 yards per game on the ground. The Skyhawks have a pair of quarterbacks that split time as each have tossed for more than 400 yards apiece. Kinkead Dent leads UTM with 549 yards through the air and five TDs. Trevonte Rucker leads the receiving corps with 19 catches and 265 yards to go along with four scores.

CRIS REISERT

HEAD COACH | 1ST SEASON | OHIO DOMINICAN '11

In 2024, Reisert enters his first season at Gardner-Webb. He most recently spent five seasons as the head coach at Tiffin University (Ohio), where he compiled an overall record of 40-11 (.784 win pct.) and a Great Midwest Conference (GMAC) record of 32-4 (.889).

At Tiffin, Reisert led his team to three GMAC championships (2019, 2020, 2023) and was named GMAC Coach of the Year in each of those championship seasons. This past season, his most successful team posted an 11-1 record, completing the regular season unbeaten before losing in the second round of the Division II national playoffs. With Reisert also handling offensive coordinator duties, the 2023 Tiffin Dragons finished ranked in the top 25 nationally in scoring offense (43.7 PPG, 6th), total offense (482.9 YPG, 4th), scoring defense (16.2 PPG allowed, T-16th), and total defense (281.2 YPG allowed, 22nd).

During his tenure at Tiffin, Reisert's other notable accomplishments included the first two Division II playoff berths in school history (2019 and 2023), the highest national ranking in school history (No. 9), and the program's first win over its primary rival (University of Findlay) in 22 years. In total, Reisert's team defeated Findlay three times in five meetings. Reisert's 40 total wins in five seasons were the most career wins by any head coach in his first five seasons in Tiffin's history.

Prior to Tiffin, Reisert spent two seasons as the offensive coordinator at his alma mater, Ohio Dominican University in Columbus. In seven seasons as the primary play caller, Reisert's teams have averaged 38 points per game and 455 yards per game.

In his stops at Ohio Dominican and Tiffin, Reisert has built a reputation for leaving an immediate impact. In 2017, his first at Ohio Dominican, the offense improved by 11.5 points and 123 yards per game, as compared to the previous season. He authored the same success in year one at Tiffin (2019), boasting a 13-point and 83-yard improvement on average.

Reisert is ready to begin work at Gardner-Webb. "It is a tremendous honor to be selected as the head football coach at Gardner-Webb University," Reisert asserted. "This is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for me and my family and we can't wait to get started building upon the amazing tradition of Gardner-Webb football. Thank you to President Downs, Dr. Goodrich and the Board of Trustees for the opportunity; we are eager to join the Cleveland County community and get to work!"

In 2021, Reisert was selected to the American Football Coaches Association's 35 Under 35 list. Other stops in his coaching career include three seasons as tight ends coach at Elon University (2014-2016), one season as an assistant offensive line coach at Ball State University (2013), and two seasons in a prior stint at Ohio Dominican as the wide receivers coach (2011-2012).

As a player, Reisert started four years at quarterback for Ohio Dominican, where he was named the 2007 National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) National Player of the Year and a two-time All-American. He was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2019.

Reisert holds a bachelor's (2009) and master's degree (2011) in business administration from Ohio Dominican. He and his wife Emily have two children, a son Hawkins and a daughter Lennox.

THE GAME

This marks the 6th overall meeting between Gardner-Webb and the Skyhawks of UT Martin.

SERIES NOTES

Gardner-Webb leads the overall series by a tally of 3-2. After taking the first two games of the series in 2001 and 2002, the Runnin' Bulldogs would drop home and away matchups in 2005 and 2006 to UTM. Following a 17-year break in action, GWU bested the Skyhawks last season with a thrilling 38-34 win, giving UT Martin its only conference loss of the season.

WHAT A SCHEDULE

Gardner-Webb has a tough stretch of games to kickoff the year. After the home opener with Wofford, the Runnin' Bulldogs travel to FBS James Madison on September 7. Gardner-Webb has five total home games this season, facing off against Tennessee Tech (9/28), Lindenwood (10/19), Eastern Illinois (11/9), and Tennessee State (11/16).

THE NEW HEAD BALL COACH

Head Coach Cris Reisert brings his coaching ability to The Webb after four successful seasons at the helm of Division II Tiffin University. During his tenure, Reisert compiled a 40-11 overall record.

BEWARE OF DAWG

The Runnin' Bulldogs start the quest for a third consecutive Big South/OVC Championship and the conference's automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs. With a lot of new faces on campus, Gardner-Webb will put its hard work and effort over the summer to the test when Wofford visits Spangler Stadium.

- Five teams on Gardner-Webb's schedule finished the 2023 campaign with a winning record while three of those teams won eight or more games
- Gardner-Webb had six games last season with 350+ yards of total offense and four with more than 400 yards of total offense

THE HEAD COACHES

Gardner-Webb head coach Cris Reisert enters his first season at the helm of the Runnin' Bulldogs program after spending the past five seasons at Division II Tiffin. While with the Dragons, Reisert compiled a 40-11 record while qualifying for the playoffs on a pair of occasions. Shawn Watson is in his second year at Wofford and holds an overall career record of 13-31 and 2-9 at WC.

LOOKING FOR THE THREE-PEAT

Gardner-Webb enters the season looking to three-peat as conference champions after winning the title in the past two seasons. Prior to the 2022 campaign, the Runnin' Bulldogs had went two decades without being crowned the top team.

Over the past two seasons, Gardner-Webb has a conference record of 10-1, going undefeated at 5-0 in the '22 slate. The Runnin' Bulldogs have went back-to-back with conference championships on a pair of occasions, but this year's team looks to make history with the third consecutive hoist of the trophy.

NEW FACES ON CAMPUS

Gardner-Webb hit the transfer portal and recruiting trail hard in the offseason, bringing in a plethora of new talent to compliment a variety of returning players. In total, Coach Reisert brought in 46 student-athletes, including 27 high school players and 19 mid-year transfers. The recruiting class also represents 15 states and one international student-athlete.

WOWSLEY

Raequan Ousley looks to continue his impressive career at Gardner-Webb as he leads the defensive secondary. Following a remarkable 2022 season, Ousley followed that up with 25 tackles, one interceptions and eight pass breakups for the Runnin' Bulldogs.

ROAD TRIP

After hosting Wofford on opening night, the Runnin' Bulldogs will not see the friendly confines of Spangler Stadium for three weeks as trips to James Madison (9/7), Charlotte (9/14) , and Presbyterian (9/21) levy the early portion of the schedule. Gardner-Webb will play one home game in September, hosting Tennessee Tech on 9/28 and one home game in October as it plays Lindenwood on 10/19. GWU finishes the season with home contests against Eastern Illinois (11/9) and Tennessee State (11/16).

GROUND'S OFF LIMITS

Gardner-Webb ranked second in the Big South/OVC after allowing only 111.3 rushing yards per game. Forcing the opponents to pass did not fare well for the visitors as the Bulldogs pass rush racked up a 204 sacks, good enough for second in the conference.

SPECIAL TEAMS ARE VERY SPECIAL

The Runnin' Bulldogs special teams unit were near the top in conference play throughout the year in several categories. The kicking unit in particular stood out after connecting on 41-of-41 extra point attempts and 9-of-13 field goals.

COMING OUT STRONG

Gardner-Webb football is 27-24-2 all-time in season opening games. The Runnin' Bulldogs longest win streak game from 1999-2003, when GWU won five straight season opening games. Gardner-Webb and App State played the season opener in 1989, a 43-7 win for the Mountaineers. Under Tre Lamb, GWU is 2-1 in season openers, including a 42-20 win in his first game as head coach in the 2021 spring season. The two ties came in 1974 against Lenoir-Rhyne and in 1988 against Knoxville College.

BONJOUR

Gardner-Webb defensive stalwart William McRaney (6-0, 228, Sr.) capped off his Runnin' Bulldogs career with three consecutive First Team All-Conference selections. The senior led Gardner-Webb in the regular season with 90 tackles, picking up 11 tackles in back-to-back games against Austin Peay and Robert Morris, and 14 tackles, along with an interception, against Eastern Kentucky. McRaney now has 323 tackles for his career, just the 20th player in GWU football history to do so and the 13th most for any Gardner-Webb player in program history. McRaney also had five pass break ups, including one on a two-point conversion to preserve a 45-44 win for GWU over Bryant. McRaney also got the job done in the classroom, earning Big South-OVC Scholar Athlete of the Year honors while also being named a finalist for the Doris Robinson Scholar Athlete Award, given to an FCS student-athlete who excels on the playing field, in the classroom and across the community.

IN CASE YOU WERE WONDERING

- * Gardner-Webb University's 225-acre campus is located 50 miles west of Charlotte, N.C., in Boiling Springs, N.C. The school is also approximately an hours drive from both Asheville, N.C., and Greenville, S.C.
- * Gardner-Webb's main campus is 11.6 miles from the South Carolina state line.
- * Gardner-Webb conferred an honorary doctor of humanities degree upon legendary singer Johnny Cash on September 28, 1971 in Ernest W. Spangler Stadium. Cash also performed a concert that day in front of an announced crowd of 12,000.
- * Gardner-Webb is named after former North Carolina Governor O. Max Gardner and his wife, Faye Webb Gardner. Founded as Boiling Springs High School in 1905 and became Boiling Springs Junior College in 1928. Renamed Gardner-Webb Junior College in 1942.
- * Gardner-Webb University and Boiling Springs hosted the 1996 U.S. Olympic Trials for Cycling.
- * The first game as a junior college came on September 14, 1928 vs. Kings Mountain High School (25-6 W)
- * Ernest W. Spangler Stadium was opened on October 8, 1966 with a 21-2 win over Chowan College. Facility was renovated in 2004 to its current configuration.
- * The largest attendance for a home football game on record is 8,490 vs. No. 2 (FCS) Appalachian State on September 23, 2006.
- * The team won conference titles in 1930, 1933, 1951, 1952, 1955, 1956, 1961, 1962, 1963, 1964, 1965, 1966, 1987, 1992, 2002 and 2003, 2022. Program also appeared in the 1974 NAIA Poultry Bowl and hosted the NAIA National Championship Bowl in 1992. The Dawgs made their first appearance in the FCS Playoffs last season, defeating Eastern Kentucky 52-41 in the first round.
- * Jim Childers, a tackle from Greenville, S.C., and George Mauney, an end from Lexington, N.C., were Gardner-Webb's first All-Conference selections in 1932.
